



APPEAL U/S 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT 1974 AGAINST THE LETTER NO. LFA/ESTT/SAS/2014 DATED 28-03-2022 WHEREBY DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT FILED AGAINST THE NOTIFICATION NO SO(ESTT)/FD/1-16/2014/LFA/SSRC/VO/IIV DATED 25-05-2018 WHEREBY IN THE APPENDIX AGAINST SERIAL NO 4 IN COLUMN 6 AMENDMENT HAS BEEN MADE, HAS BEEN REGRETTEED.

PRAYER:-

On acceptance of this appeal the impugned order/decision communicated to the appellant vide Letter No. LFA/Estt/SAS/2014 dated 28-03-2022 and Notification No SO(Estt)/FD/1-16/2014/LFA/SSRC/Vol/IIV dated 25-05-2018 whereby rules in the appendix against serial No 4 in Column 6, amendment has been made, may kindly be struck down and the rules for promotion to audit officer (BPS-16) notified as per Notification No SO(ESTT)FD/1-16/04 dated 01-06-2005 may please be restored thereby restoring 60% quota for promotion for Subordinate Accounting Service (SAS) qualified auditors.

Respectfully Submitted:-

1. That the appellant was appointed as Auditor (BPS-14) on 20-03-2013 in the Local Fund Audit which is an attached body of the Finance Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and since appointment the appellant performed his duties with honesty and full devotion and to the entire satisfaction of his high ups. The appellant qualified Subordinate Accounting Services Examination in the year 2018 which was notified vide Notification dated 15-01-2018. **(Copy of Notification dated 20-03-2013 & Notification dated 15-01-2018 is enclosed as Annexure A & B).**

2. That initially the department was governed for recruitment and appointment as per the Recruitment & Appointment Rules 1980, wherein 67% quota was reserved for Subordinate Accounting Services (herein after referred to as SAS) qualified Auditors for promotion to the post of Audit Officers (BPS-16), while 33% quota was reserved for direct recruitment, which was amended vide Notification dated 10-02-1993 whereby the SAS qualified quota of 67% was kept intact while 33% quota was reserved for promotion on the basis of Seniority Cum Fitness. **(Copy of Recruitment & Appointment Rules 1980 & Notification dated 10-02-1993 is enclosed as Annexure C & D).**
3. That the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Recruitment Appointment Rules 1980 were further amended whereby quota of auditors for promotion to the post of Audit Officers (BPS-16) was revised, wherein the quota of SAS qualified auditors was brought to 60% and 40% was equally distributed for initial recruitment as audit officer and promotion on the basis of seniority cum fitness vide Notification dated 01-06-2005.
4. That due to non-availability of SAS qualified auditors and acute shortage of officers to run the routine work of Local Fund Audit, the appointment and promotion Rules were temporary amended by reducing the SAS qualified auditor quota from 60% to 20% and enhancing the Non SAS qualified auditor quota from 20% to 60% in order to meet the increasing demand of officers whereas the quota of initial recruitment through public service commission remain unchanged to 20% duly notified vide Notification No. dated 29-04-2010. **(Copy of Notification dated 01-06-2005 & Notification dated 29-04-2010 is enclosed as Annexure E&F).**
5. That the stated rules were once again amended in the year 2018 in response to the appeal of SAS qualified auditors for restoration of original quota of SAS qualified auditors to 60% however the grievances/demand of qualified auditors were not fully addressed and SAS quota was enhanced to 30% instead of 60% vide Notification dated 25-05-2018, thus depriving Local Fund Audit department from officers with professional audit/account certification. **(Copy of Notification dated 25-05-2018 is enclosed as Annexure G).**
6. That the appellant along with other SAS qualified auditors jointly approached respondent No 1 for restoring 60% quota for the SAS qualified auditors for promotion as Audit Officers (BPS-16) and to equip the Local Fund Audit with qualified audit officers however after meeting with the auditors under the chairmanship of respondent No 1 it was decided and agreed that share of promotion quota is to be equally distributed i.e 40% both of SAS and no-SAS auditors as evident from letter dated 26-06-2021, but the same has been processed with no fruitful result. **(Copy of Notification dated 26-06-2021 is enclosed as Annexure G/1).**

7. That finally the appellant approached respondent No 1 by filing departmental appeal on 04-03-2022 which was regretted vide Letter dated 28-03-2022. **(Copy of Departmental appeal & Letter dated 28-03-2022 is enclosed as Annexure H & I).**
8. That the impugned order communicated to the appellant vide Letter dated 28-03-2022 and Notification No SO (Estt)/FD/1-16/2014/LFA/SSRC/Vol/IIV dated 25-05-2018 whereby rules in the appendix against serial No 4 in Column 6 amendment has been made, is against the law, facts and principles of justice on grounds inter-alia as follows:-

GROUND S:-

- A. That the impugned order communicated to the appellant vide Letter dated 28-03-2022 and Notification No SO(Estt)/FD/1-16/2014/LFA/SSRC/Vol/IIV dated 25-05-2018 is illegal, unlawful, without lawful authority and hence void ab-initio as SAS qualified auditors were required to be promoted faster than the Non SAS qualified/seniority cum fitness similar to Directorate of Treasury and AG Department where the quota of promotion for SAS qualified auditors is 60% and 67% respectively.
- B. Those mandatory provisions of law and rules have been badly violated by the respondents and the appellant has not been treated according to law and rules in violation of Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution.
- C. That the impugned rules were not amended as per the law and rules on the subject i,e Civil Servants Act 1973 as well as Rule 3 (2) of Appointment Promotion Transfer Rules 1989.
- D. That besides the requirements of Section 20 to 24 of the General Clauses Act 1897 were also not complied with which are mandatory for framing and amending rules. Even rules framed and amended without complying with the mandatory requirements of Section 23 of General Clauses Act 1897 were declared illegal in various Service Appeals including Service Appeal No 251/2011 Mian Farooq Iqbal VS Chief Secretary accepted 29-01-2013 and which judgment was also upheld by the Apex Court. **(Copy of Judgment dated 29-01-2013 passed in Service Appeal No 251/2011 is enclosed as Annexure J).**
- E. That it is important to note that the quota of SAS qualified candidates was reduced due to the non-availability of SAS qualified auditors and by now as the SAS qualified Auditors are available hence the rules needs to be amended accordingly.

F. That the Finance Department jointly conduct SAS exam for the employees of Directorate of Treasury and Local Fund Audit on same date and with almost equal syllabus as both entities are working under the umbrella of Finance Department but the promotion quota on the basis of SAS qualification in Directorate of Treasury is 60% and in Directorate of Local Fund Audit is 30% only. Besides the promotion quota on the basis of SAS/PIPFA in every audit/account Departments of the country is 67% in order to encourage employees to acquire professional audit/account knowledge, hence the impugned amendment is liable to be struck down. **(Copy of Notification dated 24-05-1981 is enclosed as Annexure K).**

G. That the impugned Rules have been amended even in violation of the recommendations of Standing Service Rule Committee meeting dated 19-08-2009 wherein the recommendations were as follows:

"The committee throughout examined and discussed in detail and observed that by providing reasonable quota to those who have qualified the SAS examination, the incumbents should have the reasonable opportunity of promotion on the basis of three years' service prior to those who have not qualified the SAS examination. Therefore recommended the proposed amendment."

(Copy of Minutes of the meeting of SSR Committee dated 19-08-2009 are enclosed as Annexure L).

H. That since SAS is professional qualification, is more relevant/technical hence too the appellant is entitled to be provided with more opportunities of promotion.

I. That SAS examination is technical one which is aimed at equipping the department with technically qualified professional/auditors in order to betterly run the audit activities.

J. That there are 44 sanctioned posts of Audit Officers (BPS-16) and as per the prevailing quota the share of SAS qualified is 13 which are filled while still 11 SAS qualified auditors are there.

K. That due to lesser quota for SAS qualified; there is no charm for the non SAS qualified auditors which have an adverse bearing on the overall performance of the department.

L. That the appellant being stake holder was not associated before amending the rules on the subject which being his fundamental right.

M. That the appellant has about 9 years of service with unblemished service record.

N. That the appellant seeks the permission of this honorable Tribunal for further/additional grounds at the time of arguments.

It is therefore prayed that appeal of the appellant may kindly be accepted as prayed for in the heading of the appeal.

Any other relief deemed appropriate and not specifically asked for, may also be granted in favor of the appellant.



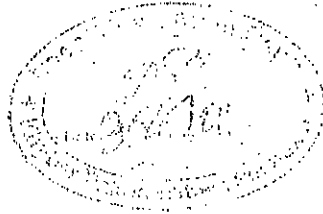

APPEAL FOR RESTORATION/INCREASING OF QUOTA FOR PROMOTION ON THE BASIS OF SAS QUALIFICATION.

The fundamental principle of management is to recruit right person for the right job. In view of the above golden principle, different promotional quotas are framed/constituted for promotion of the employees to the higher grades so as to recruit/promote the most qualified and relevant person on those positions. In this connection, it is stated that quota for the promotion of auditor possessing SAS qualification to the higher posts was 60%- and 67 % (Annex-A) in Directorate of Treasury and Local Fund Audit Departments and Comptroller General of Accounts Department respectively.

In the year 2010, a summary was moved to Finance Department for amendment in the prescribed quota for the promotion of auditor to the post of Audit Officer by the Director Local Fund Audit. The request of amendment was based on the analogy that certain posts of Audit Officers are lying vacant and due to non-availability of the SAS qualified auditors, the department is interested to promote the senior most auditors on these posts on seniority cum fitness. Finance department ascended to the amendment vide Notification No.SO (E-II)/FD/1-16/LFA/109, dated 29-04-2010. (Annex-B)

Later on, a number of Auditors qualified SAS examination and placed an appeal to the director Local Fund Audit for enhancement of quota on the previous pattern i.e., 60%. Finance department was gracious enough to increase the quota from 20% to 30 % (Annex-C). However, appeal of Auditors was not fully endorsed and the Auditors of this department were kept deprived of their righteous promotion.

It is therefore, requested that on acceptance of this appeal the service rules amended vide notification No So(Estt)/FD/1-16/2014/LFA/SSRC/Vol-IIV dated 25-5-2018 whereby in the appendix against S.No 4 in Coloumn No 6 amendment has been made, may kindly be struck down and the rules may please be restored for promotion to Audit Officer (BPS-16) as per Notification No SO(ESTT)FD/1-16/04 dated 1st June,2005 thereby restoring 60% Quota for Subordinated Accounting Services (SAS) Qualified Auditors.

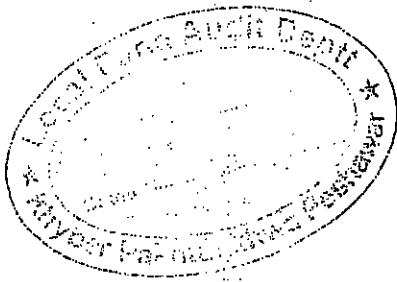

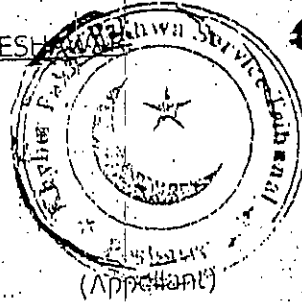

This appeal has been filed by Mian Farooq Iqbal, the appellant initially against the (i) notification No. SO(E-I)E&AD/9365/2010, dated 2.12.2010 authorizing Mr. Usman Ali Marwat Secretary Mineral Development Department to look after the work of Director General Mines & Minerals in addition to his own duties; (ii) Service Rules notified by the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa vide notification No. SO-Admn(MD)/1-6/88 Vol-V dated 17.10.2010 for appointment of Director General Mines and Mineral in the Directorate General Mines and Minerals; (iii) To replace words "selection on merit" in clause (a) of Service Rules notified vide notification No. SO-Admn(MD)1-6/88 Vol-V dated 17.10.2010 towards "seniority-cum-fitness"; and non notification of seniority list of the officers in BPS-19 of the Directorate General Mines and Minerals for the last two years. During the proceedings in the case, the learned counsel for the appellant submitted an application for allowing him to delete prayers at S.No. i, ii, and iv. His application was allowed on 5.12.2012 and the case was considered only for prayer No. iii, wherein it has been prayed that on acceptance of the appeal, restore the previous clause (b) of notification No. SOI(IND)1-6/88-Vol-V dated 10.12.2003 for appointment to the post of Director General Mines and Minerals.

Facts of the case briefly stated are: that the appellant is serving in Mines and Mineral Department as Chief Inspector of Mines in BPS-19 since 18.11.2004 having degree in Masters in Mining Engineering from University of Engineering & Technology Peshawar and is the senior most officer in BPS-19. His name is in the top of seniority list as it stood on 31.12.2008. Vide notification dated 10.12.2003, in pursuance of the provisions contained in sub-rule (2) of rule 3 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules 1989, and in supersession of all notifications on the subject, the Industries, Commerce, Mineral Development, Labour and Technical Education Department in consultation with the Establishment and Administration Department and the Finance Department laid down the method of recruitment, qualifications and other conditions in the Director General Mines and Minerals Department. The criteria for appointment of Director General laid down as under:-

- (a) by promotion on the basis of selection on merit, from amongst the holders of the posts of Director Mineral Exploration/Licensing and Chief Inspector of Mines Labour Welfare, having at least 17 years service in BPS-17 and above, provided that in case of persons initially appointed in BPS-18, the length of service for promotion shall be 12 years in BPS-18 and above; or
- (b) by transfer from persons having Bachelor's Degree in Mining Engineering or Master Degree in Geology."

These rules remained in force till 16.10/2010, when all of a sudden vide impugned notification dated 17.10.2010, the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa notified new Rules vide notification dated 17.10.2010 wherein clause (b) of the rules was replaced on mala fide intentions. According to which the criteria for appointment for the said post was laid down as under:-

- (a) by promotion, on the basis of selection on merit, from amongst the Director Exploration (Minerals), Director Licensing, Chief Inspector of Mines and Commissioner Mines Labour Welfare, having at least 17 years service in BPS-17 and above, and in case of persons initially appointed in BPS-18, the length of service for promotion to the post shall be 12 years in BPS-18 and above; or
- (b) by transfer from the provincial government department."

The appellant has been deprived from promotion to the next higher post. Feeling aggrieved the appellant filed departmental appeal and after exhausting departmental remedy, the appellant filed the present appeal.

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3. The appeal was admitted to regular hearing on 10.2.2011 and notices were issued to the respondents. The official respondents have filed their joint written reply and contested the appeal. The appellant also filed rejoinder in rebuttal.

4. Counsel for the appellant stated that Directorate of Mineral and Mines was created subsequent to detail study by Aus AID (Australian Consultation) in view of National Mineral Policy (NMP) in 1995. The post of Director General Mines & Mineral was designated to be a technical post. This has also been confirmed vide Para 7 of Reply of the respondents. Rules of appointment, promotion etc. of Director General in Service Rules is as follows:-

- (a) By promotion, on the basis of selection on merit, from amongst the holders of the posts of Director Mineral Exploraton, Director Mineral Licensing and Chief Inspector of Mines Labour Welfare having at least 17 years service in BPS-17 and above, provided that in case of persons initially appointed in BPS-18, the length of service for promotion shall be 12 years in BPS-18 and above, or
- (b) By transfr, from persons having Bachelor's Degree in Mining Engineering or Master Degree in Geology."

The above rules were abruptly modified on 17.10.2010 where in Clause (b) was mala fide modified to defeat decision of the Tribunal dated 23.4.2010 in Service Appeal No. 1876/2009 (not to give charge to junior person on transfer of the then Director General Mines & Mineral), to appoint its own blue eyed person and not to allow qualified and professional officers of the department to get promotion. Clause (b) was replaced "by transfer from the provincial Government Department". Furthermore in clause (a) the words "Selection on merit" be changed to selection on "Seniority-cum-fitness" as was the case in Punjab Government Service Rules.

5. The procedure for making rules or by-laws as specified in Section 23 of General Clauses Act 1897 as given below were not followed:-

Section 23.

- (1) the authority having power to make the rules or bye-laws shall, before making them publish a draft of the proposed rules or bye-laws for the information of persons likely to be affected thereby;
- (2) the publication shall be made in such manner as that authority deems to be sufficient, or, if the condition with respect to

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previous publication so requires, in such manner as the (government concerned) prescribes;

- (3) there shall be published with the draft a notice specifying a date on or after which the draft will be taken into consideration."

2012 PLC (CS) 1330 was relied upon wherein it has been stated that rules cannot be changed to disadvantage of employees. Regarding jurisdiction of Tribunal in the matter and filing of appeal against notification issued by the Government. Reliance was placed on 2011-SCMR-698 and 2012 PLC (C.S)142.

6. The learned MAG argued that rules have been modified in accordance with Section 21 of the General Clauses Act. It provides for posting of officers of the department as well as from outside and as such no discrimination has been made.

7. Arguments heard and record perused.

8. The Tribunal observes that the change in rules have not been made in accordance with Section 23 of the General Clauses Act 1897. No reason or rational has been stated for the modification, from which malafide on part of respondents can be seen. The appellant has also pleaded for replacing the words "selection on merit" by "selection on seniority-cum-fitness" in clause (a) of the Rules. The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act 1973 has clearly elaborated the same vide Section 9-Promotion which is reproduced as below:-

"9. Promotion:-(1) A civil servant possessing such minimum qualification as may be prescribed shall be eligible for promotion to a higher post for the time being reserved under the rule for departmental promotion in the service or cadre to which he belongs.

(2) A post referred to in sub-section(1) may either be a selection post or a non-selection post to which promotion shall be made as may be prescribed-

- (a) in the case of a selection post, on the basis of selection on merit; and
(b) in the case of non-selection post, on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness.

Furthermore, the matter has also been explained in the Esta-Code (Establishment Code) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa- Promotion Policy-Section 6 S.No. 4 as below:-

"After careful consideration and in super session of all previous orders and instructions on the subject, the Government of West Pakistan have decided that the principle for promotion from one post to another should be "by selection on merit with due regard to seniority" and that this principle should be applied uniformly all along the line from the lowest to the highest posts and from one class of service to another.

2. For this purpose, "merit" does not mean good service record only, but also includes experience, qualification and suitability for the post or service to which promotion is being made. The value of all these different factors has to be assessed in rating the officer's fitness for promotion. The words "with due regard to seniority" imply that, while emphasis is to be placed on good service record qualifications and aptitude for the higher post, the officer's relative seniority in the cadre, from which promotion is being made, should be given due weight, the greater the disparity in seniority the greater should be the junior officer's superiority in point of merit."

9. In view of the above, the Tribunal concluded to set aside modification in rules notified on 17.10.2010 and clause (b) of notification No. SOI(IND)1-688-Vol-V dated 10.12.2003 is restored and further more that promotions should be made strictly keeping in view Section 9(2) (a)(b) of Civil Servants Act 1973 and Esta Code directions stated above. This appeal alongwith connected appeal No. 456/2011 titled "Obaidullah Versus Chief Secretary Khyber Pakhtunkhwa" having common question of law are disposed off accordingly. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record.

ON 19/08/2009 AT 10.00 AM.**

To scrutinize the amendments proposed in the Service Recruitment rules of the Local Fund Audit Department 2008, a meeting was held on 19-08-2009 at 10.00 AM under the Chairmanship of Secretary Finance in his office. Following attended the meeting: -

The meeting was started with the recitation of the Holy Quran. The Chairman invited the Director Local Fund Audit to present the case item-wise detail of the case and decision arrived at areas under: -

1. **REDUCTION OF QUOTA FROM 100% TO 67% RESERVED FOR PROMOTION
AMONGST AUDITORS (BPS-16) TO ASSISTAN DIRECTORS (BPS-17)**

The Director Local Fund Audit Department informed that at present the posts of Assistant Directors are 100% reserved for promotion quota. He suggested that 33% quota may be reserved for direct recruitment and 67% by promotion. On a query, Director Local Fund Audit explained that all the 27 posts of Assistant Directors are filled in at present. In case 33% quota is reserved for initial recruitment, the posts should be reduced to 18. After detailed discussion it was observed that since all posts are filled in at present, therefore, if the quota is curtailed then there will be no chance to immediately filled any post by initial recruitment, whereas on the other hand, the officers of BS-16 who are waiting for promotion will wait for a long time, which may create imbursement amongst the existing officers of the department. After detailed discussion this item was recommended to be dropped.

AMENDMENTS IN THE SERVICE RULES OF AUDIT OFFICERS

The Director Local Fund Audit Department in classified that according to the existing qualification for initial recruitment is Master Degree in Statistics, Economics, Business Administration or Commerce is required. He was of the view that such qualification may be restricted for MBA (Finance) and for M.Com (Accounts). The committee thoroughly examined and discussed the various aspects and recommended the proposed amendment.

The Director Local Fund Audit Department further stated that at present there is 60% quota reserved for promotion against the posts of Audit Officers for those who have qualified the SAS examination and 20% is for those who have not qualified the SAS but have at least 10 years service. He further stated that there are 39 unqualified SAS Auditors available at present and as such department is suffering badly. On the other hand 115 Auditors (Non SAS) are waiting for promotion since long due to non availability of sufficient posts in the quota. He was of the view that the quota for those who have not qualified the SAS examination but have at least 10 years service as an Auditor should be enhanced. The committee thoroughly examined and discussed in detail and observed that by providing reasonable quota to those who have qualified the SAS examination the incumbent should have reasonable opportunity of promotion on the basis of 5 years service prior to those who have not qualified the SAS examination.

2 AMENDMENTS IN THE SERVICES RULES OF AUDIT OFFICERS

The Director Local Fund Audit Department clarified that according to the existing qualification for initial recruitment, 2nd class Master Degree in Statistics, Economics, Business administration or Commerce is required. He was of the view that there are various fields in MBA and M.COM such as Marketing, HRM and Banking which are not relevant to the audit and accounts job. He was of the view that for MBA it may restrict to MBA (Finance) and for M.COM it may restricted to M.COM (Accounts). The committee thoroughly examined and discussed the various aspects and recommended the proposed amendments.

The Director Local Fund Audit Department further stated that at present there is 60% quota reserved for promotion against the post of Audit Officers for those Auditors who have qualified the S.A.S examination and 20% for those who have not qualified the SAS but have at least 10 years service. He further stated that there are 39 post of Audit Officers. 60% posts for SAS qualified examination comes to 23. There is no qualified SAS Auditor is available at present and as such department is suffering badly. On the other hand, 115 Auditors (Non SAS) are waiting for promotion since long due to non-availability of sufficient post in the quota. He was of the view the quota for those who have not qualified the SAS examination but have at least 10 years service as an Auditor should be enhanced. The Director Local Fund Audit Department explained that according to the existing policy, the incumbents having professional qualification remained in search of good career with better skills. These Auditors after attaining the job experience left the lower scale job of the Auditor. This creates acute shortage of staff and lengthy wait for its recruitment through Public Service Commission. He suggested that BA BSc with Mathematics, Economics & Statistics may also be made eligible for recruitment. Besides this the qualification of ACMA is incorrectly included in Service Rules as it is higher professional education and is awarded by the Institute of Cost & Management Accountant of Pakistan and not Universities. He further stated that this qualification has to be deleted from the Rules.

3. AMENDMENTS IN THE SERVICE RULES OF AUDITORS.

The Director Local Fund Audit Department explained that according to the existing policy, the incumbents having professional qualification remained in search of good career with better skills. Those

Auditors after attaining the job experience left the lower scale job of Auditors. This create acute shortage of staff and lengthy wait of its recruitment through Public Service Commission. He suggested that BA/BSc with Mathematics, Economics & Statistics may also be made eligible for recruitment.

Besides this the qualification of ASMA is incorrectly included in the service rules as it is a higher professional education and is awarded by the Institute of Cost & Management Accountant of Pakistan and not Universities. He further stated that this qualification has to be deleted from the Rules.
