

1. **FAQIR MUHAMMAD KHOKHAR, J.** – The petitioners seeks leave to appeal from orders dated 14.6.2003, passed by the NWFP Service Tribunal, Peshawar, (hereinafter referred to as the Tribunal) in Service Appeals No.223 and 224 of 2002.

2. The petitioners felt aggrieved by order dated 25.2.2002 passed by the appellate authority in respect of their place of seniority as *Patwaris*. They preferred Service Appeals No.223 and 224 of 2002 there-against which were dismissed by the Tribunal, by the separate impugned orders dated 14.6.2003.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the order which was called in question in appeal before the Tribunal, was itself an appellate order passed by the departmental authority. Therefore, the Tribunal had taken an erroneous view of the matter in dismissing the service appeals of the petitioners on the ground that the departmental remedy had not been exhausted.



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The learned counsel for the respondents could not controvert the above petition.

4. We have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also perused the available record. We find that the respondents being aggrieved of the original order of the departmental authority in respect of their seniority had availed the remedy of appeal which was accepted by the appellate authority. It was against the order of the appellate authority that the petitioners had preferred the service appeals. In these circumstances, it could not be said that the departmental remedy had not been exhausted. The impugned orders of the Tribunal are not sustainable in law.

5. For the foregoing reasons, both these petitions are converted into appeals and the same are allowed. The impugned order dated 14.6.2003 of the Tribunal are set aside. Consequently the Service Appeals No.223 and 224 of 2002 of the petitioners shall be disposed of by the Tribunal afresh in accordance with law. There shall be no order as to costs.

Facts giving rise to the present appeal are as under:-

- 1. That appellant was initially inducted as Patwari in the respondent department and thereafter he was promoted from stage to stage on the basis of senioritycum-fitness as per law and rules on subject, lastly he was promoted to the position of **Tehsildar (BPS-16)** along with other colleagues on the recommendation of Departmental Promotion Committee vide notification No. Estt:1/26/11388 dated 04.06.2013. Presently appellant is performing his duties as Tehsildar of sub division Gagra, District Buner. Copies of the notification and minutes of the meeting of DPC as **Annex: A & B**.
- 2. That the services of appellant are governed by the rules namely Tehsildar, Naib Tehsildar/ Subordinate Revenue Service Rules, 2008 (hereinafter called Rules, 2008) notified on 26.12.2008 which were amended from time to time, the relevant parts are reproduced as under for the convenience of this Hon'ble Tribunal. That respondents No.4 to 47 have filed a writ petition No. 1720-P/2013 wherein they have challenged the order dated 04.06.2013 thereby appellant and others were promoted to the post of Tehsildar (BPS-16) on regular basis later on, on the request of Respondents/petitioners the petition was transmitted to Respondent department with the direction to treat the petition as departmental appeal and the same be decided in accordance with law and rules. Copy of the writ petition and order dated 05.11.2013 as Annex: G & H.

That in the compliance of the order of the Learned Divisional Bench of Peshawar High Court Peshawar dated 05.11.2013 the Respondent No.3 has treated the writ petition as departmental appeal of Respondents No.4

to 47 and the same was accepted and issued the **impugned notification dated 23.01.2014** thereby the earlier notification dated 04.06.2013 of the promotion of appellant and other Tehsildars was withdrawn and the appellant along with others were reverted to the post of Naib Tehsildar while by subsequent order dated 24.01.2014 all the reverted Tehsildars including appellant were directed to work on current charge basis as Tehsildar. Copy of the **notification dated 23.01.2014 and 24.01.2014** as **Annex: I & J.**

Hence the present appeal is submitted on the following amongst other grounds:-

Grounds:

C.

- A. That the promotion of appellant was made in accordance with rules on subject based on seniority-cum-fitness. The rules as referred was later on amended by the competent authority and the condition of graduation was deleted therefrom. The Respondents No.4 to 47 have misconceived the case of appellant and malafidely challenged the same on flimsy grounds before the Peshawar High Court Peshawar.
- B. That the Learned Divisional Bench of Peshawar High Court Peshawar has acted in access of its power and wrongly issued direction to Respondent No.3 to treat the petition of Respondents No.4 to 47 as departmental appeal and decide the same in accordance with law and rules. The Learned Divisional Bench has bypassed the law and rules on subject as according to relevant law and rules when the order of the competent authority affects more than one civil servant, every civil servant shall prefer the appeal separately within thirty days from the date of communication of the order to departmental appellate authority. Thus in such circumstances the order of the Hon'ble High Court is void and the Respondent No.3 has unlawfully acted upon and passed the impugned order which is not sustainable being violative of mandatory provisions of law and rules on subject.

That neither the Learned Divisional Bench of the Peshawar High Court Peshawar has summoned the appellant along with others who were arrayed as Respondents in the said writ petition nor the Respondent No.3 has provided a fair opportunity of hearing to appellant to defend his case. Therefore appellant was condemn unheard and the impugned order dated 23.01.2014 passed at the back of appellant which is not sustainable being violative of the principle of natural justice and liable to be set aside.

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- That the petition as treated departmental appeal by the Respondent No.3 on the direction of Learned Divisional Bench of Peshawar High Court was hopelessly time barred and was not sustainable under the law and rules on subject and unlawfully entertained the same by him and passed the impugned order of the reversion of appellant and others.
- E. That the impugned order dated 23.01.2014 has been passed by the Respondent No.3 who is not the appellate authority in the case of appellant. Therefore the impugned order is incompetent, corum non judious, void ab-initio, of no legal effect and inoperative on the rights of appellant and liable to be set aside.
- F. That the appellant was fully qualified and eligible for the promotion to the post of Tehsildar (BPS-16) under the law and rules on subject which was made by the competent authority on the recommendation of Departmental Promotion Committee therefore in such circumstances the impugned order of his reversion has no legal justification, having no legal sanctity and liable to be set aside.
- G. That the order of promotion was acted upon which created vested rights in favour of appellant which can not be taken away under the principle of locus poenitentiae. Even by subsequent order dated 24.01.2014 he was directed to hold the same post on current charge basis.

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of this service appeal, the impugned order dated 23.01.2014 thereby appellant was reverted to the position of Naib Tehsildar may graciously be set aside and the order dated 04.06.2013 thereby appellant was promoted to the post of Tehsildar (BPS-16) on regular basis may kindly be restored with all back benefits.

Any other relief as deemed appropriate in the circumstances of case not specifically asked for, may also be granted to appellant.

WRIT PETITION UNDER ARTICLE 199 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF PAKISTAN, 1973, AGAINST THE ORDER OF RESPONDENTS NO.1 TO 3 WHEREBY RESPONDENT NO.4 TO WERE PROMOTED VIDE NOTIFICATION NO. ESTT: 1/26/11333 DATED 04/06/20013 ISSUED IN BLATANT VIOLATION OF THE TEHS DARI AND NAIB TEHSILDARI RULES 2008 AS AMENDED FROM TIME TO TIME.

Prayer:

On acceptance of this writ petition the impugned notification and the illegal promotions may be set aside and respondents No.1 to 3 be directed to reconsider the entire case strictly in accordance with the Rules in vogue.

Respectfully Sheweth:

The petitioners submit as under:

1) That the petitioners were recruited as Naib Tehsildars through a competitive examination conducted by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission and the petitioners were accordingly appointed as Naib Tehsildars by the Respondents vide appointment order No. 1782-1907/Admn: V/PSC dated 22/01/2009. (Copy of the appointments order are at Annexure "A".

 That according to Tehsildar, Naib Tehsildar / Subordinate Revenue Service Rules 2008, Notified vide No.32102/ Admn: 1/135/SSRC dated 26/12/2008, The post of Tehsildar was to be filledin under clause-(a) to the extent

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of 20% by initial recruitment, under clause (b) to the extent of 60% by promotion from Naib Tehsildars and under clause (c) to the extent of 20% from the officials working in various branches of Revenue Administration, but for all categories minimum Qualification was 2nd Class graduation from a recognized University as per column 5 describing minimum qualification for appointment by promotion The condition of graduation was to be made applicable after 5 years of the date of notification to the promotion quota of 60% inder clause (b). (Copy of the Rules is at Annexure "B")

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3) That these Rules were further amended vide Notification No.12390 - 12429/ Admin 1/1/296/Amendment dated 30/03/2011. Through this notification clauses (b) and (c) of column 7 were substituted and officials like District Kunongos, District Revenue Accountants and Head Clerks (Revenue) were made eligible for the 60% Quota meant for the Niab Tehsildars. The non-application of the condition of graduation for 5 years was also done away with. (Copy of the Amendment Notification is at Annexure "C").

4) That yet another amendment was made in the said rules vide Notification No.Estl: 1/1/296/Amendment /29174 dated 02/12/2011 where again for the post of Tehsildar changes were introduced in the 60% Quota meant for promotion of Niah Tehsildars to the post of "chsildars. This time Sub-Registrar were included in the list of eligible officials. (Copy of this Notification is a! Annexure "D").

5) That it will be easy to conclude that the minimum qualification for recruitment to the post of Tehsildar is

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Second class Graduation as throughout these amendments, the entries in column No.5 have neither been deleted nor changed and the non-application of the condition of graduation for five years was also deleted.

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6) That it can be easily concluded that all the amendments introduced in the 60% Quota originally meant only for Naib Tehsildars, are meant to reduce the chances of directly recruited Naib Tehsildars to become Tehsildars under malafide intention of the authorities.

That respondents No.1 to 3, through the impugned orders, have promoted Respondent No.4 to 42 against the rules without ensuring the basic qualification of graduation required for promotion to the post of Tehsildar as required by the entries in column No.5 of the Rules, as these stand today, with the result that respondents No.6,7,9,10,13,14,18,19,20,21,22,23,24,28,29,30,32,33,35,36,38 &42 have been promoted despite the fact that they are not graduates. (Copy of the impugned order No.Esst: 1/26-11338 dated 04/06/2013 is at Annexure "E").

That respondent No.43&44 have been promoted clandestinely through administrative orders as both of them were Patwaries in the year 2007-08 but are now working as EACs in District Buner. According to Letter No.Estt: 1/1/7270 dated 02/03/2012, issued by respondent No.1 addressed to Director Land Record, wherein the designation of both these respondents was mentioned as District Kanungo. It is amazing that an official who was **District Kanungo** in the year of 2012, received three promotions i.e. as Naib Tehsildar, Tehsildar and EACs in one year. This could have happened only in the revenue Deptt: (Copy of the Letter is as Annexure "F"):

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9) That these promotions have been ordered in haste and without due process of law as no joint seniority list has been prepared in accordance with law regarding those officials who were to be considered for promotion to the post of Tehsildar. Such a joint seniority list is the basic requirement for any promotion process.

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- 10) That the so-called final seniority list issued vide Office No.Estt-V/S.1/927 dated 26/04/2013 contains the name of those officials who have been shown as promoted to the post of Naib Tehsildars through the <u>Administrative order</u> of <u>SMBR</u>. Such like administrative order is neither a process recognized by the Rules on the subject nor is logical because in the presence of Departmental Promotion Committee, no authority, even the Chief Secretary, cannot promote any person to any post without the process of approval by a Departmental Promotion Committee. (Copy of the Seniority List is at Annexure "G").
- 11) That the seniority list has been issued at the back of the petitioners as the same has not been circulated amongst the petitioners as required by law.
- 12) That the seniority list shows that promotions have been ordered every 2/3 days which tells upon the working of one of the most important department of the province.

13) That the respondents No. 1 to 3 are busy in processing further cases of promotion without adopting the proper procedure in accordance with rules on the subject. Any such orders, if issued, during the pendency of this writ

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petition would be brought to the notice of this Hon'ble. Court with due permission.

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- 14) That the attitude of the Respondents No.1 to 3 is arbitrary, arrogant, motivated by favourtism, against the law and facts and liable to be stopped through interim order to save the career of the petitioners who are young and are likely to suffer irreparable loss.
- 15) That feeling aggrieved, the petitioners have no other adequate remedy under the existing law of the land but to approach this 11on ble Court through this writ petition with the request to set aside the impugned promotion orders on the following, amongst others;

<u>Grounds:</u>

- A) That the impugned order is against the law on the subject and the rules framed by the respondents themselves;
- B) That the respondents want to favour certain officials to the detriment of the petitioners who have joined the service through competitive examination and the respondents are bent upon destroying their career from the very start;

C) That promoting some of the respondents as Naib Tehsildars through administrative orders, instead of the

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normal route of DPC, and then promoting them further as Tehsildars shows their favouritism and disregard for law.

D

That the orders of the respondents No.1 to 3 are illegal, arbitrary and against the fundamental rights and need interference by this Hon'ble Court.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this writ petition the impugned notification and the illegal promotions may be set aside and the respondent be directed to reconsider the entire case strictly in accordance with the Rules in vogue.

Interim Relief:

That the illegal impugned orders of promotion may kindly be suspended till the decision of this Writ petition as the same is against the Rules on face of it.

On the previous date learned counsel for the petitioners was confronted with the preposition that ultimately the Court would determine the question of rights of a civil servant under the Civil Servants Law which is beyond the jurisdiction of

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Service Tribunal. On request of the learned counsel for the petitioners the case was adjourned for further study and preparation of the case. Today the counsel lor learned the the when occupied petitioners, Rostrum, stated at the bar that through the instant Writ Petition he has challenged the impugned order on the grounds that he is eligible for promotion but the department has denied him to consider, wherein the jurisdiction of this Court is barred under Article 212 of Constitution of Pakistan and the same question is amendable to the jurisdiction of Service Tribunal constituted under the Article ibid. The learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submitted that the instant petition has been filed on 18/6/2013 and since than is pending adjudication for decision, in motion. He requested that the instant transmitted tọ writ petition be respondent No.1, as departmental

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appeal for decision. The request of the counsel for the petitioner is genuine, thus, copy of this Writ Petition be transmitted to respondent No.1 i.e. Secretary Revenue and Estate Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa shall be treated as Departmental Appeal and be decided in the prescribed limits of time strictly in accordance with Rules and Law.

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With the above observations, this Writ Petition is disposed off accordingly.

REJOINDER ON BEHALF OF APPELLANT IN RESPONSE TO REPLY FILED BY RESPONDENTS NO. 1 & 2.

Respectfully Sheweth,

Preliminary Objections:

Preliminary objections raised by answering respondents are erroneous and frivolous, the detailed replies thereof are as under:-

- I. That the promotion order of appellant was unlawfully withdrawn and reverted him to lower position without legal justification of which he was aggrieved and rightly filed the present appeal.
- II. That since the impugned order is illegal, malafide and without lawful authority so appellant has rightly exercised his legal rights and filed the present appeal.
- III. That the answering respondents have misconceived and wrongly taken the issue of maintainability of the present appeal on the plea that no departmental appellant was filed by the appellant. In this case the answering respondents have treated the writ petition of Respondents as Departmental Appeal in view of directions of the Hon'ble High Court, Peshawar and accepted the same in favour of present respondents and withdrew the promotion order of present appellant without any notice. Thus there is no provision of second departmental appeal in the service law so the appellant has rightly approached to this Hon'ble Tribunal against the impugned order in question.

- IV. That the appeal of appellant is based on cogent and strong grounds while the reply/comments is erroneous and based on exaggeration.
- V. That the appeal is within time in all respect.
- VI. That the matter in question is pertaining to terms and conditions of service and this Hon'ble Tribunal has exclusive jurisdiction in the matter.

<u>Rejoinder to Reply of Facts:</u>

- 1. That the answering respondents furnished no comments meaning thereby they have accepted the contents of this para.
- That the answering respondents furnished no comments in respect of para
 2 meaning thereby they have accepted the contents thereof.
- 3-5 That the answering respondents have conceded the facts of these paras as correct so no needs of further elucidation.
- 6. That the answering respondents have conceded the facts of this para to some extent but the reason furnished for the reversion of appellant by answering respondents that he was not graduate, is totally incorrect and not sustainable because such condition is not applicable to appellant.

<u>Rejoinder to Reply of Grounds:</u>

- A. That the reply of ground A is incorrect. The laid down condition of graduate degree as mentioned in the reply was not applicable to appellant. His promotion was made on the basis of Seniority-cum-fitness by competent authority after observing codal formalities.
- B. Furnished no comments by the answering respondents in respect of groundB so no needs of further elucidation.
- C. That the reply is erroneous so denied.
- D. That the reply is incorrect so denied. The answering respondents are legally bound to comply with the legal and lawful order of the Hon'ble

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
Peshawar High Court. In this case once the Hon'ble High Court has held that the matter in question is pertaining to terms and conditions of service and its jurisdiction ousted in view of Article 212 of the Constitution, 1973 then the Hon'ble High Court can not pass any direction/order. Moreover, in view of law on subject each and every aggrieved person shall have to file a separate departmental appeal which has not done in this case and thus the answering respondents committed a glaring mistake to treat the single petition as departmental appeal for each and every individual respondent and even on only illegality committed by the answering respondents, the impugned order is not sustainable and liable to be set aside.

E. That the reply is incorrect. The impugned order passed by Respondent No.3 who is neither the competent authority nor appellate authority and thus the impugned order is void ab initio.

F. That the reply is incorrect. The graduation condition is not applicable to the case of appellant and this was misconceived by the answering respondents.

G. That the order of promotion of appellant was passed by the competent authority on the recommendations of Departmental Promotion Committee in accordance with rules on subject.

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that the reply of answering respondents may graciously be rejected and the appeal as prayed for may kindly be accepted.
