JUDGEMENT: -

Mr. ATIQ UR REHMAN WAZIR: - Brief facts of the case are that the appellant, Mr. Rambail Khan, while serving as Deputy District Education Officer (DDEO) Dera Ismail Khan, was proceeded against on the charges of unlawful release of salaries to a class-iv employee. On the basis of inquiry conducted to this effect, charge sheet/statement of allegations were served upon appellant, to which he responded, thereafter issue show cause notice to the appellant, which also was accordingly responded and as a resulted thereof, major penalty of removal from service was imposed upon appellant. Feeling aggrieved, the appellant filed review petition before the competent forum, which was accepted and major penalty of removal from service was converted into major penalty of compulsory retirement from service, but in the meanwhile the appellant had already filed the instant service appeal, hence the appellant requested for amendment in

- service appeal, which was accepted. The appellant prayed for setting aside the impugned order dated 12-04-2018 and his re-instatement with all back benefits.
- 02. Written reply/comments were submitted by respondents.
- 03. Arguments heard and record perused.
- 04. Learned counsel for the appellant contended that no regular inquiry was conducted in case of appellant skipping the mandatory provisions of law. No opportunity of personal hearing as well as opportunity to cross-examine witnesses was afforded to the appellant, whereas in case of imposing major penalty, the principles of natural justice requires that a regular inquiry be conducted and proper opportunity of defense be provided to the civil servant proceeded against, Non adoption of required mandatory procedure would result in miscarriage of justice. Reliance was placed on 2008 SCMR 1369, 2002 SCMR 433, 1997 SCMR 1543, 2012 PLC (CS) 728 and 2012 PLC (CS) 166. The learned counsel further added that action against the appellant was discriminatory to the effect that five other accused in the issue were also recommended for imposition of major penalty but only the appellant was targeted and the remaining accused were exonerated of the charges, who however, were more responsible than the appellant. That such penalty is not tenable in the eyes of law and not warranted. Reliance was placed on 1993 PLC (CSI) 1754. The learned counsel contended that the appellant was charged on the allegations that source-1 of salary of Mr. Younas Class-iv was signed by the appellant, who however refused genuineness of such signatures, which was not accepted, whereas in case of other accused, refusal from signature was accepted, which too was discriminatory. That inspite of the fact that the concerned class-iv in his statement has categorically accepted that he himself prepared such documents and the appellant was not responsible for such act. That attributing such signatures to appellant is based on presumption having no evidence on its back and facts had to be proved and not presumed particularly for awarding major penalty.

Reliance was placed on 2002 PLC (CS) 503. The learned counsel further added that the preliminary inquiry conducted to this effect, clearly manifests that all the documents right from the letter of appointment up to his salary document including the stamp used throughout the pay activation process is fake. Besides the statement of class-iv obtained to this effect also testifies to the fact that such signatures were not affixed by the appellant, but still the formal inquiry apportioned such responsibility on the appellant solely on the presumption that he was incumbent of the post of Deputy Director, who deals in such cases. The learned counsel added that appellant is totally innocent in this case, which is evident from the statements of the class-iv and other coaccused as well as the preliminary inquiry and prayed that the impugned order may be set aside and the appellant may be re-instated into service with all back benefits.

- 05. Learned Assistant Advocate General appeared on behalf of official respondents contended that regular inquiry was conducted against the appellant and others, where proper chance of defense was provided to the appellant including personal hearing. That as a result of inquiry conducted to this effect, the appellant was held responsible for the unlawful drawl of salaries in respect of a fake employee due to the reason that he was responsible for submission of source-1 form to District Accounts Office, which he submitted under his signature and which clearly depicts that the appellant was responsible for such act. That the competent authority taking a lenient view has converted the penalty of removal from service into compulsory retirement, deserve no further leniency, hence the instant appeal may be dismissed.
- 06. We have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record. It was noted that one Mr. Younas employed as class-IV was declared fake after investigation and preliminary inquiry was conducted to ascertain the genuineness of his appointment order and subsequent drawl of salaries. The inquiry conducted so found that appointment letter, charge assumption report, his transfer orders and other related documents were fake having no official record. The official stamps used in the process

was also declared fake. The fake employee in his statement recorded before the inquiry officer also pointed out that he was assisted by one clerk namely Arshad in activation of his salary with no mention of the appellant. Because of inquiry, the fake employee Mr. Younas was terminated from service along with recovery of the salaries drawn. It was further noted that the formal inquiry in its findings has attributed the activation of salary of the fake employee for the first time to Ex-DDEO Mr. Taus Khan and Ex-DEO, Mr. Feruz Hussain Shah, but since they refused such signatures, hence their excuse was accepted and salary of the fake employee was stopped, yet the fake employee maneuvered to release his salaries again through fake submission of papers under the signature of the appellant, which was also denied by the appellant but his denial was not accepted, which was discriminatory. Record reveals that three inquires conducted to this effect concludes that the whole process of appointment as well as drawl of salaries by the fake employee was done under fake signatures and stamps. It was also noted that other co-accused in the issue were also recommended for major penalty, but they were exonerated for their denial from their signatures. The appellant was charged on the presumption that he was incumbent during the occurrence, the fake employee however, in his written statement recorded before the formal inquiry has also mentioned that one clerk Mr. Arshad assisted him in activation of salary and the appellant was declared innocent, still the appellant was penalized, which was an act of discrimination on part of the respondents. The appellant also need the same treatment as was done with other co-accused. The inquiry so conducted is also replete with deficiencies and which cannot be termed as a regular inquiry to substantiate their claims with evidences, as no proper opportunity of defense was afforded in terms of personal hearing and cross-examination of witnesses. We could not find any clue to ascertain that signatures and stamp of the appellant was original, whereas that of the others were fake. Inquires conducted so far reveals that the whole process right from

appointment till release of salaries in respect of the fake employee were fake and the appellant was penalized for an act not committed by him.

07. In view of the situation, the impugned order dated 12-04-2018 is set aside and the appellant is re-instated into service with all back benefits. Parties are left to bear their own cost. File be consigned to record room.

AMMENDED APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE ORDER DATED 12.04.2018 WHEREBY THE MAJOR PENALTY OF REMOVAL FROM SERVICE WAS CONVERTED INTO MAJOR PENALTY OF COMPULOSORY RETIRMENT FROM SERVICE BY THE APPELLATE AUTHORITY/REVIEWABLE AUTHORITY ON THE REVIEW PETITION OF THE APPELLANT.

PRAYER:

THAT THE ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPEAL, THE IMPUGNED ORDER DATED 12.04.2018 MAY BE SET ASIDE. THE RESPONDENT DEPTT: MAY PLEASE BE DIRECTED TO REINSTATE THE APPELLANT WITH ALL BACK AND CONSEQUENTIAL BENEFITS. ANY OTHER REMEDY WHICH THIS AUGUST TRIBUNAL DEEMS FIT AND APPROPRIATE THAT MAY ALSO BE AWARDED IN FAVOUR OF APPELLANT.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:

FACTS:

1. That the appellant was working as Dy: DEO (M) D.I Khan with honesty and devotion.

2. That while serving in the said capacity, charge sheet along with statement of allegation was issued to the appellant in which the following charges were leveled against the appellant that,

Being DDO you unlawfully released salary for the month of July 2013 amounting to Rs.12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs.145921/- to Muhammad Younas Class-IV whose where about unknown.

The appellant submitted detail repto the charge sheet in which he clearly mentioned that neither the appellant made the pay of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle School come under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear require sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record. (Copies of charge sheet, statement of allegations and reply to charge sheet are attached as Annexure-A,B&C)

- 3. That inquiry was conducted against the appellant in which no proper chance of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him opportunity of cross examination, but despite that the appellant was held responsible by the inquiry committee. (Copy of inquiry report is attached as Annexure-D)
- 4. That show cause notice to the appellant which was duly replied by the appellant in which he once again denied the allegations. (Copies of show cause notice and reply to show cause notice are Attached as Annexure-E&F)
- 5. That on the basis of formal inquiry report, the appellant was removed from the service vide order dated 06.11.2017. (Copy of the removal order dated 06.11.2017 is attached as Annexure-G)
- 6. That the appellant filed review petition against the impugned removal order on 15.11.2017, which was not responded within the statutory period of ninety days. (Copy of review petition is attached as Annexure-H)
- 7. That against the removal order and not taking action on the review petition of the appellant, the appellant filed service appeal No. 353/2018 in this august Service Tribunal and during the pendency of service appeal, the review petition of the appellant was decided by the appellate authority/reviewable authority on 12.04.2018 in which the major penalty of removal from service was converted into major



penalty of compusiory retirement from service. Copy of order dated 04.12.2018 is attached as Annexure-I.

- 8. That as the order dated 12.04.2018 was passed during the pendency of the appeal which needed to be challenged, therefore, he filed an application before this Service Tribunal on 18.04.2018 for allowing amendment in the service appeal which was accepted on 17.05.2018 by this august Service Tribunal. Copy of application and order sheet dated 17.05.2018 are attached as Annexure-J & K.
- 9. That now the appellant wants to file the amended appeal against the order dated 12.04.2018 in this Honorable Tribunal on the following grounds amongst others.

GROUNDS:

- A) That the impugned order dated 12.04.2018 is against the law, rules, facts and material on record, therefore not tenable and liable to be set aside.
- B) That the appellant clearly mentioned in his reply to charge sheet and show cause notice that he did not released salary for the month of July 2013 amounting to Rs.12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs.145921/- to Muhammad Younas Class-IV and all have been done by class-IV on fake and bogus sign made on behalf of the appellant as neither the appellant made the pay bill of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle Scholl came under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear requires sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record, which means that the appellant has made nothing relating to release of salary and arrear of Class-IV but he was punished for the fault of others.
- C) That inquiry was not conducted according to the prescribed procedure as no opportunity of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him chance of cross examination which is the violation of law and rules.
- D) That the inquiry committee in its recommendations recommend major penalty to Mr. Taus Khan Dy: DEO D.I Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah but the competent did not impose any penalty on Mr. Taus Khan and minor penalty of stoppage of two increments was imposed upon Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah, while major

penalty of removal from service was imposed upon the appellant which was converted into major penalty of compulsorly retirement by the appellalte authority/reviewable authority on the review petition of the appellant, which means that the appellant was discriminated which is against the norms of justice.

- E) That Muhammad Younas class-IV made fake and bogus sign on behalf of the appellant and salary for the month of July 2013 and arrears was unlawfully drawn by the Muhammad Younas by fake and bogus sign even he made transfer order from Middle School to High School by fake and bogus sign, which means that the appellant was punished for the fault of others.
- F) That the appellant promptly pointed out the irregularity of Mr. Muhammad Younas Class-IV and even addressed a letter on 1.11.2014 to the Manager NBP Main Branch D.I Khan for stoppage of salary of the said official. (Copy of letter is attached as Annexure-L)
- G) That the inquiry was conducted against Muhammad Younas Class-IV and found that all the documents/letters of the concerned official are fake and bogus and the stamp used by him was also fake and the inquiry committee recommended disciplinary proceeding against him. The stamp paper of the Deputy Education Officer used by him in charge report is bogus and self made as he has been used in the case of the appellant. (Copies of inquiry report and charge report are attached as Annexure-M & N)
- H) That the appellant has been condemned unheard and has not been treated according to law and rules.
- I) That the appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.



- 3- Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO, GHSS Mandhra Kalan now H/M, GHS Dhartian Haripur.
- 4 Mr.Atta Muhammad Ex-Supdit: 250 (M) D.I.Khan now retired.

- Charge against M/S Taus Khan Ex-Dy:DEO (M) D.I.Khan and Atta Muhammad Supdtt. at the Office of DEO (M) D.I.Khan be examined & report upon.
- iv- The committee should specify other staff of establishment & accounts section who was involve in the fraudulent draw!

PROCEEDINGS. 🗸

In compliance with the above referred notification of the competent authority, the enquipment committee started the proceedings accordingly. The competent authority has already served statement allegations and charge sheets upon the above named officers (Annex-B to M). All have submitted their repto to the enquiry committee (Annex-N to Q).

To find out the actual position the enquiry committee visited Office of DEO (M) Dera Ismail Khaldated 17-10-2016. The DEO (M) D.I.Khan was requested through camp letter No.786 dated 18-10-2019 direct the concerned Officers/Officials to provide relevant record pertaining to the said enquiry (Ancex-R) the concerned Officers/Officials were at the views that the appointment of Muhammad Younas as Chowleat GMS Wanda Yarak has not been processed accordingly. No entry of the said appointment order is earlier the Dispatch register of DEO (M) D.I.Khan. Photo copy of dispatch register is attached for ready refundances. The concerned dispatcher also stated in black and white that the endst No. of appointment order is fake and not recorded in the dispatch register of DEO (M) D.I.Khan (Annex-U).

The concerned Officers, Officials were directed to appear before the enquiry committee of 11-2016 at Commissioner Office Kohat resultantly they were appeared except Feroz Hussain Swati Ex- DEOs (M) D.I.Khan, DAO D.I.Khan, S.Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO of GHSS Mandhra Kal Khan S/Clerk of the said school. Those who were appeared before the enquiry committee statements (Annex-V to A1).

EAL.

They also recorded their statements (Annex-A3 to A5).



The Photo copies of relevant documents provided by the above named Officers were checked thoroughly and it was observed that:-

Muhammad Younas S/o Muhammad Nawaz resident of Dahother Kacha D.I.Khan was appointed against Chowkidar post at GMS Wanda Yarak D.I.Khan by DEO (M) D.I.Khan vide endstt No.1622-27/DEO (M)/Class-IV Dated 10-04-2013 (Annex-A6). The said order was invalid for the reasons that (i) there is no Chowkidar sanctioned posts in Middle Schools and (ii) there is no entry recorded ofsuch appointment order in the dispatch register of DEO (M) D.1. Khan as revealed from the available record and statement of dispatcher(already annexed).

2. Mr.Muhammad Younas Class-IV has not performed duty at GMS Wanda Yarak D.I.Khan as revealed from the written statement of Head Master, GMS Wanda Yarak (Annex-A7). There are only two classiv sanctioned posts i.e Naib Qasid and Sweeper at GMS Wanda Yarak against which Mr.Abdur Rasheed Sweeper and Mr.Azizur Rahman NQ are working since the establishment of the school (Annex-A8).

3- The pay of Muhammad Younas Class-IV was not released/computerized well in time for the reason mentioned above. Source-1 for computerization of pay was submitted to DAO D.I.Khan duly signed by Mr.Taus Khan Ex-Dy:DEO (M) and countersigned by Mr.Feroz Hussain Shah Ex-DEO (M) D.I.Khan (Annex-A9). His pay was computerized for the ist time in 07/2013 (Annex-A10).

The accused Muhammad Younas Chowkidar GMS Wanda Yarak was transferred mutually vice Mr.Zakaullah Class-IV of GHSS Mandhra Kalan D.I.Khan by DEO (M) D.I.Khan vide endstt No.8405-7 dated 08-10-2013 (Annex-A11). The said transfer order is also invalid for the reason that (i) the signatory authority (DEO M. D.I.Khan Mr.Taus Khan) has disowned the signature marked on the transfer order and (ii) the dispatch No. recorded on the said transfer order is fake and has not been recorded in dispatch register of DEO (N): D.I.Khan (Already annexed).

5- The DDO of GHSS Mandhra Kalan D.I.Khan Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah now Head Master, GHS Dagtian Haripur has released his salary for the month of 10/2013 and 11/2013 without confirmation and issuance of LPC from the quarter concerned which is required being important accounts documents (Annex-A12). Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO Mandra kalan stated that he has signed the source documents for release of pay on the request of Feroz Khan S/Clerk of the school. However Mr.Feroz Khan S/Clerk has denied the statement of DDO Concerned.

6- Mr. Taus Khan Ex-DEO (M) D I Khan now DEO (M) Karak visited GHSS Mandhra Kalan on dated 23-04-2014 and directed the Principal concerned to immediately relieve the accused Class-IV Muhammad Younas resultantly the accused was relieved and his pay was stopped on the verbal direction of Ex-DEO (M) D.I.Khan (Annex-A-13). However no further disciplinary proceeding was initiated by the competent authority due to unknown reason.

7- During the course of enquiry it was observed that though the accused was relieved form his official duty on dated 23:04-2014 but even then his salary of intervening period amounting to Rs.145000, . . were prepared and submitted to DAO D.I.Khan duly signed by Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-Dy:DEO (M) D.I.Khan now H/M, GHS Chehak D.I.Khan (Annex-A14 to A16). The DAO D.I.Khan passed the sala arrear bill (Annex-A-17). Though it was the responsibility of accountant as well as DDO concerned to point out the irregular drawl well in time but no recovery has so far been made from the accused They further recorded the said amount in monthly expdt statement for the month of 10/2014(Annex-19 to A29). The accused further stated that his salary bill for the period from 01-12-2013 to 30-09-2014 was signed by Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-DDO (M) D.I.Khan. The accused further requested for adjustment and release of pay.

Apart from above mentioned facts all the concerned DDOs/Dy:Dos/DDOs except Mr.Zawar Hussa Shah Ex-DDO GHSS Mandra Kalan now Head Master, GHS Dartian Haripur have disowned tosignatures marked on service documents of Muhammad Younas Class-IV Servant. No one is read at accept the responsibility of fraudulent drawl as well as maintenance of record.

The accused class –IV Servant was heard in person. He verbally admitted that he has not perduty at GMS Wandar Yarak for the reason that no staff member was present there. However, and a transfer to GHSS Mandra Kalan-he was performed duty from 08-10-2013 to 23-04-2014 as revealed from attendance record of the said school (Annex-A19 to A29). The accused further states $au_{
m s}$

salary bill for the period from 01-12-2013 to 30-09-2014 was signed by Mr.Rambail ex-DDO to

D.I.Khan. He requested for Re-Instatement and release of pay.

10- The District Accounts Officer D.I.Khan provided original service and salary record of Muhammad Younas duly submitted by Ex-DDOs of DEO (MO D.I.Khan which was checked thoroughly and it was confirmed that the claim was actually signed by Mr.Rambail Khan and submitted to DAO D.I.Khan which resulted irregular drawl as mentioned in the charge sheet and statement of allegations. The DAO D.I.Khan also recorded his statement (Already annexed).

11- Mr. Feroz Hussain Shah Ex- DEO (MO D.I.Khan now retired stated that he has issued the appointment order of the accused Class-IV servant on the direction of Mr. Qaisar Rasheed Judge Peshawar High Court (Already annexed).

✓ 12- Mr.Zawar Hussain now Head Master, GHS Dartian Haripur stated in black & white that he has signed the source form of Muhammad Younas Class-IV for release of his pay.

13- Mr.Feroz Khan S/Clerk of GHSS Mandra Kalan stated that he has stamped the source form of Muhammad Younas Class-IV prior to sign of DDO Concerned (Already annexed).

It is worth mentioning to state that three enquiries have already been conducted against the above named class-IV Servant (Annex-A30 to A33). All the three enquiry committees have declared the 1st appointment order and transfer order as fake and bogus. Though his appointment order was issued under 25 percent reserved quota for the children of class-IV servants as his father was retired from service. However no record was found at DEO (M) D.I.Khan:

During the course of enquiry, it was observed that supporting staff of establishment section and accounts section are fully involved in such fraudulent drawl. Disciplinary proceedings are required to be initiated against them under E&D Rules, 2011. However now they are trying to save their skin from any drastic action.

The Charges have been proved against Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-Dy:DO (id) D.I.Khan now H/M GHS Chehak, Mr.Taus Khan Ex-Dy:DO (M) D.I.Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO GHSS Mandhra Kalar, now h/M. GHS Dartian Haripur. Mr.Feroz Hussain Shah Ex-DEO (M) D.I.Khan and Mr.Atta Muhammad have already been retired from service. It is further added that no involvement of Atta Muhammad Ex-Supdtt: has been proved.

RECOMMENDATIONS.

In the light of above mentioned racts and documentary proof on record, the charges have been proved against the above named Officers. It is therefore recommended that:

- 13 Major Penalty may be imposed upon Mr.Ramabil Khan now H/M, GHS Chehak D.I.Khan, Mr.Taus Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah now H/M, GHS Dartian Haripur under 180 Rules, 2011.
- 2- Major Penalty of Dismissal may be imposed upon Muhammad Younas Class-IV under E&D Rules 2011. The salary of absence period drawn fraudulently may be recovered and deposit into Govt treasury without further loss of time.
- 3- Disciplinary proceedings may be initiated against Mr.Muhammad Aftab J/Clerk, Tariq Aziz S/Clerk Muhammad Arshad J/Clerk and Feroz Khan S/Clerk of E&SE Deptt; D.I.Khan for their involvement of fraudulent drawl.

- 1. In this context brief history of the Case has already been elucidated to the enquiry committee on the spot and necessary affidavit and the relevant papers of enquiry report of enquiry committee dated 06.01.2015 constituted by DEO (Male) DIKhan (copy attached).
- 2. In the light of Departmental Enquiry Committee, the brief History of the case was submitted to the then Enquiry Officer Mr. Muhammad Iftikhar Ahmad Shamozai Asstt: Director Sports Directorate of E&SE, KPK, Peshawar vide No. 15315 dated 17.08.2016. The 73 pages report which were self explanatory. (Copy attached).
- 3. Previously the enquiry report against fraudulent drawl of Rs. 145000/- in r/o Muhammad younis, Class-IV was already conducted by the enquiry Committee consisting on Mr. Qamar-uz-Zaman, Principal, GHS. Paroa (DIKhan) and Mr. Jamal Ahmad Mirza, Head Master, GHS. Behari Colony DIKhan, which was constituted by DEO (M) DIKhan No. 21766-21767/DEO(M) B&AO dated 10.11.2014, which is self explanatory and all the relevant reports were attached with the enquiry report (Copies attached).
- 4. All the amount in question has been recovered from the Class-IV concerned.
- 5. The said Class-IV was not appointed under any signature and his 1st Source form was not presented in DAO, DIKhan for feeding through myself. Moreover his Service Book was also not signed by me.





- I was not involved in that malpractice. All thel process about his drawl was made with the collusion of some one either in the office or outsider just to defame my dignity.
- 7. The all process was made on surmise basis just to safe some one.
- 8. It is irony of fat that I have already illegally punished by degrading my scale from BPS-18 to BPS-17.

Benari Colony DiKhan dated 06.01.2015 (office Dy: No. 258 dated 10.01.2015 and the brief History of the case submitted vide DEO (M) DIKhan No. 15315 dated 17:08.2016 (copies attached).





- 14. Simultaneously, the reply of questionnaire which was submitted to Mr. Hassam-ul-Haq, Principal GHS. No. 3 Kohat dated 12.08.2015 and the current reply in this regard submitted vide No.662-6 dated 23.08.2016 referred to above are attached for your kind perusal please.
- 15. All the allegation based on prejudicially and inequitable the one sided report was prepared on the basis of conjecture just to safe some one from these self-maded allegations.
- 16. Lam totally innocent and not involved with any serious irregularities hence not calling for the action regarding to impose Major penalty under Rule-04. I have rendered 30 years meritorious service in Education Deptt: . The inequitable one sided action taken against me will take on my future career in Service/life and great financial loss.
- 17. I have already submitted all the relevant inquiry report, made by me from time to time along with relevant documents to your good self.

As all the irregularities/iilegal process were made by the then DEO(M) DIKhan or by some one, hence it is requested that my case may please be reviewed and I may be exonerated from this critical situation and to avoid mental torture.

It is also stated that I would like to appear in person before the competent authority for my defence, as & when called for the purpose. I hope that my genuine report will be given sympathetic consideration please.

The appellant submitted detail reply to the charge sheet in which he clearly mentioned that neither the appellant made the pay of he clearly mentioned that neither the appellant made the pay of helper the appellant or Budget & Accounts of helper the appellant or Budget & Accounts of the appellant by the Accounts of arrest does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in Middle Scholl come under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. 3. That no regular inquiry was conducted against the appellant in which the proper chance of defence was provided to the appellant as peither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him opportunity of cross examination but despite that the appellant was held responsible by the inquiry committee.

4. That show cause notice to the appullant which was duly replied by the appellant in which he once again denied the allegations. (Copies of show cause notice and reply to show cause notice are Attached as

- 5. That on the basis of formal inquiry report, the appellant was removed from the service vide order dated 06.11.2017. (Copy of the removal order dated 06.11.2017 is attached as Annexure-E)
- 6. That now the appellant wants to file the review petition against the order dated 06.11.2017 on the following grounds.

GROUNDS:

- A) That the impugned order dated 06.11.2017 is against the law, rules, facts and material on record, therefore not tenable and liable to be set aside.
- B) That the appellant clearly mentioned in his rely to charge sheet and show cause notice that he did not released salary for the month of July 2013 amounting to Rs.12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs.145921/- *to Muhammad Younas Class-IV and all have been done by class-IV on fake and bogus sign made on behalf of the appellant as neither the appellant made the pay bill of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle Scholl came under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear requires sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record, which means that the appellant has made nothing relating to release of salary and arrear of Class-IV but he was punished for the fault of others.
 - C) That inquiry was not conducted according to the prescribed procedure as no opportunity of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him chance of cross examination which is the violation of law and rules.
 - D) That the inquiry committee in its recommendations recommend major penalty to Mr. Taus Khan Dy: DEO D.I Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah but the competent did not impose any penalty on Mr. Taus Khan and minor penalty of stoppage of two increments was imposed upon Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah, while major penalty of removal from service was imposed upon the appellant which means that the appellant was discriminated which is against the norms of justice.
 - E) That Muhammad Younas class-IV made fake and bogus sign on behalf of the appellant and salary for the month of July 2013 and



arrears was unlawfully drawn by the Mr. Muhammad Younas by fake and bogus sign even he made transfer order from Middle School to High School by fake and bogus sign, which means that the appellant was punished for the fault of others.

- F) That the appellant promptly pointed out the irregularity of Mr. Muhammad Younas Class-IV and even addressed a letter to the Manager NBP Main Branch D.I.Khan for stoppage of salary of the said official. In addition to this letter was also addressed for inactivation of pay to D.A.O D.I.Khan (copy of the letter is attached as annexure-F).
- G) That the inquiry was conducted against Muhammad Younas Class-IV and found that all the documents/letters of the concerned official are fake and bogus and the stamp used by him was also fake and the inquiry committee recommended disciplinary proceeding against him. The Stamp of Deputy Education officer used by him in charge report is also bogus and self-made as has been used in the case of the appellant (Copy at Annex- C & II)
- H) That the appellant has been condemned unheard and has not been treated according to law and rules.
 - I) That the appellant has more than 30 years of service and penalty of removal from service is very harsh which is against norm of justice.

It is therefore, most humbly requested that on acceptance of this review petition the impugned order dated 06.11.2017 may be set aside and reinstate the appellant with all back and consequential benefits.





- 1. Appointment order No 1622-29 of dated 10/04/2013 does not exist in the despatch register.
- 2. Charge report of 10/04/2013 shows a fake stamp with designation of Dy: Education officer Dera Ismail Khan. This post even does not exist at all.
- 3. Ex-DDO GHSS Mandran Kalan Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah activated the monthly salary of Mohammad Younis without any LPC. The detailed statements of the clarks in GHSS Mandran Kalan is annexed.(Annexure A,B)
- 4. Statement submitted by the accountant Mr. Muhammad Aftab Dy:DEO Mr. Rambail Khapdeclared that they have not been involved in the activation of salary of Muhammad Younis or hisarrears. DDEO declared that he had not issued pay release order in respect of M. Younis class-iv.(Annexure C.D).
- Muhammad Younis stated in his on-oath statement that he appeared before the present DDEO for activation of pay and arrears but Dy:DEQ directed that pay activation is responsibility of the office.

Muhammad Younis in his statement declared that he sought the help of M. Hashim (his relative) for activation of pay. In this regard Mohammad_Arshad J/C DEO(F) DIKhan fully facilitatedM.Hashim to release the salary (Annexure E)

Conclusion:-

All the relevant letters of Muhammad Younis class-iv are fake and bogus. The department has nothing to do with the letters.

The stamp used throughout the pay activation process is fake.

Decision:-

1. Muhammad Younis be directed to deposit Rs 145921/- in the exchequer and be warned in furture.

2. Department should initiate an inquiry against the two Government employees as pointed out by the statement of Muhammad Younis class-jv.

3. Pay active source form and arrears bill had been passed by the District Accounts office DIKhan under wrong designation shown in the stamp.(Annexure F,G,H) The concerned DAO staff DIKhan must be warned to be conscious in all aspects while passing/ feeding the bills of the Government servants.



THAT THE ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPEAL, THE IMPUGNED ORDER DATED 06.11.2017 MAY BE SET ASIDE. THE RESPONDENT DEPTT: MAY PLEASE BE DIRECTED TO REINSTATE THE APPELLANT WITH ALL BACK AND CONSEQUENTIAL BENEFITS. ANY OTHER REMEDY WHICH THIS AUGUST TRIBUNAL DEEMS FIT AND APPROPRIATE THAT MAY ALSO BE AWARDED IN FAVOUR OF APPELLANT.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:

FACTS:

1. That the appellant was working as Dy: DEO (M) D.I Khan with honesty and devotion.

2. That while serving in the said capacity, charge sheet along with statement of allegation was issued to the appellant in which the following charges were leveled against the appellant that,

Being DDO you unlawfully released salary for the month of July 2013 amounting to Rs.12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs.145921/- to Muhammad Younas Class-IV whose where about unknown.

The appellant submitted detail repto the charge sheet in which he clearly mentioned that neither the appellant made the pay of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle School come under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear require sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record. (Copies of charge, statment of allegations and reply to charge sheet are attached as Annexure-A,B&C)

- 3. That inquiry was conducted against the appellant in which no proper chance of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him opportunity of cross examination, but despite that the appellant was held responsible by the inquiry committee. (Copy of inquiry report is attached as Annexure-D)
- 4. That show cause notice to the appellant which was duly replied by the appellant in which he once again denied the allegations. (Copies of show cause notice and reply to show cause notice are Attached as Annexure-E&F)
- 5. That on the basis of formal inquiry report, the appellant was removed from the service vide order dated 06.11.2017. (Copy of the removal order dated 06.11.2017 is attached as Annexure-G)
- 6. That the appellant filed review petition against theimpugned removal order on 29.11.2017, which was not responded within the statutory period of ninety days. (Copy of review petition is attached as Annexure-H)
- 7. That now the appellant wants to file the review petition against the order dated 06.11.2017 on the following grounds.

GROUNDS:

3

A) That the impugned order dated 06.11.2017 and not taking action on teh review petition are against the law, rules, facts and material on record, therefore not tenable and liable to be set aside.

- B) That the appellant clearly mentioned in his reply to charge sheet and show cause notice that he did not released salary for the month of July 2013 amounting to Rs.12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs.145921/- to Muhammad Younas Class-IV and all have been done by class-IV on fake and bogus sign made on behalf of the appellant as neither the appellant made the pay bill of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle Scholl came under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear requires sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record, which means that the appellant has made nothing relating to release of salary and arrear of Class-IV but he was punished for the fault of others.
- C) That inquiry was not conducted according to the prescribed procedure as no opportunity of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him chance of cross examination which is the violation of law and rules.
- D) That the inquiry committee in its recommendations recommend major penalty to Mr. Taus Khan Dy: DEO D.I Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah but the competent did not impose any penalty on Mr. Taus Khan and minor penalty of stoppage of two increments was imposed upon Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah, while major penalty of removal from service was imposed upon the appellant which means that the appellant was discriminated which is against the norms of justice.
- E) That Muhammad Younas class-IV made fake and bogus sign on behalf of the appellant and salary for the month of July 2013 and arrears was unlawfully drawn by the Muhammad Younas by fake and bogus sign even he made transfer order from Middle School to High School by fake and bogus sign, which means that the appellant was punished for the fault of others.
- F) That the appellant promptly pointed out the irregularity of Mr. Muhammad Younas Class-IV and even addressed a letter on 1.11.2014 to the Manager NBP Main Branch D.I Khan for stoppage of salary of the said official. (Copy of letter is attached as Annexure-I)
- G) That the inquiry was conducted against Muhammad Younas Class-IV and found that all the documents/letters of the concerned official are fake and bogus and the stamp used by him was also fake and the inquiry committee recommended disciplinary proceeding against him.

The stamp paper of the Deputy Education Officer used by him in charge report is bogus and self made as he has been used in the case of the appellant. (Copies of inquiry report and charge report are attached as Annexure-J&K)

- H) That the appellant has been condemned unheard and has not been treated according to law and rules.
- I) That the appellant has more than 30 years of service and penalty of removal from service is very harsh which is against norm of justice.
- J) That the appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for

I solemnly declare on oath that neither I made the pay of Muhammad Younas Class .IV active nor the same was brought before me by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the Middle School.

As per SOP Pay of Chowkidar cannot be made active as no Post of Chowkidar exists at middle School .

i.e.DEC being Principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record.

I am career oriented having strong belief on rule of law and cannot think of Such an irregularity, Muhammad Younas ClassIV himself affixed bogus signature of the undersigned which are totally fabricated.

The charges framed against me in haste vide above referred letter are factitious, baseless without ground and devoid of any material evidence, just to malign me and shift owns responsibility on my shoulders.

The competent authority has constituted the following enquiry committee vide office Notification No.SO(S/M)E&SED/4-17/2015/Syed Zawar Hussain Shah HM, GHS Mitha Pur/171 Dated 08-08-2016 to conduct formal enquiry against the following Officers for the charges mentioned in the charge sheet and statement of allegations already served upon the concerned Officers (Annex-A).

- 1 Mr. Taus Khan Ex-Dy:DEO (M) D.I.Khan now DEO (M) Karak.
- 2- Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-Dy:DEO (M) D.I.Khan now H/M, GHS Chehak D.I.Khan
- 3- Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO, GHSS Mandhra Kalan now H/M, GHS Dhartian Haripur.
- 4. Mr.Atta Muhammad Ex-Si-pdtt(DFO /M) D.I.Khan now retired.

ALLEGATIONS.

Being DDOs unlawfully released pay and arrears of Muhammad Younas Class-IV for various periods which caused great loss to Govt exchequer.

TERMS OF REFERENCE OF ENQUIRY COMMITTEE.

- The aforesaid committee shall look into the matter, conduct formal inquiry for the charges mentioned in the charge sheet and statements of allegations already served upon the concerned Officers and submit recommendation/report to the competent authority.
- ii- In pursuance of letter No.SO(S/M)E&SED/4-17/2015/S.Záwar Hussain Shah & others/171 dated 17-02-2017, the committee clarify the present status of Muhammad Younas Class-IV.
- iii- Charge against M/S Taus Khan Ex-Dy:DEO (M) D.I.Khan and Atta Muhammad Supdtt: at the Office of DEO (M) D.I.Khan be examined & report upon.
- iv- The committee should specify other staff of establishment & accounts section who was involved in the fraudulent drawl.

PROCEEDINGS.

In compliance with the above referred notification of the competent authority, the enquiry committee started the proceedings accordingly. The competent authority has already served statement of allegations and charge sheets upon the above named officers (Annex-B to M). All have submitted their replies to the enquiry committee (Annex-N to Q).

To find out the actual position the enquiry committee visited Office of DEO (M) Dera Ismail Khan on dated 17-10-2016. The DEO (M) D.I.Khan was requested through camp letter No.786 dated 18-10-2016 to direct the concerned Officers/Officials to provide relevant record pertaining to the said enquiry (Annex-R). All the concerned Officers/Officials were of the views that the appointment of Muhammad Younas as Chowkidar at GMS Wanda Yarak has not been processed accordingly. No entry of the said appointment order is existing in the Dispatch register of DEO (M) D.I.Khan: Photo copy of dispatch register is attached for ready reference (Annex-S&T). The concerned dispatcher also stated in black and white that the endstt No. of the said appointment order is fake and not recorded in the dispatch register of DEO (M) D.I.Khan (Annex-U).

The concerned Officers/Officials were directed to appear before the enquiry committee on dated 22 11-2016 at Commissioner Office Kohat resultantly they were appeared except Feroz Hussain Shah & Ris Swati Ex- DEOs (M) D.I.Khan, DAO D.I.Khan, S.Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO of GHSS Mandhra Kalan and Fero Khan S/Clerk of the said school. Those who were appeared before the enquiry committee recorded the statements (Annex-V to A1).

EXP.

29.11-2016 at Commissioner Office Konat resultantly they appeared before the enquity commission 42). They also recorded their statements (Annex-A3 to A5).

DINGS.

The Photo copies of relevant documents provided by the above named Officers were checked thoroughly and it was observed that:-

- 1- Muhammad Younas S/o Muhammad Nawaz resident of Dahother Kacha D.I.Khan was appointed against Chowkidar post at GMS Wanda Yarak D.I.Khan by DEO (M) D.I.Khan vide endstt No.1622-27/DEO (M)/Class-IV Dated 10-04-2013 (Annex-A6). The said order was invalid for the reasons that (i) there is no Chowkidar sanctioned posts in Middle Schools and (ii) there is no entry recorded of such appointment order in the dispatch register of DEO (M) D.I.Khan as revealed from the available record and statement of dispatcher(already annexed).
- 2- Mr.Muhammad Younas Class-IV has not performed duty at GMS Wanda Yarak D.I.Khan las revealed from the written statement of Head Master, GMS Wanda Yarak (Annex-A7). There are only two classiv sanctioned posts i.e Naib Qasid and Sweeper at GMS Wanda Yarak against which Mr Abdur Rasheed Sweeper and Mr. Azizur Rahman NQ are working since the establishment of the school (Annex-A8).
- 3- The pay of Muhammad Younas Class-IV was not released/computerized well in time for the reason mentioned above. Source-1 for ເປັດການປະຕາຊາຍາດ of pay was submitted to DAO D.I.Khan duly signed by Mr.Taus Khan Ex-Dy:DEO (M) and countersigned by Mr.Feroz Hussain Shah Ex-DEO (M) D I.Khan (Annex-A9). His pay was computerized for the ist time in 07/2013 (Annex-A10).
- 4- The accused Muhammad Younas Chowkidar, GMS Wanda Yarak was transferred mutually vice: Mr.Zakaullah Class-IV of GHSS Mandhra Kalan D.I.Khan by DEO (M) D.I.Khan vide endstt No.8405-7 dated 08-10-2013 (Annex-A11). The said transfer order is also invalid for the reason that (i) the signatory authority (DEO M D.i.Khan Mr.Taus Khan) has disowned the signature marked on the transfer order and (ii) the dispatch Noll recorded on the said transfer order is fake and has not been recorded in dispatch register of DEO (M) D.I.khan (Aiready annexed).
- 5- The DDO of GHSS Mandhra Kalan D.I.Khan Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah now Head Master, GHS Dartian Haripur has released his salary for the month of 10/2013 and 11/2013 without confirmation and issuance of LPC from the quarter concerned which is required being important accounts documents (Annex-A12). Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO Mandra kalan stated that he has signed the source documents for release of pay on the request of Feroz Khan S/Clerk of the school. However Mr.Feroz Khan S/Clerk has denied the statement of DDO Concerned.
- 6- Mr.Taus Khan Ex-DEO (M) D ! Khan now DEO (M) Karak visited GHSS Mandhra Kalan on dated 23-04-,2014 and directed the Principal concerned to immediately relieve the accused Class-IV Muhammad Younas resultantly the accused was relieved and his pay was stopped on the verbal direction of Ex-DEO (M) D.I.Khan (Annex-A-13), althowever no further disciplinary proceeding was initiated by the competent authority due to unknown reason.
- 7- During the course of enquiry it was observed that though the accused was relieved form his official duty on dated 23-04-2014 but even then his salary of intervening period amounting to Rs.145000/were prepared and submitted to DAO D.I.Khan duly signed by Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-Dy:DEO (M): D.I.Khan now H/M, GHS Chehak D.I.Khan (Annex-A14 to A16). The DAO D.I.Khan passed the said arrear bill (Annex-A-17). Though it was the responsibility of accountant as well as DDO concerned to point out the irregular drawl well in time but no recovery has so far been made from the accused They further recorded the said amount in monthly expdt statement for the month of 10/2014 (Annex-19 to A29). The accused further stated that his salary bill for the period from 01-12-2013 to 30-09-2014 was signed by Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-DDO (M) D.I.Khan. The accused further requested for adjustment and release of pay.
- 8- Apart from above mentioned facts all the concerned DDOs/Dy:Dos/DDOs except Mr.Zawar Hussa Shah Ex-DDO GHSS Mandra Kalan now Head Master, GHS Dartian Haripur have disowned tosignatures marked on service documents of Muhammad Younas Class-IV Servant. No one is read. It accept the responsibility of fraudulent drawl as well as maintenance of record.
- 9- The accused class –IV Servant was heard in person. He verbally admitted that he has not perfect duty at GMS Wandar Yarak for the reason that no staff member was present there. However emertransfer to GHSS Mandra Kalanghe was performed duty from 08-10-2013 to 23-04-2014 as released ATTESTED from attendance record of the said school (Annex-A19 to A29). The accused further stated in a

salary bill for the period from 01-12-2013 to 30-09-2014 was signed by Mr.Rambail ex-Dr. B.i.Khan. He requested for Re-Instatement and release of pay.

- The District Accounts Officer D.I.Khan provided original service and salary record of Mulanimad Younas duly submitted by Ex-DDOs of DEO (M0 D.I.Khan which was checked thoroughly and it was confirmed that the claim was actually signed by Mr.Rambail Khan and submitted to DAO D.I.Khan which resulted irregular drawl as mentioned in the charge sheet and statement of allegations. The DAO D.I.Khan also recorded his statement (Already annexed).
- 11- Mr.Feroz Hussain Shah Ex- DEO (MO D.I.Khan now retired stated that he has issued the appointment order of the accused Class-IV servant on the direction of Mr.Qaisar Rasheed Judge Peshawar High Court (Already annexed).
- 12- Mr.Zawar Hussain now Head Master, GHS Dartian Haripur stated in black & white that he has signed the source form of Muhammad Younas Class-IV for release of his pay.
- 13- Mr.Feroz Khan S/Clerk of GHSS Mandra Kalan stated that he has stamped the source form of Muhammad Younas Class-IV prior to sign of DDO Concerned (Already annexed).

It is worth mentioning to state that three enquiries have already been conducted against the above named class-IV Servant (Annex-A30 to A33). All the three enquiry committees have declared the 1st appointment order and transfer order as fake and bogus. Though his appointment order was issued under 25 percent reserved quota for the children of class-IV servants as his father was retired from service. However no record was found at DEO (M) D.I.Khan.

During the course of enquiry, it was observed that supporting staff of establishment section and accounts section are fully involved in such fraudulent drawl. Disciplinary proceedings are required to be initiated against them under E&D Rules, 2011. However now they are trying to save their skin from any drastic action.

The Charges have been proved against Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-Dy:DO (M) D.I.Khan now H/M GHS Chehak, Mr.Taus Khan Ex-Dy:DO (M) D.I.Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO GHSS Mandhra Kalan now H/M GHS Dartian Haripur. Mr.Feroz Hussain Shah Ex-DEO (M) D.I.Khan and Mr.Atta Muhammad have already been retired from service. It is further added that no involvement of Atta Muhammad Ex-Supdtt: has been proved.

RECOMMENDATIONS.

In the light of above mentioned racts and documentary proof on record, the charges have been proved against the above named Officers: It is therefore recommended that:-

- 1- Major Penalty may be imposed upon Mr.Ramabil Khan now H/M, GHS Chehak D.I.Khan, Mr.Taus Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah now H/M, GHS Dartian Haripur under 180 Rules, 2011.
- 2- Major Penalty of Dismissal may be imposed upon Muhammad Younas Class-IV under E&D Rules 2011. The salary of absence period drawn fraudulently may be recovered and deposit into Govt treasury without further loss of time.
- 3- Disciplinary proceedings may be initiated against Mr.Muhammad Aftab J/Clerk, Tariq Aziz S/Clerk Muhammad Arshad J/Clerk and Feroz Khan S/Clerk of E&SE Deptt; D.I.Khan for their involvement of fraudulent drawl.

- 1. In this context brief history of the Case has already been elucidated to the enquiry committee on the spot and necessary affidavit and the relevant papers of enquiry report of enquiry committee dated 06.01.2015 cor:stituted by DEO (Male) DIKhan (copy attached).
- 2. In the light of Departmental Enquiry Committee, the brief History of the case was submitted to the then Enquiry Officer Mr. Muhammad Iftikhar Ahmad Shamozai Asstt: Director Sports Directorate of E&SE, KPK, Peshawar vide No. 15315 dated 17.08.2016. The 73 pages report which were self explanatory. (Copy attached).
- 3. Previously the enquiry report against fraudulent drawl of Rs. 145000/- in r/o Muhammad Younis, Class-IV was already conducted by the enquiry Committee consisting on Mr. Qamar-uz-Zaman, Principal, GHS. Paroa (DIKhan) and Mr. Jamal Ahmad Mirza, Head Master, GHS. Behari Colony DIKhan, which was constituted by DEO (M) DIKhan No. 21766-21767/DEO(M) B&AO dated 10.11.2014, which is self explanatory and all the relevant reports were attached with the enquiry report (Copies attached).
- 4. All the amount in question has been recovered from the Class-IV concerned.
- 5. The said Class-IV was not appointed under any signature and his 1st Source form was not presented in DAO, DIKhan for feeding through myself. Moreover his Service Book was also not signed by me.



- 6. I was not involved in that malpractice. All thel process about his drawl was made with the collusion of some one either in the office or outsider just to defame my dignity.
- 7. The all process was made on surmise basis just to safe some one.
- 8. It is irony of fat that I have already illegally punished by degrading my scale from BPS-18 to BPS-17.
- 9. Now I have again involved and indict in the insignificant and repugnant case as rotated on conjecture basis as prejudicially. There is no proper tangible documents against me. The case was prepared against me as malafide and not based on facts. I have presented submitted the reply to Mr. Mussarat Hussain, Commissioner Kohat and Mr. Saifur Rehman, Principal GHS. No.1 Nowshera in the light of notification No. SO(S/M) E&SED/4-17/2015/ S.Zawar Hussain Shah, Head Master, GHS. Mithapur/171 dt: 08.08.2016 alongwith relevant document which was self explanatory and comprehence. In which, I solemnly declared on oath that neither the pay of Mr. Muhammad Younis, Class-IV was drawn under my signature and no illegally transferred from GHS. Mandhran Kalan to GMS. Wanda Yarik, where no post of Chowkidar was exist.
- 10. It was a insignificant and devoid charges against me which was intentionally speared and dragged just to defame my dignity being a direct selected on Management cadre.
- 11. Previously , I have faced great loss and reverted from the post of Dy: DEO(M) DIKhan (BPS-18) to the Head Master, GHS. Chahkan (BPS-17).
- 12. Sir, it was not understood that there was no irregularity and embezzlement was made, then why an ex-party drastic action is being taken against me.
- 13. I have already submitted the enquiry report of Mr. Qamar-uz-Zaman, Principal, GHS. Paroa and Mr. Jamal Ahmad Mirza, Head Master GHS. Benari Colony DIKhan dated 06.01.2015 (office Dy: No. 258 dated 10.01.2015 and the brief History of the case submitted vide DEO (M) DIKhan No. 15315 dated 17.08.2016 (copies attached).



REVIEW PETITION AGAINST THE ORDER DATED 06.11.2017, WHEREBY THE APPELLANT WAS REMOVED FROM SERVICE.

Respected Sir,

1. That the appellant was working as Dy: DEO (M) D.I Khan with honesty and devotion.

2. That while serving in the said capacity, charge sheet along with statement of allegation was issued to the appellant in which the following charges were leveled against the appellant that,

Being DDO vou unlawfully released salary for the month of July 2013 amounting to Rs.12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs.145921/- to Muliammad Younas Class-IV whose where about unknown.

The appellant submitted detail reply to the charge sheet in which he clearly mentioned that neither the appellant made the pay of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle School come under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear require sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record. (Copies of charge sheet and reply to charge sheet are attached as Annexure-A&B)

- 3. That no regular inquiry was conducted against the appellant in which no proper chance of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him opportunity of cross examination but despite that the appellant was held responsible by the inquiry committee.
- 4. That show cause notice to the appellant which was duly replied by the appellant in which he once again denied the allegations. (Copies of show cause notice and reply to show cause notice are Attached as Annexure-C&D)

- 5. That on the basis of formal inquiry report, the appellant was removed from the service vide order dated 06.11.2017. (Copy of the removal order dated 06.11.2017 is attached as Annexure-E)
- 6. That now the appellant wants to file the review petition against the order dated 06.11.2017 on the following grounds.

GROUNDS:

- A) That the impugned order dated 06.11.2017 is against the law, rules, facts and material on record, therefore not tenable and liable to be set aside.
- B) That the appellant clearly mentioned in his rely to charge sheet and show cause notice that he did not released salary for the month of July 2013 amounting to Rs.12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs.145921/- *to Muhammad Younas Class-IV and all have been done by class-IV on fake and bogus sign made on behalf of the appellant as neither the appellant made the pay bill of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle Scholl came under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear requires sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record, which means that the appellant has made nothing relating to release of salary and arrear of Class-IV but he was punished for the fault of others.
- C) That inquiry was not conducted according to the prescribed procedure as no opportunity of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him chance of cross examination which is the violation of law and rules.
- D) That the inquiry committee in its recommendations recommend major penalty to Mr. Taus Khan Dy: DEO D.I Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah but the competent did not impose any penalty on Mr. Taus Khan and minor penalty of stoppage of two increments was imposed upon Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah, while major penalty of removal from service was imposed upon the appellant which means that the appellant was discriminated which is against the norms of justice.
- E) That Muhammad Younas class-IV made fake and bogus sign on behalf of the appellant and salary for the month of July 2013 and



arrears was unlawfully drawn by the Mr. Muhammad Younas by fake and bogus sign even he made transfer order from Middle School to High School by fake and bogus sign, which means that the appellant was punished for the fault of others.

- F) That the appellant promptly pointed out the irregularity of Mr. Muhammad Younas Class-IV and even addressed a letter to the Manager NBP Main Branch D.I.Khan for stoppage of salary of the said official. In addition to this letter was also addressed for inactivation of pay to D.A.O D.I.Khan (copy of the letter is attached as annexure-F).
- G) That the inquiry was conducted against Muhammad Younas Class-IV and found that all the documents/letters of the concerned official are fake and bogus and the stamp used by him was also fake and the inquiry committee recommended disciplinary proceeding against him. The Stamp of Deputy Education officer used by him in charge report is also bogus and self-made as has been used in the case of the appellant (Copy at Annex- G & H)
- H) That the appellant has been condemned unheard and has not been treated according to law and rules.
- I) That the appellant has more than 30 years of service and penalty of removal from service is very harsh which is against norm of justice.

It is therefore, most humbly requested that on acceptance of this review petition the impugned order dated 06.11.2017 may be set aside and reinstate the appellant with all back and consequential benefits.







Reference enquiry No 21766-67of dated 10/11/2014 was assigned to the under signed. A detailed inquiry was held and findings of the inquiry are hereby submitted in your worthy respect.

- 1. Appointment order No 1622-29 of dated 10/04/2013 does not exist in the despatch register.
- 2. Charge report of 10/04/2013 shows a fake stamp with designation of Dy: Education officer Dera Ismail Khan. This post even does not exist at all.
- Ex-DDO GHSS Mandran Kalan Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah activated the monthly salary of Mohammad Younis without any LPC. The detailed statements of the clerks in GHSS Mandran Kalan is annexed (Annexure A,B)
- 4. Statement submitted by the accountant Mr. Muhammad Aftab Dy:DEO Mr. Rambail Khan declared that they have not been involved in the activation of salary of Muhammad Younis or hisarrears. DDEO declared that he had not issued pay release order in respect of M. Younis class-iv.(Annexure C,D)
- Muhammad Younis stated in his on-oath statement that he appeared before the present DDEO for activation of pay and arrears but Dy:DEQ directed that pay activation is responsibility of

Muhammad Younis in his statement declared that he sought the help of M. Hashim (his relative) for activation of pay: In this regard Mohammad Arshad J/C DEO(F) DIKhan fully facilitated M. Hashim to release the salary (Annexure E)

Conclusion:-

All the relevant letters of Muhammad Younis class-iv are fake and bogus. The department has nothing to do with the letters.

The stamp used throughout the pay activation process is fake.

Decision:-

1. Muhammad Younis be directed to deposit Rs 145921/- in the exchequer and be warned in furture.

2. Department should initiate an inquiry against the two Government employees as pointed out by the statement of Muhammad Younis class-iv.

3. Pay active source form and arrears bill had been passed by the District Accounts office DIKhan under wrong designation shown in the stamp (Annexure F,G,H) The concerned DAO staff DIKhan must be warned to be conscious in all aspects while passing/ feeding the bills of

the Government servants.



9. Incorrect. The appellant has good cause of action to file the instant appeal which is liable to be accepted on the following grounds.

GROUNDS:

- A. It is correct that the removal from service was modified into compulsory retirement on the review petition of the appellant, but that order is also against the law, rules, material on record, therefore not tenable and liable to be set aside. Moreover, there is no need of further departmental appeal against the order dated 12.04.2018 as per rules and law.
- B. Incorrect. While para B of the appeal is correct.
- C. Incorrect. No proper opportunity of defence was provided to the appellant during the inquiry as neither statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him opportunity of cross examination.
- D. Not replied according to para D of the appeal. Moreover para D of the appeal is correct.
- E. Incorrect. The appellant did not release the salary of the appellant. Moreover the Muhammad Younis gave himself the contradictory statements which shows the malafide of Muhammad Younis.
- F. Incorrect. While para F of the appeal is correct.
- G. Incorrect. The appellant did not sign the salary bill of Muhammad Younis and has no role in the issue.
- H. Incorrect. While para H of the appeal is correct.

I. Legal.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of appellant may kindly be accepted as prayed for.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:

Preliminary Objections:

(1-15) All objections raised by the respondents are incorrect and baseless. Rather the respondents are estopped to raise any objection due to their own conduct.

FACTS:

- 1. First portion of para 1 is admitted correct, hence no comments, while the rest of the para is incorrect hence denied.
- 2. Incorrect. The appellant did not sign the salary bill of Muhammad Younis. Moreover the claim was not signed by the appellant and submitted to DAO D.I Khan.
- 3. Incorrect. No proper opportunity was provided to the appellant during the inquiry proceeding. Moreover Muhammad Younis gave himself contradictory statement in different inquiries conducted on the issue. (statements of Muhammad Younis Khan statements are attached as Annexure-R-1)
- 4. Incorrect. The appellant submitted reply to show cause notice in which he denied all allegations.
- 5. Incorrect. The appellant was removed from service which was modified to compulsory retirement without conducting regular inquiry which is violation of law and rules.
- 6. Pertain to record, however the removal order was modified to compulsory retirement on his review petition and there is no need of further departmental appeal as per rules and law.
- 7. Pertain to record, however the grievance of the appellant was not redressed as the appellant filed the instant appeal for reinstatement and not for modification of removal order to compulsory retirement.
- 8. Incorrect. The removal order was modified to compulsory retirement on his review petition and there is no need of further departmental appeal as per rules and law.

AMMENDED APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE ORDER DATED 12.04.2018 WHEREBY THE MAJOR PENALTY OF REMOVAL FROM SERVICE WAS CONVERTED INTO MAJOR PENALTY OF COMPULOSORY RETIRMENT FROM SERVICE BY THE APPELLATE AUTHORITY/REVIEWABLE AUTHORITY ON THE REVIEW PETITION OF THE APPELLANT.

PRAYER:

THAT THE ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPEAL, THE IMPUGNED ORDER DATED 12.04.2018 MAY BE SET ASIDE. THE RESPONDENT DEPTT: MAY PLEASE BE DIRECTED TO REINSTATE THE APPELLANT WITH ALL BACK AND CONSEQUENTIAL BENEFITS. ANY OTHER REMEDY WHICH THIS AUGUST TRIBUNAL DEEMS FIT AND APPROPRIATE THAT MAY ALSO BE AWARDED IN FAVOUR OF APPELLANT.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:

FACTS:

1. That the appellant was working as Dy: DEO (M) D.I Khan with honesty and devotion.

2. That while serving in the said capacity, charge sheet along with statement of allegation was issued to the appellant in which the following charges were leveled against the appellant that,

Being DDO you unlawfully released salary for the month of July 2013 amounting to Rs.12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs.145921/- to Muhammad Younas Class-IV whose where about unknown.

The appellant submitted detail repto the charge sheet in which he clearly mentioned that neither the appellant made the pay of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle School come under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear require sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record. (Copies of charge sheet, statement of allegations and reply to charge sheet are attached as Annexure-A,B&C)

- 3. That inquiry was conducted against the appellant in which no proper chance of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him opportunity of cross examination, but despite that the appellant was held responsible by the inquiry committee. (Ccpy of inquiry report is attached as Annexure-D)
- 4. That show cause notice to the appellant which was duly replied by the appellant in which he once again denied the allegations. (Copies of show cause notice and reply to show cause notice are Attached as Annexure-E&F)
- 5. That on the basis of formal inquiry report, the appellant was removed from the service vide order dated 06.11.2017. (Copy of the removal order dated 06.11.2017 is attached as Annexure-G)
- 6. That the appellant filed review petition against the impugned removal order on 15.11.2017, which was not responded within the statutory period of ninety days. (Copy of review petition is attached as Annexure-H)
- 7. That against the removal order and not taking action on the review petition of the appellant, the appellant filed service appeal No. 353/2018 in this august Service Tribunal and during the pendency of service appeal, the review petition of the appellant was decided by the appellate authority/reviewable authority on 12.04.2018 in which the major penalty of removal from service was converted into major

penalty of compusiory retirement from service. Copy of order dated 04.12.2018 is attached as Annexure-I.

- 8. That as the order dated 12.04.2018 was passed during the pendency of the appeal which needed to be challenged, therefore, he filed an application before this Service Tribunal on 18.04.2018 for allowing amendment in the service appeal which was accepted on 17.05.2018 by this august Service Tribunal. Copy of application and order sheet dated 17.05.2018 are attached as Annexure-J & K.
- 9. That now the appellant wants to file the amended appeal against the order dated 12.04.2018 in this Honorable Tribunal on the following grounds amongst others.

GROUNDS:

- A) That the impugned order dated 12.04.2018 is against the law, rules, facts and material on record, therefore not tenable and liable to be set aside.
- B) That the appellant clearly mentioned in his reply to charge sheet and show cause notice that he did not released salary for the month of July 2013 amounting to Rs.12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs.145921/- to Muhammad Younas Class-IV and all have been done by class-IV on fake and bogus sign made on behalf of the appellant as neither the appellant made the pay bill of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle Scholl came under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear requires sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record, which means that the appellant has made nothing relating to release of salary and arrear of Class-IV but he was punished for the fault of others.
- C) That inquiry was not conducted according to the prescribed procedure as no opportunity of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him chance of cross examination which is the violation of law and rules.
- D) That the inquiry committee in its recommendations recommend major penalty to Mr. Taus Khan Dy: DEO D.I Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah but the competent did not impose any penalty on Mr. Taus Khan and minor penalty of stoppage of two increments was imposed upon Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah, while major

penalty of removal from service was imposed upon the appellant which was converted into major penalty of compulsorly retirement by the appellalte authority/reviewable authority on the review petition of the appellant, which means that the appellant was discriminated which is against the norms of justice.

- E) That Muhammad Younas class-IV made fake and bogus sign on behalf of the appellant and salary for the month of July 2013 and arrears was unlawfully drawn by the Muhammad Younas by fake and bogus sign even he made transfer order from Middle School to High School by fake and bogus sign, which means that the appellant was punished for the fault of others.
- F) That the appellant promptly pointed out the irregularity of Mr. Muhammad Younas Class-IV and even addressed a letter on 1.11.2014 to the Manager NBP Main Branch D.I Khan for stoppage of salary of the said official. (Copy of letter is attached as Annexure-L)
- G) That the inquiry was conducted against Muhammad Younas Class-IV and found that all the documents/letters of the concerned official are fake and bogus and the stamp used by him was also fake and the inquiry committee recommended disciplinary proceeding against him. The stamp paper of the Deputy Education Officer used by him in charge report is bogus and self made as he has been used in the case of the appellant. (Copies of inquiry report and charge report are attached as Annexure-M & N)
- H) That the appellant has been condemned unheard and has not been treated according to law and rules.
- I) That the appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.

All have submitted their replication to the enquiry committee (Annex-IV to Q).

To find out the actual position the enquiry committee visited Office of DEO (M) Dera Ismail Khandated 17-10-2016. The DEO (M) D.I.Khan was requested through camp letter No.786 dated 18-10-2016 direct the concerned Officers/Officials to provide relevant record pertaining to the said enquiry (Annex-R) the concerned Officers/Officials were with eviews that the appointment of Muhammad Yourias as Chowk at GMS Wanda Yarak has not been processed accordingly. No entry of the said appointment order is exist in the Dispatch register of DEO (M) D.I.Khan. Photo copy of dispatch register is attached for ready refer (Annex-S&T). The concerned dispatcher also stated in black and white that the endstt No. of the appointment order is fake and not recorded in the dispatch register of DEO (M) D.I.Khan (Annex-U)

The concerned Officers/Official were directed to appear before the enquiry committee on data 11-2016 at Commissioner Office Kohat resultantly they were appeared except Feroz Hussain Shah & Swati Ex- DEOs (M) D.I.Khan, DAO D.I.Khan, S.Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO of GHSS Mandhra Kalaii and Khan S/Clerk of the said school. Those who were appeared before the enquiry committee recorded statements (Annex-V to A1).

The Photo copies of relevant documents provided by the above named Officers were checked thoroughly and it was observed that:-

- 1. Muhammad Younas S/o Muhammad Nawaz resident of Dahother Kacha D.I.Khan was appointed against Chowkidar post at GMS Wanda Yarak D.I.Khan by DEO (M) D.I.Khan vide endstt No.1622-27/DEO (M)/Class-IV Dated 10-04-2013 (Annex-A6). The said order was invalid for the reasons that (i) there is no Chowkidar sanctioned posts in Middle Schools and (ii) there is no entry recorded of such appointment order in the dispatch register of DEO (M) D.I.Khan as revealed from the available record and statement of dispatcher(already annexed).
- 2: Mr.Muhammad Younas Class-IV has cot performed duty at GMS Wanda Yarak D.I.Khan as revealed from the written statement of Head Master, GMS Wanda Yarak (Annex-A7). There are only two classiv sanctioned posts i.e. Naib Qasid and Sweeper at GMS Wanda Yarak against which Mr.Abdur Rasheed Sweeper and Mr.Azizur Rahman NQ are working since the establishment of the school (Annex-A8).
- 3- The pay of Muhammad Younas Class-IV was not released/computerized well in time for the reason mentioned above. Source-1 for computerization of pay was submitted to DAO D.I.Khan duly signed by Mr.Taus Khan Ex-Dy:DEO (M) and countersigned by Mr.Feroz Hussain Shah Ex-DEO (M) D.I.Khan (Annex-A9). His pay was computerized for the ist time in 07/2013 (Annex-A10).
- 4- The accused Muhammad Younas Chowkidar, GMS Wanda Yarak was transferred mutually vice Mr.Zakaullah Class-IV of GHSS Mandhra Kalan D.I.Khan by DEO (M) D.I.Khan vide endstt No.840% 7 dated 08-10-2013 (Annex-A11). The said transfer order is also invalid for the reason that (i) the signatory authority (DEO M D.I.Khan Mr.Taus Khan) has disowned the signature marked on the transfer order and (ii) the dispatch No. recorded on the said transfer order is fake and has not been recorded in dispatch register of DEO (N) D.I.Khan (Already annexed).
- Haripur has released his salary for the month of 10/2013 and 11/2013 without confirmation and issuance of LPC from the quarter concerned which is required being important accounts documents (Annex-A12). Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO Mandra kalan stated that he has signed the source documents for release of pay on the request of Feroz Khan S/Clerk of the school. However Mr.Feroz Khan S/Clerk has denied the statement of DDO Concerned.
- 6- Mr. Taus Khan Ex-DEO (M) Dil Khan now DEO (M) Karak visited GHSS Mandhra Kalan on dated 23-04-2014 and directed the Principal concerned to immediately relieve the accused Class-IV Muhammad Younas resultantly the accused was relieved and his pay was stopped on the verbal direction of Ex-DEO (M) D.I. Khan (Annex-A-13). However no further disciplinary proceeding was initiated by the competent authority due to unknown reason.
- 7- During the course of enquiry it was observed that though the accused was relieved form his official duty on dated 23-04-2014 but even then his salary of intervening period amounting to Rs.145000/- were prepared and submitted to DAO D.I.Khan duly signed by Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-Dy:DEO (M) D.I.Khan now H/M, GHS Chehak D.I.Khan (Annex-A14 to A16). The DAO D.I.Khan passed the said arrear bill (Annex-A-17). Though it was the responsibility of accountant as well as DDO concerned to point out the irregular drawl well in time but no recovery has so far been made from the accused They further recorded the said amount in monthly expdt statement for the month of 10/2014 (Annex-19 to A29). The accused further stated that his salary bill for the period from 01-12-2013 to 30-09-2014 was signed by Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-DDO (M) D.I.Khan. The accused further requested for adjustment and release of pay.
 - 8- Apart from above mentioned facts all the concerned DDOs/Dy:Dos/DDOs except Mr.Zawar Hussa. Shah Ex-DDO GHSS Mandra Kalan now Head Master, GHS Dartian Haripur have disowned to signatures marked on service documents of Muhammad Younas Class-IV Servant. No one is read. The accept the responsibility of fraudulent drawl as well as maintenance of record.
 - 9- The accused class HIV Servant was heard in person. He verbally admitted that he has not person duty at GMS Wandar Yarak for the reason that no staff member was present there. However, and transfer to GHSS Mandra Kalan has use performed duty from 08-10-2013 to 23-04-2014 as received from attendance record of the said school (Annex-A19 to A29). The accused further stated to a

salary bill for the period from 01-12-2013 to 30-09-2014 was signed by Mr.Rambail ex-DD orton.

D.I.Khan. He requested for Re-Instatement and release of pay.

The District Accounts Officer D.I.Khan provided original service and salary record of Muhammad Younas duly submitted by Ex-DDOs of DEO (MO D.I.Khan which was checked thoroughly and it was confirmed that the claim was actually signed by Mr.Rambail Khan and submitted to DAO D.I.Khan which resulted irregular drawl as mentioned in the charge sheet and statement of allegations. The DAO D.I.Khan also recorded his statement (Already annexed).

- 11- Mr.Feroz Hussain Shah Ex- DEO (MO D.I.Khan now retired stated that he has issued the appointment order of the accused Class-IV servant on the direction of Mr.Qaisar Rasheed Judge Peshawar High Court (Already annexed).
- 12- Mr.Zawar Hussain now Head Master, GHS Dartian Haripur stated in black & white that he has signed the source form of Muhammad Younas Class-IV for release of his pay.
- 13- Mr. Feroz Khan S/Clerk of GHSS Mandra Kalan stated that he has stamped the source form of Muhammad Younas Class-IV prior to sign of DDO Concerned (Already annexed).

It is worth mentioning to state that three enquiries have already been conducted against the above named class-IV Servant (Annex-A30 to A33). All the three enquiry committees have declared the 1st appointment order and transfer order as fake and bogus. Though his appointment order was issued under 25 percent reserved quota for the children of class-IV servants as his father was retired from service. However no record was found at DEO (M) D.I.Khan.

During the course of enquiry, it was observed that supporting staff of establishment section and accounts section are fully involved in such fraudulent drawl. Disciplinary proceedings are required to be initiated against them under E&D Rules, 2011. However now they are trying to save their skin from any drastic action.

The Charges have been proved against Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-Dy:DO (M) D.I.Khan now H/M GHS Chehak, Mr.Taus Khan Ex-Dy:DO (M) D.I.Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO GHSS Mandhra Kalar, nov. F/M. GHS Dartian Haripur. Mr.Feroz Hussain Shah Ex-DEO (M) D.I.Khan and Mr.Atta Muhammad have already been retired from service. It is further added that no involvement of Atta Muhammad Ex-Supdtt: has been proved.

RECOMMENDATIONS.

In the light of above mentioned facts and documentary proof on record, the charges have been proved against the above named Officers. It is therefore recommended that:-

- 1- Major Penalty may be imposed upon Mr.Ramabil Khan now H/M, GHS Chehak D.I.Khan, Mr.Taus Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah now H/M, GHS Dartian Haripur under 18 D Rules, 2011.
- 2. Major Penalty of Dismissal may be imposed upon Muhammad Younas Class-IV under E&D Rules 2011. The salary of absence period drawn fraudulently may be recovered and deposit into Govt treasury without further loss of time.
- 3- Disciplinary proceedings may be initiated against Mr.Muhammad Aftab J/Clerk, Tariq Aziz S/Clerk Muhammad Arshad J/Clerk and Feroz Khan S/Clerk of E&SE Deptt; D.I.Khan for their involvement of fraudulent drawl.

- 1. In this context brief history of the Case has already been elucidated to the enquiry committee on the spot and necessary affidavit and the relevant papers of enquiry report of enquiry committee dated 06.01.2015 constituted by DEO (Male) DIKhan (copy attached).
- 2. In the light of Departmental Enquiry Committee, the brief History of the case was submitted to the then Enquiry Officer Mr. Muhammad (ftikhar Ahmad Shamozai Asstt: Director Sports Directorate of E&SE, KPK, Peshawar vide No. 15315 dated 17.08.2016. The 73 pages report which were self explanatory. (Copy attached).
- 3. Previously the enquiry report against fraudulent drawl of Rs. 145000/- in r/o Muhammad Younis, Class-IV was already conducted by the enquiry Committee consisting on Mr. Qamar-uz-Zaman, Principal, GHS. Paroa (DIKhan) and Mr. Jamal Ahmad Mirza, Head Master, GHS. Behari Colony DIKhan, which was constituted by DEO (M) DIKhan No. 21766-21767/DEO(M) 8&AO dated 10.11.2014, which is self explanatory and all the relevant reports were attached with the enquiry report (Copies attached).
- 4. All the amount in question has been recovered from the Class-IV concerned.
- 5. The said Class-IV was not appointed under any signature and his 1st Source form was not presented in DAO, DIKhan for feeding through myself. Moreover his Service Book was also not signed by me.



- 6. I was not involved in that malpractice. All thel process about his drawl was made with the collusion of some one either in the office or outsider just to defame my dignity.
- 7. The all process was made on surmise basis just to safe some one.
- 8. It is irony of fat that I have already illegally punished by degrading my scale from BPS-18 to BPS-17.
- 9. Now I have again involved and indict in the insignificant and repugnant case as rotated on conjecture basis as prejudicially. There is no proper tangible documents against me. The case was prepared against me as malafide and not based on facts. I have presented submitted the reply to Mr. Mussarat Hussain, Commissioner Kohat and Mr. Saifur Rehman, Principal GHS. No.1 Nowshera in the light of notification No. SO(S/M) E&SED/4-17/2015/S.Zawar Hussain Shah, Head Master, GHS. Mithapur/171 dt: 08.08.2016 alongwith relevant document which was self explanatory and comprehence. In which, I solemnly declared on oath that neither the pay of Mr. Muhammad Younis, Class-IV was drawn under my signature and no file in this regard was put up to me by the Account Branch of the office. The said Class-IV was illegally transferred from GHS. Mandhran Kalan to GMS. Wanda Yarik, where no post of Chowkidar was exist.
- 10. It was a insignificant and devoid charges against me which was intentionally speared and dragged just to defame my dignity being a direct selected on Management cadre.
- 11. Previously, I have faced great loss and reverted from the post of Dy: DEO(M) DIKhan (BPS-18) to the Head Master, GHS. Chahkan (BPS-17).
- 12. Sir, it was not understood that there was no irregularity and embezzlement was made, then why an ex-party drastic action is being taken against me.
- 13. I have already submitted the enquiry report of Mr. Qamar-uz-Zaman, Principal, GHS. Paroa and Mr. Jamal Ahmad Mirza, Head Master GHS. Benari Colony DIKhan dated 06.01.2015 (office Dy: No. 258 dated 10.01.2015 and the brief History of the case submitted vide DEO (M) DIKhan No. 15315 dated 17:08.2016 (copies attached).



- 14. Simultaneously, the reply of questionnaire which was submitted to Mr. Hassam-ul-Haq,
 Principal GHS. No. 3 Kohat dated 12.08.2015 and the current reply in this regard submitted vide
 No.662-6 dated 23.08.2016 referred to above are attached for your kind perusal please.
 - 15. All the allegation based on prejudicially and inequitable the one sided report was prepared on the basis of conjecture just to safe some one from these self maded allegations.
 - 16. I am totally innocent and not involved with any serious irregularities hence not calling for the action regarding to impose Major penalty under Rule-04. I have rendered 30 years meritorious service in Education Deptt: . The inequitable one-sided action taken against me will take on my future career in Service/life and great financial loss.
 - 17. I have already submitted all the relevant inquiry report, made by me from time to time along with relevant documents to your good self.

As all the irregularities/iilegal process were made by the then DEO(M) DIKhan or by some one, hence it is requested that my case may please be reviewed and I may be exonerated from this critical situation and to avoid mental torture.

It is also stated that I would like to appear in person before the competent authority for my defence, as & when called for the purpose. I hope that my genuine report will be given sympathetic consideration please.

Respected Sir,

- 1. That the appellant was working as Dy: DEO (M) D.I Khan with honesty and devotion.
- 2. That while serving in the said capacity, charge sheet along with statement of allegation was issued to the appellant in which the following charges were leveled against the appellant that,

Being DDO you unlawfully released salary for the month of July 2013 amounting to Rs. 12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs. 145921/- to Mulicinimad Younas Class-IV whose where about unknown.

The appellant submitted detail reply to the charge sheet in which he clearly mentioned that neither the appellant made the pay of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle School come under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear require sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record. (Copies of charge sheet and reply to charge sheet are attached as Annexure-A&B)

- 3. That no regular inquiry was conducted against the appellant in which not proper chance of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him opportunity of cross examination but despite that the appellant was held responsible by the inquiry committee.
- 4. That show cause notice to the appellant which was duly replied by the appellant in which he once again denied the allegations. (Copies of show cause notice and reply to show cause notice are Attached as Annexure-C&D)

- 5. That on the basis of formal inquiry report, the appellant was removed from the service vide order dated 06.11.2017. (Copy of the removal order dated 06.11.2017 is attached as Annexure-E)
- 6. That now the appellant wants to file the review petition against the order dated 06.11.2017 on the following grounds.

GROUNDS:

- A) That the impugned order dated 06.11.2017 is against the law, rules, facts and material on record, therefore not tenable and liable to be set aside.
- B) That the appellant clearly mentioned in his rely to charge sheet and show cause notice that he did not released salary for the month of July 2013 amounting to Rs.12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs.145921/- to Muhammad Younas Class-IV and all have been done by class-IV on fake and bogus sign made on behalf of the appellant as neither the appellant made the pay bill of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle Scholl came under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear requires sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record, which means that the appellant has made nothing relating to release of salary and arrear of Class-IV but he was punished for the fault of others.
 - C) That inquiry was not conducted according to the prescribed procedure as no opportunity of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him chance of cross examination which is the violation of law and rules.
 - D) That the inquiry committee in its recommendations recommend major penalty to Mr. Taus Khan Dy: DEO D.I Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah but the competent did not impose any penalty on Mr. Taus Khan and minor penalty of stoppage of two increments was imposed upon Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah, while major penalty of removal from service was imposed upon the appellant which means that the appellant was discriminated which is against the norms of justice.
 - E) That Muhammad Younas class-IV made fake and bogus sign on behalf of the appellant and salary for the month of July 2013 and



arrears was unlawfully drawn by the Mr. Muhammad Younas by fake and bogus sign even he made transfer order from Middle School to High School by fake and bogus sign, which means that the appellant was punished for the fault of others.

- F) That the appellant promptly pointed out the irregularity of Mr. Muhammad Younas Class-IV and even addressed a letter to the Manager NBP Main Branch D.I.Khan for stoppage of salary of the said official, In addition to this letter was also addressed for inactivation of pay to D.A.O D.I.Khan (copy of the letter is attached as annexure-I).
- G) That the inquiry was conducted against Muhammad Younas Class-IV and found that all the documents/letters of the concerned official are fake and bogus and the stamp used by him was also fake and the inquiry committee recommended disciplinary proceeding against him. The Stamp of Deputy Education officer used by him in charge report is also bogus and self-made as has been used in the case of the appellant (Copy at Annex- C & II)
- H) That the appellant has been condemned unheard and has not been treated according to law and rules.
 - I) That the appellant has more than 30 years of service and penalty of removal from service is very harsh which is against norm of justice.

It is therefore, most humbly requested that on acceptance of this review petition the impugned order dated 06.11.2017 may be set aside and reinstate the appellant with all back and consequential benefits.



2. Charge report of 10/04/2013 shows a fake stamp with designation of Dy: Education officer Dera Ismail Khan. This post even does not exist at all.

Ex- DDO GHSS Mandran Kalan Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah activated the monthly salary of Mohammad Younis without any LPC. The detailed statements of the clerks in GHSS

Mandran Kalan is annexed.(Annexure A,B) Statement submitted by the accountant Mr. Muhammad Aftab Dy:DEO Mr. Rambail Khan declared that they have not been involved in the activation of salary of Muhammad Younis or hisarrears. DDEO declared that he had not issued pay release order in respect of M. Younis class-iv.(Annexure C,D)-

Muhammad Younis stated in his on-oath statement that he appeared before the present DDEO for activation of pay and arrears but Dy:DEO directed that pay activation is responsibility of

the office.

Muhammad Younis in his statement declared that he sought the help of M. Hashim (his relative) for activation of pay. In this regard Mohammad Arshad I/C DEO(F) DIKhan fully facilitatedM. Hashim to release the salary (Annexure E)

Conclusion:-

All the relevant letters of Muhammad Younis class-iv are take and bogus. The department has nothing to do with the letters.

The stamp used throughout the pay activation process is fake.

Decision:-

1. Muhammad Younis be directed to deposit Rs 145921/- in the exchequer and be warned in furture.

2. Department should initiate an inquiry against the two Government employees as pointed out by the statement of Muhammad Younis class-iv.

3. Pay active source form and arrears bill had been passed by the District Accounts office DIKhan under wrong designation shown in the stamp.(Annexure F,G,H) The concerned DAO staff DIKhan must be warned to be conscious in all aspects while passing/ feeding the bills of the Government servants.



THE RESPONDENT DEPTT: MAY PLEASE BE DIRECTED TO REINSTATE THE APPELLANT WITH ALL BACK AND CONSEQUENTIAL BENEFITS. ANY OTHER REMEDY WHICH THIS AUGUST TRIBUNAL DEEMS FIT AND APPROPRIATE THAT MAY ALSO BE AWARDED IN FAVOUR OF APPELLANT.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:

FACTS:

1. That the appellant was working as Dy: DEO (M) D.I Khan with honesty and devotion.

2. That while serving in the said capacity, charge sheet along with statement of allegation was issued to the appellant in which the following charges were leveled against the appellant that,

Being DDO you unlawfully released salary for the month of July 2013 amounting to Rs. 12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs. 145921/- to Muhammad Younas Class-IV whose where about unknown.

The appellant submitted detail repto the charge sheet in which he clearly mentioned that neither the appellant made the pay of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle School come under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear require sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record. (Copies of charge, statment of allegations and reply to charge sheet are attached as Annexure-A,B&C)

- 3. That inquiry was conducted against the appellant in which no proper chance of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him opportunity of cross examination, but despite that the appellant was held responsible by the inquiry committee. (Copy of inquiry report is attached as Annexure-D)
- 4. That show cause notice to the appellant which was duly replied by the appellant in which he once again denied the allegations. (Copies of show cause notice and reply to show cause notice are Attached as Annexure-E&F)
- 5. That on the basis of formal inquiry report, the appellant was removed from the service vide order dated 06.11.2017. (Copy of the removal order dated 06.11.2017 is attached as Annexure-G)
- 6. That the appellant filed review petition against theimpugned removal order on 29.11.2017, which was not responded within the statutory period of ninety days. (Copy of review petition is attached as Annexure-H)
- 7. That now the appellant wants to file the review petition against the order dated 06.11.2017 on the following grounds.

GROUNDS:

A) That the impugned order dated 06.11.2017 and not taking action on teh review petition are against the law, rules, facts and material on record, therefore not tenable and liable to be set aside.

- B) That the appellant clearly mentioned in his reply to charge sheet and show cause notice that he did not released salary for the month of July! 2013 amounting to Rs.12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs.145921/- to Muhammad Younas Class-IV and all have been done by class-IV on fake and bogus sign made on behalf of the appellant as neither the appellant made the pay bill of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle Scholl came under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear requires sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record, which means that the appellant has made nothing relating to release of salary and arrear of Class-IV but he was punished for the fault of others.
- C) That inquiry was not conducted according to the prescribed procedure as no opportunity of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him chance of cross examination which is the violation of law and rules.
- D) That the inquiry committee in its recommendations recommend major penalty to Mr. Taus Khan Dy: DEO D.I Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah but the competent did not impose any penalty on Mr. Taus Khan and minor penalty of stoppage of two increments was imposed upon Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah, while major penalty of removal from service was imposed upon the appellant which means that the appellant was discriminated which is against the norms of justice.
- E) That Muhammad Younas class-IV made fake and bogus sign on behalf of the appellant and salary for the month of July 2013 and arrears was unlawfully drawn by the Muhammad Younas by fake and bogus sign even he made transfer order from Middle School to High School by fake and bogus sign, which means that the appellant was punished for the fault of others.
- F) That the appellant promptly pointed out the irregularity of Mr. Muhammad Younas Class-IV and even addressed a letter on 1.11.2014 to the Manager NBP Main Branch D.I Khan, for stoppage of salary of the said official. (Copy of letter is attached as Annexure-I)
- G) That the inquiry was conducted against Muhammad Younas Class-IV and found that all the documents/letters of the concerned official are fake and bogus and the stamp used by him was also fake and the inquiry committee recommended disciplinary proceeding against him.

The stamp paper of the Deputy Education Officer used by him in charge report is bogus and self made as he has been used in the case of the appellant. (Copies of inquiry report and charge report are attached as Annexure-J&K)

- H) That the appellant has been condemned unheard and has not been treated according to law and rules.
 - I) That the appellant has more than 30 years of service and penalty of removal from service is very harsh which is against norm of justice.
 - J) That the appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.



PREAMBLE.

The competent authority has constituted the following enquiry committee vide office Notification No.SO(S/M)E&SED/4-17/2015/Syed Zawar Hussain Shah HM, GHS Mitha Pur/171 Dated 08-08-2016 to conduct formal enquiry against the following Officers for the charges mentioned in the charge sheet and statement of allegations already served upon the concerned Officers (Annex-A).

- 1 Mr. Taus Khan Ex-Dy: DEO (M) D.I. Khan now DEO (M) Karak.
- 2- Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-Dy:DEO (M) D.I.Khan now H/M, GHS Chehak D.I.Khan
- 3- Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO, GHSS Mandhra Kalan now H/M, GHS Dhartian Haripur.
- 4 Mr. Atta Muhammad Ex-Sepdit: 250 /M) D.I. Khan now retired.

ENQUIRY COMMITTEE

ALLEGATIONS.

Being DDOs unlawfully released pay and arrears of Muhammad_Younas Class-IV for various periods which caused great loss to Govt _exchequer.

TERMS OF REFERENCE OF ENQUIRY COMMITTEE.

- The aforesaid committee shall look into the matter, conduct formal inquiry for the charges mentioned in the charge sheet and statements of allegations already served upon the conficerned Officers and submit recommendation/report to the competent authority.
- ii- In pursuance of letter No.SO(S/M)E&SED/4-17/2015/S.Zawar Hussain Shah & other\$/171 dated 17-02-2017, the committee clarify the present status of Muhammad Younas Class-IV [3].
- iii- Charge against M/S Taus Khan Ex-Dy:DEO (M) D.I.Khan and Atta Muhammad Supdtt lat the Office of DEO (M) D.I.Khan be examined & report upon.
- iv- The committee should specify other staff of establishment & accounts section who was involve in the fraudulent draw!

PROCEEDINGS.

In compliance with the above referred notification of the competent authority, the enquicommittee started the proceedings accordingly. The competent authority has already served statement allegations and charge sheets upon the above named officers (Annex-B to M). All have submitted their replito the enquiry committee (Annex-N to Q).

To find out the actual position the enquiry committee visited Office of DEO (M) Dera Ismail Khanddated 17:10-2016. The DEO (M) D.I.Khan was requested through camp letter No.786 dated 18-10-2016 direct the concerned Officers/Officials to provide relevant record pertaining to the said enquiry (Annax-R), the concerned Officers/Officials were a file views that the appointment of Muhammad Younas as Chowkic at GMS Wanda Yarak has not been processed accordingly. No entry of the said appointment order is exist in the Dispatch register of DEO (M) D.I.Khan. Photo copy of dispatch register is attached for ready referer (Annex-S&T). The concerned dispatcher also stated in black and white that the endstt No. of the sappointment order is fake and not recorded in the dispatch register of DEO (M) D.I.Khan (Annex-U)

The concerned Officers/Officials were directed to appear before the enquiry committee of dated 11-2016 at Commissioner Office Kohat resultantly they were appeared except Feroz Hussain Shah & 1 Swati Ex- DEOs (M) D.I.Khan, DAD D.I.Khan, S.Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO of GHSS Mandhra Kalan and Fe Khan S/Clerk of the said school. Those who were appeared before the enquiry committee recorded statements (Annex-V to A1).

DINGS.

The Photo copies of relevant documents provided by the above named Officers were checked thoroughly and it was observed that:-

- 1. Muhammad Younas S/o Muhammad Nawaz resident of Dahother Kacha D.I.Khan was appointed against Chowkidar post at GMS Wanda Yarak D.I.Khan by DEO (M) D.I.Khan vide endstt No.1622-27/DEO (M)/Class-IV Dated 10-04-2013 (Annex-A6). The said order was invalid for the reasons that (i) there is no Chowkidar sanctioned posts in Middle Schools and (ii) there is no entry recorded of such appointment order in the dispatch register of DEO (M) D.I.Khan as revealed from the available record and statement of dispatcher(already annexed).
- 2- Mr.Muhammad Younas Class-IV has reat performed duty at GMS Wanda Yarak D.I.Khan as revealed from the written statement of Head Master, GMS Wanda Yarak (Annex-A7). There are only two classiv sanctioned posts i.e Naib Qasid and Sweeper at GMS Wanda Yarak against which Mr.Abdur Rasheed Sweeper and Mr.Azizur Rahman NQ are working since the establishment of the school (Annex-A8).
- 3- The pay of Muhammad Younas Class-IV was not released/computerized well in time for the reason mentioned above. Source-1 for computerization of pay was submitted to DAO D.I.Khan duly signed by Mr.Taus Khan Ex-Dy:DEO (M) and countersigned by Mr.Feroz Hussain Shah Ex-DEO (M) D.I.Khan (Annex-A9). His pay was computerized for the ist time in 07/2013 (Annex-A10).
- 4- The accused Muhammad Younas Chowkidar, GMS Wanda Yarak was transferred mutually vice Mr.Zakaullah Class-IV of GHSS Mandhra Kalan D.I.Khan by DEO (M) D.I.Khan vide endstt No.8403-7 dated 08-10-2013 (Annex-A11). The said transfer order is also invalid for the reason that (i) the signatory authority (DEO M D.I.Khan Mr.Taus Khan) has disowned the signature marked on the transfer order and (ii) the dispatch No. recorded on the said transfer order is fake and has not been recorded in dispatch register of DEO (N) D.I.Khan (Already annexed).
- S- The DDO of GHSS Mandhra Kalan D.I.Khan Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah now Head Master. GHS Dartian Haripur has released his salary for the month of 10/2013 and 11/2013 without confirmation and issuance of LPC from the quarter concerned which is required being important accounts documents (Annex-A12). Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO Mandra kalan stated that he has signed the source documents for release of pay on the request of Feroz Khan S/Clerk of the school. However Mr.Feroz Khan S/Clerk has denied the statement of DDO Concerned.
- 6- Mr.Taus Khan Ex-DEO (M) D I Khan now DEO (M) Karak visited GHSS Mandhra Kalan on dated 23-04-2014 and directed the Principal concerned to immediately relieve the accused Class-IV Muhammad Younas resultantly the accused was relieved and his pay was stopped on the verbal direction of Ex-DEO (M) D.I.Khan (Annex-A-13). However no further disciplinary proceeding was initiated by the competent authority due to unknown reason.
- During the course of enquiry it was observed that though the accused was relieved form his official duty on dated 23-04-2014 but even then his salary of intervening period amounting to Rs.145000, were prepared and submitted to DAO D.I.Khan duly signed by Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-Dy.DEO (MD.I.Khan now H/M, GHS Chehak D.I.Khan (Annex-A14 to A16). The DAO D.I.Khan passed the salar arrear bill (Annex-A-17). Though it was the responsibility of accountant as well as DDO concerned to point out the irregular drawl well in time but no recovery has so far been made from the accused.

 They further recorded the said amount in morithly expdt statement for the month of 10/2014 (Annex-19 to A29). The accused further stated that his salary bill for the period from 01-12-2013 to 30-09-2014 was signed by Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-DDO (M) D.I.Khan, The accused further requested for adjustment and release of pay.
- 8- Apart from above mentioned facts all the concerned DDOs/Dy:Dos/DDOs except Mr.Zawar Hussa Shah Ex-DDO GHSS Mandra Kalan now Head Master, GHS Dartian Haripur have disowned signatures marked on service documents of Muhammad Younas Class-IV Servant. No one is regional accept the responsibility of fraudulent drawl as well as maintenance of record.
- 9- The accused class –IV Servant was heard in person. He verbally admitted that he has not personal duty at GMS Wandar Yarak for the reason that no staff member was present there. However are transfer to GHSS Mandra Kalan he was performed duty from 08-10-2013 to 23-04-2014 as refer to attendance record of the said school (Annex-A19 to A29). The accused further stated in a

salary bill for the period from 01-12-2013 to 30-09-2014 was signed by Mr.Rambail ex-DDO-tMcD.i.Khan. He requested for Re-Instatement and release of pay.

- The District Accounts Officer D.I.Khan provided original service and salary record of Muhammad Younas duly submitted by Ex-DDOs of DEO (MO D.I.Khan which was checked thoroughly and it was confirmed that the claim was actually signed by Mr.Rambail Khan and submitted to DAO D.I.Khan which resulted irregular drawl as mentioned in the charge sheet and statement of allegations. The DAO D.I.Khan also recorded his statement (Already annexed).
- 11- Mr. Feroz Hussain Shah Ex- DEO (MO D.I.Khan now retired stated that he has issued the appointment order of the accused Class-IV servant on the direction of Mr. Qaisar Rasheed Judge Peshawar High Court (Already annexed).
- 12- Mr. Zawar Hussain now Head Master, GHS Dartian Haripur stated in black & white that he has signed the source form of Muhammad Younas Class-IV for release of his pay.
- 13- Mr.Feroz Khan S/Clerk of GHSS Mandra Kalan stated that he has stamped the source form of Muhammad Younas Class-IV prior to sign of DDO Concerned (Already annexed).

It is worth mentioning to state that three enquiries have already been conducted against the above named class-IV Servant (Annex-A30 to A33). All the three enquiry committees have declared the 1st appointment order and transfer order as fake and bogus. Though his appointment order was issued under 25 percent reserved quota for the children of class-IV servants as his father was retired from service. However no record was found at DEO (M) D.I.Khan.

During the course of enquiry, it was observed that supporting staff of establishment section and accounts section are fully involved in such fraudulent drawl. Disciplinary proceedings are required to be initiated against them under E&D Rules, 2011. However now they are trying to save their skin from any drastic action.

The Charges have been proved against Mr.Rambail Khan Ex-Dy:DO (M) D.I.Khan now H/M GHS Chehak, Mr.Taus Khan Ex-Dy:DO (M) D.I.Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah Ex-DDO GHSS Mandhra Kalari now h/M. GHS Dartian Haripur. Mr.Feroz Hussain Shah Ex-DEO (M) D.I.Khan and Mr.Atta Muhammad have already been retired from service. It is further added that no involvement of Atta Muhammad Ex-Supdtt: has been proved.

RECOMMENDATIONS.

In the light of above mentioned facts and documentary proof on record, the charges have been proved against the above named Officers. It is therefore recommended that:-

- 1- Major Penalty may be imposed upon Mr.Ramabil Khan now H/M, GHS Chehak D.I.Khan, Mr.Taus Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr.Zawar Hussain Shah now H/M, GHS Dartian Haripur under 18-0 Rules, 2011.
- 2- Major Penalty of Dismissal may be imposed upon Muhammad Younas Class-IV under E&D Rules 2011. The salary of absence period drawn fraudulently may be recovered and deposit into Govt treasury without further loss of time.
- 3- Disciplinary proceedings may be initiated against Mr.Muhammad Aftab J/Clerk, Tariq Aziz S/Clerk Muhammad Arshad J/Clerk and Feroz Khan S/Clerk of E&SE Deptt; D.I.Khan for their involvement of fraudulent drawl.



- In this context brief history of the Case has already been elucidated to the enquiry committee
 on the spot and necessary affidavit and the relevant papers of enquiry report of enquiry
 committee dated 06.01.2015 constituted by DEO (Male) DIKhan (copy attached).
- In the light of Departmental Enquiry Committee, the brief History of the case was submitted to the then Enquiry Officer Mr. Muhammad Iftikhar Ahmad Shamozai Asstt: Director Sports Directorate of E&SE, KPK, Peshawar vide No. 15315 dated 17.08.2016. The 73 pages report which were self explanatory. (Copy attached).
- 3. Previously the enquiry report against fraudulent drawl of Rs. 145000/- in r/o Muhammad Younis, Class-IV was already conducted by the enquiry Committee consisting on Mr. Qamar-uz-Zaman, Principal, GHS. Paroa (DiKhan) and Mr. Jamal Ahmad Mirza, Head Master, GHS. Behari Colony DiKhan, which was constituted by DEO (M) DiKhan No. 21766-21767/DEO(M) B&AO dated 10.11.2014, which is self explanatory and all the relevant reports were attached with the enquiry report (Copies attached).
- 4. All the amount in question has been recovered from the Class-IV concerned.
- 5. The said Class-IV was not appointed under any signature and his 1st Source form was not presented in DAO, DIKhan for feeding through myself. Moreover his Service Book was also not signed by me.



- 6. I was not involved in that malpractice. All thei process about his drawl was made with the collusion of some one either in the office or outsider just to defame my dignity.
- 7. The all process was made on surmise basis just to safe some one.
- 8. It is irony of fat that I have already illegally punished by degrading my scale from BPS-18 to BPS-17.
- 9. Now I have again involved and indict in the insignificant and repugnant case as rotated on conjecture basis as prejudicially. There is no proper tangible documents against me. The case was prepared against me as malafide and not based on facts. I have presented submitted the reply to Mr. Mussarat Hussain, Commissioner Kohat and Mr. Saifur Rehman, Principal GHS. No.1 Nowshera in the light of notification No. SO(S/M) E&SED/4-17/2015/

 S.Zawar Hussain Shah, Head Master, GHS. Mithapur/171 dt: 08.08.2016 alongwith relevant document which was self explanatory and comprehence. In which, I solemnly declared on oath that neither the pay of Mr. Muhammad Younis, Class-IV was drawn under my signature and no illegally transferred from GHS. Mandhran Kalan to GMS. Wanda Yarik, where no post of Chowkidar was exist.
- 10. It was a insignificant and devoid charges against me which was intentionally speared and dragged just to defame my dignity being a direct selected on Management cadre.
- 11. Previously, I have faced great loss and reverted from the post of Dy: DEO(M) DIKhan (BPS-18) to the Head Master, GHS: Chahkan (BPS-17).
- 12. Sir, it was not understood that there was no irregularity and embezzlement was made, then why an ex-party drastic action is being taken against me.
- 13. I have already submitted the enquiry report of Mr. Qamar-uz-Zaman, Principal, GHS. Paroa and Mr. Jamal Ahmad Mirza, Head Master GHS. Benari Colony DIKhan dated 06.01.2015 (office Dy: 15315 dated 17.08.2016 (copies attached).



- 14. Simultaneously, the reply of questionnaire which was submitted to Mr. Hassam-ul-Haq, Principal GHS. No. 3 Kohat dated 12.08.2015 and the current reply in this regard submitted vide No.662-6 dated 23.08.2016 referred to above are attached for your kind perusal please.
- 15. All the allegation based on prejudicially and inequitable the one sided report was prepared on the basis of conjecture just to safe some one from these self-maded allegations.
- 16. I am totally innocent and not involved with any serious irregularities hence not calling for the action regarding to impose Major penalty under Rule-04. I have rendered 30 years meritorious service in Education Deptt: . The inequitable one sided action taken against me will take on my future career in Service/life and great financial loss.
- 17. I have already submitted all the relevant inquiry report, made by me from time to time along with relevant documents to your good self.

As all the irregularities/iilegal process were made by the then DEO(M) DIKhan or by some one, hence it is requested that my case may please be reviewed and I may be exonerated from this critical situation and to avoid mental torture.

It is also stated that I would like to appear in person before the competent authority for my defence, as & when called for the purpose. I hope that my genuine report will be given sympathetic consideration please.

REVIEW PETITION AGAINST THE ORDER DATED 06.11.2017, WHEREBY THE APPELLANT WAS REMOVED FROM SERVICE.

Respected Sir,

- 1. That the appellant was working as Dy: DEO (M) D.I Khan with honesty and devotion.
- 2. That while serving in the said capacity, charge sheet along with statement of allegation was issued to the appellant in which the following charges were leveled against the appellant that,

Being DDO you unlawfully released salary for the month of July 2013 amounting to Rs.12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs.145921/- to Mulicinimad Younas Class-IV whose where about unknown.

The appellant submitted detail reply to the charge sheet in which he clearly mentioned that neither the appellant made the pay of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle School come under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear require sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record. (Copies of charge sheet and reply to charge sheet are attached as Annexure-A&B).

- 3. That no regular inquiry was conducted against the appellant in which no proper chance of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him opportunity of cross examination but despite that the appellant was held responsible by the inquiry committee.
- 4. That show cause notice to the appellant which was duly replied by the appellant in which he once again denied the allegations. (Copies of show cause notice and reply to show cause notice are Attached as Annexure-C&D)

- 5. That on the basis of formal inquiry report, the appellant was removed from the service vide order dated 06.11.2017. (Copy of the removal order dated 06.11.2017 is attached as Annexure-E)
- 6. That now the appellant wants to file the review petition against the order dated 06.11.2017 on the following grounds.

GROUNDS:

- A) That the impugned order dated 06.11.2017 is against the law, rules, facts and material on record, therefore not tenable and liable to be set aside.
- B) That the appellant clearly mentioned in his rely to charge sheet and show cause notice that he did not released salary for the month of July. 2013 amounting to Rs.12201/- and arrears for the period from 1.12.2013 to 31.10.2014 amounting to Rs.145921/- to Muhammad Younas Class-IV and all have been done by class-IV on fake and bogus sign made on behalf of the appellant as neither the appellant made the pay bill of Muhammad Younas class-IV active nor the same was brought before the appellant by the Accountant or Budget & Accounts Officer as required under the standard operating procedure. The question of either making pay active and payment of arrear does not arise as the employee concerned never remain in office or in any of the middle School, he further contended in his reply that Middle Scholl came under domain of the appellant and no post of Chowkidar exists at Middle School. The appellant also contended in his reply that payment of arrear requires sanction of competent authority i.e DEO being principal accounting officer was obligatory which was neither granted nor available on record, which means that the appellant has made nothing relating to release of salary and arrear of Class-IV but he was punished for the fault of others.
 - C) That inquiry was not conducted according to the prescribed procedure as no opportunity of defence was provided to the appellant as neither the statements were recorded in the presence of the appellant nor gave him chance of cross examination which is the violation of law and rules.
 - D) That the inquiry committee in its recommendations recommend major penalty to Mr. Taus Khan Dy: DEO D.I Khan now DEO (M) Karak and Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah but the competent did not impose any penalty on Mr. Taus Khan and minor penalty of stoppage of two increments was imposed upon Mr. Zawar Hussain Shah, while major penalty of removal from service was imposed upon the appellant which means that the appellant was discriminated which is against the norms of justice.
 - E) That Muhammad Younas class-IV made fake and bogus sign on behalf of the appellant and salary for the month of July 2013 and



arrears was unlawfully drawn by the Mr. Muhammad Younas by fake and bogus sign even he made transfer order from Middle School to High School by fake and bogus sign, which means that the appellant was punished for the fault of others.

- F) That the appellant promptly pointed out the irregularity of Mr. Muhammad Younas Class-IV and even addressed a letter to the Manager NBP Main Branch D.I.Khan for stoppage of salary of the said official. In addition to this letter was also addressed for inactivation of pay to D.A.O D.I.Khan (copy of the letter is attached as annexure-F).
- G) That the inquiry was conducted against Muhammad Younas Class-IV and found that all the documents/letters of the concerned official are fake and bogus and the stamp used by him was also fake and the inquiry committee recommended disciplinary proceeding against him. The Stamp of Deputy Education officer used by him in charge report is also bogus and self-made as has been used in the case of the appellant (Copy at Annex- C & II)
- H) That the appellant has been condemned unheard and has not been treated according to law and rules.
 - I) That the appellant has more than 30 years of service and penalty of removal from service is very harsh which is against norm of justice.

It is therefore, most humbly requested that on acceptance of this review petition the impugned order dated 06.11.2017 may be set aside and reinstate the appellant with all back and consequential benefits.
