R/SHEWETH: ON FACTS:

- 1- That appellant is the employee of the respondent Department and is serving as Assistant Professor (Physics) at GPGC Nowshera quite efficiently and up to the entire satisfaction of his superiors.

- 3- That during service the appellant was transferred from GPGC Nowshera to GDC Kaki, Buner vide Notification dated 15.05.2018 communicated to the appellant on 22.6.2018 on administrative ground inspite of the fact that the appellant had never absented himself from duty nor he was involved in any misconduct. Copy of the impugned Notification dated 15.05.2018 is attached as annexure.

- **6** That after receiving attested copy of the judgment dated 16.08.2018 the appellant submitted the same before the appellate authority but inspite of clear directions of the Honorable Peshawar High Court Peshawar the appellate authority was using delaying tactics and has failed to decided the Departmental appeal of the appellant within the statutory period. POSTING / TRANSFER POLICY OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT.


- All the posting/transfers shall be strictly in public interest and shall not be abused/misused to victimize the Government servants
 - All Government servants are prohibited to exert political, Administrative or any other pressures upon the posting/transfer authorities for seeking posing/transfers of their choice and against the public interest.
 - iii) All contract Government employees appointed against specific posts, can not be
- The normal tenure of posting shall be three years subject to the condition that for the officers/officials posted in unattractive areas the tenure shall be two years and for the hard areas the tenure shall be one year. The unattractive and hard areas will be notified by the Government.
- vi) While making postings/transfer from settled areas to FATA and vice-versa, specific approval of Governor, NWFP needs to be obtained
 - ²While making postings/transfers of officers/officials up to BS-17, from settled areas to FATA and vice-versa approval of the Chief Secretary NWFP needs to be obtained. Whereas, in case of posting/transfer of officers in BS-18 and above, from settled areas to FATA and vice versa, specific approval of the Governor NWFP shall be obtained.
- vi (a) All Officers/officials selected against Zone-I/FATA quota in Services should compulsorily serve in FATA for atleast eighteen months in each scale/grade of each cadre.
- Officers may be posted on executive/administrative posts in the Districts of their domicile except District Coordination Officers (D.C.Os) and DPOs/Superintendent of Police (SP). Similarly Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) shall not be posted at a viii)

- viii) No posting/transfers of the officer's/officials on detailment basis shall be made.
- Regarding the posting of husband/wife, both in Provincial services, possible would be made to post such persons at one station subject to the public
- All the posting/transferring authorities may facilitate the posting/transfer of the unmarried female government Servants at the station of the residence of their parents.



- xiii) While considering posting/transfer proposals all the concerned authorities shall keep in mind the following:
- To ensure the posting of proper persons on proper posts, the Performance Evaluation Report/annual confidential reports, past and present record of service, performance on post held presently and in the past and general considered.
 - b) Tenure on present post shall also be taken into consideration and the posting transfers shall be in the best public interest.

Government servants including District Govt. employees feeling aggrieved due to the orders of posting/transfer authorities may seek remedy from the next higher authority / the appointing authority as the case may be through an appeal to be submitted within seven days of the receipt of such orders. Such appeal shall be disposed of within fifteen days. The option of appeal against posting/ transfer orders could be exercised only in the following cases.

- i) Pre-mature posing/transfer or posting transfer in violation of the provisions of this policy.
- ii) Serious and grave personal (humanitarian) grounds.
- 2. To streamline the postings/transfers in the District Government and to remove any irritant/confusions in this regard the provision of Rule 25 of the North West Frontier Province District Government Rules of Business 2001 read with schedule IV thereof is referred. As per schedule-IV the posting/transferring authorities for the officers/officials shown against each are as under:-

S. No.	Officers	Authority
1.	Posting of District Coordination Officer and Executive District Officer in a District.	Provincial Government.
2.	Posting of District Police Officer.	Provincial Government
3.	Other Officers in BPS-17 and above posted in the District.	Provincial Government
4.	Official in BPS-16 and below	Executive District Officer in consultation with District Coordination Officer.

- 3. As per Rule 25(2) of the Rules mentioned above the District Coordination Department shall consult the Government if it is proposed to:
 - a) Transfer the holder of a tenure post before the completion of his tenure or extend the period of his tenure.
 - b) Require an officer to hold charge of more than one post for a period exceeding two months.
- 4. I am further directed to request that the above noted policy may be strictly observed /implemented.

All concerned are requested to ensure that tenures of the concerned officers/officials are invariably mentioned in summaries submitted to the Competent Authorities for Posting/Transfer.
