

At the outset learned District Attorney raised preliminary objection regarding lack of jurisdiction of this Tribunal in entertaining and deciding the appeal in hand. He referred to Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 and Section 2 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 to substantiate his objection.

Learned counsel for the appellant could not deny or rebut the fact that the appellant was initially appointed on 8.11.2011 for a fixed period and against contract. He continued to serve as such till the date his resignation was accepted by the respondents and his service was dispensed with.

In view of the aforesaid fact and circumstances we are constrained to hold that the appeal in hand is not competent before the Tribunal. The same is disposed of accordingly. Instant order shall, by no means, preclude the appellant from seeking his legal remedy before the appropriate forum in accordance with the law.

Appellant (Ex-Assistant Director Fisheries) has filed the present service appeal u/s 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act 1974, on the ground that he was forced to sign already prepared resignation letter dated 11.06.2018; that on 13.06.2018 the appellant submitted application for withdrawal of his resignation, quite in time, but the same was not considered and the said resignation letter purportedly signed by the appellant was accepted vide impugned order dated 27.06.2018; that the appellant also filed departmental appeal/representation however he was verbally informed that his representation has been filed on 03.08.2018. Learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant made all out efforts to procure the order dated 03.08.2018 in respect of his departmental representation but to no avail.

Points urged need consideration. The present service appeal is admitted for regular hearing subject to all the legal objections. The appellant is directed to deposit security and process fee within 10 days. Thereafter notices be issued to the respondents for written reply/comments. 

The appellant submits as under:-

1. That the appellant after being appointed as Assistant director Fisheries has being performing his duty with zeal and complacency. (Copy of appointment order and other documents annexed as Annexure "A&B")

2. That on '11/06/2018,' the appellant was telephonically directed to appear and attend his office.

3. That it is pertinent to mention here that the worthy directed was not in good terms with the undersigned and he was not only transferred the appellant but malafidely allotted six regions to the appellant whose monitoring and supervision was assigned to the appellant without providing any official vehicle for the supervision of the same. Hence this act of the worthy Director spoke volumes of the intentions of the worthy director to torture the appellant.

4. That when the appellant appeared before the worthy director on 11-06-2018. The Director Fisheries FATA, instead of solving the Genuine problems of the appellant in the capacity of the superior officer, without any justification and cogent reasons insulted and humiliated the appellant in the presence of whole staff and the appellant was so tortured that he was forced to sign an already prepared resignation Letter and the appellant was directed to sign the same. (Copy of resignation letter dated 11-06-2018 is annexed as annexure "C").

5. That against the said alleged resignation letter dated 11/06/2018, the appellant on the third day i.e. on 13/06/2018 submitted a withdrawal application, quite in time but the same was not considered and the alleged resignation letter purportedly signed by the appellant was accepted vide Office order dated 27/06/2008. (Copy of withdrawal application and order dated 27/06/2018 are annexed as annexure "D & E")

6. That against the order dated 27/06/2008 regarding the rejection of request for reinstatement the appellant moved a departmental representation on 06/07/2018 which was also caused fruitless and the appellant was verbally informed that the departmental application was filed/ignored on 03/08/2018, which is in the custody of the respondents, hence the instant appeal on the following grounds inter alia:- (Copy of Representation is annexed as F)

GROUNDS:

A. That the impugned orders are against law, rules and principle of Natural justice, not tenable in the eye of law is liable to be set aside.

B. That the order impugned regarding the acceptance of resignation never been filed with free will and the turned down/rejection of the departmental appeal on such score are act without lawful authority, without jurisdiction, of no legal effect and ineffective upon the valid and legal rights of the appellant.

C. That the representation in shape of application negative response of the Respondents with distinguish illegal and unwarranted behavior and response of the Respondent as clear from the documents is approve vide which the appellant was put undue pressure to present his resignation hence everything as done with appellant was in act base on malafide therefore the same is nor sustainable.

D. That the representation made by the appellant was well based but the rejection as made in the matter was infact nullity in the eyes of law.

E. That the appellant belongs to a respectable and middle class family having no other source of income and the acceptance of the said resignation will badly effected the whole family of the appellant.

F. That any other ground not raised here may graciously be allowed to be raised at the time of arguments.

It is, therefore, requested that on acceptance of this appeal the impugned orders dated 27/06/2018 and 03/08/2018 may be set aside and application dated 13/06/2018 of the appellant and departmental appeal dated 06/07/2018 may be accepted. the appellant may be reinstated with all back benefit with grant of additional relief not specifically prayed for but is available in the circumstances may be awarded to the appellant in the ends of justice.

Any other relief not specifically asked for may also graciously be extended in favour of the appellant in the circumstances of the case.

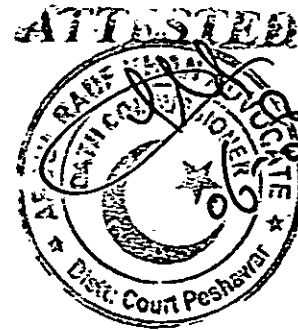



OFFICE ORDER

Consequent upon the recommendation and approval of the Project Selection/ Recruitment Committee held in a meeting on 27/10/2011, the Competent Authority is pleased to appoint Mr. Jehangir Khan S/O Roghan Shah, Batai Alizai P.O Khar, Teh: Khar Bajaur Agency and post him as Assistant Director Fisheries Bajaur at Bajaur for Bajaur & Mohmand Agency in BPS-17 @ Rs. 45,000 on fixed pay per month with 5% annual increment at maximum according to Govt. policy circulated vide Section Officer (I-stab.) FATA Secretariat (Co-Ordination & Administration Department Peshawar No.FS/F/100-19 (Vol-25)/2535-41 dated 31-03-2009 under the ADP scheme "Development of Fisheries in Dams Reservoirs & Water Harnessing Basins in FATA" on contract basis with immediate effect for a period of one year, extendable subject to the satisfactory performance till the expiry of the project period or till the approval of SNI: post arrival of regular ADF from PSC/Promotion.

The Terms and Condition would be as under:

1. The terms and conditions of his/her appointment to the post will be regulated by the instructions contained in the Govt. of NWFP, S&GAD vide No. SOR-1 (S&GAD) 4-7/86 dated 9-4-88 and No. F1 (SOSR-III) 12-1/2002 dated 26-10-2002 and amendment as per government policy.
2. The appointment shall be purely on contract basis and his/her services can be terminated on 14 days notice without any reason being assigned at any time, irrespective of the fact that he/she is holding a post other than one to which He/She was originally recruited or on the payment of 14 days salary in lieu of the notice or on the winding up of the project which ever is earlier.
3. In case he/she wishes to resign at any time, 14 days notice will be necessary in lieu of otherwise one month pay shall be forfeited or deposited to Govt. Account.
4. He/She shall not indulge him/herself in any trade, business and any other activity etc what so ever, which has been declared prohibited for the Government Servants in Civil Servant Act 1973.
5. His/her appointment to the above post will not conform his/her any right of regular appointment/absorption against the post of Assistant Director Fisheries or any other post and nor his/her service will count towards seniority/promotion/pension.
6. He/She will be entitled to all those allowances admissible under the rules/ project policy.
7. He/She will not be entitled for any TA/DA for joining service.
8. He/She will not be entitled to pension and gratuity benefits.
9. This offer is subject to the condition that he/she will execute an agreement on stamp paper with the Fisheries Department.
10. He/She will have to produce a Medical Fitness Certificate from a Civil Surgeon in a recognized Govt. Hospitals or from Federal Hospital Hasan Gari Peshawar.
11. The appointment to the post is subject to the verification of all the academic documents from the concerned University/Institution. Salaries would be released after the verification of the documents and if the documents found fake / bogus, the case will be registered against the appointee under CrPe and other relevant rules/ law.

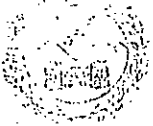

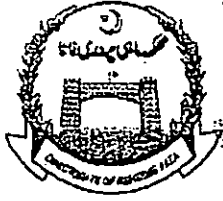

PARAWISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENTS NO.01 to 04

Respectfully Sheweth:

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIVES

1. The appellant has no "locus Standi" and /or cause to file the instant appeal.
2. The appellant is not authorized and entitled to file appeal before honorable service tribunal being project employee.
3. The appeal is wholly incompetent, misconceived, and untenable.
4. The Appellant has not come to the court with clean hands. The Appeal also suffers from misstatement and concealment of facts.

FACTS

1. Mr. Jahangir Khan (appellant) was appointed as Assistant Director Fisheries under Developmental Project "Strengthening of Fisheries Department in FATA on fixed pay on contract basis only for project period i.e w.e.f 02-11-2011 for period of one year, further extendable subject to extension of project and his satisfactory performance. However his service record was not clean as he had always shown negligence in his Govt duty, copies of explanations are attached as (Annex-A-1 to A-7). Further a fact finding inquiry was also initiated against him by the Secretary Production & Livelihood Development Department FATA vide letter No.SO(P&LDD)/FS/ Fisheries/1-9/2013/1351-53 dated 10/07/2017 (Annex-B), The inquiry report submitted by the enquiry officer (Deputy Secretary P&LDD) (Annex-C) clearly reveals lack of interest /negligence in Govt duty on

part of Mr. Jehangir Khan Ex- Assistant Director Fisheries Bajur, resultantly Mr. Jehangir Khan was transferred from Mohmand/ Bajur to FR Bannu/DI Khan/SWA/NWA/.(Annex-D)

It is pertinent to mention that The said officer even after transfer continued his non serious attitude toward performance of Govt duty and mostly remained absent from his duty. His absence was also reported by the then Assistant Political Agent FR Bannu. (Annex.E)

2. Incorrect. The Director Fisheries never called Mr. Jahangir Khan to attend his office on 11/06/2018 , rather he came to office to collect his TA bill cheques from Disburser of this office (Annex-F). However upon his request through PA the Director Fisheries met with him on same day.
3. Incorrect. Director Fisheries always deal all the field officers including appellant and subordinate staff in good manner. Further existing Director Fisheries has no role in his transfer as evident from the fact that; Mr. Jahangir Khan was transferred by the Secretary Production & Livelihood Development Department FATA on the recommendation of enquiry officer as stated in para -1 above, (Annex-G) before the Assumption of charge by the existing Director Fisheries FATA. Transfer Order of existing Director Fisheries FATA and his charge assumption report are attached (Annex-H&I).
Moreover a Government Vehicle was on the disposal of Assistant Director Fisheries FR Bannu/DI Khan/NWA/SWA office, but after transfer to the said post Mr. Jahangir Khan Ex- Assistant Director Fisheries FR Bannu did not use the said vehicle and returned the vehicle vide letter No. 1166/ADF dated 27/04/2018. Copy of his letter is attached as (Annex-J)

4. Incorrect: Mr. Jahangir Khan Ex-Assistant Director Fisheries visited the office of Director Fisheries FATA on 11-05-2018. Upon his request through PA, Director Fisheries met with him. During discussion the Director Fisheries advised him to be punctual and be present on his duty station. In this regard, Director Fisheries showed him a letter of Assistant Political Agent FR Bannu (Annex-K) wherein Assistant Political Agent FR Bannu reported that Mr. Jahangir Khan Assistant Director Fisheries FR Bannu was found absent during ADP meeting held on 23-05-2018. In response to above mention advice Mr. Jahangir Khan responded categorically that he is unable to perform his duty at FR Bannu, due to his some personal reasons therefore he intends to tender his resignation right now. Meanwhile it was Zuhar prayer time in the month of Holy Ramzan. After prayer Mr. Jahangir Khan ADF again came back and brought a written resignation and submitted in office in the presence of most of the staff members, (Resignation & Written statement on stamp paper of staff is attached) (Annex-L&M). As such, it is evident that Mr. Jehangir Khan Ex-ADF tendered his resignation according to his own desire and will. It is also evident from above that any torturing or humiliation is absolutely baseless and incorrect.

5. The resignation of Mr. Jahangir was submitted to Secretary Production & Livelihood Development Department on next day vide this office letter No. 2342-49 dated 12-06-2018 (Annex-N). Meanwhile the appellant submitted his application to Secretary P&LDD. In response the Secretary P&LDD called the applicant and Director Fisheries in his office on 26-06-2018 vide section officer P&LDD telephonic instruction on dated 25-06-2018, for personal hearing which was also endorsed to appellant with a copy to Secretary Production & Livelihood Development Department by Director Fisheries vide No.2892-94 dated 25-06-2018 (Annex-O). After personal hearing, due to non-satisfactory reply by Mr. Jahangir Khan, the Secretary P&LDD rejected his request of withdrawal of his resignation, As Such his resignation was accepted by the Secretary P&LDD vide No. SO/P&LDD/FS/Fisheries/1-9/13/1785-90 dated 27-06-2018 (Annex-P) and the same was endorsed to Mr. Jahangir Khan vide this office letter No. 2905-08 dated 29-06-2018 (Annex-Q).
6. Thereafter The appellant submitted application to the competent authority i.e Additional Chief Secretary FATA regarding withdrawal/turned down of resignation acceptance letter issued by Secretary Production & Livelihood Development Department FATA. However, the competent authority i.e Additional Chief Secretary FATA after considering all pros & cons filed the appeal of the appellant under the rules, which are reproduced as under:-
- i. *“when a resignation tendered by a Government servant has been accepted and the acceptance has been communicated to him, it becomes final. There can be no question of allowing him to ‘withdraw the resignation.’”*
 - ii. *“where an appellate authority finds that the resignation was not tendered voluntarily or that is otherwise null and void, the appellate authority may re-instate the Government servant concerned. On re-instatement the Government servant shall be regarded as having continued service throughout.”*


GROUNDS

- A. Incorrect: The appellant has been treated according to the laws and rules and none of the constitutional rights of the appellant have been violated.
- B. Incorrect: The resignation of the appellant accepted by the competent authority under the rules.
- C. Incorrect: The appellant willfully submitted his resignation in presence of most of staff members as per (Annex-M), there was absolutely no pressure on the appellant.
- D. Incorrect: the act of the respondent is legal and according to law.
- E. Incorrect: As replied above.


F. The respondents seek permission of the honorable court to argue on other ground, which will be raised during arguments.

In the light of above facts it is most humbly prayed that appeal in hand may be dismissed in favor of the respondents with cost throughout.

FACTS FINDING INQUIRY REPORT AGAINST MR. JAHANGIR KHAN ASSISTANT
DIRECTOR FISHERIES BAJAUR AGENCY.

Background

The undersigned was entrusted an inquiry regarding the omission/commission act of Mr. Jahangir Khan Assistant Director Fisheries, Bajaur Agency vide Secretary P&LDD order No. 50 P&LDD/FS/Fisheries/1-9/13/1351-53 dated 10/7/2017 (Flag-A). The proceedings are as under:

Proceedings

The undersigned approached Assistant Director Fisheries Bajaur Agency to obtain his statement in the subject matter. The AD Fisheries in his written statement stated that the contractor doesn't take interest in his work and carry out his work with subordinate staff (Flag-B). As per statement of M/S Wazir Bros & Company four fish farms were established timely while the remaining four fish farms weren't due to lack of interest and demand of 10% commission by the Assistant Director Fisheries Bajaur (Flag-C).

Findings

1. Contract for establishment of Fish Farm in FATA was awarded to M/S Wazir Brothers by the Directorate of Fisheries FATA.
2. The Director Fisheries FATA informed the undersigned through note pari dated 23/8/2017 that Mr. Jahangir AD Fisheries Bajaur did not verify the bills of the contractor for which the work is done by him. (Flag-D)
3. Establishment of Fish farms was delayed by the Assistant Director Fisheries Bajaur as he had failed to provide the remaining four sites in spite of the repeated directions from the Director Fisheries vide letters No. 523-28 dated 18/4/2017, 06-09/DFI dated 15/5/2017, 1001-02 dated/DF/DR-2 dated 5/6/2017, 128-132/DFI dated 9/6/2017 and No. 141-44 dated 13/6/2017. (Flag-E,F,G,H&K)

Conclusion

After thorough examination of all the documents it was concluded that the scheme was not completed due to lack of interest of the Assistant Director Fisheries Bajaur which was due for completion in June 2017. As far as the Director Fisheries is concerned, he repeatedly directed AD Fisheries Bajaur to provide the remaining sites for construction but he (the Director) only relied on correspondence, and no solid action was taken by him against the AD Fisheries Bajaur due to which the construction work could not be completed in time.

Recommendations

1. Action may be taken against Mr. Jahangir Khan, Assistant Director Fisheries Bajaur being responsible for incompleteness of work.
2. Action may also be taken against Director Fisheries FATA as mentioned in the conclusion portion of the inquiry.

**FACTS FINDING INQUIRY REPORT AGAINST MR. JAHANGIR KHAN ASSISTANT
DIRECTOR FISHERIES BAJAUR AGENCY**

Background

The undersigned was entrusted an inquiry regarding the omission/commission act of Mr. Jahangir Khan Assistant Director Fisheries, Bajaur Agency vide Secretary P&LDD order No. SO P&LDD/FS/Fisheries/1-9/13/1351-53 dated 10/7/2017 (Flag-A). The proceedings are as under

Proceedings

The undersigned approached Assistant Director Fisheries Bajaur Agency to obtain his statement in the subject matter. The AD Fisheries in his written statement stated that the contractor doesn't take interest in his work and carry out his work with subordinate staff (Flag-B). As per statement of M/S Wazir Bros. & Company four fish farms were established timely while the remaining four fish farms weren't due to lack of interest and demand of 10% commission by the Assistant Director Fisheries Bajaur (Flag-C).

Findings


1. Contract for establishment of Fish Farm in FATA was awarded to M/S Wazir Brothers by the Directorate of Fisheries FATA.
2. The Director Fisheries FATA informed the undersigned through note part dated 23/6/2017 that Mr. Jahangir AD Fisheries Bajaur did not verify the bills of the contractor for which the work is done by him. (Flag-D)
3. Establishment of Fish farms was delayed by the Assistant Director Fisheries Bajaur as he had failed to provide the remaining four sites in spite of the repeated directions from the Director Fisheries vide letters No. 523-28 dated 18/4/2017, 05-09/DFI dated 15/5/2017, 1001-02 dated/DF/DR-2 dated 5/6/2017, 123-132/DFI dated 9/6/2017 and No. 141-44 dated 13/6/2017. (Flag-E,F,G,H&K)

Conclusion

After thorough examination of all the documents it was concluded that the scheme was not completed due to lack of interest of the Assistant Director Fisheries Bajaur which was due for completion in June 2017. As far as the Director Fisheries is concerned, he repeatedly directed AD Fisheries Bajaur to provide the remaining sites for construction but he (the Director) only relied on correspondence and no solid action was taken by him against the AD Fisheries Bajaur due to which the construction work could not be completed in time.

Recommendations

1. Action may be taken against Mr. Jahangir Khan, Assistant Director Fisheries Bajaur being responsible for incompleteness of work.
2. Action may also be taken against Director Fisheries FATA as mentioned in the conclusion portion of the inquiry.

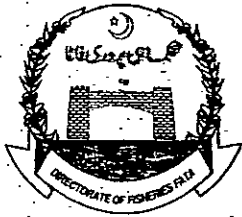

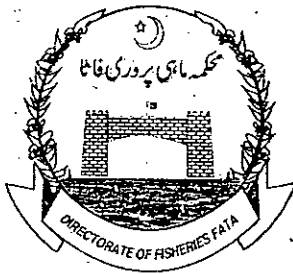

MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 23-05-2018 UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF ASSISTANT POLITICAL AGENT FR BANNU REGARDING PREPARATION OF DRAFT FATA ADP 2018-19.

As per direction of Deputy Commissioner Bannu/ PA FR Bannu, a meeting was held under the chairmanship of Assistant Political Agent FR Bannu on 23/05/2018 for preparation of draft FATA ADP 2018-19 FR Bannu. The list of participants is enclosed as Annex-A.

The meeting was started with the recitation of Holy Quran and the Chairman welcomed all the participants and elaborated on the importance of the meeting. The Chairman discussed timeframe for formulation of draft FATA ADP-2018-19 to submit proposals /suggestions by all stack holders, line departments pertaining to their sector as per guideline of P&D FATA.
