On acceptance of this appeal the impugned orders dated 31.12.2013 and 10.03.2014 may please be set-aside and the appellant may be re-instated in service with all back benefits of service.

Respectfully Submitted:

- 1. That initially the appellant was enlisted as Constable in police department in the year 1986. During the course of his service the appellant also got promotions and was lastly promoted to the rank of Assistant Sub Inspector.
- 2. That ever since the appointment, appellant had performed his duties as assigned to him with zeal and devotion and there was no complaint whatsoever regarding his performance. It is pertinent to

mention here that during the entire service, the performance of the appellant remained commendable, he traced and arrested criminals who were required to the Police in some high profile cases. Beside this, during the roar of militancy, he always remained in the front line against the militants and demonstrated exceptional performance, gallantry and devotion beyond the call of duty. His performance was also appreciated by the High Ups.

- 3. That while serving in the said capacity the appellant was suspended from service allegedly on account of having tainted reputation and involvement in anti-social activities. (Copy of suspension order dated 7.11.2013 is attached as annexure A).
- 4. That the appellant was served with Charge Sheet and statement of allegations dated 06.12.2013, containing certain unfounded and baseless allegations. The allegations leveled in the Charge Sheet are reproduced bellow, for ready reference:

"You have been suspended by the regional Police Officer Bannu on the basis of your tainted reputation and your alleged involvement in anti social activities."

(Copy of the Charge Sheet and Statement of Allegations is attached as Annexure B)

- 5. That the appellant duly replied the Charge Sheet and refuted the allegations leveled against him as false and baseless vide reply dated 12.12.2013. (Copy of the Reply is attached as Annexure C)
- 6. That a partial inquiry was conducted and the inquiry officer without properly associating the appellant with the inquiry proceedings conducted inquiry and submitted his findings wherein he recommended the appellant for major punishment vide the inquiry report dated 27.12.2013. (Copy of the Inquiry Report is attached as Annexure D).
- 7. That thereafter without issuing upon him any Final Show Cause Notice, the appellant was awarded the major punishment of "Compulsory Retirement from Service" vides order dated 31.12.2013 to the appellant. (Copy of the Order dated 31.12.2013 is attached as Annexure E)
- 8. That the appellant submitted his departmental appeal oon 10.01.2014, however it has also been rejected vide order dated 10.03.2014. Copy of the rejection order was however communicated to the appellant on 14.03.2014. (Copies of the departmental appeal and rejection order are attached as Annexure H & I)

9. That the impugned Orders are illegal unlawful against law and facts hence liable to be set aside inter alia on the following grounds:

GROUNDS OF APPEAL.

- A. That the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law hence his rights secured and guaranteed under the law are badly violated.
- B. That no proper procedure has been followed before awarding the major penalty of *Compulsory Retirement from Service*, to the appellant. No proper inquiry has been conducted, the appellant has not been associated with the inquiry proceedings, statements of witnesses if any were never taken in his presence nor he has been allowed opportunity of cross examination, moreover he has not been served with any show cause notice, thus the whole proceedings are defective in the eyes of law.
- C. That the allegations leveled against the appellant are general in nature and no specific instance has been shown where he has been found involved in the charges leveled against him, thus the Charge Sheet in itself is ambiguous and not warranted under the law.
- D. That the appellant has not been allowed opportunity of personal hearing, thus he has been condemned unheard.
- E. That in the Charge Sheet/ Statement of allegations it was alleged that the appellant is having *tainted reputation and allegedly involved in anti social activities*, however not a single instance has been mentioned wherein he has been found involved in such like such like activities, thus he has not been allowed fair opportunity to defend himself against the charges.
- F. That the charges leveled against the appellant were never proved in the enquiry, the enquiry officer gave his findings on surmises and conjunctures, moreover the inquiry officer had stated in the inquiry report that he secretly collected information from the local people about the character, however neither the names of those person (if any) were brought on record nor the appellant has been allowed to cross examine those person on whom statements the inquiry officer relied and recommended him for major punishment. Thus the inquiry report is defective in nature.

- G. That the appellant has never been served with Show Cause Notice, nor has he been provided the copy of the inquiry report, before the imposition of penalty upon him, which is mandatory in case of awarding major penalty.
- H. That the appellant has never indulged in any such activities beneficial to his person except the performance of good duty. The allegations leveled against the appellant are quite baseless, based on hearsay evidence which has got no footings in the service laws. The Superior Courts have always held that no one should be condemned without solid reasons.
- I. That appellant has never committed any act or omission which could be termed as misconduct, albeit been awarded the penalty of "Compulsory Retirement from Service."
- J. That the appellant has not been associated with the inquiry proceedings, his statement has not been recorded by the inquiry officer, nor any witness have been examined or if so examined the appellant has not been allowed to cross examine those who may have deposed against me.
- K. That the appellant has at about 28 years bright and spotless service career at his credit, the service record of the appellant bear testimony of his spotless service career, the appellant has never communicated any adverse entries nor has any bad entries in his ACRs, the penalty imposed upon him is too harsh and liable to be set aside.
- L. That the appellant never committed any act and omission that could be termed as misconduct albeit he has been awarded the penalty of dismissal from service. The charges leveled against the appellant were based on mere presumptions, moreover the same also remained unproved during the inquiry. All the proceedings conducted against the appellant and the penalty awarded to him was predetermined.
- M. That the facts and grounds mentioned in the reply to the Charge Sheet and the departmental appeal of the appellant may also be read as integral part of the instant departmental appeal.
- N. That the appellant is jobless since his illegal *Dismissal from Service*.

O. That the appellant also seeks permission of this Honorable Tribunal to rely on additional grounds at the time of hearing of the instant appeal.

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of this appeal the impugned orders dated 31.12.2013 and 10.03.2014 may please be set-aside and the appellant may be <u>re-instated in service</u> with all back benefits of service



Respectfully Sheweth:

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:

1) That the appeal is not maintainable in its present form.

- 2) That the appellant has concealed the material facts from the Honorable Tribunal.
- 3) That the appeal of appellant is time barred.
- 4) That the appellant has no cause of action.
- That the appellant has no locus standi to file the appeal.
- 6) That the appellant has been estopped by his own conduct to file the appeal.

OBJECTIONS ON FACTS:

1) Pertains to record hence needs no comments.

2) Incorrect. The appellant has bad reputation in the Police force and always performed duty as routine and never showed exceptional performance.

3) In wake of initiatives of Govt: regarding eradication of corruption from the government servants, the appellant and others were found of tainted reputation and their involvement in anti social activities, thus he was suspended followed by regular inquiry under Police Rules 1975.

4) Incorrect. The allegations were verified through various sources and found accurate. Thereafter conveyed to appellant and scrutinized through inquiry officer.

5) The reply of appellant was found unsatisfactory and based on unsound reasons.

6) Incorrect. Regular inquiry wherein all the opportunities of hearing and defense were afforded to appellant.

7) All the opportunities of hearing were provided to appellant. Final show-cause notice is not mandatory under Police Rules 1975.

8) Pertains to record hence needs no comments.

9) Incorrect. The orders are legal, valid, based on facts, law and justice.

OBJECTIONS ON GROUNDS.

- (A) Incorrect. The appellant was treated under the proper law/rules i-e Police Rules 1975 and no right of appellant has been violated.
- (B) Incorrect. Regular inquiry through inquiry officer (DSP Nourang Lakki Marwat) was conducted and all the opportunities of hearing/defense were afforded to the appellant in accordance with law/rules.
- (C) Incorrect. The allegations were verified through various sources and conveyed to appellant in shape of charge sheet based on statement of allegations which was established in the regular inquiry conducted by the inquiry officer.

- (D) Incorrect. The appellant was provided opportunities and defense at all level and was also heard in orderly room held on 30.12.2013 and 10.03.2014 but he failed to satisfy the respondents regarding the allegations leveled against him.
- (E) Incorrect. Despite bad entries in service record of appellant allegations of dealing of pretty boys and girls for illegal purpose were established during departmental probe.
- (F) Incorrect. The involvement of appellant in anti social immoral activities were verified through secret sources and the names of the informers can not be disclosed under the law/rules.
- (G) Incorrect. All the codel formalities have been observed during departmental probe. Final show-cause is not mandatory under Police Rules 1975.
- (H) Incorrect. As per inquiry report, the appellant was found involved in anti social and immoral activities.
- (I) Incorrect. Misconduct on the part of appellant was established through regular inquiry carried out by enquiry officer i.e DSP Naurang Lakki Marwat.
- (J) Incorrect. All codal formalities fulfilled opportunities of defense were afforded to appellant during course of inquiry.
- (K) Incorrect. The appellant has indifferent record and after proper probe, his retention in police force was found harmful and thus retired him from service compulsory.
- (L) Incorrect. The misconduct on the part of appellant has been established through various sources and regular inquiry.
- (M) Reply and departmental appeal of appellant were found unsatisfactory and based on unsound reasons.
