JUDGMENT:

AHMAD HASSAN, MEMBER:- Arguments of the learned counsel for the parties heard and record perused.

ARGUMENTS:

02. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that he was enlisted as Constable (BPS-07) in the Police Department on 19.07.2007 and his performance remained satisfactory. Due to heart ailment, the appellant was advised complete bed rest by the physician. Due to these compelling reasons, he was unable to perform duty. On the other hand on the allegations of absence from duty disciplinary proceedings were conducted under Police Rules 1975 and thereafter major penalty of dismissal from service was awarded to him vide impugned order dated 03.01.2018. Learned counsel for the appellant further argued that two separates enquiries were ordered



against the appellant and respondents nominated two different enquiry officers. The rules demanded that upon winding up separate orders should have been passed on these enquiries. However, the respondents awarded major penalty to the appellant through the impugned order referred to above. He filed departmental appeal on 01.08.2018, which was dismissed on 15.10.2018, hence, the present service appeal. Action against the appellant was not backed by law and rules and the respondents failed to observe various formalities contained therein. Reliance was placed on case law reported as 2011 PLC (CS) 1111, 2018 PLC (CS) 93, 2008 PLC (C.S) 2011, 2007 SCMR 73, 1991 SCMR 640, 1995 SCMR 950, PLD 2000 Supreme Court 502, 2011 PLC (C.S) 808, 2006 SCMR 1018, 2008 SCMR 214.

O3. Learned Additional Advocate General in rebuttal at the very outset raised objection on the maintainability of the present service appeal. Departmental appeal filed by the appellant was barred by time. Therefore, the present service appeal was not maintainable. He stated that on account of willful absence from duty disciplinary proceedings were initiated against the appellant. As a member of disciplined force, even on account of illness, he should have got leave/permission from the competent authority. He also stated at the bar that two separate enquiries were conducted against the appellant and major penalty of dismissal from service was imposed on him through impugned order dated 03.01.2018. Action was taken against the appellant after observance of all codal formalities.

CONCLUSION:

04. According to the record submitted by the respondents, the appellant absented himself from duty w.e.f. 14.02.2017 till the issuance of charge sheet on 09.03.2017 and SDPO Cantt: Peshawar was nominated as enquiry officer. The enquiry officer

in his report dated 15.12.2017 opined that as the appellant failed to join the proceedings, therefore, ex-parte action was initiated against him. He further recommended punishment after issuance of show cause notice.

Similarly another charge sheet issued by respondents vide endorsement dated 05. 15.05.2017 showed that he remained absent w.e.f 21.11.2016 to 27.01.2017 (two months and six days). To probe the matter SDPO, Chamkani was nominated as enquiry officer. The enquiry officer in his report dated 28.12.2017 proposed to treat the period of his absence as leave without pay. Thereafter, the respondents served final show cause notice dated 19.12.2017 on the appellant. This show cause notice was vague, evasive, ambiguous and not on the proper format. It did not divulge relevant details and was also silent on the crucial point of enquiry which was made basis for issuance of the above show cause notice. Moreover, copy of enquiry report conducted against the appellant was not annexed with the show cause notice. This illegality alone on the strength of countless judgments of the superior courts followed by this Tribunal was sufficient to vitiate the entire disciplinary proceedings. We would again like to emphasize and sensitize the respondents that by not serving the show cause notice on its proper format and non-provision of enquiry report snatched the right of offering proper defense from the appellant and he was condemned unheard. Due to these serious inherent flaws/deficiencies and illegalities, it could not be termed as regular enquiry. Only through regular enquiry opportunity of fair trial could be extended to the appellant (2008 SCMR 1369). Even, in some of the judgments such orders were declared as void. It goes against the dictates of Article-4 and 10-A of the Constitution of 1973.

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06. This Tribunal deems it appropriate to draw attention of the respondents to Rule-5 of Police Rules 1975 and is reproduced below for ready reference:-

"On receipt of the findings of the Inquiry Officer or where no such officer is appointed, on receipt of the explanation of the accused, if any, the authority shall determine whether the charge has been proved or not. In case the charge is proved the authority shall award one or more of major punishments as deemed necessary".

- On the strength of above rule, it was incumbent upon the respondents to have passed separate orders on each enquiry conducted against the appellant. Through impugned order dated 03.01.2018 the appellant was awarded major punishment of dismissal from service for the period, he remained absent i.e from 21.11.2016 to 27.01.2017 (two months and six days) and 14.02.2017 till date (10 months and 17 days) total 12 months and 23 days. Mandatory provisions of rules were flouted without any cogent reason/justification. At this juncture attention of learned Assistant Advocate General was drawn towards the illegality/irregularity committed by the respondents but he was unable to give any satisfactory response.
- O8. The appellant has more than ten years service and it would be against the principles of natural justice to non-suit him on mere technicalities and that too when the respondents were not able to defend their case on merit. It would also be unjust to adopt different standards for the appellant and respondents. Both of them will have to be treated on equal footings. To address the shortcomings, meet the ends of justice and to provide opportunity of fair trial to the appellant de-novo enquiry be conducted in the matter.
- 09. As a sequel to the above, the appeal is appeals accepted, impugned orders dated 03.01.2018 and 15.01.2018 are set aside and the appellant is reinstated in to

service. The respondents are directed to conduct de-novo enquiry within a period of ninety days after the date of receipt of this judgment. The issue of back benefits shall be subject to the outcome of the de-novo proceedings. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.

Learned counsel for the appellant present, preliminary arguments heard.

The appellant (Ex-Constable) has filed the present service appeal against the order dated 03.01.2018 whereby he was dismissed from service on the ground of absence from duty. The appellant has also challenged the order dated 15.10.2018 through which his departmental appeal was dismissed/rejected.

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Learned counsel for the appellant argued inter-alia that the impugned orders are against law, facts and norms of natural justice and that the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law. Further argued that the appellant could not attend to his duties due to severe illness and that the punishment awarded to the appellant is extremely harsh.

Points raised need consideration. It appeared that the appellant has submitted departmental appeal beyond the period of thirty (30) days. In the interest of justice, the appeal is admitted for regular hearing subject to all legal objections including the issue of limitation and maintainability. The appellant is directed to deposit security and process fee within 10 days, thereafter notices be issued to the respondents for written reply/comments. In this regard, he was issued charge sheet & summary of allegations. Two separate enquiries were initiated & conducted by SDPO Chamkani & SDPO Cantt.

SDPO Chamkani conducted the enquiry proceedings in the $\mathbf{1}^{\mathsf{st}}$ absence period &" submitted his report that the defaulter official taken the plea of his illness but failed to produce any medical prescriptions. The E.O further recommended that his period of absence may be treated as leave without pay vide Enquiry Report No.25/St dated 28.12.217. {

SDPO Cantt conducted the enquiry proceedings in 2nd absence period & submitted his report that the defaulter official did not attend the enquiry proceedings. The E.O further stated that he has been transferred to District Kohistan but he failed to report arrival as yet as per intimation of DPO Kohistan and recommended him for taking ex-parte decision against the defaulter official after issuing of final show cause notice vide Enquiry Report No.712/E/S dated 15.12.2017.

Upon the finding of E.O, he was issued final show cause notice & delivered him on home address through local Police PS Chamkani but he failed to receive the said notice or appear before this office as yet.

In the light of recommendations of E.O & other material available on record, the undersigned came to conclusion that the alleged official is not interested in his job and found unwilling worker. Therefore, he is hereby dismissed from service under Police & Disciplinary Rules-1975 with immediate effect. Hence, the period he remained absent from 21.11.2016 to 27.01.2017 & 14.02.2017 till date is treated without pay.



IX. While I was under treatment, SP HQrs, on its own conducted an enquiry, for which I was never made part of and by taking ex-parte decision I was dismissed from service.

X. It is pertinent to mention that applicant was transferred to upper Kohistan and I was not the strength of Police Lines, Peshawar, then how can I be dismissed from service by the SP HQrs. And applicant was dismissed from service through an ex-parte action without associating me with the enquiry proceedings.

Therefore, it is requested that the dismissal orders may be set-aside and I may kindly be re-instated to service.

ORDER.

This order will dispose off the departmental appeal preferred by Ex-Constable Abdur Rehman No.4730 who was awarded the major punishment of "Dismissal from service" by SP/HQrs Peshawar vide OB No.55, dated 03-01-2018.

- The allegations leveled against him were that he while posted at Police Lines Peshawar absented himself from his lawful duty w.e from 21-11-2016 to 27-01-2017 (02 months & 06 days) and from 14-02-2017 till his dismissal i.e 03-01-2018 (10 months & 17 days) for a total period of 12 months and 23 days.
- 3- He was issued proper charge sheet and summary of allegations by SP/HQrs Peshawar and SDPO Chamkani was appointed as enquiry officer for his first absence period. The enquiry officer in his findings submitted that the delinquent official has taken the plea of his illness but failed to produced any medical prescription etc to cover his absence. The delinquent official was recommended that period of absence may be treated as leave without pay. Similarly on account of his another absence SDPO Cantt was appointed as enquiry officer. The enquiry officer submitted in his findings that the accused official failed to attend the enquiry proceedings and further stated that he has already been transferred to District Kohistan in another allegations. On perusal of findings of both the enquiry officers the competent authority issued him Final Show Cause Notice which was delivered to him on home address through local Police of PS Chamkani but he failed to receive the same and also not appear to before the competent authority, hence he was awarded the above major punishment by SP/HQrs Peshawar.
- 4- He was heard in person in O.R. The relevant record perused along with his explanation but he failed to submit any plausible explanation in support of his absence, therefore his appeal to set aside the major punishment awarded to him by SP/HQrs Peshawar vide OB No.55, dated 03-01-2018 is dismissed/rejected.

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS.

- 1. That the appeal is badly time barred.
- 2. That the appeal is bad for mis-joinder and mon-joinder or necessary parties.
- 3. That the appellant has not come to this Tribunal with clean hands.
- 4. That the appellant has no cause of action.
- 5. That the appellant is estopped by his own conduct to file the instant appeal.
- 6. That the appellant concealed the material facts from Honorable Tribunal.
- 7. That the appellant got no locus standi and cause of action to file the instant appeal.

FACTS:-

- 1. Para No.01 pertains to record, hence need no comments.
- 2. Para No.02 pertains to record, hence need no comments.
- 3. Para No.03 pertains to record, hence need no comments.
- 4. Para No.04 is incorrect in fact the appellant while posted at police Lines, Peshawar deliberately absented himself from his lawful duty without taking leave/permission.
- 5. Para No.05 is incorrect and denied. The appellant absented himself without taking leave/permission and was enjoying his long absence period without any prior permission.
- 6. Para for the appellant to Prove.
- 7. Incorrect. The appellant was issued charge sheet and statement of allegations for willful absence from duty. Two separate enquiries were initiated and conducted by SDPO/Chamkani, SDPO/Cantt:. SDPO/Chamkni conducted the enquiry in the 1st absence period (21.11.2016 to 27.01.2017 total 2 Months and Six days) and submitted his report that the appellant taken the plea of his illness, but failed to produce any medical prescriptions to justify his stance. SDPO/Cantt: conducted the enquiry in second absence period (14.02.2017 to 03.01.2018 total 8 Months and 17 days) Grand Total (12 months & 23 days) and submitted his

report that the appellant did not attend the enquiry proceedings and further stated that he has already been transferred to district Kohistan. Upon the finding of enquiry officers he was issued final show cause notice and delivered him on home address through local police of PS Chamkani. After fulfilling all the codal formalities, he was awarded major punishment of dismissal from service.(copy of charge sheet, statements of allegations, enquiry reports and final show cause notice are attached)

- 8. Para No.08 is correct to the extent that he filed departmental appeal which after due consideration was filed/rejected on the ground that the allegations were stand proved. It is worth mentioning here that his appeal was also time barred for about 7 months.
- 9. Incorrect. The appeal is not tenable on the given grounds.

GROUNDS:-

- A. Incorrect. The orders are just, legal and have been passed in accordance with law and rules.
- B. Incorrect. The appellant was treated as par law/rules. Proper departmental enquiries were conducted and the enquiry officers reported that charges leveled against the appellant were proved. Therefore, the punishment order was passed which is in accordance with law.

- E. Incorrect. The appellant was associated in the enquiry proceedings and proper of opportunity of defense was provided to appellant, but he failed to defend the charges leveled against him.
- F. Para not related, hence needs no comments.
- G. Incorrect the punishment order was passed by competent authority in pursuance of his long absence period which is not tolerable in the disciplined force.
- H. Incorrect the appellant availed the opportunities of defense, but he could not prove himself innocent with plausible grounds.
- I. Para pertains to record, hence needs no comments.
- J. Incorrect. The punishment order was passed in accordance with law/rules and no right of appellant has been violated.
- K. Incorrect. After fulfilling the codal formalities, he was awarded major punishment of dismissal from service.

REJOINDER ON BEHALF OF APPELLANT

Respectfully Sheweth
Preliminary Objection:

All the preliminary objections raised by the Respondent are incorrect and raised with the intention to deprive the appellant from his due legal rights, and appeal of the appellant is not time barred because the period of limitation starts from the final order of the respondent while appellant applied to this Hon'ble Court in time, while deciding the departmental appeal of the appellant by Respondent No.2 has not raised any objection regarding the limitation while passing the final order, so it comes under the principle of estopple locus - poenitentiae.

FACTS:-

1. That the appellant has never been allowed any opportunity to be hear in person and

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absence of the appellant is not willful and intentional.

- 2. That after passing the final order, the limitation period should be started while the appellant approached to this Hon'ble Court in time and petition of the appellant is not time barred.
- 3. That the appeal of the appellant is in time and CCPO didn't raise any objection while deciding the appeal where is the instant appeal filed within a specified time.
- 4. That no Show-Cause Notice has been delivered or issued to the appellant and no fair opportunity of personal hearing was granted to the appellant, which is against the legal maxim "No one should be condemned unheard".
- 5. That the appellant was never associated with any inquiry proceeding whereas no proper inquiry was conducted by the Respondents and the Appellant is not treated by the Respondents in accordance with law and rules while passing the impugned order.

GROUNDS:-

- A. That the order is illegal and which is not passed in accordance with law and rules.
- B.In the appellant was not treated in accordance with law and rules, proper departmental inquiry was not conducted and the inquiry officer reported the charge leveled against the appellant were also not proved, therefore, the impugned order may kindly be suspended/ set aside.
- C. That Para No. C is correct and the reply is incorrect.
- D.That appellant was not issued any chargesheet, statement of allegation for absence of duty and no Show-Cause Notice was delivered to the appellant by the local police.
- E. That the appellant was not treated lawfully according to the law and rules and was not given a chance of personal hearing, therefore, the appellant has a legal right not to be condemned unheard.

- F. That absence of the appellant was not willful and intentional but due to severe illness.
- G.That the punishment order was passed by competent authority was illegal and not in accordance with law.
- H.That the appellant is innocent and respondents didn't provide any opportunity to the appellant to hear in person.
- I. That the appellant during his entire 10 years of service will full zeast and zeal and never gave any chance of complaint to his superiors regarding his service.
- J. That the respondents acted in arbitrary manner and the punishment order was passed illegally, where the right of the appellant has been violated.
- K.That mandatory provision of law has not been fulfilled by the respondents nor respondents fulfilled the codal formalities while awarding the major punishment.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this rejoinder the comments filed by Respondents may be rejected and the appeal of the appellant may please be accepted and the appellant may graciously be reinstate in service keeping in view the overall circumstances & legal position of the case.

Any other relief which this Hon'ble' Tribunal may deems fit and appropriate may also very graciously be granted in favor of the appellant.
