

Against the impugned order the appellant filed departmental appeal which was rejected/filed by the competent authority vide impugned order dated 23.01.2014, hence the present appeal on 06.02.2014.

- 2) That the appellant was promoted as Kanongo (BPS-09) by a competent DPC vide order dated. 10.8.2009. Copy of the order is attached as Annexure – B.
- 3) That the appellant along with two other colleagues were promoted as DK (BPS-14) by the competent DPC vide order dated. 2.7.2013 and since then the appellant has been performing his duties as DRA in Buner till date. Copies of order and duty certificate are attached as Annexure – C&D.
- 4) That at the back of appellant, without any prior notice or information to appellant, the respondent No.2 first held in abeyance the promotion order on 10.7.2013 and then withdrew the promotion order of appellant on 11.7.2013 without any notice to appellant. Copies of the orders are attached as Annexure – E&F.
- 5) That as the appellant came to know about the held in abeyance and withdrawal orders, he forth with applied for provision of the said orders on 13.1.2014 and the same were provided to appellant on his application. Copy of the application is attached as Annexure – G.
- 6) That after obtaining the copies of the orders, the appellant submitted departmental appeal on 15.1.2014 but the same has been filed/rejected for no good grounds on 23.1.2014. Hence the present appeal on the following grounds amongst the others. Copies of appeal and rejection order are attached as Annexure – H&I.

GROUND:


- A) That the order dated. 23.1.2014 as well as orders dated. 10.7.2013 & 11.7.2013, are against the law, facts, norms of justice and material on record, therefore, not tenable and liable to be set-aside.

- B) That the appellant has been condemned unheard as no prior chance of hearing or defence, has been provided to appellant. Thus the principles of Audi Alteram Partem are violated due to which the all impugned orders are nullity in the eyes of law.
- C) That the orders have been passed after the proper recommendations of the competent DPC, therefore, the respondent no.2 was having no legal authority to hold in abeyance or withdraw the promotion order, especially when the order was notified on 2.7.2013.
- D) That the order dated. 2.7.2013 has been acted upon and the appellant is still performing his duty as DRA Buner till date. Thus valuable rights have been created in favour of appellant and the same can not be taken back under the principles of LOCUS POENTENTIAE.
- E) That after the promotion order passed on 2.7.2013, the respondent no.2 became FUNCTUS OFFICIO, thus the orders dated. 10.7.2013 & 11.7.2013 are not sustainable and liable to be set-aside.
- F) That the appellant has not been treated according to law and rules and has been condemned unheard through out.
- G) That there is no stay order of any for a against the promotion order of appellant which could be based to hold in abeyance or withdraw the promotion order of appellant. Thus the respondent no.2 has acted in an arbitrary manner.
- H) That even the final rejection order is a non-speaking order, containing no reasons which is the violation of section 24-A of the \general Clauses Act 1856.
- I) That the appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.







2. The seniority issue, which has been made a base for the impugned order though subjudice, but there is no stay or restrain order from the Tribunal to undo my promotion.
3. Since the order dated: 02-07-2013 has fully acted upon which create valuable rights in my favour, therefore under the principles of "Locus poenetentiae". The said order can not be held in abeyance or withdraw.


