Prayer

By accepting this appeal, the impugned order of respondent No.1 dated 07.11.2017 and respondent No.2 whereby he did not respond to the departmental appeal may be set aside and consuequely the appellant may be allowed to perform hid duty at Shabqadar Forest Check post.

## Respectfully Sheweth:

- 1. That the Appellant was inducted in Forest Department as Forester way back in 1982 and thus he has thirty five (35) years of service in his credit.
- 2. That in long carrier of the appellant, no complaint has ever been reported against him and thus he is having an unblemished service record.
- 3. That all of sudden on 07.11.2017, respondent No.1 issued the impugned order whereby the appellant was attached with Divisional Forest Office, D.I.Khan. (Copy of Order dated 07.11.2017 is attached as annexure "A").

- 4. That it also pertinent to mention here that aforesaid attachment order was passed as punishment as transpired from impugned order dated 07.11.2017 to the effect that three number of trucks loaded with timber were allegedly smuggled from FATA to the settled area.
- 5. That there are many check posts in between Shabqadar & Khairabad one at Ring road, Peshawar, Nisatta Interchange Charsadda & thirdly, at Khairabad. Similarly on other hand, there are many check posts which fall before Shabqadar i.e. Bajour Check post at Khaar & Yakaghund Forest check post at Mohmand Agency.
- of impugned order dated 07.11.2017 when all of sudden his salary was attached vide order dated 23.11.2017. (Copy of Order dated 23.11.2017 is attached as Annexure-B).
- 7. That the appellant submitted departmental appeal/representation to respondent No.2 but till date the same has not been responded so far. (Copy of the departmental appeal/representation is attached as annexure "C").

- 8. That on one hand, appellant was waiting for the outcome of his departmental appeal and on the other, he alongwith his other colleagues, filed Writ Petition No.5009/2017 before Peshawar High Court which came up for hearing before Hon'ble Court on 18.01.2018 which was disposed off in terms that order of attachment of salary dated 23.11.2017 was declared as ineffective whereas as for the second part of pray i.e. attachment, the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court Peshawar abstain itself from passing any order on the ground of lack of jurisdiction. (Copies of Writ Petition and order dated 18.01.2018 are attached as annexure "D" & "E").
- 9. That the appellant after exhausting the departmental remedy of filing departmental appeal and waiting for statutory period i.e. ninety (90) days is preferring the instant service appeal before this Hon'ble Tribunal for following amongst other grounds:

## GROUNDS:-

A. That as transpired from the impugned order that there are allegations of illegal movement of 3 trucks of timber from FATA to settled area which allegations were out rightly rejected and denied

by the appellants but respondents unilaterally passed the impugned order as a punishment to the appellants and thus on this score alone the impugned order of respondent No.1 is illegal, unlawful and thus ineffective upon the rights of the appellants.

- B. That through the impugned order appellants services were ordered to be "attached" with the office of Divisional Forest Officer, D.I. Khan which word is alien to the Rules and Regulation governing the service of the appellant and thus on this ground too, the impugned order is liable to be set aside.
- C. That on one hand there are serious allegations which may questions the conduct and efficiency of the appellant but on other hand they have not been issued any show cause notice to explain their position viza-a-via the truthfulness or otherwise of allegations made against them therefore on this ground too, the impugned order is liable to be struck down.
- D. That the impugned order dated 07.11.2017 was passed in a unilateral manner without confronting the appellant with the allegations of illegal movement of timber. In this view of the matter, the

impugned order is prima facie illegal which is not sustainable in the eyes of law.

- E. That appellant have been subjected discrimination as other employees posted at Ring Road Check post Peshawar, Nisata Check post Charsadda and Rashakai Check Post Nowshera have not been disturbed or attached to a far flung division where as the appellant has been singled out, therefore, the impugned order is smacked with ill will and malafide. Similarly employees posted at Bajour check post Khaar and Yakaghund check post Mohmand Agency have also not been touched.
- F. That the impugned order has been passed in vacuum without having solid, cogent and convincing evidence of illegal movement of timber, therefore, the impugned order is illegal, unlawful and is the result of colorable exercise of powers vested in respondent No.1.
- G. That the impugned order of attachment dated 07.11.2017 has been passed without any regular inquiry, therefore the same has no legal footing to stand upon.
- H. That no opportunity of hearing has been provided to appellant before passing of impugned order.

- I. That impugned order of respondent No.1 is void ab-initio, corum-non-judice as respondent No.1 is not legally authorized to sent the appellant to another Division and thus on this ground too, the impugned order is liable to be struck down.
- J. That any other ground will be raised at the time of arguments with the prior permission of this Hon'ble Tribunal.

It is, therefore most humbly prayed that by accepting this appeal, the impugned order of respondent No.1 dated 07.11.2017 and respondent No.2 whereby he did not respond to the departmental appeal may please be set aside and consuequetly the appellant may be allowed to perform hid duty at Shabqadar Forest Check post.



PETITION UNDER ARTICLE 199 CONSTITUTION OF PAKISTAN, 1973 FOR A DECLARATION/ ORDER/DIRECTION TO THE EFFECT THAT THE IMPUGNED ORDERS OF RESPONDENT NO.1 **DATED** 07.11.2017 WHEREBY THE PETITIONERS WERE "ATTACHED" WITH THE OFFICE OF DIVISIONAL FOREST OFFICER, D.I.KHAN AND ORDER 23.11.2017 WHEREBY RESPONDENT NO.1 STOPPED THE SALARY OF PETITIONERS BE DECLARED AS ILLEGAL, UNLAWFUL AGAINST THE PRINCIPLE OF GOOD GOVERNANCE AND THUS INEFFECTIVE UPON THE RIGHTS OF THE **PETITIONERS** AND CONSEQUENTLY RESPONDENTS MAY BE DIRECTED TO ALLOW THE PETITIONERS TO PERFORM THEIR DUTIES AT THEIR RESPECTIVE STATION OF DUTY I.E. SHABQADAR FOREST CHECK POST AND KHAIRABAD FOREST CHECK POST.

## **Respectfully Sheweth:**

1. That the petitioners No.1 and4 were inducted in the Forest Department as Forester whereas petitioners No.2, 3, 5 and 6 where inducted as a Forest Guard and thus they have performed their duties for a period ranging from 26 to 34 years.

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- 2. That in the long career of the petitioners no complaints whatsoever has ever been reported against them and thus they have an unblemished service record.
- 3. That all of sudden on 07.11.2017, respondent No.1 issued the impugned order whereby petitioners were "attached" with the office of Divisional Forest Officer D.I.Khan Forest Division. It merits to mention here that their attachment order has been passed as a punishment as allegedly there was an illegal movement of Timber. (Copy of impugned Order is attached as annexure "A").
- 4. That it also merits to mention here that there are many check posts in between Shabqadar and Khair Abad i.e. one at Ring Road Peshawar, Nisatta Interchange Charsadda and thirdly at Rashakai Forest Check post. It is also worthy to note that there are several other check posts which come fall before Shabqadar check post namely Bajour Forest Check Post at Khaar, Yakaghund Forest check Post at Mohmand Agency.
- 5. That despite the fact that petitioners were never served or informed before passing of the impugned order dated 07.11.2017 when all of sudden their

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salaries were also stopped through the impugned order dated 23.11.2017. (Copy of the impugned order is attached as annexure "B").

- 6. That all the petitioners submitted their representation to respondent No.2 however initially he refused to entertain the same so the petitioners sent through TCS courier service but the same have not been responded so for. (Copies of Representation are attached as annexure "C").

That as transpired from the impugned order that there are allegations of illegal movement of 3 trucks of timber from FATA to settled area which allegations were out rightly rejected and denied by the petitioners but respondent unilaterally passed the impugned order as a punishment to the petitioners and thus on this score alone the impugned order of respondent No.1 is illegal, unlawful and thus ineffective upon the rights of the petitioners.

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both the impugned orders are prima facie illegal which are not sustainable in the eyes of law.

- F. That petitioners have been subjected to discrimination as other employees posted at Ring Road Check post Peshawar, Nisata Check post Charsadda and Rashakai Check Post Nowshera have not been disturbed or attached to a far flung division where as the petitioners have been singled out, therefore, the impugned order is smacked with ill will and malafide. Similarly employees posted at Bajour check post Khaar and Yakaghund check post Mohmand Agency have also not been touched.
- G. That the impugned order has been passed in vacuum without having solid, cogent and convincing evidence of illegal movement of timber, therefore, both the impugned orders are illegal, unlawful and is the result of colorable exercise of powers vested in respondent No.1.
- H. That the Petitioners have been treated against the law and they have also been deprived of equal protection of law.

It is, therefore, prayed that by accepting this petition, the impugned orders of respondent No.1 respectively dated 07.11.2017 and 23.11.2017 may please be declared as illegal, unlawful and thus ineffective upon the rights of the petitioners and consuequetly respondents may be directed to allow

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the petitioners to perform their duty at their respective station of duty i.e. Shabqadar Check post and Khairabad Check post. OR

Any other relief deems fir and appropriate in the circumstances of the case may please be passed.

## **INTERIM RELIEF:**

## **JUDGMENT**

ROOH-UL-AMIN KHAN, J:- By this common judgment, we, propose to decide C.M. No.81-P/2018 and the main writ petition.

2. Petitioners are the employees of Forest Department, out of whom, petitioners No.1 and 4 are serving as "Foresters" while petitioners No.2,3, 5 and 6, as "Forest Guard" in the respondents-department. They have filed the aforesaid C.M. for release of their monthly salaries, stopped by the respondents vide order dated 23.11.2017, on the ground of their failure to comply with the order dated 07.11.2017.

3. Mr. Meen ud Din Hamayoun, the learned AAG present in the Court was put to notice. He contended that

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due to illegal movement/ smuggling of timber through different vehicles from FATA to settle area, the petitioners were placed under suspension along with their attachment order with the office of Divisional Forest Officer, D.I. Khan Forest Division. Further contended that since the petitioners were adamant to obey the orders of the authority, hence, their monthly salaries were stopped.

4. Admittedly, the petitioners have been placed under suspension and payment of full pay to a civil servant under suspension has been resolved by the Hon'ble Hon'ble Supreme Court in case titled, "Government of NWFP Vs I.A Sherwani and another" (PLD 1994 SC 72), in the following words:-

"that rule 53 of the Fundamental Rules and rule mentioned in S. No.106 and all the parallel rules of the Provinces were repugnant to injunction of Islam to the extent that they deprive Governments Servants of their full salary and other benefits during the period of suspension.

Suspended Government Servant was entitled to full amount of his salary and all other benefits and facilities provided to him under the contract of service."

5. In view of the judgment (supra) of the Hon'ble apex Court, the C.M. is allowed and the respondents are

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Directed to release the salaries/pays of the petitioners with immediate effect.

6. In the writ petition, the petitioners have asked for issuance of the following writ:-

"It is therefore, prayed that by accepting this petition, the action/orders of respondent No.1, with regard to their suspension and attachment with the Office of Divisional Forest Officer, DI Khan, Forest Division, may please be declared as illegal, unlawful and without lawful authority and that the respondents may be directed to allow them to perform their duties at their respective stations of duty i.e. Shabqadar and Khairabad Check-Posts."

7. It appears from the impugned order that the petitioners have been placed under suspension on the ground of their involvement in a case of misconduct, hence, the writ sought in this regard by the petitioners, is not amenable to the constitutional jurisdiction of this Court under Article 199 of the Constitution. Accordingly, the writ petition being not maintainable is hereby dismissed.



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

#### PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS.

- 1. The appellant has got no locus standi to file the instant appeal.
- 2. The appellant has not come to the Court with clean hand and concealed material facts from this Honorable Court.
- 3. The appellant is allegedly involved in smuggling and through connivance of the appellant illegal timber were transported from FATA to settled area.
- 4. The appeal is bad due to mis-joinder and non-joinder of necessary parties.
- 5. The appeal is premature and appears to be an attempt to stifle/influence the inquiry proceedings.
- 6. The appeal is not maintainable as per Sec.4 of the KPK Service Tribunal Act as no final order has been passed as yet.

#### **FACTS:**

- 1. Para-1 pertains to service record of appellant.
- 2. Incorrect. Appellant service is full of complaints and bad entries.
- 3. Incorrect. The appellant was suspended on 07.11.2017 on account of allegation of illegal smuggling of timber and inquiry constituted which is still underway.
- 4. Incorrect. The impugned order 07.11.2017 has been passed according to law as admitted by the respondent that appellant was involved in 03 No. of trucks loaded with illegal timber and smuggled from FATA to settled area. The appellant has not been punished as yet and any final order will be passed after conclusion of the inquiry.
- 5. Incorrect. The appellant is well advised to raise/address these facts before the inquiry committee
- Incorrect. The impugned order has been passed according to law and appellant was informaccording to law.
- 7. Incorrect. The appellant has not filed any departmental appeal/representation to respondent. The answering respondent has not received any such appeal and ostensibly it appears that the is an afterthought.
- 8. Correct to the extent that Peshawar High Court Peshawar have passed an order for the rethe salary of the appellant and Peshawar High Court has upheld the order of suspension and passed by the authority as the same pertains to terms and conditions of the service of the a
- Incorrect. The appellant has not invoked the jurisdiction of Honorable Tribunal with intention. No appeal has been submitted/received by the answering respondent.

#### **GROUNDS:**

- A. Incorrect. The authority have passed the impugned order according to law, as per allegations the appellant have facilitated and transported illegal timber of trucks to settled area. However no final order with respect to the appellant's exoneration/ punishment has been passed as yet.
- B. Incorrect. The services of the appellant has been rightly attached with D.I.Khan Forest Division as postings and transfer is a routine matter within the competence of the answering respondent.
- C. Incorrect. The appellant should associate himself with inquiry proceedings. The departmental inquiry is underway whereafter the appellant will be either punished or exonerated.
- D. The impugned order 07.11.2017 is passed according to law and appellant services have been attached to D.I.Khan Forest Division. Posting and transfer is a routine matter and in normal circumstances is not amicable to interference by this Honorable Tribunal.
- E. Appellant has been treated according to law. No discrimination has been made against the appellant. The appellant is required under the law to serve wherever he is posted. In the meanwhile appellant has been attached to D.I.Khan Forest Division.
- F. Incorrect. The appellant has not been punished as yet. The impugned order is legal and according to law.
- G. The impugned order dated 07.11.2017 has all the legal formalities. Attachment is not a punishment. The inquiry is underway and appellant is advised to join the same.
- H. Transfer/Posting/attachment is not a punishment and there is no need of prior hearing.
- I. The impugned order 07.11.2017 is according to law and passed by the rightful authority and appellant attachment order is rightly passed by the respondent No.01 and the appellant, being a Civil Servant, is obliged under the law to serve where he is transferred/posted.
- J. Needs no reply.

In view of the above ex-position, it is therefore most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this reply, the appeal of the appellant may be dismissed with cost.
