APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KP SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 READ WITH CLAUSE XIV OF POSTING TRANSFER POLICY, AGAINST THE IMPUGNED ADJUSTMENT (TRANSFER) ORDER DATED 06.01.2022 AND REJECTION OF DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL ORDER DATED 19.01.2022 WITHIN 15 DAYS AS PROVIDED UNDER CLAUSE XIV OF THE POSTING TRANSFER POLICY.

PRAYER:

THAT ON THE ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPEAL THE ADJUSTMENT/TRANSFER ORDER DATED 06.01.2022 AND REJECTION ORDER DATED 19.01.2022 MAY PLEASE BE SET ASIDE AND THE APPELLANT MAY BE ADJUSTED AGAINST THE POST OF PSHT (BPS-15) AT ANY NEAR SCHOOL FROM PLACE OF HIS RESIDENCE(plan area), SWABI DUE TO HIS MEDICAL DISABILITY ON HUMANITARIAN GROUND UNDER THE POSTING TRANSFER POLICY. ANY OTHER

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**REMEDY WHICH THIS AUGUST TRIBUNAL DEEMS
FIT AND APPROPRIATE THAT MAY ALSO BE
AWARDED IN FAVOUR OF THE APPELLANT.**

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:

FACTS:

1. That the appellant is a respectable citizen of Pakistan and is serving in the Education Department as PSHT (BPS-15).
2. That the appellant has been giving his services to the department with utmost dedication and honesty for many years, and up to the entire satisfaction of his superiors.
3. That the appellant through Order dated 06.01.2022 along with other SPSTs (BPS-14) was promoted to PSHT (BPS-15) and adjusted at different schools throughout district Swabi. **Copy of Impugned Order dated 06.01.2022 is attached as Annexure - A.**
4. That the appellant through the impugned order dated 06.01.2022 was adjusted at GPS Seri Utmanzai (G), Swabi which is a hilly area and quite far from the appellant as he has difficulty in walking and movement due to his medical condition as he had subtrochanteric fracture femur (right) with external fixation. Due to his medical condition he has even been declared disabled by a government authorized medical board. **Copy of Disability Certificate & other related documents are attached as Annexure - B.**
5. That the appellant then submitted a departmental appeal on 12.01.2022 against the impugned adjustment/transfer order to the department but sadly, the departmental appeal of the appellant was rejected on 19.01.2022. **Copy of the Departmental Appeal dated 12.01.2022 & Rejection Order dated 19.01.2022 are attached as Annexure - C & D.**
6. That now the appellant comes to this august Tribunal for the redressal of his grievances on the following grounds amongst others.

GROUND:

- A) That the adjustment/posting order dated 06.01.2022 and 19.01.2022 are against norms of justice, material on record and also against the Principles of Natural Justice therefore, not tenable and liable to be set aside.

- B) That the impunged orders were issued without considering the medical condition of the appellant which is violation of the government laid down Posting Transfer Policy. Copy of Posting Transfer Policy is attached as Annexure - E.
- C) That the opportunity of personal hearing and personal defense was not provided to the appellant which is against the spirit of Article 10-A of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
- D) That the appellant also filed this appeal on grave humaniatarian ground. In the same situation the tribunal already accepted the appeal titled Jamal Ahmad Vs. Govt. of KP. So the appellant is also entitled to the same relief.
- E) That such long traveling and then walking distance is required to reached at the place of posting because the place of posting of appellant is at hilly area and it is impossible for the appellant to reached at this place. So the impugned adjustment order is illegal and against the natural justice.
- F) That in the special circumstances of the case and due to urgency in the instant appeal as being transfer matter the appeal of the appellant may be heard in the light of posting policy and order dated 03.06.2021 of this august Tribunal in Service Appeal No.5338/2021.
- G) That the appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.

Posting and Transfer

Statutory Provision.

Section 10 of the NWFP Civil Servants Act, 1973.

Posting and Transfer. Every civil servant shall be liable to serve anywhere within or outside the Province, in any post under the Federal Government, or any Provincial Government or Local authority, or a Corporation or body set up or established by any such Government:-

Provided that nothing contained in this section shall apply to a civil servant recruited specifically to serve in a particular area or region;

Provided further that, where a civil servant is required to serve in a post outside a service or cadre, his terms and conditions of service as to his pay shall not be less favourable than those to which he would have been entitled if he had not been so required to serve.

POSTING / TRANSFER POLICY OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT

- i) ~~All the posting/transfers shall be strictly in public interest and shall not be abused/misused to victimize the Government servants~~
- ii) All Government servants are prohibited to exert political, Administrative or any other pressures upon the posting/transfer authorities for seeking posting/transfers of their choice and against the public interest.
- iii) All contract Government employees appointed against specific posts, can not be posted against any other post.
- iv) The normal tenure of posting shall be three years subject to the condition that for the officers/officials posted in unattractive areas the tenure shall be two years and for the hard areas the tenure shall be one year. The unattractive and hard areas will be notified by the Government.
- v) { }
- vi) While making postings/transfer from settled areas to FATA and vice-versa, specific approval of Governor, NWFP needs to be obtained.

needs to be obtained. Whereas, in case of posting/transfer of officers in BS-18 and above, from settled areas to FATA and vice versa, specific approval of the Governor NWFP shall be obtained.

- vi (a) All Officers/officials selected against Zone-I/FATA quota in the Provincial Services should compulsorily serve in FATA for at least eighteen months in each grade. This should start from senior most scales/grades downwards in each scale/grade of each cadre.
- vii) Officers may be posted on executive/administrative posts in the Districts of their domicile except District Coordination Officers (D.C.Os) and DPOs/Superintendent of Police (SP). Similarly Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) shall not be posted at a place where the Police Station (Thaana) of his area/residence is situated.
- viii) No posting/transfers of the officer's/officials on detailment basis shall be made.
- ix) Regarding the posting of husband/wife, both in Provincial services, efforts where possible would be made to post such persons at one station subject to the public interest.
- x) All the posting/transferring authorities may facilitate the posting/transfer of the unmarried female government Servants at the station of the residence of their parents.
- xi) Officers/officials except DCOs and DPOs/SPs who are due to retire within one year may be posted on their option on posts in the Districts of their domicile and be allowed to serve there till the retirement
2 DCOs and DPOs who are due to retire in the near future may also be posted in the District of their domicile subject to the condition that such posting would be against non-administrative posts of equivalent scales;
- xii) In terms of Rule-17(1) and (2) read with Schedule-III of the NWFP Government Rules of Business 1985, transfer of officers shown in column 1 of the following table shall be made by the authorities shown against each officer in column 2 thereof:

xiii) While considering posting/transfer proposals all the concerned authorities shall keep in mind the following:

- a) To ensure the posting of proper persons on proper posts, the Performance Evaluation Report/annual confidential reports, past and present record of service, performance on post held presently and in the past and general reputation with focus on the integrity of the concerned officers/officials be considered.
- b) Tenure on present post shall also be taken into consideration and the posting/transfers shall be in the best public interest.

xiv) ✓ Government servants including District Govt. employees feeling aggrieved due to the orders of posting/transfer authorities may seek remedy from the next higher authority / the appointing authority as the case may be through an appeal to be submitted within seven days of the receipt of such orders.

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ESTA CODE [Establishment Code Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] 87

Such appeal shall be disposed of within fifteen days. The option of appeal against posting/ transfer orders could be exercised only in the following cases.

- i) Pre-mature posing/transfer or posting transfer in violation of the provisions of this policy.
- ii) Serious and grave personal (humanitarian) grounds.

2. To streamline the postings/transfers in the District Government and to remove any irritant/confusions in this regard the provision of Rule 25 of the North West Frontier Province District Government Rules of Business 2001 read with schedule - IV thereof is referred. As per schedule-IV the posting/transferring authorities for the officers/officials shown against each are as under:-

1.	Posting of District Coordination Officer and Executive District Officer in a District.	Provincial Government.
2.	Posting of District Police Officer.	Provincial Government
3.	Other Officers in BPS-17 and above posted in the District.	Provincial Government
4.	Official in BPS-16 and below	Executive District Officer in consultation with District Coordination Officer.

3. As per Rule 25(2) of the Rules mentioned above the District Coordination Department shall consult the Government if it is proposed to:

- a) Transfer the holder of a tenure post before the completion of his tenure or extend the period of his tenure.
- b) Require an officer to hold charge of more than one post for a period exceeding two months.

4. I am further directed to request that the above noted policy may be strictly observed /implemented.

5. All concerned are requested to ensure that tenures of the concerned officers/officials are invariably mentioned in summaries submitted to the Competent Authorities for Posting/Transfer.
