

The appellant was initially appointed as instructor (Electrical) (BPS-17). He was appointed on acting charge basis as Assistant Professor on the recommendation of the PSB and transfer to Govt. College Technology Timergara against the vacant post on 24.10.2013. On 04.03.2015 he was posted as acting Assistant Professor in Polytechnic Institute Batkhela against the vacant post. Vide impugned order dated 25.01.2018, he was transferred to Govt. College of Technology, Swat on his regular promotion as Assistant Professor. Feeling aggrieved on his transfer from his home station to Govt. Polytechnic Institute Swat he filed departmental appeal on 08.02.2018</p> |

which was rejected on 08.03.2018, hence he filed the instant service appeal on 04.04.2018.

3. The learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant has not been treated in accordance with the law, in violation of the wedlock policy posted out without considering his performance and violating the principle of judicious exercise of the administrative powers as provided in the constitution and the laws made there under. He further argued that the respondent ignored the letter of the principal of Govt. Polytechnic Institute Batkhela dated 07.12.2017 wherein the retention of the appellant in Batkhela was requested in the public interest hence the appeal may be accepted and the order dated 25.01.2018 may please be set-aside and allowing the appellant to continue his duty in the Govt. Polytechnic Institute Batkhela.

4. The learned District Attorney contested the facts, grounds of the appeal and arguments of the learned counsel for the appellant and stated that on his regular promotion to the post of Assistant Professor the appellant was posted in GCT Swat, against the vacant post available at the nearest station to his residence which is Batkhela. His departmental appeal was placed before the HR committee which considered the appeal and decided that no other post is available for the adjustment of the appellant and in case he insists to be retained GCT Batkhela then the only option available is that he should be asked to forgo his promotion. This decision of the HR committee was intimated to the appellant. He further stated that posting transfer is an ordinary measure which is being regulated by the Posting Transfer Policy which is issued by the government in exercise of the power covered under the Civil Servant Act and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Appointment, Promotion Transfer) Rules

1989. He further argued that as the appeal does not carry any merits hence the same may be dismissed with costs.

5. Arguments heard. File Perused.

6. The Tribunal examined the record on file, arguments and counter arguments of both the parties and observed that the appellant has based his case on the wedlock policy and provision of Posting Transfer Policy.

The respondent department has submitted that posting of the appellant was required after his promotion from BPS-17 to BPS-18 on regular basis for the purpose of actualization of his promotion against the vacant position in his specialty at a station nearer to the placed of his residence.


The respondent department also stated that while considering of his departmental appeal the appellant was given option of foregoing his promotion in case the appellant intends to be not disturbed from his posting in area of his residence on the ground that no vacant post is available in BPS-18 in his specialty in GCT Batkhela.

7. In view of the above discussion the Tribunal reaches to the conclusion that the respondent posted the appellant in GCT Swat in view of his regular promotion hence the order dated 25.01.2018 is not in violation of any of statutory rights hence the appeal is dismissed. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.



On acceptance of this appeal the order dated 25.01.2018, may please be set-aside and the appellant be allowed to continue his duties Govt; Polytechnic Institute, Batkhela

Respectfully Submitted:

1. That Appellant was initially appointed by the recommendations of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public service commission as Instructor (Electrical) (BPS-17) in the department, Ever since my appointment, the Appellant had performed my duties as assigned with zeal and devotion and there was no complaint whatsoever regarding my performance.

2. That the appellant while serving the department in the capacity of instructor BPS 17, on the recommendation of Provincial Selection Board promote the petitioner the post of Assistant professor (Electrical) BPS 18 and posted / transferred to Govt; Collage Technology, Timergra on acting charge basis against the vacant post vide order dated 24.10.2013. (Copy of the order dated 24.10.2013 is attached as annexure A)
3. That the respondent department again vide notification dated 04.03.2015 issued the posting / transfer order of the appellant from the Govt Collage of Technology, Tirmergra to Govt; Polytechnic Institute Batkhela against the vacant post of assistant of Professor BPS 18 with Immediate effect. (Copy of the order dated 04.03.2015 is attached as annexure B)
4. That the principal of Govt; Polytechnic Institute Batkhela Malakand address a letter to the Managing director Khyber Pakhtunkhwa TEVTA vide letter dated 07.12.2017 regarding the present appellant and one of his colleague as they are working HOD civil and HOD electrical in this institute as a regular employee of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa TEVTA in civil technology, and performing their duties very well, and requested not to transfer from the college in the best interest of student and peaceful teaching/learning process. (copy of latter dated 07.12.2017 is attached as annexure C)
5. That the appellant in the 2010 get married to one lady namely Safia bibi D/o Jehandar Badshah, who was appointed on the recommendation of Public Service Commission on 27.05.2010 at Julgram, Batkhela as Female Lecturer and also local resident of Batkhel.(Copy of Appointment order, Marriage certificate and CNIC are annexure D,E & F) .
6. That according to the Posting / transfer policy of the provincial govt firstly all the posting transfer shall be strictly in public interest and shall not be abused / misused to victimize the govt servant, in case of present appellant the order of Posting/ transfer was not issued in the mod and manner of the posting transfer policy as the wife of present appellant serving as female lecturer in Batkhela Malakand and also local resident of the said locality, more so the posting transfer policy support i.e both the husband and wife

serving in provincial services, affects were possible would be made to post such persons i.e civil servants at one station. (Copy of the posting/ transfer policy is attached as annexure G)

7. That while serving in the said capacity, the Appellant was Posted at Govt; College of Technology, Swat as Instructor (Electrical)(BPS-17) under same order of appointment. (Copy of the order is attached as annexure H)
8. That the Appellant while performing his duties with zeal and devotion and there was no complaint whatsoever regarding the performance and upon the political approach/ interference and also against the wedlock policy, the Appellant was again prematurely transferred vide order dated 25.01.2018, the Appellant has hardly served, the order impugned is illegal and against the law. (Copy of the order dated 25.01.2018 is attached as annexure I)
9. That the appellant filed departmental appeal on 08.02.2018 against the posting / transfer order dated 25.01.2018, which was duly forwarded to the office of Managing director Khyber Pakhtunkhwa TEVETA.(Copy of the Departmental Appeal dated 08.02.2018 is attached as annexure J)
10. That the respondents vide order dated 08.03.2018 dismissed the Departmental appeal of the appellant on the ground that if he is willing to forgo his promotion then he can be posted back to Govt Polytechnic Institute Batkhela. (Copy of the order dated 08.03.2018 is attached as annexure K)
11. That the transferred order is illegal unlawful against law and facts hence liable to be set aside inter alia on the following grounds :

GROUND OF DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL .

- A. That the Appellant have not been treated in accordance with law hence my rights secured and guaranteed under the law are badly violated.
- B. That according to the Posting / transfer policy of the provincial govt firstly all the posting transfer shall be strictly in public interest and shall not be abused / misused to

order of Posting/ transfer was not issued in the mod and manner of the posting transfer policy as the wife of present appellant serving as female lecturer in Batkhela Malakand and also local resident of the said locality, more so the posting transfer policy support i.e both the husband and wife serving in provincial services, affects were possible would be made to post such persons i.e civil servants at one station.

- C. That the Appellant while performing his duties with zeal and devotion and there was no complaint whatsoever regarding my performance, was prematurely transferred Govt; College of technology Timergara vide order dated January 2010, Then again Transferred in October 2011 to Govt; Poly Technic Institute Batkhela, then again transferred to Govt College of Technology Timergara vide order dated .6.11.2013 and again very shortly to Poly Technic Institute Batkhela vide order dated March 2015, and lastly through impugned order dated 25.01.2018 to Govt college of Technology Swat, the undersigned has hardly served in each institute/college, and has not completed my normal tenure, the order impugned is illegal and against the law laid down by the apex court, in its case reported in PLD 1995 Supreme Court Page No. 530.
- D. That on 27.10.2010 I duly married to Safia bibi who was appointed as Lecturer in Govt, Girls College Julagram Batkhela, recently promoted to the post Assistant Professor (BPS-18) and again posted at the same college.
- E. That under the Wedlock policy of posting and transfer was intended to ensure to the benefit of a family, it advanced social good and unless there were insurmountable hurdles, in its Case reported in 2004 PLC (CS) 622, 2003 PLC (CS) 1322, 1994 PLC(CS)1644, 1991PLC(CS)478.
- F. That the transfer order is illegal and unlawful, moreover the same is in violation of posting and transfer policy (Wedlock Policy) of the Provincial Govt.
- G. That the transfer order is illegal and unlawful, politically motivate, moreover the same is in violation of posting and transfer policy of the Provincial Govt.


- H. That the principal of Govt; Polytechnic Institute Batkhela Malakand address a letter to the Managing director Khyber Pakhtunkhwa TEVTA vide letter dated 07.12.2017 regarding the present appellant and one of his colleague as they are working HOD civil and HOD electrical in this institute as a regular employee of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa TEVTA in civil technology, and performing their duties very well, and requested not to transfer from the college in the best interest of student and peaceful teaching/learning process.
- I. That there was no complaint whatsoever against the appellant, and quite wrongly the transfer order was given the colour of public interest and on complaint.
- J. That the impugned transfer order is illegal, unlawful, without lawful authority and passed without jurisdiction, not in the prescribed period, in violation of transfer and posting policy.
- K. That during the posting of the Undersigned at Poly Technic Institute Batkhela his performance remained commendable and there was no complaint whatsoever regarding my performance.
- L. That in fact there exist no exigencies of service nor the order of transfer can be termed as in the public interest, rather it was issued in violation of law and transfer / posting policy of the Provincial Govt.
- M. That the transfer order of the appellant is in outcome of political pressure which smacked malafide and such order issued on the recommendation of the political Minister respectively show that the impugned order is the outcome of political pressure. The issue was held in 2012 PLC (CS) 648.
- N. That the impugned transfer order is illegal, unlawful, politically motivated without lawful authority and passed without jurisdiction, not in the prescribed period, in violation of transfer and posting policy.
- O. That the transfer order issued without caring for law, had in a quick succession issued a number of orders against the public interest or exigency of service.

P. That the Undersigned seeks the permission to the rely on additional ground at the hearing of this appeal.

It is, therefore, very humbly prayed that On acceptance of this appeal the order dated 25.01.2018, may please be set-aside and the appelliant be allowed to continue his duties *Govt; Polytechnic Institute, Batkhela*

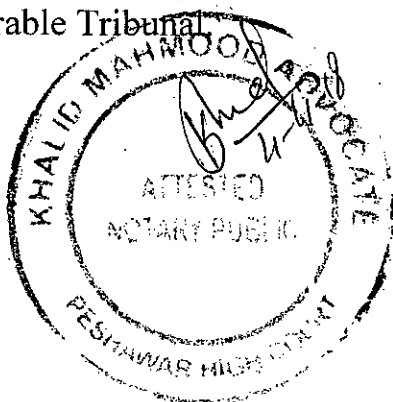

Instances have come to the notice of Governor's Secretariat NWFP, where policy on posting/transfer to and from FATA is not being followed in letter and spirit. The Governor, NWFP has taken serious notice of the violation of the said policy and directed that all Departments must obtain his prior approval before issuing all such posting/transfer orders.

Inter Provincial Transfer

SI.No.6

Attention is invited to Rule-8 of the NWFP, Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989 where under Inter-Provincial Transfers of employees in BPS 1 to 15 and 16 and above are permissible subject to the fulfilment of conditions laid down in the aforesaid rule. However, in most of the cases, the requests for Inter-Provincial Transfers are not strictly scrutinized in the light of the aforesaid rules which creates not only embarrassment for the S&GAD but also causes delays in finalizing of such cases.

2. While examining cases, it has been noticed that inter-provincial transfer results in an over all increase of officials in the NWFP, which is against the downsizing policy of the Government. The un-employment situation in NWFP is more acute than in any other province. Large scale transfers of officials from other provinces would also deprive the people of NWFP from employment in other Provinces. It may, therefore, be necessary to restrict the inter-provincial transfers to very exceptional cases where a strong humanitarian ground exists or where technical expertise, which is not available in the province, is required.

3. It is requested that the provisions of Rule-8 of the NWFP, Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989 may be observed strictly while recommending cases of inter-provincial transfers, with full justification for consideration of the competent authority.

 - (iv) No officer shall be allowed to be posted in his own District of domicile.
 - (v) No postings/transfers of the officers/officials on detrainment basis shall be made.
 - (vi) About the posting of husband/wife, both in Provincial Services, at one station, the overriding consideration will be the administrative position. It may be desirable to post such persons at one station and this will be subject to the public interest.

2. It is requested that the above policy may please be implemented in letter and spirit.

(vi) About the posting of husband/wife, both in Provincial Services, at one station, the overriding consideration will be the administrative position. It may be desirable to post such persons at one station and this will be subject to the public interest.

(vii) Officers/officials who are due to retire within two years may be posted on their option, on non-executive/non-administrative posts in the Districts of their domicile and be allowed to serve there till their retirement.

2. As already notified, all postings/transfers of officers/officials will be done on the recommendations of the placement scrutiny committees at the Provincial, Departmental and Divisional level, while keeping in mind the following:-

(i) Recommendations should be based on Annual Confidential Reports, past and present record of service, performance on post held presently and in the past and his general reputation with focus on integrity;

(ii) Tenure on present post should also be taken into consideration.

The following policy of the Federal Government with regard to the posting of husband and wife at one station of duty, has been adopted by the Provincial Government of NWFP in respect of its employees working in Government Departments, Autonomous and Semi-Autonomous Bodies in the NWFP:-

(i) Where a request is made for posting at a different station in the same department/service/cadre in which an employee is already serving, the request may be accepted subject to availability of a post in the same BPS.

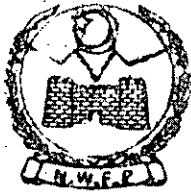
(ii) If a request involves temporary deputation to another department, it may be processed in consultation with the concerned department, and may be accepted on the prescribed terms of deputation subject to availability of a post in the same BPS.

(iii) When a request is made for permanent transfer to/absorption in another department/agency, the request may be processed in consultation with the department concerned, subject to the condition that in the event of permanent transfer, seniority shall be determined in accordance with Section-8 of the NWFP Civil Servants Act, 1973 read with Rule-17 of the NWFP Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989.

(iv) If there is a tie between two or more Government servants for posting at the same station in the same department/unit of an organization, the Government servant with greater length of service may be preferred.





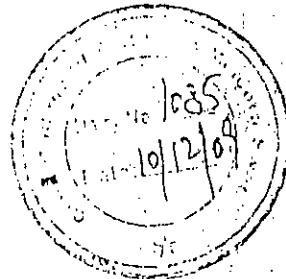

The appellant very humbly submit the following few lines for your kind and sympathetic consideration:

1. That I was initially appointed by the recommendations of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public service commission as Instructor (Electrical) (BPS-17) in the department, Ever since my appointment, I had performed my duties as assigned with zeal and devotion and there was no complaint whatsoever regarding my performance.
2. That while serving in the said capacity, I was Posted at Govt; College of Technology, Swat as Instructor (Electrical)(BPS-17) under same order of my appointment. (Copy of the order is attached)
3. That the undersigned while performing his duties with zeal and devotion and there was no complaint whatsoever regarding my performance and upon the political approach/ interference and also against the wedlock policy, I was again prematurely transferred vide order dated 25.01.2018, the undersigned has hardly served, the order impugned is illegal and against the law.

ATTESTED

4. That the transferred order is illegal unlawful against law and facts hence liable to be set aside inter alia on the following grounds :

GROUND OF DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL .

- A. That I have not been treated in accordance with law hence my rights secured and guaranteed under the law are badly violated.
- B. That the undersigned while performing his duties with zeal and devotion and there was no complaint whatsoever regarding my performance, was prematurely transferred Govt; College of technology Timergara vide order dated January 2010, Then again Transferred in October 2011 to Govt; Poly Technic Institute Batkhela, then again transferred to Govt College of Technology Timergara vide order dard .6.11.2013 and again very shortly to Poly Technic Institute Batkhela vide order dated March 2015, and lastly through impugned order dated 25.01.2018 to Govt college of Technology Swat, the undersigned has hardly served in each institute/college, and has not completed my normal tenure, the order impugned is illegal and against the law laid down by the apex court, in its case reported in PLD 1995 Supreme Court Page No. 530.
- C. That on 27.10.2010 I duly married to Safia bibi who was appointed as Lecturer in Govt; Girls College Julagram Batkhela, recently promoted to the post Assistant Professor (BPS-18) and again posted at the same college.(copy of appointment, promotion and Marriage Certificate order are attached).
- D. That under the Wedlock policy of posting and transfer was intended to ensure to the benefit of a family, it advanced social good and unless there were insurmountable hurdles, in its Case reported in 2004 PLC(CS)622,2003 PLC(CS)1322:1994 PLC(CS)1644:1991PLC(CS)478.
- E. That the transfer order is illegal and unlawful, moreover the same is in violation of posting and transfer policy (Wedlock Policy) of the Provincial Govt.
- F. That during the posting of the Undersigned at Poly Technic Institute Batkhela his performance remained commendable and there was no complaint whatsoever regarding my performance.

ATTENTION

- G. That in fact there exist no exigencies of service nor the order of transfer can be termed as in the public interest, rather it was issued in violation of law and transfer / posting policy of the Provincial Govt.
- H. That the transfer order of the appellant is in outcome of political pressure which smacked malafide and such order issued on the recommendation of the political Minister respectively show that the impugned order is the outcome of political pressure. The issue was held in 2012 PLC (CS) 648.
- I. That the impugned transfer order is illegal, unlawful, politically motivated without lawful authority and passed without jurisdiction, not in the prescribed period, in violation of transfer and posting policy.
- J. That the transfer order issued without caring for law, had in a quick succession issued a number of orders against the public interest or exigency of service.

Polytechnic Institute, Batkhela, District Malakand.

9. **Correct to the extent** that Appellant's appeal was placed before the HR Committee of K.P-TEVTA. However, appellant as well as Muhammad Altaf who has been retained at GPI BATKHELA against the post of BPS-18 (vacated as a result of appellant's transfer to GCT SWAT) are both degree holders in Electrical Technology. Resultantly, both the appellant and the officer Muhammad Altaf have the same seniority list, and both are entitled to get the same benefits and compensation from KP-TEVTA.

11. **Contents false and misconceived.** Respondents have favoured Muhammad Altaf vide impugned order dated, 25-01-2017, as Muhammad Altaf has been serving at GPI BATKHELA since October 2010 and has not been transferred despite his regular promotion to the post of Assistant Professor BPS-18. Moreover, the appellant had

requested the department for his transfer to GPI BATKHELA against the vacant post of BPS-18 under wedlock policy in 2015. Despite all this, appellant requested Respondent No.2 vide letter dated 18.05.2018 and 15.09.2018, to appoint him against the vacant post at GTVC Chakdara, Dir Lower but that too felt on deaf ears and Respondent No.2 instead appointed one Mr. Israr, even though he is not even a graduate degree holder. This depicts the discriminative behaviour of Respondents towards appellant.



WRITTEN ARGUMENTS ALONG WITH BRIEF SERVICE
HISTORY ON BEHALF OF THE APPELLANT :

This appeal is pendente lite in this honorable Tribunal and is fixed for today i-e 06.05.2019 for arguments. The detailed service history of the appellant and arguments on behalf thereof are lodged forth below in seriatim:

1. That the appellant was initially appointed on 28.05.2009 in the capacity of instructor BPS-17, at Govt. College of Technology Swat.
2. **On 27.10.2010, the appellant got married with Mst. Safia (the appellant's wife). At the time of marriage, she was serving as lecturer in Govt. Girls College Julagram since her appointment on 27.05.2010.**

(Annexure D Page No. 12)(Copy of appointment order, marriage certificate and CNIC as annexure D, E and F)

3. The appellant was promoted on acting charge basis to the post of Assistant Professor on 24.10.2013 and was thereupon transferred to Govt. College of Technology Themergara .
4. Thereafter, the appellant was transferred to Govt. Polytechnic Institute, Batkhela against the same post vacant over there Annexure B dated 04.03.2015.
5. On 25.01.2018 the appellant on regularization in BPS-18, was again transferred to Govt. College of Technology Swat. (Annexure J dated 25.01.2018) **in sheer violation of wedlock policy as contained in Para No. VI of Posting/ Transfer rules (Annexure K).** Thus, the appellant served, out of home station for the previous one and half years (Approximately) at Govt College of Technology Swat.
6. Under SI.No. 9 of the wedlock policy adopted by the Govt of KPK Annexure G Page No. 16 which lays down the policy, generally known as the wedlock policy, so as

to ensure service of the spouses at the nearest station and to facilitate the upbringing of children and smooth running of family matters. The instant appeal by the appellant is covered by the afore quoted policy as and calls for the justified transfer of the appellant to the home station/ nearest station which, in my case happen either to be Govt. Polytechnic Institute Batkhela or GTVC (Boys) at Chakdara.

7. The constitution of Pakistan 1973 under article 35 guarantees **“the protection of the marriage, the family, the mother and the child”**. Since the children of the appellant are in a shaping period wherein thorough parental supervision of the parents and more particularly that of father, is intensely needed, so posting of father outside home station, entails unpredictable ruination for the future of children, hence this appeal to this august Tribunal, for transfer of appellant to home/ nearest station of service i.e Govt Polytechnic Institute Batkhela or GTVC (Boys) at Chakdara.

8. The Promotion Notification ^{1-1/2017} (SON/IND) dated, 25.01.2018,

is a self speaking undeniable proof of the callous & indifferent attitude, based on utter mala fide, towards my supplication for being transferred to my home

station/ nearest home station. In the afore-mentioned Notification, the promotees at S.No. 03 & 21 were allowed to serve at GPI Batkhela while I, the Appellant, who figures at S.No.10 was transferred to GCT Swat, although, our qualification was the same (as B.Tech has been declared equivalent to B.Sc. Engineering). This Notification solely suffices to expose the departmental disregard towards the compassionate Wedlock Policy.


PRAYER:
