decided on 15.09.2021 with the observation that under Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the appellant had to approach this Tribunal and that the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court has no jurisdiction in the mater. It was then another departmental appeal was filed on 11.10.2021 and hence this appeal.

3. On issuance of the impugned order on 10.02.2020 the appellant filed two departmental appeals, one on and another on 17.02.2020 and under Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 the appellant ought to have waited for ninety days period after making her departmental appeal against the impugned order and after expiry of ninety days waiting period she had to come to this Tribunal within next 30 days by filing an appeal but she, instead, filed Writ Petition before the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court. It is true that the time barred appeal could be admitted after expiry of the period of limitation prescribed there-for when the appellant satisfies the Tribunal that she had sufficient cause for not preferring the appeal within such period and the decision of the Tribunal as to the sufficiency of cause shall be final. As regard this case she did not agitate any plausible ground to satisfy this Tribunal to admit this appeal especially when the tenure of her posting is about to ripe. Finding no merit in this appeal, it is dismissed in limine. Consign.

ON ACCEPTANCE OF INSTANT SERVICE APPEAL THIS HONORABLE SERVICE TRIBUNAL MAY BE PLEASED TO PASS AN ORDER FOR SETTING ASIDE IMPUGNED TRANSFER / POSTING ORDER BEARING NO. 598-607/FTS/CT DATED 10/02/2020 TO THE EXTENT OF RESPONDENT NO. 4 AND APPELLANT BEING UNMARRIED MAY BE POSTED AT GGMS TAJORI ENTITLED AS PER CLAUSE (X) PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT POLICY NO. SOR-II(E&AD)1-1/85 DATED 15-02-2003, IN PLACE OF RESPONDENT NO. 4 IN THE INTEREST OF JUSTICE.

- 1. That petitioner was initially appointed on the post of PST (BPS-12) at GGPS Tajori Tehsil & Dissect Tank on the recommendation of Departmental Selection Committee after passing NTS test vide appointment order bearing No. 856-66/NTS/Appointment/2018/PST dated 28/01/2019 and was posted in the ibid branch. Copy of appointment letter dated 28/01/2019 is enclosed and marked as Annexure A.
- 2. That during the course of her posting on PST post at GGPS Tajori an advertisement, for appointments on vacant posts of CT (BPS-15) Teachers in various Schools of District Tank including GGMS Tajori, was published in the Daily News Paper. Appellant being High Qualified and academically eligible applied for the said CT posts and after appearing in the test conducted by FAIR TESTING SERVICE (FTS) she got through the ibid test and thereafter appellant was selected by Departmental Selection Committee on one of the CT BPS-15) post



and was posted at GGMS Kot Habibullah District Tank vide office order 598-607/FTS/CT dated 10-02-2020 whare as she was to be posted on vacant post at GGMS Tajori in the light of clause(x) of Provincial Govt Policy bearing No. SOR-II CE+AD)1-1/85 dated 15-02-2003 being unmarried and is living at the station of Tajori being residence of her parents. Copy of Posting Order dated 10/02/2020 is enclosed and marked as Annexure B.

3. That according to clause (x) of Posting Transfer policy of Provincial Government Bering No. SOR-II(E+AD) 1-1/85(Vol-11) dated 15-02-2003 appellant being unmarred was to be posted on vacant post of CT GGMS Tajori but despite that respondents No. 4 resident of village Pai Tehsil & District Tank was posted at GGMS Tajori. Relvant Partion of ibid Policy is reproduced here under under the contraction of the con

"All the posting/ Transferring authorities may facilitate the posting / Transfers of unmarried female Government servants at the station of the resident of their parents. Copy of policy dated 15/02/2003 is enclosed and marked as Annexure C.

4. That appellant severally requested respondents No. 3 to post her at her native town Tajori under the Govt Policy dated 05/02/2003 but no heed was paid to her request. Therefore she instituted writ petition No. 8-D/2020 Peshawar High Court Bench D.I.Khan for issuance of writ in her favour by directing the respondents to adopt the govt policy dated 15/02/2003 in letter and spirit and appellant being unmarried is to be posted at her native town being station of residence of her parents in the light of clause (x) of ibid Policy, was disposed on 15/09/2021 in the following manner by agus 1: High Court.

"We cannot lose sight of the fact that non-obstante clauses of Articles 212(1) and (2) begin with "notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained," thus overriding, inter alia, the constitutional jurisdiction of the High Court under Article 199, which is already "subject to the Constitution." Article 212(1)(a) provides that a Tribunal established under the law will enjoy exclusive jurisdiction in the matters relating to terms and conditions of persons who are or have been in the service of Pakistan, including disciplinary matters. Article 212(2) in unambiguous terms states that no other Court can grant injunction, make any order or entertain any proceedings in respect of any matter to which the jurisdiction of such Administrative Court or Tribunal extends. Scope of jurisdiction and powers of the Tribunal are provided in sections 4 and 5 of the Act. The High Court, therefore, has no jurisdiction to entertain any proceedings in respect of terms and conditions of service of a civil servant which can be adjudicated upon by the Tribunal under the Act. This Court as a constitutional Court is mindful of the jurisdictional exclusion contained under Article 212 of the Constitution. Any transgression of this constitutional limitation will render the order of the High Court void and illegal. Therefore, unless the jurisdiction of the Tribunal is ousted under section 4(1)(b) of the Act, as described above, assumption of jurisdiction by the High Court in respect of matters of terms and conditions of a civil servant is unconstitutional and impermissible" for the above reasons this petition is dismissed, however the petitioner is at liberty to approach the proper forum for her redressal, if she is so advised. 





Subject: POSTING /TRANSFER POLICY OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT.

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to say that in supersession of all policy instructions issued in this behalf, the competent authority has approved the following posting Transfer Policy.

- i. All the postings /transfers shall be strictly in public interest and shall not be abused misused to victimize the Government servants.
- ii. All Government servants are prohibited to exert political. Administrative or any other pressures upon the posting /transfer authorities for seeking posting /transfers of their choice and against the public interest.
- against anyother post.
 - iv. The normal tenure of posting shall be three years subject to the condition that for the officers /officials posted in unattractive areas, the tenure shall be two years and for hard areas the tenure shall be one year. The unattractive and hard areas will be notified by the Government.
 - v Months of March and July are fixed for posting /transfer of the officers /officials excluding the officers in B-19 and above in the Province. Posting /transfer in Education and Health Departments shall be made in March while the remaining Departments shall make posting /transfers in July. There shall be a ban on posting/transfers throughout the year excluding the aforesaid two months. However, there shall be no restriction in cases where posting /transfer of Government employees become inevitable in other months due to promotion /retirement /creation of new posts/return from long leave/involvement in

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disciplinary proceedings and adjustment of surplus staff for which specific relaxation shall be obtained from the Chief Minister.

- vi. While making postings transfers from settled areas to FATA and vice versa specific approval of the Governor, NWFP needs to be obtained.
- vii.Officers may be posted on executive /administrative posts in the Districts of their domicile except District Coordination Officers (D.C.Os) and Superintend of Police (SP). Similarly Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) shall not be posted at a place where the Police Station (Thana) of his area /resident is situated.
- viii. No postings /transfers of the officers/officials on detailment basis shall be made.
- ix.Regarding the posting of husband /wife, both in Provincial services, efforts where possible would be made to post such persons at one station and this will be subject to the public interest.
 - All the posting /transferring authorities may facilitate the postings /transfers of the unmarried female Government Servants at the station of the residence of their parents.
- xi.Officers /officials except DCOs and SPs who are due to retire within one year may be posted on their option, on posts in the Districts of their domicile and be allowed to serve their till the retirement.
- xii.In terms of Rules-17 (1) and (2) read Schedule-III of the Government of NWFP Rules of Business 1985, transfer of officers shown in column 1 of the following table shall be made by the authorities shown against.

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Outside the Secretariat

i. Officers of the all Pakistan Unified Group i.e DMG, PSP including Provincial Police Officers in BPS-18 and above.

- ii.Other officers in BPS-17 and above to be posted against schedule posts, or posts normally held be the APUG, PCS (EG) and PCS (SG).

 Officers in B-19 & above in all
 Departments.

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- xiii While considering postings /transfers proposals all the concerned authorities shall keep in mind the following:
 - a. To ensure the posting of proper persons on proper posts, the annual confidential reports, past and present record of service, performance on post held presently and in tile past and general reputation with focus on the integrity of the concerned officers/officials be considered.
 - b. Tenure on present post shall also be taken into consideration and the posting transfers shall be in the best public interest.
- ix) Governments servants including District Govt. employees feeling aggrieved due to the orders of ,posting/transfers authorities may seek remedy from the next higher authority/the appointing authority) as the case may be through an appeal to be submitted within seven days of the receipt of such orders. Such appeal shall ,be disposed of within fifteen days. The option of appeal against posting /transfer orders could be exercised only in the following cases:-
- i) pre-mature posting/transfer or posting/transfer in violation of the provisions of this policy.
 - ii) Serious and grave personal (humanitarian) grounds.

To streamline the postings /transfers in the District Government and to remove any irritant/confusions in this regard the provision of Rule 25 of the North- West Frontier Province District Government Rules of Business 2001 read with schedule -IV thereof is referred. As per schedule -IV the posting/transferring authorities for the officers /officials against each are as



JUDGMENT

Sahibzada Asaduilah, J.-Through the instant constitutional petition filed under Article 199 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, the petitioner Mst. Sher Bano has sought the following relief:-

> It is therefore respectfully prayed that on acceptance/issuance of this petition and by declaring the impugned posting/transfer order No. 598-607/FTS/C.T dated 10.2,2020 issued by respondent No. 3 as illegal, without jurisdiction, without lawful authority, based on political victimization to the extent of petitioner. Any other relief deemed appropriate in the given circumstances may also be granted to the petitioner in the large interest of justice.

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
Record tells that petitioner was appointed as PST in Education Department Tank on ad-hoc basis vide order dated 10.2.2020 and she has served the department on ad-hoc based appointment, that's why, legally the status of ad-hoc employee falls under the sphere and scope of civil servant. Before discussing the stance/prayer of the petitioner, it would be beneficial to survey the applicable law regulating the appointment of a civil servant.

The Act of 1973 regulates the appointment of a person to the service of Pakistan and their terms and conditions. The appointment of a civil servant is, therefore, governed under the provisions of the Act of 1973. The other relevant legislation for the purpose of adjudication of the instant petition is the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973. The object and purpose of the Act of 1973 is to regulate, by law, the appointment of persons to the service of Pakistan and their terms and conditions. Sub section (2) of section 1 declares that the Act of 1973 shall apply to all civil servants wherever they may be. The expression 'civil servant' is defined in section 2(b) as a person who is a member of an All-Pakistan Service or of a civil service of the Federation, or who holds a civil post in connection with the affairs of the Federation, including any such post connected with defence. Section 2(a) defines 'ad

hoc appointment' as meaning an appointment made otherwise than in accordance with the prescribed method of recruitment, pending recruitment.

- Having discussed the provisions of the Act of 1973, the A.P.T Rules, the status of the petitioner being adhoc employee does fall within the definition of civil servant which excludes jurisdiction of this Court to adjudicate upon the matters relating to the terms and conditions of a civil servant and the Tribunal established under the provision of the Service Tribunal Act, 1974 is the proper forum for adjudication of such matters.
- clauses of Articles 212(1) and (2) begin with "notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained," thus overriding, inter alia, the constitutional jurisdiction of the High Court under Article 199, which is already "subject to the Constitution." Article 212(1)(a) provides that a Tribunal established under the law will enjoy exclusive jurisdiction in the matters relating to terms and conditions of persons who are or have been in the service of Pakistan, including disciplinary matters. Article 212(2) in unambiguous terms states that no other Court can grant injunction, make any order or entertain any proceedings in respect of any matter to which the jurisdiction of such Administrative

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Court or Tribunal extends. Scope of jurisdiction and powers of the Tribunal are provided in sections 4 and 5 of the Act. The High Court, therefore, has no jurisdiction to entertain any proceedings in respect of terms and conditions of service of a civil servant which can be adjudicated upon by the Tribunal under the Act. This Court as a constitutional Court is mindful of the jurisdictional exclusion contained under Article 212 of the Constitution. Any transgression of this constitutional imitation will render the order of the High Court void and illegal. Therefore, unless the jurisdiction of the Tribunal is ousted under section 4(1)(b) of the Act, as described above, assumption of jurisdiction by the High Court in respect of matters of terms and conditions of a civil servant is unconstitutional and impermissible.

7. For the above reasons, this petition is dismissed, however, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the proper forum for her redressal, if she is so advised.

Respectfully sheweth,

With profound regards it is benignly and humbly submitted:

- 1. That appellant had been performing duty on post of PST (BPS-12) at Govt Girls Primary school Tajori Tehsil And District Tank since 10-02-2020. During the course of performing of duty an advertisement for appointment on the post of C.T (BPS-15) was Published in the daily News Paper. Appellant being eligible applied for the vacant post at Tajori and she was selected on one of the vacant post at Tajori by Departmental Selection committee vide office order No. 856-56/NTS appointment 2018/PST dated 29-01-2019.
- 2. That according to clause X of Posting Transferring Policy of the Provincial Government all the posting and Transferring authorities was to facilitate the posting /Transfers of the unmarried female government Servant at the station of the residence of their parents vide Notification No SOR-II(E&AD) 1-1/85(Vol-II) dated 15/62/2003 which is still in field and intact.
- 3. That appellant being unmarried and also resident of village Taiori Tehsil & District Tank was to be appointed /Posted on vacant post at Tajori but she was posted at Govt Girls Middle School Kot Habitullah, which is 50 to 60 Kilometer away from Tajori, Vide Office order No. 598-607/FTS CT dated 10-02-2020.
- 4. That appellant severally requested the District Education Officer (Female) Tank to Transfer / post her at her native Town Tajori. So that she may stay with her parents being unmarried but no heed was paid to her genuine and legal request.
- 5. That appellant also filed writ petition No. 8-D/202 for redressal of her grievances in Peshawar High Court Bench Dera Ismail Khan which was disposed of in the following manner vide judgment dated 15-09-2021.

"We cannot lose sight of the fact that non-obstante clauses of Articles 212(1) and (2) begin with "notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained," thus overriding, inter alia, the constitutional jurisdiction of the High Court under Article 199, which is already "subject to the Constitution." Article 212(1)(a) provides that a Tribunal established under the law will enjoy exclusive jurisdiction in the matters relating to terms and conditions of persons who are or have been in the service of Pakistan, including disciplinary matters. Article 212(2) in unambiguous terms states that no other Court can grant injunction, make any order or entertain any proceedings in respect of any matter to which the jurisdiction of such

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Administrative Court or Tribunal extends. Scope of jurisdiction and powers of the Tribunal are provided in sections 4 and 5 of the Act. The High Court, therefore, has no jurisdiction to entertain any proceedings in respect of terms and conditions of service of a civil servant which can be adjudicated upon by the Tribunal under the Act. Any transgression of this constitutional limitation will render the order of the High Court void and illegal. Therefore, unless the jurisdiction of the Tribunal is ousted under section 4(1)(b) of the Act, as described above, assumption of jurisdiction by the High Court in respect of matters of terms and conditions of a civil servant is unconstitutional and impermissible" for the above reasons this petition is dismissed, however the petitioner is at liberty to approach the proper forum for her redressal, if she is so

6. That appellant being Civil Servant now file instant Departmental Appeal for resressal of her genuine rights.

advised.

- 7. That order dated 10-02-2020 of EDO (F) Tank is illegal and without lawful authority even against government policy dated 15/2/2003 therefore the alleged order dated 10/02/2020 is liable to be set at naught and posting of one Zainab Ina Qureshi (Resident of Village Pai Tank) is liable to be recalled and she being resident of Tajori and unmarried is entitled for posting at Tajori.
- 8. That appellant has been discriminated on instance and pressure of some Political Figure and she has been posted for away from her native Town.
- 9. That appellant being female is facing hard ship and problems in the performance of her duty at Kot HabibUllah which is for away from her home town. Apart from that her family has enmity in the locality therefore her life is at stake and any mishappening can be expected any time therefore, she request your honor to consider her case on humanitarian grounds also.

In view of the submissions made above it is humbly prayed that office order dated 10/02/2020 may kindly be recalled /cancelled and appellant may be posted at Tajori on post of CT BPS-15in place of Zainab Ina in the interest of justice. The appellant remains Sir.
