



AND POSITION OF CIVIL DEFENCE OFFICER (BPS-17). RESULTANTLY, DEPRIVING THE APPELLANT FROM HIS LEGITIMATE AND FUNDAMENTAL RIGHT OF PROMOTION TO THE ABOVE SAID POST OF CIVIL DEFENCE OFFICER (CDO, BPS-17), WHICH IS ILLEGAL, AGAINST THE LAW AND FACTS. HENCE NEEDS TO BE REMEDIED THROUGH THE INSTANT APPEAL BEFORE THIS HON'BLE TRIBUNAL.

Respectfully Sheweth:

1. That on 10.04.1984, the appellant was appointed as Junior Clerk (BPS-5) in the respondents department and later on was adjusted as Instructor Grade-III (BPS-07) and on 18.02.2013, promoted to the post of Instructor Grade-II (BPS-11) on regular basis w.e.f. 11.02.2013.

(Copies of Appointment Order dated 10.04.1984 and Office Order dated 18.02.2013 are annexure "A" & "B" respectively).

2. That on 02.07.2015, the appellant alongwith others was promoted on regular basis to the post of Instructor Grade-I (BPS-15).

(Copy of Office Order bearing the name of Appellant at Sr.No.23 is annexure "C").

3. That the appellant as per the laid down policy and condition for promotion to the post of Civil Defence Officer/CDO (BPS-17) has completed the required trainings as well.

(Copies of Training Certificates are annexure "D").

4. That on 12.02.2021, final seniority list bearing the name of the appellant at Sr.No.16 has also been issued/circulated by the respondents.

(Copy of Final Seniority List is annexure "E").

5. That on 07.09.2021, the appellant was transferred from Civil Defence Office, District Peshawar and was adjusted as Civil Defence Officer (BPS-17) at District Charsadda in his own pay and scale.

(Copy of Transfer Notification dated 07.09.2021 showing the Appellant as CDO at Sr.No.5 is annexure "F").

6. That it is pertinent to mention here that 26 posts of Civil Defence Officers are laying vacant and on 07.03.2022, nine (09) posts of Civil Defence Officers (CDOs) have also been advertised by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission in 25% quota by initial appointment while posts in the 75% quota by promotion are still vacant.

(Copy of Advertisement is annexure "G").

7. That on 07.12.2021, the appellant also filed departmental appeal before the respondent No.1 (the Secretary, Relief Rehabilitation & Settlement Khyber Pakhtunkhwa), but of no avail. Hence after the lapse of statutory tenure of 90 days the instant appeal before this Hon'ble Tribunal, on the following amongst other grounds;

(Copy of Departmental Appeal is annexure "H").

GROUND S:

- A. The appellant has come to this Hon'ble Tribunal with clean hands.
- B. Despite of so many (26) vacant posts of Civil Defence Officers (CDOs) in the respondents department, the appellant has been deprived of his legitimate and fundamental right of promotion to the post of Civil Defence Officer (BPS-17).
- C. As stated in the above para No.6 on facts, that for the last two years, the appellant is performing his duties as Civil Defence Officer (OPS) wholeheartedly, committedly and to the entire satisfaction of his high-ups, but due to unknown reasons, the respondents for the last two years on one pretext or

another are not ready to hold the meeting of DPC (Departmental Promotion Committee) for considering the appellant for promotion to the above said post of Civil Defence Officer (CDO), which is no more than abuse of authority and against the principles of natural justice as well as the guidelines laid down in different dicta of this Hon'ble Tribunal and Superior Courts.

- D. As also stated in the above paras on facts (para 8) that on 07.03.2022, as per 25% quota by initial appointment, 09 posts of Civil Defence Officers (BPS-17) have been advertised by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission and if the appellant is not considered for promotion for which the appellant is already eligible/entitled, as soon as possible, the appellant's seniority will be affected and as a result the appellant will suffer an irreparable loss.
- E. Any other ground with the permission of this Hon'ble Tribunal, will be raised at the time of arguments.


It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the instant case, the respondents may kindly be directed to consider the appellant (being eligible) for promotion to the post of Civil Defence Officer (CDO) on regular basis with effect from the due date with all back benefits.

Any other relief deems fit and appropriate in the circumstances of the case may also be granted.
