

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

APPEAL U/S: 4 OF THE NWFP SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT, 1974 BY DIRECTING THE RESPONDENTS ALLOW THE APPELLANT TO PERFORM HIS DUTY AND RELEASE THE SALARY AND OTHER ALLOWANCES OF APPELLANT AND NOT TO INTERFERE IN THE DUTY / TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE OF APPELLANT WITHOUT DUE COURSE OF LAW.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:

The appellant most humbly submits as under:

1. That the appellant was appointed on 31.03.2004 as a PST Teacher in the GGMS B.D Shah, Ahmadi Banda union council Teri.
(Copy of appointment order is attached as annexure A)
2. That the appellant performed his duty to the entire satisfaction of his Superior and during the period of his service no adverse remark or black spot has been found on the part of appellant.

(Copy of service record is attached as annexure B)

3. That in September 2004 the appellant was diagnosed with severe discase for which the doctors advised him for complete bed rest, therefore the appellant applied for extra ordinary leave for about four months and which was sanctioned.
(Copies of applications and medical receipts are attached as annexure C, C1-D, D1)
4. That respondents issued vide letter No: 1490, dated: 04.10.2004 in which Mr. Said Umar was deputed to work at GPS Banda on the place of appellant.
(Copy of letter is attached as annexure E)
5. That appellant through his brother moved application for extension of leave and leave of appellant was extended as the appellant was not in position to continue his duty.
(Copy of application is attached as annexure F)
6. That on 20.05.2005, the appellant moved an application to respondents for joining of duty and produced medical fitness certificate.
(Copy of application and medical fitness certificate are attached as annexure G-H)
7. That when appellant joined his duty again, he was performing his duty regularly but the respondents did not release his salary on one pretext or the other when the appellant inquired about the matter he was informed by the respondents that the salary of appellant will be released soon.
8. that in April 2007 the appellant was stopped and he was not allowed to perform his duty in the school and on complaint he was informed by the Head Master that his case is put to High-ups and the appellant will be allowed to perform duty after the decision of High-ups and then salary will be released but during that time period whenever the appellant went to school or EDO office to inquire about his case, he was often told by the staff that his case is pending before High-ups and after the decision he will be allowed to perform his duty and his salary will also be released which is stopped.
9. That thereafter the appellant was contacting the Head Master as well as the EDO (male) Karak but they lingered on the matter on one pretext or the other. during this time period the appellant moved number of applications for the redressal of his grievances to the respondents but they turned a deaf ear.
(Copies of applications are attached as I to I-7)
10. That on 21.02.2021 when the appellant moved an application to respondents to inquire about the present status of the appellant, the respondents again did not give any positive response and orally advised him to knock the door of Hon'ble Court.
(Copy of the application is attached as annexure I)
11. That feeling aggrieved from the ill conduct of the respondents, the appellant knocked the door of this Hon'ble Court on the following grounds inter-alia:

GROUND:-

- A. That the appellant is a pure teacher interested in his duties and teaching profession.
- B. That no codal formalities as enumerated in the concerned laws have been adopted nor any procedure as prescribed in the legal manner has been obeyed by the issuing authority.
- C. That not a single word regarding the enquiry proceedings, evidence or any final show cause notice is available on the record and without any order the appellant is stopped from his duty, which is against law.

- D. That such an attitude of hire and fire is not even warranted by any law in the institution where a simple master and servant rule is applicable, whereas the whole procedure of dealing with the Civil Servant in the cases of any misconduct as enumerated in the Service Laws has been bulldozed in such a manner by stopping the appellant from his duty.
- E. That an illegal act of respondents is against law and facts, without adopting the proper procedure and without giving any opportunity of personal hearing to the appellant, stopped the appellant from his lawful duty.
- F. That there is a basic principle of Islam as well as of law that no one should be condemned unheard.

IT IS, THEREFORE, PRAYED THAT ON ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPEAL AN ORDER BY DIRECTING THE RESPONDENTS TO ALLOW THE APPELLANT TO PERFORM HIS DUTY AND RELEASE THE SALARY AND OTHER ALLOWANCES OF APPELLANT AND NOT TO INTERFERE IN THE DUTY / TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE OF APPELLANT WITHOUT DUE COURSE OF LAW MAY KINDLY BE PASSED.






