**Para-wise comments on behalf of the respondent No.1, 2, 3 & 4.**

Respectfully Sheweth:

**PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:**

1. That the appellant has got no locus standi for filing this appeal.
2. That the appeal is liable to be dismissed on the ground of mis joinder or non joinder of parties.
3. The appeal is based on illegal and unlawful presumptions.
4. The appellant has got no cause of action to file the present appeal.
5. The appeal is not maintainable in its present form.
6. That the appeal is badly time barred.

**FACTS**

1. No Comments.
2. Correct.
3. Correct.
4. Incorrect. According to promotion policy provided in Esta Code, **the minimum** length of service for promotion to posts from BS-17 to BS-18 is 5 years (Annexure-A). It is also mentioned in the Notification No. SO(L&DD)AD—E-I(236)/2008 dated 08/07/2009 that after 5 years of service an officer becomes eligible to be promoted to higher scale, with due regard to seniority and fitness.(Annexure-B).
5. Incorrect. There are a number of pre requisite for promotion to the higher grade, the most important one is the seniority list of the officers in the present pay scale. Since the joint seniority list of the officers in BPS-17, including the appellant was challenged by some officers of the Department, therefore, in such circumstances the promotion case could not be processed till finalization and circulation of the seniority list. (Annexure-C).
6. As stated in Fact No. 05.
7. Incorrect. The seniority list of BPS-17 officers was duly circulated by respondents after an inquiry was conducted to resolve reservations shown by some of the officers of the Department through letter No. 18090-145 dated 30/12/2014. (Annexure-D).
8. As stated in Fact No.07.
9. Incorrect. Objections were raised by officers because the seniority list was available to them, therefore, the statement of the appellant that the seniority list was kept secret, is wrong. A committee was constituted to address the reservations of the officers regarding the seniority list, and the appellant was one of the committee members. In the findings and the subsequent report, nothing was find out regarding any violation in the seniority list. It means that the appellant is giving wrong statement to mislead this Honorable

Court and clearly shows 'malafide intensions' of the appellants towards respondents. (Enquiry report as Annexure-E).

10. Incorrect. It is evident from his own statement of the appellant that if the seniority list would have not circulated timely, then how would have Dr. Muhammad Zafar shown his reservations regarding his seniority position. (Annexure-F).
11. Correct to the extent that reservations were shown on some entries in the seniority list of BPS-17 officers, for which a committee was constituted, with the mandate to look into the seniority list and provide its recommendations. In the findings and the subsequent report, nothing was found out regarding any violation in the seniority list.
12. Pertains to the record.
13. Incorrect. All the officers in the Department have equal rights and their lawful grievances shall have to be addressed. Since reservations of some officers regarding the seniority list were received by the Department, therefore, these reservations have to be addressed first. The good intentions of the Department can be judged from the facts that the appellant himself was made a member of the committee for checking the seniority list. But the appellant is making false allegations and due to some personal interest is blaming the whole system.
14. Incorrect. All the mandatory documents must have to be completed before a promotion case is submitted to the Provincial Selection Board. It is pertinent to mention that the appellant was made member of the committee to prepare the promotion case, so that any delay could be avoided.
15. Incorrect. The reply is given in earlier paras.
16. Incorrect. Seniority list has never been disturbed.
17. Incorrect. Proper reply was provided to the appellant. (Annexure-G).
18. Correct.
19. Correct.
20. No Comments.

**Grounds**

- A. Incorrect. The respondents are bound to deal the appellant according to law and no violation of Article 4 of the constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973 has been made by the respondents.
- B. Incorrect. The promotion of the appellant has not been delayed but the notification of the correct and undisputed seniority list of the officers took long time due to complaints from various officers. Therefore, the seniority position of all officers remained same as they were entitled and no adverse effect found on the career of appellant as well as other officers.
- C. Incorrect. As stated in Fact No. 07.
- D. Incorrect. The respondents are bound to deal the appellant in accordance with law.
- E. Correct to the extent that the appellant submitted Departmental Appeal before the respondents which reply was submitted by the respondent Department.
- F. Pertains to court record.

G. Incorrect. The respondents have not omitted to deny the occurred right of appellant and has dealt the petitioner in accordance with law.

H. No comments.

The respondents seek permission to raise additional grounds at the time of arguments.

In view of the parawise comments it is respectfully prayed that by accepting the same, the instant appeal may kindly be dismissed in the best interest of public with cost.

### Promotion Policy

In order to consolidate the existing Promotion Policy, which is embodied in several circular letters issued in piecemeal from time to time, and to facilitate the line departments at every level in prompt processing of promotion cases of Provincial civil servants, it has been decided to issue the "North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants Promotion Policy, 2009" duly approved by the competent authority, for information and compliance by all concerned. This Policy will apply to promotions of all civil servants holding appointment on regular basis and will come into effect immediately. The Policy consists of the provisions given hereunder:-

#### I. Length of service.

(a) Minimum length of service for promotion to posts in various basic scales will be as under:

Basic Scale 18 :	5 years' service in BS-17
Basic Scale 19 :	12 years' service in BS-17 & above
Basic Scale 20 :	17 years' service in BS-17 & above

No proposal for promotion shall be entertained unless the condition of the prescribed length of service is fulfilled.

(b) Service in the lower pay scales for promotion to BP-18 shall be counted as follows:

- (i) Half of the service in BS-16 and one fourth in Basic Scales lower than 16, if any, shall be counted as service in Basic Scale 17.
- (ii) Where initial recruitment takes place in Basic Scale 18 and 19, the length of service prescribed for promotion to higher Basic Scales shall be reduced as indicated below:

Basic Scale 19 :	7 years' service in BS-18
Basic Scale 20 :	10 years' service in BS-18 and above. or 3 years' service in BS-19.

#### II. Linking of promotion with training:

(a) Successful completion of the following trainings is mandatory for promotions of officers of the Provincial Civil Service / Provincial Management Service to various Basic Scales:

- Mid-Career Management Course at National Institute of Management (NIM) for promotion to BS-19
- Senior Management Course at National Management College, Lahore for promotion to BS-20
- National Management Course at National Management College, Lahore for promotion to BS-21

(b) This condition will not be applicable to civil servants in specialized cadres such as Doctors, Teachers, Professors, Research Scientists and incumbents of purely



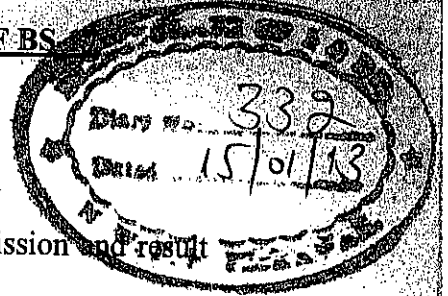



Human errors are always there, therefore the above mentioned seniority arrangement is open to queries/observations if any.



Therefore he relinquished the post of VO (Res) (Annex-32) and joined the post of VO(H) in L&DD Extension. As per inter-se list (annex-7) provided for the post of VO (H) by KP PSC, Dr. Ahmad Khan deserve a seniority position where he is now inserted at his proper position given above.

Similarly Dr. Noor Daraz was recommended by KP PSC both for the post VO (Res) in Research wing of L&DD as well as VO (H) in the extension wing of L&DD. He was first appointed as VO (Res) vide notification SO(L&DD)AD-E-1(324)/2003/VOL-II dated 17-05-2004 (Anex-33), who joined the same post on 30-06-2004 (Annex-34). Later on he was appointed as VO (H) vide Notification No SO(L&DD)AD-E-1(141)/2004/KC dated 31-07-2004 (Annex-9). Thereafter he relinquished the post of VO (Res) (Annex-35) and joined the post of VO (H). As per inter-se list (Annex-7) provided for the post of VO (H) by the KP PSC, Dr. Noor Daraz Khan deserves the right position where he is now inserted in the list above.

As per rules their appointment in the Research wing at earlier dates cannot conform upon them senior positions in the Extension wing. Either they have to be placed in the seniority list of L&DD Extension wing in light of inter-se merit list provided for the post of VO (H) by the KP PSC OR at the tail of Seniority list that was final at the time of their joining extension wing provided that they were properly transferred from Research wing and absorbed in Extension wing, which is not the case at all.

Human errors are always there, therefore the above motioned seniority arranged is open to queries/observations if any.

The two affectees were asked to justify their status at senior positions (Annex-36,37&38) as was earlier reflected in the seniority List. Dr. Ahmad Khan and Dr. Noor Daraz khan submitted their written replies (Annex-39 & 40) to the enquiry committee, however their replies could not satisfy the committee, in support of their claim at higher position in the seniority list.

The enquiry committee constituted Dr. Muhammad Iqbal Khattak, Principle Research Officer (Research Wing), at every step of enquiry proceedings, who whole heartedly guided and assisted the committee in investigation and compilation of these proceedings. The committee is highly indebted to his assistance and guidance.


As per rules their appointment in the Research wing at earlier dates cannot conform up on them senior positions in the Extension wing. Either they have to be placed in the seniority list of L&DD Extension wing in light of inter-se merit list provided for post of VO (H) by the KP PSC OR at the tail of Seniority list that was final at the time of their joining extension wing provided that they were properly transferred from Research wing and absorbed in Extension wing, which is not the case at all.


Human errors are always there, therefore, the above mentioned seniority arrangement is open to queries/observations if any.

The two affectees were asked to justify their status at senior positions (Annex-36, 37 & 38) as was earlier reflected in the seniority list. 

view that the appellant was entitled to a show-cause notice as envisaged under section 12(3) of the Civil Servants Act, this omission in our view is of a serious nature and is enough to vitiate the order of reversion of the appellant. This to our mind is a case which on the ground of a technical flaw, the department action which otherwise appears to have been taken on merits is rendered null and void.

22. In view of the above serious lapse on the part of the department the show-cause notice was not issued to the appellant before the punitive action of reversion, we are of the considered opinion that the appellant is entitled to relief. Therefore, we direct that the Notification reverting the appellant to the post of National Savings Officer be withdrawn and the appellant resorted to the post of Assistant Director with effect from the date of reversion. However, the department will be within its rights to proceed against the appellant by issuing show-cause notice under the provisions of section 12(3) of the Civil Servants Act, 1973 and also afford her an opportunity of personal hearing as per dicta laid down by the superior judicial fora. The payment of back-benefits would depend on the outcome of such proceedings, which should be completed within four months of issuance of this judgment.

TASSADUQ HUSSAIN JILLANI, J.---Through this petition, leave is sought against the judgment dated 31-1-2011 passed by the learned Punjab Service Tribunal vide which petitioner's appeal was dismissed with the observation that the Competent Authority in Services and General Administration Department should consider petitioner's case for promotion as he has remained in pay scale BS-17 for a period of 30 years.

2. Facts in brief are that petitioner while serving as Assistant Director/Regional Manager in BS-17 in the Directorate of Manpower and Training Punjab was given various assignments in BS-18 on current charge basis. However, since 31-5-1994 the current charge was not extended. The grievance being voiced in his appeal before the Service Tribunal was that he be granted pay for the higher post from the year 2001-2007, and that he should be considered for promotion with effect from the date when the post in the higher grade fell vacant.

3. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Law Officer at some length.

4. Though the petitioner was inducted into service in BS-17 in the Directorate of Manpower and Training Punjab through Punjab Public Service Commission (on 31-5-1980) but vide order dated 25-10-1992 he was promoted as Deputy Director in BS-18 on current charge basis for a period of six months. It is not denied that the said period was extended upto 31-5-1994. On the abolition of Employment Exchanges in Punjab in terms of notification dated 29-5-1994 he along with other officers was rendered surplus and in terms of the order dated 2-6-1994 passed by the Director Manpower and Training, Punjab he was directed to report to surplus pool of S&GAD. He continued to be treated, as Deputy Director in BS-18. However, on 17-8-1999 he was posted as Under Secretary in Local Government and Rural Development Department. However, on 19-3-2007 Additional Chief Secretary, Government of Punjab transferred him and posted him as Section Officer, Commerce and Investment Department and he was placed in BS-17 officer of the surplus pool of S&GAD Department. It is not denied that when he was promoted as Deputy Director in BS-18 on current charge basis he was eligible for promotion to the said scale and even vacancies were available. It is further not denied that he was continued to be treated as BS-18 officer

even as Under Secretary in Local Government and Rural Development Department which post he held till 17-8-1999. He was also granted move-over to BS-18 with effect from 1-12-1991 vide the order dated 1-5-1993 of the Secretary Labour and Manpower Department. The argument of learned Law Officer that his promotion as Deputy Director (BS-18) on current charge basis was a mis-description and as a matter of fact it was appointment, is an afterthought which is evident, firstly, from the fact that he retained the said scale till 19-3-2007 when he was posted as Grade-17 officer (Section Officer, Commerce and Investment Department) and secondly, he was granted move-over to BS-18 as far back as 1-5-1993 and that too with effect from 1-12-1991. It is also not denied that when he was promoted to BS-18 on current charge basis, vacancies in the said scale were available and petitioner was qualified. In Government of N.-W.F.P. v. Buner Khan (1985 SCMR 1158) in almost similar circumstances the appeal was allowed and it was directed that the officers shall be considered for promotion to Grade-18 post with effect from the dates when vacancies in their quota became available and thereafter a joint seniority list, was directed to be issued. Similarly in Islamic Republic of Pakistan v. Abdul Karim, Deputy Accountant General, N.-W.F.P. (1978 SCMR 289), this Court upheld the judgment of the Service Tribunal which had directed that the employee promoted to officiate in a higher post involving higher responsibility was entitled to minimum pay of grade of higher post. In Abu Saeed v. Government of N.-W.F.P. (1990 SCMR 1623), leave was granted to consider two issues, which are as under:--

"(i) Whether the promotion of the respondents could be ante-dated to the vacancy occurring in Grade-18 and reserved for promotion?"

(ii) Whether reversion of the appellants from Grade-19 to Grade-18 was not in violation of the principles of the natural justice and against the decision already rendered by the Tribunal in service appeals inter partes?"

5. The Court while upholding the judgment of the Service Tribunal held as follows:--

"6. As regards the legal question whether the promotees could be considered and appointed on a promotion post not from the date of their selection or appointment or taking over of the appointment; but from the date when the vacancies occurred, the decision of the Supreme Court rendered inter partes is final and binding. There is no going back or questioning that decision. Hence the appellants cannot dispute the proposition. The only question that could be agitated is that the promotees

were not eligible when the vacancies occurred and on being considered for promotion they could not be declared eligible for promotion. That, however, is not their case. The eligibility of the promotees for promotion on the date when the vacancies occurred for promotion quota has not been challenged upto now at any stage."

6. For what has been discussed above, this petition is converted into appeal and partly allowed and it is directed that the petitioner shall be considered for promotion to Grade-18 post with effect from the date when the vacancy occurred provided he was qualified to be considered for the same.

The above mentioned seniority position affects Dr. Ahmad Khan and Dr. Noor Daraz Khan, lowering Dr. Ahmad Khan from seniority position 22 to 39 and Dr. Noor Daraz Khan from 23 to 59. In fact Dr Ahmad Khan was appointed as Veterinary Officer (Research) in Research wing of L&DD vide Notification SO(L&DD)AD-E-1(324)/2003/VOL-II dated 8.5.2003 (Annex-29) and, he accordingly joined that post (Annex-30). Later on he applied through proper channel for the post of Veterinary Officer (Annex-31) advertised by the KP Public Service commission wherein he was selected and appointed vide notification No SO(L&DD)AD-E-1(141)/2004/KC dated 17.7.2004 (Annex-8). Therefore he relinquished the post of VO (Res) (Annex-32) and joined the post VO (H) in L&DD Extension. As per inter-se list (annex-7) provided for the post of VO (H) by KP PSC, Dr. Ahmad Khan deserves a seniority position where he is now inserted at his proper position given above.

Similarly Dr. Noor Daraz was recommended by KP PSC both for the post VO (Res) in Research wing of L&DD as well as VO (H) in the Extension wing of L&DD. He was first appointed as VO (Res) vide notification

SO(L&DD)AD-E-1(324)/2003/VOL-II dated 17.5.2004 (Annex-33), who joined the same post on 30.6.2004 (Annex-34). Later on he was appointed as VO (H) vide notification No SO(L&DD)AD-E-1(141)/2004/KC dated 31.7.2004 (Annex-9). Thereafter he relinquished the post of VO (Res) (Annex-35) and joined the post of VO (H). As per inter-se list (Annex-7) provided for the post of VO (H) by the KP PSC, Dr Noor Daraz Khan deserves the right position where he is now inserted in the list above.


As per rules their appointment in the Research wing at earlier dates cannot conform up on them senior positions in the Extension wing. Either they have to be placed in the seniority list of L&DD Extension wing in light of inter-se merit list provided for post of VO (H) by the KP PSC OR at the tail of Seniority list that was final at the time of their joining extension wing provided that they were properly transferred from Research wing and absorbed in Extension wing, which is not the case at all.


Human errors are always there, therefore, the above mentioned seniority arrangement is open to queries/observations if any.

The two affectees were asked to justify their status at senior positions (Annex-36, 37 & 38) as was earlier reflected in the seniority list. Dr. Ahmad Khan and Dr. Noor Daraz Khan submitted their written replies (Annex-39 & 40) to the enquiry committee; however their replies could not satisfy the committee in support of their claim at higher position in the seniority list.



The appellant (Ex-PTC Teacher) has filed the present appeal u/s 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 against the order dated 31.01.2014 whereby the services of the appellant were terminated due to his long absence from duty.</li> <li>3. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant</li> </ol>

performed his duties on the PTC post till 22.02.2013 and applied for two (02) years earned leave however respondent No.4 instead of sanctioning the leave, issued the termination order of the appellant. Further argued that the appellant received impugned order on 20.05.2014 and thereafter preferred departmental appeal on 18.06.2014. Further argued that the departmental appeal of the appellant was not responded resultantly the appellant filed Writ Petition No.81-P/2015 before the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court Peshawar and vide judgment/order dated 13.03.2015, the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court Peshawar directed the respondent No.2 to proceed with the case of the appellant and decide the same in accordance with law. Further argued that respondent No.2 did not pay heed to the directions of Hon'ble Peshawar High Court Peshawar. Further argued that the impugned order was issued without fulfillment of legal formalities. Learned counsel for the appellant vehemently stressed for setting aside the impugned order and reinstatement of the appellant in service. Learned counsel for the appellant referred to the judgments reported in 2002 PLC (C.S) page 268, 2003 SCMR page 1110, 2008 SCMR page 1369, 2009 SCMR page 339, 2013 SCMR page 881 and 2006 PLC (C.S) page 74.

4. As against that learned Additional Advocate General contended that no departmental appeal was filed by the appellant against the impugned order hence the present service appeal is not maintainable and that the same is also time barred. Further argued

that the appellant remained willfully absent from duty for a sufficient period without any permission. Further argued that the impugned order was issued in accordance with law and needs no interference.

5. Arguments heard. File perused.

6. Appellant has not performed duties for a considerable period without sanction of leave by the competent authority.

7. It may also be mentioned that the appellant approached the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court Peshawar by filing Writ Petition with the following prayer that:

*"Therefore, it is requested that on acceptance of this Writ Petition, please consider the present petition as departmental appeal, send the same to the respondent No.2 with the direction to decide the same within stipulated reasonable time".*

8. Perusal of the judgment/order dated 13.03.2015 of the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court Peshawar passed in Writ Petition No.81-P/2015, filed by the appellant, would show that upon the statement of the learned counsel for the appellant at the bar that he would be satisfied if the respondents are directed to decide the appeal/representation pending before them in accordance with law, the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court Peshawar directed the respondent No.2 to look into the matter of the appellant and decide the same in accordance with law expeditiously.

9. The respondents No.2 & 3 in their joint written reply expressed in unequivocal terms that no departmental appeal was

submitted by the appellant.

10. Plea taken by the appellant is that he preferred departmental appeal on 08.06.2014 which was not responded. Be that as it may be, the appellant has allegedly preferred undecided departmental appeal on 18.06.2014 but he filed the present service appeal on 06.07.2015 i.e. after more than one (01) year of filing the alleged departmental appeal hence in this backdrop the present service appeal of the appellant is hopelessly time barred.

11. It is settled principle of law that Article-14 of The Limitation Act 1908 is not applicable to the appeals and litigation before another forum cannot extend the period of limitation for filing appeal before Service Tribunal. In this regard the judgment of the august Supreme Court of Pakistan in case titled Khushi Muhammad through L.Rs. and others---Appellants Versus Mst. Fazal Bibi and others---Respondents (PLD 2016 Supreme Court 872) may be quoted as a reference. Judgments referred to by the learned counsel for the appellant are not found applicable to the facts and circumstances of the present service appeal.

12. In view of above, the present service appeal is dismissed being barred by limitation. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.
