JUDGMENT:

AHMAD HASSAN, MEMBER:- Arguments of the learned counsel for the parties heard and record perused.

ARGUMENTS:

O2. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that she was appointed as Female Welfare Worker vide order dated 02.04.2005 and performed duty regularly. That her services were placed at the disposal of respondent no.3 for further posting in erstwhile FATA. Upon completion of normal tenure, she made a representation for transfer from FATA to settled area but without any positive outcome. Action on the part of the respondents had not backing of law. She served in FATA for more than thirteen years and deserved to be adjusted in settled area.

Learned District Attorney argued that as per advertisement appointment of the appellant was made for Population Welfare Program in erstwhile FATA. She could not claim posting in settled area. Moreover, in the post merger scenario of FATA in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, the issue pertaining to the status of the appellant was yet to be resolved by the respondents. As she is not on the strength of the Population Welfare Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, therefore, her transfer in settled area is not possible.

CONCLUSION:

- 04. The appellant was an employee of erstwhile FATA, and through the present service appeal seeks transfer in the settled area. We have observed that departmental appeal dated 19.03.2018 filed by the appellant was not decided by the respondents within the given deadline. Even they have not provided any cogent reasons for not deciding the same. In these circumstances, it would be appropriate to remit the service appeal back to the respondents to decide her departmental appeal, through a well reasoned speaking order.
- 05. As a sequel to the above, the appeal is remitted to the respondents with the direction to decide the departmental appeal of the appellant through a speaking order within a period of sixty days from the date of receipt of this judgment. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.

PRAYER IN APPEAL:

That on acceptance of this appeal, the respondents may kindly be directed to treat the Appellant in accordance with law/rules/policy and notifications of the Govt: regarding posting/transfer and not to discriminate her in the matter of transfer from FATA to settled area and thus the respondents (competent authority) may kindly be directed to issue the transfer order of the Appellant from FATA to settled area.

Respectfully Submitted:-

- 1. That the Appellant is unmarried female residing with her parents at village Gul Mera, P/o Lund Khwar, Tehsil Takht Bhai, District Mardan. (Copy of CNIC is attached as annexure "B").
- 2. That since her appointments as family welfare workers vide order dated 02/04/2005, the Appellant is performing her

duties in the office of Agency Population Welfare Officer Bajour Agency respondent No 6 (Copy of Appointment Order is attached as annexure "C").

- 3. That the respondent No 2 is the appointing authority for the entire province including FATA and after selection and appointment of the candidates for FATA, they are placed on the disposal of respondent No 3 for further postings and after completing normal tenure there and then they are transferred and posted in settled area on the approval of the respondent No 5.
- 4. That after completion of not only the normal tenure, but passing a considerable long period, the Appellant submitted an application/representation for her transfer from FATA to settled area and an NOC was also issued in her favour, but even then she has not been considered for her transfer as such and it is pertinent to mention here that now after merging of FATA in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa no NOC, post of availability certificates or substitute is required. (Copy of NOC is attached as annexure "D")
- 5. That the Appellant approached the authority time and again for her transfer from FATA to settled area, but of no use, hence this appeal on the following amongst other grounds:

Grounds:-

- A. That the act & omission of the respondents is illegal, unconstitutional, without jurisdiction, without lawful authority and of no legal effect, therefore, need the interference of this Honourable
- B. That the act and omission of the respondents is not only factually incorrect and legally untenable, but also is based on the malafide intention of the respondents and also is discriminatory in nature.
- C. That the respondents have not treated the Appellant in accordance with laws/rules/policies and notifications of the Provincial Government, regarding posting/transfer and thus have acted in violation of the constitution by unlawfully ignoring the transfer of the Appellant from FATA to settled area.
- D. That under Article 35 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, it is the obligatory duty of the state to protect the marriage, the family, mother and child, however, the Appellant has been denied the fundamental rights, which has resulted in gross miscarriage of justice.

- E. That the respondents are bound to follow the policy and notifications of the Provincial Government frame/circulated in the public interest to redress the grievances of the aggrieved civil servants, but they have failed to discharge the responsibilities/obligations cast upon them by the law, which is utterly illegal, unconstitutional and hence not maintainable under the law.
- F. That being unmarried female due to the posting of the Appellant in far flung area in FATA and her parents residing in settled area, the family life of the Appellant as well as of her parents have been quite miserable as they are compelled to reside separately due to the service of the Appellant and the Appellant as well as her parents always disturbed due to the separate living therefore not only legally and constituently, but on humanitarian grounds also the Appellant is entitled for her transfer from FATA to settled area.
- G. That the Appellant has served for about 13 years in FATA efficiently, honestly and without giving any chance of complaint to her superiors, which facts also go in her favour entitling him for her transfer for FATA to settled area.

- H. That under the various provisions of the policy of the government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa also the appellant is entitled for her transfer to FATA to settled area.
- I. That except the Appellant no other female member is available at home to take care of her old aged parents and 2 disable sisters and in these circumstances, it is very difficult for the Appellant to continue her duties in such far flung area.
- J. That other grounds not specifically been mentioned in this petition, may also kindly be allowed at the time of arguments.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this appeal, the respondents may kindly be directed to treat the Appellant in accordance with law/rules/policy and notifications of the Govt: regarding posting/transfer and not to discriminate her in the matter of transfer from FATA to settled area and thus the respondents (competent authority) may kindly be directed to issue the transfer order of the Appellant from FATA to settled area.

Any other remedy/relief available in the circumstances of the case may also kindly be given to the Appellant.



NISAR HUSSAIN KHAN, J.- Petitioner through the instant petition seeks issuance of an appropriate writ directing the respondents to transfer him from FATA to settled area according to Law, Rules and Policy of the Government on the subject.

- 2. We have gone through the record carefully and have also considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.
- 3. Undeniably, petitioner is a civil servant, performing his duties as Family Welfare Worker in the Agency Population Welfare Officer, Bajaur Agency. Admittedly, the transfer and posting is a matter pertaining to the terms and conditions of service which only falls within the domain of Service





4. Beside that it is case of the petitioner that she was appointed as Family Welfare Worker and posted at the office of the Agency Population Welfare Department vide order/endorsement dated 2.4.2005, where she took over the charge on 6.4.2005. It was contended on behalf of the petitioner that as per Clause-6 of Posting/Transfer Policy of the Provincial Government from settled area to FATA and vice versa, approval of the Government of KPK is required to be obtained, which requirement she has complied. The respondents in their comments have submitted







that petitioner is not Provincial Civil Servant as she was not recruited by the Provincial Government of KPK, whereas, Female Welfare workers in the Population Welfare Department are serving in BPS-8 while according to appointment of petitioner, she is in BPS-9, so in terms of Rules of the service, she cannot be accommodated in the Provincial Service in BPS-9. In that respect in Estacode KPK Revised Edition 2011 Vol-5(IX) provided that person appointed in Agency Cadre, if appointed in the settled area will resign from service in FATA and resume service in settled area as fresh candidate. In view of this anomalous situation too, prayer of the petitioner cannot be allowed.

For what has been discussed above, this petition being devoid of merit is dismissed in limine.



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Posting and Transfer

Statutory Provision.

Section 10 of the NWFP Civil Servants Act, 1973.

Posting and Transfer. Every civil servant shall be liable to serve anywhere within or outside the Province, in any post under the Federal Government, or any Provincial Government or Local authority, or a Corporation or body set up or established by any such Government:

Provided that nothing contained in this section shall apply to a civil servant recruited specifically to serve in a particular area or region;

Provided further that, where a civil servant is required to serve in a post outside a service or cadre, his terms and conditions of service as to his pay shall not be less favourable than those to which he would have been entitled if he had not been so required to serve.

Posting/transfer policy of the Provincial Government.

- i) All the posting/transfers shall be strictly in public interest and shall not be abused/misused to victimize the Government servants
- ii) All Government servants are prohibited to exert political, Administrative or any other pressures upon the posting/transfer authorities for seeking posing/transfers of their choice and against the public interest.
- iii) All contract Government employees appointed against specific posts, can not be posted against any other post.
- 12. Existing tenure of posting/transfer of three (03) years for settled areas and two (02) years for unattractive/hard areas shall be reduced to two (02) years for settled areas, 01½ years for unattractive areas and one year for hard areas.
- V) -0[

Para-Iv) regarding months of March and July for posting/transfer and authorities for relaxation of ban deleted vide letter No: SOR-VI (E&AD) 1-4/2008/Vol-VI, dated 3-6-2008. Consequently authorities competent under the NWFP Government Rules of Business, 1985. District Government Rules of Business 2001. Posting/Transfer Policy and other rules for the time being in force, allowed to make Posting/Transfer subject to observance of the policy and rules.

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wi) while making posting/transfers of officers/officials up to BS-17 from settled areas to FATA and vice versa approval of the Chief Secretary, NWFP needs to be obtained. Save Tehsildars/Naib Tehsildars within a division in respect of whom the concerned Commissioner will exercise the same power. Whereas, in case of posting/transfer of officers in BS-18 and above, from settled areas to FATA and vice versa, specific approval of the Governor, NWFP shall be obtained.

Provided that the power to transfer Political Tehsildars and Political Naib Tehsildars within FATA between different divisions shall rest in Additional Chief Secretary FATA.

- vi (a) All Officers/officials selected against Zone-I/FATA quota in the Provincial Services should compulsorily serve in FATA for at least eighteen months in each grade. This should start from senior most scales/grades downwards in each scale/grade of each cadre.
- Officers may be posted on executive/administrative posts in the Districts of their domicile except District Coordination Officers (D.C.Os) and DPOs/Superintendent of Police (SP). Similarly Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) shall not be posted at a place where the Police Station (Thanna) of his area/residence is situated.
- viii) No posting/transfers of the officers/officials on detailment basis shall be made.
- ix) Regarding the posting of husband/wife, both in Provincial services, efforts where possible would be made to post such persons at one station subject to the public interest.
- x) All the posting/transferring authorities may facilitate the posting/ transfer of the unmarried female government Servants at the station of the residence of their parents.
- vi) Officers/officials except DCOs and DPOs/SPs who are due to retire within one year may be posted on their option on posts in the Districts of their domicile and be allowed to serve there till the retirement

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**DCOs and DPOs who are due to retire in the near future may also be posted in the District of their domicile subject to the condition that such posting would be against non-administrative posts of equivalent scales;

Nii) In terms of Rule 17(1) and (2) read with Schedule-III of the NWFP Government Rules of Business 1985, transfer of officers shown in column 1 of the following table shall be made by the authorities shown against each officer in column2 thereof:

- xiii) While considering posting/transfer proposals all the concerned authorities shall keep in mind the following:
 - a) To ensure the posting of proper persons on proper posts, the Performance Evaluation Report/annual confidential reports, past and present record of service, performance on post held presently and in the past and general reputation with focus on the integrity of the concerned officers/ officials be considered.
 - b) Tenure on present post shall also be taken into consideration and the posting/transfers shall be in the best public interest.

- xiv) Government servants including District Govt. employees feeling aggrieved due to the orders of posting/transfer authorities may seek remedy from the next higher authority / the appointing authority as the case may be through an appeal to be submitted within seven days of the receipt of such orders. Such appeal shall be disposed of within fifteen days. The option of appeal against posting/ transfer orders could be exercised only in the following cases.
 - i) Pre-mature posting/transfer or posting transfer in violation of the provisions of this policy.
 - ii) Serious and grave personal (humanitarian) grounds.
- 2. To streamline the postings/transfers in the District Government and to remove any irritant/confusions in this regard the provision of Rule 25 of the North West Frontier Province District Government Rules of Business 2001 read with schedule IV thereof is referred. As per schedule-IV the posting/transferring authorities for the officers/officials shown against each are as under:-

S. No.	Officers	Authority
1.	Posting of District Coordination Officer and Executive District Officer in a District.	Provincial Government.
2.	Posting of District Police Officer.	Provincial Government
3.	Other Officers in BPS-17 and above posted in the District.	Provincial Government
4	Official in BPS-16 and below	Executive District Officer in consultation with District Coordination Officer.

3. As per Rule 25(2) of the Rules mentioned above the District Coordination Department shall consult the Government if it is proposed to:

a) Transfer the holder of a tenure post before the completion of his tenure or extend the period of his tenure.

b) Require an officer to hold charge of more than one post for a period exceeding two months.

4. I am further directed to request that the above noted policy may be strictly observed/ implemented.

5. All concerned are requested to ensure that tenures of the concerned officers/officials are invariably mentioned in summaries submitted to the Competent Authorities for Posting/Transfer.

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*PLACEMENT POLICY.

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als ig/ In order to utilize the expertise of the officers who have received foreign training in various fields, the provincial Government has decided to adopt the Placement Policy, approved by the Prime Minister of Pakistan, and make it a part of its Posting/Transfer Policy. Placement Policy is as follows:-

- i) All placements would be made on the basis of merit and keeping in view the needs of the organization.
- ii) The first priority in placement must go the parent organization of the participant from where the individual had applied. This will be in consonance with the concept of establishing the "Need" for the department and fulfilling the need through "capacity building for the organization.
- iii) In order to follow the "bottom up approach" for Devolution, the priority within departments must go to the Districts, the Provinces and than the Federal Government.
- The second priority in placement should go to up-grading the existing training Institution within the country. The knowledge gained by the officers, will be of immense value to bring about a qualitative change in the training institutions. The following proposals are made in this regard:
 - a) Permanent posting of an officer to the training institutions for 2-3 years;
 - b) Temporary attachment with the training intuitions for 3 to 6 months for some research project on helping in developing case studies;
 - c) Earmarked as a visiting faculty member for specific subject.
- v) Individuals posted to their parent organizations will also organize training for their subordinates within the department, in order to transfer the knowledge and bring about a qualitative change internally;
- vi) The Normal tenure of posting as already provided in the policy would be ensured;
- No participant should be allowed to be posted on deputation to multinational donor agencies for at least 5 years;
- viii) No participants will decline/represent against his/her posting.

St Placement Policy has been made part of the posting/transfer policy vide Urdu circular No.SOR-VI(E&AD)1-i/06, dated 9-2-2007

It has been decided by the Provincial Government that posting/transfer orders of all the officers up to BS-19 except Heads of Attached Departments irrespective of grades will be notified by the concerned Administrative Departments with prior approval of the Competent Authority obtained on the Summary. The Notifications/orders should be issued as per specimen given below for guidance.

All posting/transfer orders of BS-20 and above and Heads of Attached Departments (HAD) shall be issued by the Establishment Department and the Administrative Department shall send approved Summaries to E&A Department for issuance of Notifications.

Respectfully Sheweth:

Preliminary objections:

- 1. The appellant is a Project Employee of Population Welfare Program in FATA funded through Public Sector Development Program; therefore, the court lacks the jurisdiction to entertain the instant appeal.
- 2. The appeal is not maintainable in its present form.
- 3. That the appellant has no cause of action.
- 4. The instant appeal is barred by law.

FACTS:

- 1. Incorrect: As per record the Appellant is the resident of Upper Dir (Copy of Domicile Certificate is attached as **Annexure "I"**)
- 2. Correct.
- 3. Incorrect. The appointing authority of the Appellant is the respondent No.3 and not the respondent No.2. After Selection and appointment the Appellant was placed at the disposal of respondent No. 6 for further posting. (Copy of Appointment Order of the Appellant is attached as **Annexure "II"** and Advertisement of the post as **Annexure "II"**).
- 4. Correct to the extent that the Appellant has completed her normal tenure of service at FATA but she was appointed for FATA and not for settled area, even then she was issued NOC by the Department, subject to the condition of provision of substitute, who will report first in FATA as per rules. (Copy of relevant rules is attached as **Annexure "IV"**). However, in the post-merger scenario, the applicant status is not yet finalized and she is not on the staff strength of Population Welfare Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Once taken on the staff strength of Population Welfare Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and her status become clear only then her case of transfer can be considered as per transfer/ posting policy.
- 5. Correct to the extent that the Appellant has approached the authority for Transfer from FATA to settled area, but as she is employee of Population Welfare Program Tribal Districts (ex-FATA) and is not on the staff strength of Population Welfare Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa therefore, she cannot be transferred to settle area.

GROUNDS:



- A. Incorrect: Nothing illegal, unconstitutional and without lawful authority has been done to the Appellant.
- B. Nothing discriminatory and based upon mollified intention is done to the Appellant.
- C. The Appellant is treated in accordance with law/rules/policies and notification of provincial Government, regarding posting/Transfer and no violation of the constitution is done.
- D. No violation of the Article 35 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 is done.
- E. Policy and notifications of the Provincial Government to redress the grievances of the civil servants are fully adhered with and no violation is made in this respect.
- F. Subject to proof, however, detail reply has been given above.
- G. Transfer & posting is not a vested right.
- H. The Appellant being employee of Population Welfare Program Tribal Districts (ex-FATA) and not on the staff strength of Population Welfare Department KPK therefore, she cannot be transfer to Population Welfare Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- I. Being a Civil Servant she is to serve anywhere she is posted.
- J. No comments.

It is therefore most humbly submitted/Prayed that, the Appellant is treated in accordance with law/rules/policy and notifications of the Government, and no discrimination is made to her regarding posting/transfer from FATA to settled area, therefore the Appeal of the Appellant may kindly be dismissed with cost.



Transfer of officers during training with the Public Administration/Training Institutes in Pakistan.

SI.No.3

Instances have come to the notice of Provincial Government wherein officers were transferred while they were still under training with the National Institute of Public Administration, PARD etc. This is against the policy of the Provincial Government according to which an officer who is sent for training is not to be transferred from his post. In order to maintain sanctity of this policy, maintain institutional standards at feirly desirable levels and enable the officers to fully concentrate on their training, it is desirable that the trainees are not disturbed.

2. The aforesaid policy of the Government may kindly be strictly adhered to and that in future no officer under training at the PASC/NIPA/Academy for Rural Development, Shariah Academy, etc. should be transferred from his post till completion of the training period. However, in case, the nominating authority of an officer feels that it has become absolutely essential to fill up the vacancy caused by the officer's participation in a training programme, such transfers should be effected only with the prior concurrence of the Services and General Administration Department.

Necessary instructions have been issued time and again to the effect that no postings and transfers to and from EATA, including E.Rs, shall be made unless approval from the Agent to the President Le (Governor, NWEP) is obtained. In this connection, a Circular letter was issued by the Governor's Secretariat, NWEP addressed to all the Administrative Departments vide No. SO(P)GS/16(2)1/96/365-89, dated 12.2.1996 with the direction that all cases for grant of NOC for transfer from FATA to settled Areas pray be submitted to the Governor's Secretariat only by the Department concerned and not by the individual officials, 12. It has been observed that the above instructions are not being followed accordingly. Under the circumstances, it is once again resiterated that the above instructions may kindly be adhered to strictly.

3. It is, however, clarified that when an employee completes his prescribed tenure of posting in FATA/FiRs, the requisite NCC in such cases, shall not be required. The competent authority may dispose of such cases subject to observance of all other codal formalities and subject to the provision of a substitute. It may be kept in view that in case of Provincial/Divisional cadde post, the substitute shall have to move first to join his post in FATA.
