





Respectfully Sheweth:

1. That the Appellant is a naturally born bona-fide citizen of Islamic Republic of Pakistan and hails from a respectable family of District Charsadda.
2. That after going through the mandatorily required criteria laid down for selection & induction into Police Force, the Appellant got enrolled into service decades back.
3. That after getting onto the rolls of this prestigious department, the Appellant has ever remained a pragmatic and devoted member of the force, who never left any stone unturned in performance of his duties and fulfillment of his obligations, bestowed upon his shoulders.
4. That the Appellant has been the most devoted, punctual and professional member and because of his professionalism, there is no soot or sootage of any sort upon his long career spread over decades.
5. That it was in this background that the Appellant got promoted as S.I (Sub Inspector) on officiating basis on 22-11-2004. Later on instead of confirming the Appellant in the rank of S.I, w.e.f dated: 22-11-2004, that is date of officiating S.I, the Appellant was confirmed in the same rank of S.I w.e.f dated: 10-11-2010 vide office order No. 4383/EC-I dated: 03/03/2021. (Copy of Office Order Dated 03-03-2021 is annexed herewith as Annexure "A").
6. That besides the aforementioned discrimination meted out to the Appellant, the Appellant was envisaged with yet another great dilemma in the form of requiring the Appellant to be posted as an S.H.O for a specified length of period. Which notion has repeatedly been discouraged & depreciated by Superior Courts of the land as well as by this Hon'ble Tribunal

in plethora of its judgments. (Copies of different judgments are annexed as Annexure "B")

7. That both these two anomalies and illegalities have caused the deprivation of the Appellant from his timely promotions to the post of Inspector and D.S.P as well as wrong placement in the Seniority coupled with formidable fact of promoting juniors and placing them ahead of the Appellant which certainly cannot be justified and thus the Appellant has been deprived of his timely promotion and wrong placement in the Seniority list.
8. That feeling aggrieved the Appellant preferred a Departmental Appeal, which was turned down vide impugned Office Order No. 12345/EC-I Dated 09-07-2021. (Copy of Departmental Appeal & Order Dated 09-07-2021 are annexed herewith as "C & D").
9. That feeling aggrieved the Appellant prefers the instant appeal for anti-dated promotion to the rank of confirm S.I w.e.f 22-11-2004 with all consequential benefits as well as declaring the short or non-existent S.H.O tenure as irrelevant for due and timely promotions upon the following grounds inter-alia:-

Grounds:

- A. That the Appellant is entitled to be confirmed in the rank of S.I with effect from date of taking charge/ notification of officiating S.I.
- B. That Appellant is entitled for anti-dated promotion in the rank of confirm S.I with effect from date of officiating S.I and its refusal as per on part of respondents is wrong and illegal.
- C. That it is established law on subject and the same has repeated itself that date of officiating is to be reckoned is

date of taking probationary charge and as a probationer, is entitled to confirmation from taking charge as probationa list in other departments so in the case of officiating charge in Police Force and the same has been held as such by this Hon'ble Tribunal repeatedly that the date of confirmation is to reckoned from date of taking charge as on officiating basis.

- D. That besides the above there is another anomaly which is rampant in the Police Force and that is that S.I are required to undergo S.H.O specified tenure for getting promotions into the ranks of Inspector allegedly in the light of certain standing orders of I.G.P. Now this anomaly is repeatedly been struck down, discouraged and deplored by this Hon'ble Tribunal persistently in its numerous judgments that an official of police cannot post himself as an SHO, rather it's the job of the government and now where an officer cannot post himself nor can designate himself as an S.H.O then the same can neither be a criteria for promotion nor can be a requirement as such as the same as not be a qualification. So in all cases the Appellant cannot be made escape goat.
- E. That because of the foregoing anomaly made juniors or promoted by leaving the Appellant in lurch as Inspector(s) and lastly as D.S.P(s). While the Appellant was promoted at a much belated stage as inspectors.
- F. That thus the Appellant is entitled to be given anti-dated confirmation in the rank of S.I w.e.f 22-11-2004 as well as is entitled from due and timely anti-dated promotions in the rank of Inspector and thereafter as DSP by placing the Appellant ahead of his juniors i.e. private respondents.
- G. That any other ground not raised here may graciously be allowed at the time of arguments.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of the instant Service Appeal, the Appellant may graciously be extended anti-dated promotion in the rank of confirmed S.I w.e.f 22-11-2004 with all back benefits as well as declared and extended his due and timely promotions in the rank of Inspector by excluding the S.H.O Tenure condition in the light of numerous judgments of this Hon'ble Tribunal and thereafter be promoted as D.S.P and be given his due placement in the Seniority list of both inspectors and DSPs and be placed ahead of his juniors i.e, private respondents with all back benefits.

Any other relief not specifically asked for may also graciously be extended in favor of the appellant in the circumstances of the case.



JUDGEMENT: -

Mr. ATTIQ UR REHMAN WAZIR: - Appellant Mr. Nazar Hussain, Inspector Kohat Police has assailed the order dated 27-11-2018, whereby the departmental appeal of the appellant for confirmation and placing his name with colleagues/ batch mates has been rejected.

Brief facts of the case are that the appellant initially appointed as ASI on 28-06-2006 and confirmed as ASI on 29-06-2010 from the date of appointment. His name brought on list E and further promoted to SI on officiating basis along with his colleagues dated 24-08-2010. In DPC



meeting held on 06-02-2013, the appellant deferred due to deficiency, while his other colleagues confirmed as SI vide order dated 24-08-2013. The appellant confirmed as SI in subsequent DPC w.e.f. 03-01-2014 instead of 06-02-2013, where his other colleagues were confirmed. That seniority list issued on 29-06-2018, where the appellant placed at Serial No 297, whereas his colleagues are at Serial No 90,91,92 and 93. Appellant filed departmental appeal dated 28-08-2018, rejected on 27-11-2018, hence the instant service appeal with prayers that the impugned order dated 27-11-2018 may be set aside and name of the appellant be placed in confirmation list with his colleagues/batch mates with all back benefits.

3. Written reply/comments were submitted by respondents.
4. Arguments heard and record perused.
5. Learned counsel for the appellant contended that the appellant initially appointed as ASI on 28-12-2006, subsequently confirmed on 29-06-2010 from the date of initial appointment. That the appellant promoted as officiating SI on 24-08-2010. That in a DPC meeting held on 06-02-2013, other colleagues of the appellant were confirmed as SI vide order dated 20-02-2013, whereas the case of appellant was deferred, being not completed PTC posting period. That appellant confirmed as SI in subsequent DPC w.e.f. 03-01-2014 instead of 06-02-2013, where his other colleagues were confirmed. The learned counsel argued that as per minutes of the same DPC dated 06-02-2013, at serial No 2, an officiating SI, Gharib Nawaz deferred in previous DPC dated 15-08-2012 for want of deficiency was confirmed with his colleagues confirmed earlier in DPC dated 15-08-2012.

considered by the subsequent DPC and the appellant confirmed with immediate effect inspite of the fact that he was deferred and not superseded. That in case of deferment the seniority is not affected after fulfillment of the deficiency. That it is the legal right of the appellant to be confirmed from the date, his other colleagues were confirmed. That final seniority list issued on 29-06-2018 placed the appellant on Serial No 297, whereas his colleagues/batch mates are at Serial No 90, 91, 92 and 93. That such act of the respondents was discriminatory and against law and the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law; hence, his rights secured and guaranteed under the constitution were badly violated. The learned counsel referred to the judgments of this tribunal in service appeal No 407/2011, 1227/2013 and Service Appeal No 197/2016, where in similar nature cases, relief has been granted by this tribunal. The learned counsel also referred to the judgments of supreme court of Pakistan in 2006 SCMR 1938 and 2002 PLC (CS) 1388. On question of limitation the learned counsel referred to the judgment of supreme court of Pakistan in 2002 PLC (CS) 1388 and 2009 PLC (CS) 178, where on the issue of promotion, pay and other emoluments, limitation would not foreclose his right accrued to him. The learned counsel prayed that in view of the situation, the impugned order dated 27-11-2018 may be set aside and the respondents may be directed to place the name of the appellant in confirmation list with his colleagues/ batch mates by ante dating his confirmation to meet the end of justice with all back and consequential benefits of service.

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6. The learned Deputy District Attorney appeared on behalf of official respondents opposed the contention of learned counsel for appellant. He argued that the appeal is badly time barred in the first place as his seniority affected in the year 2014, whereas the appellant preferred appeal in 2018 after issuance of seniority list in 2018. Reliance Civil appeal No 566/2020. The learned Deputy District Attorney further argued that the appellant had not qualified/ completed the mandatory period of posting required for confirmation, hence not confirmed in the DPC meeting. That after completion of mandatory posting period, the appellant confirmed to the rank of SI under section 13.18 of Police Rules 1934. The learned Deputy District Attorney prayed that the instant appeal being devoid of merit may be dismissed.


7. We are conscious of the fact that time limitation needs to be kept in mind, but in the light of judgments of Supreme Court of Pakistan referred to above and in view of provisions of S.23 of Limitation Act 1908, the appellant has a continuous cause of action and issuance of seniority list at belated stage by respondents created a fresh cause of action for the appellant, not knowing the fact that his confirmation in 2014 with immediate effect would entail seniority issue at a later stage. Moreover, deferment shall not debar the appellant from confirmation from the date of his deferment, after making good the deficiency. We did not find anything adverse on record except deferment to substantiate his confirmation on a later date. We also did not notice any other seniority list on record except the revised seniority list issued on 22-06-2018. It also established from the prevailing rules that civil servants selected for promotion to a higher post (AS

one batch shall, on their promotion to the higher post, retain their inter se seniority as in the lower post. Moreover this Tribunal as well as Supreme Court of Pakistan in number of Judgments have granted relief in similar cases.

8. In the light of facts and circumstances of the present case, the instant appeal is accepted, the impugned order dated 27-11-2018 set aside with the directions to the respondents to place the name of the appellant in confirmation list with his batch mates and accordingly revise the seniority list with all consequential benefits. No orders as to costs. File be consigned to the record room.



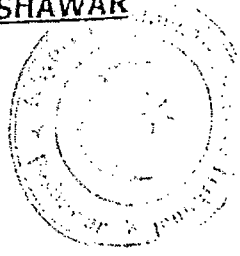

His batchmates were promoted but the appellant was neither posted to complete his period of S.H.O ship nor was promoted

with his batchmates despite repeated requests to his high-ups. Lastly, he was confirmed in the rank of S.I on 05.01.2017 and his name was placed on list "F" but with immediate effect. After confirmation, he filed departmental appeal but to no avail, hence the instant service appeal.

2. Learned counsel for appellant contended that the appellant was initially appointed as Assistant Sub Inspector on 20th October, 2006 and was confirmed in rank of A.S.I vide notification dated 01.01.2010. That in a D.P.C Meeting, other colleagues of the appellant were confirmed whereas the case of appellant was not considered. He submitted that the appellant was confirmed in the rank of S.I on 05.01.2017 but with immediate effect instead of confirming him from the date when his other colleagues were confirmed. Learned counsel further argued that appellant was treated in a discriminatory manner as some other Officiating Sub Inspectors who were deferred for want of deficiency, were confirmed with those colleagues who had been confirmed earlier. He submitted that there is nothing on file which could show any sort of bad entry on the record of the appellant and that he was never superseded. He submitted that in case of deferment for want of any deficiency, seniority is not affected and this is the legal right of the appellant to be confirmed from the date when his other colleagues were confirmed. He contended that such act of the respondents was discriminatory and against the law as the appellant was not treated in accordance with law and his rights guaranteed under the Constitution were badly violated. Reliance was

placed on the judgments of this Tribunal in Service Appeal No. 29/2019; 407/2011; 1227/2013 and 197/2016, wherein, in similar nature cases, relief was granted by this Tribunal. He, therefore, requested for placing the name of the appellant in the confirmation list with his colleagues by ante dating his confirmation to meet the ends of justice with all back benefits.

3. Conversely, learned A.A.G submitted that the appellant was provided with several opportunities to show efficiency and good work in the discharge of his official duty as S.H.O but he failed to perform his duty up to the satisfaction of his seniors. He submitted hat he was suspended and was dealt with departmentally on account of inefficiency and misuse of official authority. He contended that confirmation in the rank of S.I is subject to qualifying the laid down criteria and the appellant on the fulfillment of said pre-requisite criteria, under Rule 13.10(2) was confirmed in the rank of S.I without any discrimination.

4. Perusal of record would reveal that appellant was appointed/recruited as an A.S.I upon the recommendation of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission. He alongwith his batchmates/colleagues, was confirmed in the rank of A.S.I vide notification dated 01.01.2010 and his name was brought on promotion list "E" w.e.f 25.09.2006. Name of the appellant finds mention at Serial No.4, whereas, his colleagues Johar Shah, Abdur Rasheed and Khalid Khan have been placed at Serial No.9, 13 and 14 respectively. His above-mentioned colleagues were confirmed in the

rank of S.I w.e.f 14.03.2012 vide notification dated 10.09.2012, whereas, the appellant was confirmed in the rank of S.I with immediate effect vide notification dated 05.01.2017. There is nothing on file which could show that he was superseded rather he was not considered on the ground of not completing a period of one year as an Officiating Sub Inspector in independent charge of a Police Station in a district. The issue relating to confirmation of the appellant as Sub Inspector from the date when his colleagues were confirmed, holds ground as it was not within the authority of the appellant to post himself as an S.H.O of an independent Police Station. We did not find anything adverse on record except deferment to substantiate his confirmation on later date. It is established from the prevailing rules that civil servant selected for promotion to a higher post in one batch shall, on their promotion to the higher post, retain their inter-se seniority as in the lower post.

5. For the above-mentioned reasons, we are constrained to accept the present appeal with directions to the respondents to place the name of appellant in the confirmation list with his batchmates as Sub Inspector w.e.f 14.03.2012 when his colleagues were confirmed in the rank of S.I and accordingly revise the seniority list with all consequential benefits. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.
