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
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

Preliminary objection.

- 1. That the appeal is badly time barred.
- 2. That the appeal is not maintainable in its present forum.
- That the appeal is bad for mis-joinder and non-joinder of necessary parties. 3.
- That the appellant has not come to this Tribunal with clean hands. 4.
- That the appellant has concealed the facts as his first appeal has been 5. implemented/ disposed off (Annexure-A). The appellant is only wasting the precious time of the Tribunal.

ON FACTS.

- 1. The appellant was appointed as Assistant (BPS-14) purely on temporary basis in the Board of Revenue Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on 25.06.2010 and was deputed to the office of District Officer (R&E)/Collector, Mardan to draw salary against the post of Mr. Sardar Ali Assistant of the office of District Officer (R&E)/Collector, Mardan, who was on Ex-Pakistan leave as there was no vacancy in Board of Revenue.
- 2. Mr. Sardar Ali Assistant of the office of District Officer (R&E)/Collector, Mardan submitted his arrival report after Ex-Pakistan leave on 01.9.2010; therefore, the Respondent No.3 returned the service of appellant to Board of Revenue w.e.f 31.08.2010. There was no vacant post of Assistant (BPS-14) in the Board of Revenue to adjust the appellant against the said vacant post. Moreover, the appellant was appointed purely on temporary basis, so his appointment order dated 25.6.2010 was withdrawn.
- Incorrect. The appellant was appointed as Assistant (BPS-14) purely on temporary basis and due to non availability of post, his appointment order was withdrawn hence no illegality was done in this regard.

- Incorrect. The Departmental appeal of appellant was filed by the Competent Authority Chief Secretary, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Annexure-A)
- 5. As in para-4 above.

GROUNDS.

- Incorrect. Both the orders are in accordance with law. A.
- B. Incorrect. Both the officials were appointed by competent authority on contract basis. No discrimination has been done with appellant as the appellant was not appointed on contract basis but was appointed purely on temporary basis.
- Incorrect. The appointment order was withdrawn by competent authority C. therefore, there was no need of personal hearing.
- D. As in 'C' above.
- E. Incorrect. The withdrawal of appointment order was issued in accordance with law/rules.
- F. Incorrect. The appellant has been treated in accordance with law.
- G. Incorrect. As para-2 of the facts.
- H. Incorrect. As in 'E' above.
- I. The respondent will also seek permission to advance additional grounds at the time of arguments.


Keeping in view of the above, the appeal may please be dismissed with costs.
