



Counsel for the appellant present and heard. The learned counsel for the appellant, inter-alia, argued that the appellant was promoted as Naib Tehsildar in his own pay and scale vide order dated 19.08.2006 and was subsequently promoted on regular basis as Naib Tehsildar (BPS-14) vide order dated 2.5.2009 but with immediate effect. Aggrieved of the order dated 02.05.2009, the appellant preferred departmental appeal to the SMBR, which was accepted and the appellant was given his rightful place in the tentative as well as final seniority lists issued during the year 2009 but in the revised final seniority list issued in the year 2010, the appellant was placed at the bottom of the seniority list against the order of the SMBR whereby his departmental appeal was accepted and he was placed at the senior most position w.e. from the date on which he was promoted as Naib Tehsildar in his own pay and scale. Against the revised seniority list, the appellant filed writ petition which was disposed of by the Peshawar High Court in terms of order dated 09.09.2010, followed by the order dated 5.11.2010 whereby the seniority position was restored and service of the appellant was regularized w.e.f 19.8.2006. The appellant was accordingly placed at his rightful place in the tentative seniority list as it stood on 31.12.2010 but in the final seniority list the appellant was again relegated to the junior position, against which he preferred departmental appeal, but the same was rejected vide impugned order dated 23.05.2013, hence this appeal on 20.06.2013. The learned counsel for the appellant further contended that in the meantime, Naib Tehsildars junior to the appellant have been promoted to the rank of Tehsildar (BPS-16), which has also been assailed in the appeal with prayer for promotion of the appellant from the date when Naib Tehsildars Junior to him were promoted to the next higher post. The points raised at the Bar need consideration. Admit. Process fee and security within 10 days. Thereafter, notices be issued to the respondents for written reply/comments before learned Bench-II on 17.12.2013.

Respectfully Sheweth:

Brief facts giving rise to the appeal are as under:

1. That the appellant was promoted as Naib Tehsildar BPS-14 vide order dated 19.08.2006 but in his own pay and scale. Lateron, appellant was promoted as

Naib Tehsildar on regular basis vide order dated 02.05.2009. (Copy of order dated 19.08.2006 is Annexure "A" and order dated 02.05.2009 is Annexure "B").

2. That vide order dated 02.04.2009, Naib Tehsildars, Haider Hussain and Qaisar Naz were given seniority from the date of first promotion on his own pay and scale as the post was available and they were qualified for the post. (Copy of order dated 02.04.2009 is Annexure "C").
3. That on the basis of said order dated 02.04.2009 and seniority; they were promoted as Tehsildar in BPs-16 are placed in seniority list of Tehsildars at Serial No.82 and 83. (Copy of seniority list of Tehsildar dated 13.08.2010 is Annexure "D").
4. That on the principle of judgment of Supreme Court of Pakistan reported in 2006 SCMR 1938 and being followed in case of Haider Hussain and Qaisar Naz, appellant was given the same benefit vide order dated 01.10.2009 by SMBR. (Copy of 2006 SCMR 1938 is Annexure "E" and order is Annexure "E/1").
5. That a tentative seniority list of Naib Tehsildar was prepared by respondents on 24.03.2010 wherein appellant was shown at Serial No.30. (Copy of tentative seniority list is Annexure "F").
6. That final seniority list of Naib Tehsildar was prepared on 30.06.2010, wherein appellant is shown serial No.36. (Copy of final seniority list is Annexure "G").

7. That to the utter shock and dismay of appellant another sonority list in the same year with the name of final revised seniority was prepared on 10.08.2010 and appellant is lowered to Serial No.170 without hearing or notice. (Copy of revised final seniority dated 10.08.2010 is Annexure "H").
8. That appellant was fit to be promoted as Naib Tehsildar at the time of first promotion own pay and scale vide order dated 23.08.2006 on the basis of Tehsildar/ Naib Tehsildar Services Rules, 2001 as well as 2008 (Naib Tehsildar Rules of 2001 is Annexure "I" and Naib Tehsildar is Annexure "J").
9. That the appellant filed written petition before the Honourable High Court, Peshawar which was disposed-off and order dated 09.09.2010 is Annexure "K").
10. That the appellant moved an application before SMBR for implementation of High Court order dated 09.09.2010 on which notes were prepared. (Copy of application and Note are Annexure "L" & "M").
11. That on the basis of application for implementation of High Court order another order dated 05.11.2010 was issued by respondent No.2 and was given sonority with immediate effect from 23.08.2006. (Copy of order dated 05.11.2011 is Annexure "N").
12. That vide order dated 23.05.2013 both orders dated 01.10.2009 and 05.11.2010 were withdrawn and the appeal was rejected. (Copy of representation and is

Annexure "O & P" and other relevant documents is Annexure "Q").

13. That in a state of disappointment finding no effective alternate remedy, the appellant approach this Honourable Court, inter alia, on the following grounds:

G R O U N D S:

- A. That there is no provision of issuing another revised seniority list in the same year, once tentative seniority list is culminated into final seniority list.
- B. That as per Article 189 of Constitution of Pakistan, 1973, the precedent of Supreme Court is binding upon every citizen, including bureaucracy and especially when a judicial order has been passed in respect of the same and acted upon and vested right has been accrued to appellant, thus, as per Article 187 of the Constitution of Pakistan, 1973 this Honourable Court can direct respondent to strictly act in accordance with 2006 SCRM 1938 and judicial order of SMBR 01.10.2009.
- C. That the authority who passed an order has got no power to undo the same and that authority becomes functus officio. Thus SMBR has no power to undo the same.
- D. That there is neither provision of review in KPK Departmental Appeal Rules, 1986 nor in Board of Revenue Act, 1967 and this Honourable Court has struck down orders of SMBR whereby he changed his earlier orders in review.

- E. That as per Section 24-A General Clauses Act, solid reasons are required, but no reason muchless plausible has been shown in the revised final seniority list.
- F. That act of respondent smacks malafide to promote their blue-eyed persons and thereafter petitioner would be thurted to prolonged litigation and justice delayed is justice denied.
- G. That if the hands of respondents are not stopped, it will yield to corruption and evil practices and all efforts for the rule of law will go waste.
- H. That such type of orders yields to lack of confidence of subordinates in their superior officers.
- I. That Haider Hussain and Qaisar Naz have been given the same benefit thus petitioner is discriminated and Article 25/27 of Constitution are violated.
- J. That one Naik Muhammad, Said Rehman, Naib Din, Gulshan Muhammad were given sonority form their earlier dates and the appellatant was treated differently which is against the command of constitution.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that the respondents may be directed:

- i. To declare the revised final seniority list of Naib Tehsildar dated 10.08.2010 as illegal, without lawful authority, coram-non-judice, based on malafide and final seniority list of Naib Tehsildar be restored.

- ii. To direct the respondents to act in accordance with judgment of Supreme Court of Pakistan reported in 2006 SCRM 1938 and order of SMBR dated 01.10.2009 and to treat the appellant at par with Haider Hussain and Qaisar Naz.
- iii. To set the order dated 23.05.2013 and be declared as illegal, unlawful, void ab-initio and ineffective upon the rights of the appellant and the order made by the predecessor of the present SMBR dated 01.10.2009 and 05.11.2010 may kindly be restored and the appellant may please be considered for promotion from the date when his juniors were promoted with all back benefits.
- iv. Any other relief which this Honourable Court deems fit and appropriate in the circumstances of the case and not specifically asked of may kindly also be granted.

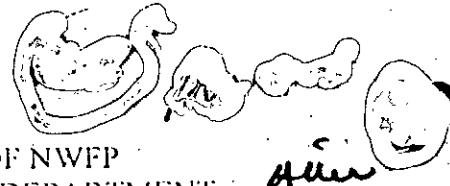

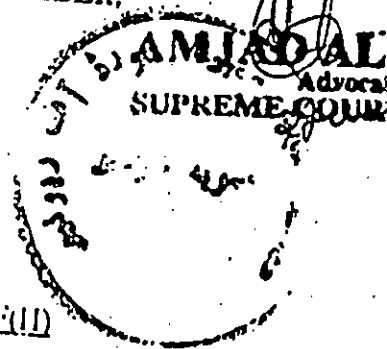

He being aggrieved preferred an appeal before the Senior Member, Board of Revenue, NWFP against the selection of the present petitioners. The said appeal was dismissed by the court of Senior Member, Board of Revenue, NWFP on 18/04/2002. He preferred another appeal before the NWFP Service Tribunal, the said appeal was partially accepted and it was directed that inter se seniority amongst the petitioners and respondent be fixed and senior one should be promoted on regular basis and the junior one on acting charge basis.

In compliance with the order of Service Tribunal, NWFP a meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee was held on 27/02/2009 whereby Haider Hussain was considered Naib Tehsildar on regular basis with effect from 2006 while Qaisar Naz was reverted and appointment on acting charge basis.

The relevant portion of the said judgment is reproduced below:-


"It is quite apparent that restriction imposed in para 4 of the Revenue Department Notification mentioned above; pertains to the appointment as Mukhtiar Kar and in the cases under consideration will have no bearing for the reasons that respondents were granted exemptions in accordance with circulars requirements of which were duly fulfilled by them and not only that but exemptions were implemented and they received necessary training as such valuable rights had accrued to them which could not be interfered with. In this context reference can be made to section 20 of General Clauses Act and guidelines laid down in the case of Pakistan Versus Muhammad Himayatullah Farukhi (PLD 1969 Supreme Court 407) in which it is held that principle of locus poenitentiae is available to the Government or relevant authorities and further authority which is competent to make order has power to undo it, but such orders cannot be withdrawn or rescinded once it has taken legal effect and created certain rights in favour of any individual".

In view of the above, the Departmental Promotion Committee has no powers to revert the petitioner or to affect the seniority of the petitioners. Furthermore, the service rendered on adhoc basis with effect from 18/06/1991 to 09/04/2001 by Mr. Haidar Hussain Naib Tehsildar has already been counted towards regular service by this court vide order dated 27/11/2008, thus Mr. Haider Hussain is regular Naib Tehsildar with effect from 18/06/1991. So for the question of Mr. Qaisar Naz Naib Tehsildar is concerned his name be placed in the seniority list of Naib Tehsildars after the name of Hameed Khan Naib Tehsildar. It is further directed that a fresh Departmental Promotion Committee Meeting may be called sharply for the promotion of the petitioners.

(a) North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants Act (XVIII of 1973)---

---S. 8---Promotion---Principle---Acting charge---Departmental Promotion Committee issued delayed notification---Effect---Where a post was available against which a civil servant could be promoted; where such civil servant was qualified to be promoted to such a higher post; where he was put on such higher post on officiating or acting charge basis only because requisite exercise of allowing regular promotion to such post was being delayed by competent authority and where he was subsequently found fit for such promotion and was so promoted on regular basis, then the civil servant was entitled not only to the salary attaching to such post but also to all consequential benefits from that very date from which he had put on the said post on officiating or acting charge basis.

(b) North-West Frontier Province Civil Servants Act (XVIII of 1973)---

---S. 8---Promotion---Acting charge---Date of promotion---Determination---Civil servants were promoted on 31-3-2000, on acting charge basis but Departmental Promotion Committee issued their notification of promotion on 27-5-2003---Grievance of civil servants was that their promotion was not considered from the date when they were promoted on acting charge basis---Validity---Civil servant who was asked to hold a higher post to which he was subsequently promoted on regular basis, was entitled to the salary etc. attaching to such post for the period that he held the same---Such civil servant was also entitled to any other benefits which might be associated with such post---If a vacancy existed in the higher cadre to which a civil servant was qualified to be promoted on regular basis but was not so promoted without any fault on his part and was instead put on such post on officiating basis, then on his regular promotion to such post, the civil servant would be deemed to have been so promoted to the same from the date from which he was allowed to hold the higher post, unless justifiable reasons existed to hold otherwise---Supreme Court converted petition for leave to appeal into appeal and set aside the judgment passed by Service Tribunal---Supreme Court declared the civil servants to be deemed to be promoted from 31-3-2000 and not from 27-5-2003---Appeal was allowed.

JUDGMENT

KHALIL-UR-REHMAN RAMDAY, J.---All these petitions, twenty-eight in number, involve identical questions of law and facts; arise out of the same consolidated judgment of the learned N.-W.F.P. Service Tribunal and are, therefore, being disposed of together through this single judgment.

2. The petitioners in all these cases were serving the respondent-Government as S.E.Ts. in different schools of the Province. Through a notification dated 31-8-2000, they were "ADJUSTED" against the higher posts of Subject-Specialists in the following terms:

"The following SETs holding M.A./M.Sc. Degrees in the relevant subject for the post of Subject Specialists on acting charge basis in the schools noted against each on seniority basis with immediate effect subject to the terms and conditions in vogue or ones to be framed in future."

3. After the petitioners had held the said higher posts of Subject Specialists and Headmasters for about three years, a further notification was issued on 27-5-2003 which read as under:

"On the recommendation of the Departmental Promotion Committee, the Competent Authority has been pleased to promote the following S.E.Ts. (BPS-16) (I/C S.S.) to the rank of Subject Specialists (BPS-17) on regular basis with immediate effect and adjusted in the schools as noted against their names."

4. The petitioners felt aggrieved of their promotion to the said post from 27-5-2003 and not from the date when they had been actually appointed to the said posts though on acting charge basis i.e. from 31-

10. They sought redress of their said grievance from the learned Service Tribunal but failed.

Hence these petitions.

5. It has not been denied even before us that clear vacancies of Subject Specialists existed on 31-8-2000. It has also not been denied that all the petitioners possessed the requisite qualifications for being regularly promoted to the said posts on the said date and no impediment existed in their way to such a promotion. The reason offered for not so doing was that since a large number of S.T.'s were to be promoted, therefore, it took the Departmental Promotion Committee some time i.e. about three years to do the needful. It was, however, submitted that no financial loss had accrued to the petitioners because during these three years when they were holding the said higher posts, they had been paid salaries etc. attached to the same.

7. The learned Tribunal non-suited the petitioners essentially on the ground that during the period in question when they were holding the higher posts on acting charge basis, they were entitled only to the salaries of the said posts and nothing more and that they were not possessed of any right to claim regular promotion from 31-8-2000. A mention had also been made by the learned Tribunal that during this period some twenty-seven persons had got directly recruited as Subject Specialists who had not been arrayed as parties to the appeals filed by the petitioners before the said learned Tribunal; that ante-dating the promotion of the petitioners to the said posts would adversely affect the seniority of the said direct appointees and since they had not been made parties to the said appeals, therefore, the sought relief could not be granted to them. From the impugned judgment of the learned Service Tribunal, an impression is also gathered that while refusing the said relief to the petitioners, the said learned Tribunal had also been influenced by the fact that they had not re-coursed to the available remedies in the year 2000 when they had been promoted to the posts in question on acting charge basis only and not on regular basis.

8. We have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also perused the record in the light of the submissions made before us.

9. It is then a position admitted on all sides that nothing existed in the way of the petitioners on 31-8-2000 which could have disentitled them to regular promotion to the posts in question and that it was only the usual apathy, negligence and bureaucratic red-tapism which had deprived the petitioners of the fruits that they deserved. The petitioners could not be punished for the faults and inaction of others. We are of the view that where a post was available against which a civil servant could be promoted; where such a civil servant was qualified to be promoted to such a higher post; where he was put on the said higher post on officiating or acting charge basis only because the requisite exercise of allowing the regular promotion to the said post was being delayed by the competent authority and where he was subsequently found fit for the said promotion and was so promoted on regular basis then he was entitled not only to the salary attaching to the said posts but also to all consequential benefits from the very date from which he had been put on the said post on officiating or acting charge basis and we hold accordingly.

10. The learned Tribunal had brushed aside some precedent cases cited before it including some cases of this Court by declaring that the same were distinguishable. We have gone through the said judgments delivered by this Court and find that the learned Tribunal had failed to read the said judgments properly and to appreciate the ratio of the same in its correct prospective.

11. One such judgment to which a reference had been made in detail in the impugned judgment was Sarwar Ali Khan's case reported as PLD 1994 SC 233. This was a case where a Deputy Registrar of the Sindh Labour Appellate Tribunal had been appointed to the post of the Registrar of the same Tribunal

judgment

5-7-1988 with immediate effect and till further orders but in his own pay and scale. It was almost three years later that he was regularly promoted to the said post on the recommendation of the Departmental Promotion Committee. Since there was no prospect of his further promotion beyond the post of Registrar, therefore, he had claimed only the salary of the post of Registrar which he had held on officiating basis for about three years and had prayed for nothing more. This claim was denied to him which finally led him to this Court. And this is what was held by this Court in the said facts and circumstances:

".... This cannot be stretched to cover the case in hand, where the incumbent has worked against that post on his own pay and status for three years, particularly when there was no legal impediment in his way to be promoted at that time on regular basis when he was inducted on 5-7-1988. In the instant case, since the appellant was eligible and qualified for promotion to B-18, there appears no justifiable reason to deprive him of the salary and other benefits of that post for a period of three years, which he would have received, had he been promoted on regular basis. The appellant had discharged full duties and responsibilities of the higher post and in the absence of some plausible reason, he cannot be deprived of the salary and other benefits connected with that post." (Underlining is ours).

12. Dealing with this judgment, the learned Tribunal had failed to appreciate the principle laid therein by this Court by omitting to give the requisite weight to the principle enunciated and the words "other benefits" emphasized by this Court through the said judgment.

13. Another judgment of this Court placed before the learned Tribunal for its guidance was the one delivered in the case of Chaudhry Mehmood Akbar reported as 2003 SCMR 13.

14. This was a case where Muhammad Afzal, the respondent in that case, while serving as Deputy Superintendent of Jail on 21-12-1989, was transferred and posted as Superintendent of Jail in his own pay and scale and it was almost five years thereafter i.e. on 1-9-1994 that he was regularly promoted to the said post of Superintendent. He reached the Service Tribunal claiming regular promotion from the date when he had been appointed to the said post of Superintendent i.e. from 21-12-1989 instead of the date of his regular promotion to the same i.e. on 1-9-1994. The learned District Attorney who represented the Government before the learned Tribunal did not object to the grant of the said relief and the same was accordingly allowed to him. One Muhammad Akbar questioned the said judgment of the learned Tribunal before this Court, submitting that he was senior to Muhammad Afzal in service; had been promoted to the post of Superintendent of Jail after Muhammad Afzal had been put on the said post in his own pay and scale but before his regular promotion to the said post on 1-9-1994 and that granting promotion to the said Muhammad Afzal with effect from 21-12-1989 would operate prejudicially to his seniority and interests vis-a-vis the said Muhammad Afzal. After hearing all the sides, this Court sanctified the promotion of Muhammad Afzal with effect from the date when he had been actually put on the said higher post i.e. with effect from 21-12-1989 subject only to the proviso that the same would not adversely affect the rights of the other Superintendents of Jail who were senior to the said Muhammad Afzal.

15. A bare perusal of these judgments would thus, show that this Court had always accepted the principle that a person who was asked to hold a higher post to which he was subsequently promoted on regular basis, was entitled to the salary etc. attaching to such a post for the period that he held the same; that he would also be entitled to any other benefits which may be associated with the said post and further that if a vacancy existed in a higher cadre to which a civil servant was qualified to be promoted on regular basis but was not so promoted without any fault on his part and was instead put on the said post on officiating basis then on his regular promotion to the said post, he would be deemed to have been so promoted to the same from the date from which he was allowed to hold the said higher post.

less justifiable reasons existed to hold otherwise.

16. The appeals filed by the petitioners before the learned Service Tribunal could not have been dismissed on the ground of limitation. Firstly, because it was the subsequent notification dated 27-5-2003 which had ordered their regular promotion not from the date that they had been promoted to the posts in question on acting charge basis but from the date of the said notification, which had caused grief to them. Therefore, limitation would start running against them not from 31-8-2000 but from 27-5-2003. And secondly, because on similar question of limitation, this Court had thus, held in Sarwar Ali Khan's case (supra)

"... it can be said that presumption favourable to the civil servant (appellant) would be that it was temporary arrangement and would not last long but it lasted for three years. Filing representation was also proper remedy and in such circumstances, it would not be fair to knock down service appeal as time-barred on the ground that first notification was not challenged."

17. This brings us to the question whether the petitioners could have been denied relief by the learned Tribunal on the ground that allowing relief in question to them could have operated to the prejudice of some persons who had been directly recruited to the posts of Subject Specialists between 31-8-2000 and 27-5-2003 and who had not been impleaded as respondents in the said appeals. Suffice it to say that the appeals filed by the petitioners before the Service Tribunal did not seek seniority over the said directly recruited persons and what they were asking for was the vindication of their right to regular promotion from the date in question and if the petitioners were found entitled to the same then they could not be deprived of it only because it could have caused some prejudice to some others nor could the said others be heard to deny the said benefit deserved by the petitioners. Therefore, we find that nonimpleading of the said direct recruits to the appeals filed by the present petitioners in the learned Tribunal could also be no ground to deny them a right which had lawfully accrued to them.

18. Having thus, examined all aspects of the matter and for the above-discussed reasons, all these petitions are converted into appeals which are allowed as a result whereof the impugned judgment of the N.-W.F.P. Service Tribunal is set aside and as a further result whereof it is declared that the petitioners (now appellants) shall be deemed to have been regularly promoted as Subject Specialists from 31-8-2000 and not from 27-5-2003.

19. No orders as to costs.

187 of the Constitution of Pakistan, 1973, this Hon'ble Court can direct respondent to strictly act in accordance with 2006 SCMR 1938 and judicial order of SMBR dated 1.10.2009. This hon'ble court has issued directions in writ petitions in case of Patwari Mumtaz v/s Govt. to follow the judicial order of Commissioner Mardan. (Copy of order of Mumtaz Patwari is Annexure "A/12").

- c. Because the authority who passes an order has got no power to undo the same and that authority becomes functus officio. Thus SMBR has no power to undo the same.
- d. Because there is neither provision of review in KPK Departmental Appeal Rules 1986 nor in Board of Revenue Act, 1967 and this hon'ble Court has struck down orders of SMBR whereby he changed his earlier orders in review. (Copy of order in case of Masood is Annexure "A/13").
- e. Because as per section 24-A General Clauses Act, solid reasons are required, but no reason muchless plausible has been shown in the revised final seniority list.
- f. Because act of respondent smacks malafide to promote their blue-eyed persons and thereafter petitioners would be thurted to prolonged litigation and justice delayed is justice denied.
- g. Because if the hands of respondents are not stopped, it will yield to corruption and evil practices and all efforts for the rule of law will go waste.
- h. Because such type of orders yields to lack of confidence of subordinates in their superior officers.
- i. Because Haider Hussain and Qaiser Naz have been given the same benefit thus petitioners are discriminated and Article 25/27 of Constitution are violated.





- 6) That final seniority list of Naib Tehsildar was prepared on 30.06.2010, wherein petitioner No.1 is shown at S.No.31 and petitioner No.2 at S.No.36.
- 7) That to the utter shock and dismay of petitioners another seniority list in the same year with the name of final revised seniority list was

prepared on 10.08.2010 and petitioners No.1 and 2 are lowered to S.No.169 and S.No.170 respectively without hearing or notice.

- 8) That petitioners were fit to be promoted as Naib Tehsildar at the time of first promotion in own pay and scale vide order dated 23.08.2006 on the basis of Tehsildar/ Naib Tesildar Service Rules 2001 as well as 2008.
- 9) That although issuance of revised seniority list is unprecedented and in violation of Section 8 of Civil Servant Act, 1973 as seniority is to be issued once in an year, however, petitioners filed representation dated 30.08.2010 against the revised final seniority list, which were received in the office on 30.08.2010 and notes were made upon the same but instead of finalizing the representations, respondent hurriedly convinced DPC on 31.08.2010, in order to promote their favourties.
- 10) That there was very hue and cry in the whole Board of Revenue, so the same could not be finalized but postponed to 20.09.2010.
- 11) That hon'ble High Court disposed off writ petition vide order dated 09.09.2012.
- 12) That appellant filed implementation petition wherein both the worthy SMBR and MBR concurred vide office note dated 01.11.2010 for extending same benefit to appellant as given to other like Said Rehman, Naib Din, Gulshan Mabood etc. and finally appellants service is regularized vide order dated 05.11.2010.
- 13) That in consequence of said order dated 05.11.2010 appellant was placed at S.No.31 in a tentative seniority list.
- 14) That astonishingly in final seniority list appellant is again lowered than the proper position in seniority list.
- 15) That four NTS junior to appellant have been promoted.

16). That appellant approaches this Hon'ble Authority on following grounds.

GROUND:

- a) Because there is no provision of issuing another revised seniority list in the same year, once tentative seniority list is culminated into final seniority list.
- b) Because as per Article 189 of Constitution of Pakistan, 1973, the precedent of Supreme Court is binding upon every citizen, including bureaucracy and especially when a judicial order has been passed in respect of the same and acted upon and vested right has been accrued to petitioner, thus as per Article 187 of the Constitution of Pakistan, 1973, this Hon'ble Court can direct respondent to strictly act in accordance with 2006 SCMR 1938 and judicial order of SMBR dated 01.10.2009. This hon'ble court has issued directions in writ petitions in case of Patwari Mumtaz v/s Govt. to follow the judicial order of Commissioner, Mardan.
- c) Because the authority who passes an order has got no power to undo the same and that authority becomes functus officio. Thus SMBR has no power to undo the same.
- d) Because there is neither provision of review in KPK Departmental Appeal Rules, 1986 nor in Board of Revenue Act, 1967 and this Hon'ble Court has strucked down orders of SMBR whereby he charged his earlier orders in review.
- e) Because as per section 24-A General Clauses Act, solid reasons are required, but no reason muchless plausible has been shown in the revised final seniority list.
- f) Because act of respondent smacks malafide to promote their blue-eyed persons and thereafter petitioners would be thurted to prolonged litigation and justice delayed is justice denied.

- g) Because if the hands of respondents are not stopped, it will yield to corruption and evil practices and all efforts for the rule of law will get waste.
- h) Because such type of orders yields to lack of confidence of subordinate in their superior officers.
- i) Because Haider Hussain and Qaiser Naz have been given the same benefit. thus petitioners are discriminated and Article 25/27 of Constitution are violated.
- j) Because after issuing order dated 05.11.2010 on the basis of order of Hon'ble High Court, decision of Supreme Court, giving proper position in tentative seniority list, summersault to square one in final seniority i.e. lowering again list cannot be made as it is against all canons of justice.

It is, therefore, humbly requested that appellant may please be considered for promotion w.e.f. when his juniors were promoted and the tentative seniority list be finalized as final seniority list to the extent of appellant.

ORDER

This order will dispose off the Departmental Appeal of the petitioner directed / filed against the final seniority list of Naib Tehsildars for the year 2010 wherein the petitioner was placed at S. No. 170 of the said seniority list.

Brief facts of the case are that the appellant was basically Assistant of the office of District Officer (R&E)/Collector, Swabi and was posted as Naib Tehsildar Upper Dir against the vacant post in his (Own Pay & Scale) on 19.08.2006. Subsequently, he was promoted as Naib Tehsildar on regular basis through Departmental Promotion Committee on 02.05.2009. Perusal of comments received from Assistant Secretary (Estt), Board of Revenue reveals that the petitioner was not given seniority for the period spent as Naib Tehsildar (Own Pay & Scale). The seniority given on the basis of Administrative order for the period spent as Naib Tehsildar (Own Pay & Scale) was rightly withdrawn.

Moreover, under Section 8(4) of the Civil Servants Act, 1973, seniority in a post, service or cadre to which a Civil Servant is promoted shall take effect from the date of regular appointment to the post. Appellant request for assigning seniority w.e.f 19.08.2006 can not be acceded to. Appeal is accordingly rejected.

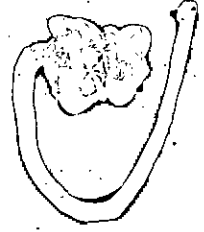
