

AG alongwith Mukhtiar Ali, Superintendent for official respondents No. 1 to 3 present.</p> <p>2. This judgment shall dispose of the instant service appeal No, 555/2013 titled "Mr. Fazal Rehman Versus Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa through Chief Secretary, Peshawar etc." as well as service appeal No. 566/2013 titled "Mr. Gohar Zaman Versus Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa through Chief Secretary, Peshawar etc." and service appeal No. 567/2013 titled "Haq Nawaz Versus Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa through Chief Secretary, Peshawar etc." as identical questions of facts and law are involved therein.</p> <p>3. Brief facts giving rise to the afore-stated service appeals are that final seniority list dated 31.12.2010 was issued on 05.10.2012 communicated to the appellants on 14.10.2012</p>

wherein appellants were placed at S. Nos. 168 to 170 despite the fact that they were to be placed senior to one Abdur Rashid, private respondent No. 4 who was placed at S.No. 64 of the seniority list. The appellants have prayed that they be placed above the said private respondent Abdur Rashid in the said seniority list.

4. Learned counsel for the appellant has argued that the appellants as well as the said private respondent No. 4 Abdur Rashid were serving on acting charge basis as Naib Tehsildars. That the appellants were reverted from the post of Naib Teshildar while the said private respondent No. 4 Abdur Rashid was promoted on regular basis constraining the appellants to prefer service appeals which were decided in their favour vide judgment passed 23.07.2010 in service appeal No. 559/2010. That on the basis of the same appellants were promoted to the post of Naib Tehsildar on regular basis w.e.f. 29.05.2008 vide order dated 02.09.2010. That despite implementation of the judgment and promotion of appellants w.e.f. 29.05.2008 appellants were shown junior in the seniority list to the said private respondent No. 4 as appellants were enlisted at S. Nos. 168 to 170 while private respondent No. 4 was enlisted at S. No. 64. That the impugned seniority list dated 31.12.2010 is therefore liable to correction by placing the appellants above position of private respondent No. 4.

5. Learned Addl. Advocate General has argued that the promotion of the appellants is under probe as they were not



entitled to promotion and as such the appellants are not entitled to claim seniority as regular Naib Tehsildars on regular basis w.e.f 29.05.2008. That the judgment of this Tribunal may hamper the proceedings and probe and as such the appeals of the appellants are liable to dismissal.


6. We have heard arguments of learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.


7. Position emerging from the judgment of this Tribunal dated 23.07.2010 and order dated 02.09.2010 based on the judgment of the Tribunal referred to above would suggest that the appellants were granted promotion as Naib Tehsildars (BPS-14) on regular basis w.e.f. 29.05.2008 while at the time of finalizing the seniority list they were erroneously shown at S.No. 168 to 170 of the said seniority list as their dates of appointment as Naib Tehsildar on regular basis was erroneously shown as 02.09.2010 i.e. the date of order of promotion instead of date of promotion of the appellants as Naib Tehsildars on regular basis i.e. 29.05.2008. We are therefore of the view that the appellants, being senior to private respondent No. 4 are entitled to be placed above the name and enlistment of the said private respondent in the seniority list.

8. For the above reasons we accept the appeals and as a consequence thereof direct that the seniority list dated 31.12.2010 be corrected by enlisting the names of the appellants above the name of private respondent No. 4 (Abdur Rashid). It is however added that if a consequence of any departmental action

appellants lose their present position or appointments then the seniority list updated on the strength of this judgment shall be liable to correction accordingly. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.







APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT 1974 AGAINST THE FINAL SENIORITY LIST DATED 31-12-2010 ISSUED ON 5-10-2012 COMUNICATED TO THE APPELLANT ON 14-10-2012 ,WHEREBY THE APPELLANT HAS BEEN PLACED WRONGLY AND ILLEGALLY AT SERIAL NO 168 INSTEAD OF ABOVE THE NAME OF ABDUR RASHID i.e. SERIAL NO 69 AND AGAINST NOT TAKING ACTION ON THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF APPELLANT WITHIN STAUTORY PERIOD OF NINETY DAYS

PRAYER: That on acceptance of this appeal the respondents may be directed to extent that the seniority list dated 31-12-2010 may be corrected by placing the appellant above at serial No.69 above the name of respondent No.3 (Mr. ABDUR RASHID N.T) with all consequential benefits. Any

other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit that may also be awarded in favor of appellant

R.SHEWATH:

- 1- That the appellant was initially appointed as patwari in the Revenue Department and later on was promoted to the post of Kanungo (BPS-09) vide order dated 15-1-2008 on the basis of seniority cum fitness. Copy of the promotion order is attached as annexure**A.**
- 2- That during service appellant passed Niab Tehsildari examination and later on the appellant was promoted to the post of Niab Tehsildar (BPS-14) on acting charge basis on the recommendations of the proper Departmental selection Committee vide order dated 2-7-2008.
- 3- That while working as Naib Tehsildar (BPS-09) an order dated 8-12-2009 was issued due to which the appellant was reverted to the post of kanungo from Naib Tehsildar without any plausible reason and justification. That respondent No.3 namely Abdur Rashid who was junior to the appellant was regularized on the post of Naib Tehsildar while the petitioner has been reverted to the post of kanungo illegally.
- 4- That feeling aggrieved appellant filed Departmental appeal and then knocked the door of this Honorable Service Tribunal Peshawar. That the said appeal was decided in favor of the appellant and subsequently vide order dated 2-9-2010 the service of the appellant has been regularized on the post of Naib Tehsildar (BPS-14) w.e. from 29-5-2008. Copies of the judgment and order are attached as annexure**B & C.**
- 5- That in the year 2010 a tentative seniority list was issued due to which the seniority of the appellant was placed below the

name of respondent No.3 (Abdur Rashid) who was much more junior to appellant. That appellant filed review against the said seniority list but inspite of that the said seniority list has been declared final by respondent No.2 vide Notification dated 5-10-2012 communicated to the appellant on 14-10-2012. Copies of the review and seniority list are attached as annexure
..... **D and E.**

6- That feeling aggrieved appellant filed Departmental appeal before the respondent No.2 but no reply has been received so far. Copy of the Departmental appeal is attached as annexure
..... **F.**

6- That having no other remedy appellant filed this appeal on the following grounds amongst the others.

GROUND:

A- That the impugned seniority list dated 31-12-2010 is against the law, facts, natural justice and materials on the record therefore not tenable and liable to be set aside.

B- That as evident from the aforesaid Judgment and order the services of the appellant were regularized vide order dated 29-5-2008 but the impugned seniority list issued on 5-10-2012 communicated to the appellant on 14-10-2012 is against the spirit of the aforesaid order and judgment of this Honorable Service Tribunal dated 23-7-2010.

C- That appellant has not been treated in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Pakistan 1973.

D- That appellant has been highly discriminated and not treated by the authorities in accordance with law and rules.

E- That despite of having senior to respondent No.3 to 102 the appellant has been placed junior to them by violating the appointment, promotion and transfer Rules 1989.

F- That appellant seeks the permission of this august court to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore most humbly prayed that the appeal of appellant may be accepted as prayed for.





JUDGMENT

ABDUL JALIL, MEMBER :- This appeal has been filed by the appellant against the order dated 8.12.2009 whereby he was reverted from the post of Naib Tehsildar (BPS-14) and posted as Kanungo (BPS-9).

2. Brief facts of the case are that the appellant was initially appointed as Patwari. He was promoted as Kanungo on 15.1.2007. He qualified Naib Tehsildari departmental examination. On the recommendation of Departmental Promotion Committee he was promoted as Naib Tehsildar on acting charge basis by the competent authority (SMBR). He was senior amongst his colleagues. He was senior to Respondent No. 4 (Abdur Rashid Khan). The appellant's promotion was withdrawn without hearing him or to issue show cause notice as such he was condemned unheard. The appellant was

promoted on acting charge basis in view of his eligibility and availability of vacancy of Naib Tehsildar. Respondent No. 4 who was junior to the appellant and was promoted on acting charge basis was regularized while the appellant was reverted.

3. Arguments heard and file perused.
4. The learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant was eligible for promotion. He was promoted on acting charge basis. Respondent No. 4 being junior to the appellant was also promoted on acting charge basis, but his services were regularized while the appellant was reverted. He referred this Tribunal judgment dated 19.5.2008, the relevant part of which is reproduced below :-

“15. The dispute, therefore, between the parties is not that whether Javed Khan was fit for promotion as Naib Tehsildar or to hold the post of Naib Tehsildar. The dispute was that whether Javed Khan could be appointed on regular basis in preference to both the appellants. As both the appellants are senior to Javed Khan (Respondent No. 2), the officially respondents were legally bound to consider the seniority of the appellants versus Respondents No. 2 and 5 and to appoint the senior most amongst them on regular basis, while the others were to be appointed either on acting charge basis or, as the case might be, on temporary basis till the arrival of recommendees of the NWFP Public Service Commission, or till a regular vacancy was, turn by turn, available for them.

In the light of the above, we partially accept both the appeals to the extent that the official respondents shall take up the exercise to consider the seniority of the appellants and respondents No. 2 and 5, and appoint the senior most amongst them on regular basis as Naib Tehsildar, while the others may be regularized as Naib Tehsildars as and when vacancies are available for them. But they shall remain as Naib Tehsildars for the periods for which their promotion as Naib Tehsildar is permissible under the law, either on current charge basis or on acting charge basis. In view of the complicated nature of the case, we leave the parties to bear their own costs.”

5. The A.G.P argued that the appellant is basically Field Kanungo and was promoted as Naib Tehsildar on acting charge basis through D.P.C. The Commissioner is fully empowered of the service matters of Naib Tehsildar, therefore, he reverted the appellant from the post of Naib Tehsildar. He referred Notification dated 12.12.2009 issued by the Establishment Department which says that the Divisional Commissioner is empowered to deal with the service matters of Naib Tehsildars. The appellant was

promoted on acting charge basis. It was a temporary promotion and when the recommendees of the Public Service Commission submitted their arrival reports, as a result the appellant was reverted to his original post to accommodate the recommendees of Public Service Commission. The nominees of the Public Service Commission have superior rights than the officials who were working on acting charge basis. He also contended that under the Provision of Section (9) of the NWFP Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules 1989 clearly envisages in Sub Section 6 that acting charge appointment shall not confer any vested right for regular promotion to the post held on acting charge basis.

6 He also argued that promotee Naib Tehsildars are in excess in the Division as per detail provided by the Commissioner office.

7. In the light of the above referred judgment, the official respondents shall take up the seniority of appellant and Respondent No. 4 and appoint senior most among them on regular basis as Naib Tehsildar while the other may be regularized as Naib Tehsildar as and when vacancies are available for them. But they shall remain as Naib Tehsildars for the period for which their promotion is permissible under the law either on current charge basis or on acting charge basis.

8. This judgment will also dispose of the other connected appeals bearing Nos. 560/2010 by Gohar Zaman and 568/2010 by Haq Nawaz, involving common question of law, in the same manner.

No order as to costs. File be consigned to the record.

SENIORITY LIST OF NAIB TEHSILDARS FOR THE YEAR 2010

Facts of the case are that the above named Kanungos of DIKhan Division were appointed as Naib Tehsildars by Board of Revenue vide order No. 1774-83/Admn:V, dated 02.07.2008 through Departmental Promotion Committee meeting on Acting Charge Basis. It is pointed out that M/S Gohar Zaman, Fazal Rehman, Haq Nawaz were reverted by Commissioner, DIKhan Division on 08.12.2009.

M/S Gohar Zaman etc filed appeals against their reversion order which was rejected by the Senior Member Board of Revenue. Aggrieved by the said order they filed appeals before the Service Tribunal which were accepted to the extent that senior most be appointed on regular basis and the others be regularized on the availability of vacancies. In pursuance of the Service Tribunal order dated 23.07.2010, they were promoted as Naib Tehsildars on regular basis on 02.09.2010 through Administrative order of the then Senior Member, Board of Revenue without holding DPC meeting.

They filed review petitions against the final seniority list of Naib Tehsildars for the year 2010 with the prayer that the seniority list issued on 05.08.2012 be corrected and they may be placed senior to Mr. Abdur Rashid appearing at S. No. 69. According to the 2008 seniority list of Kanungos of DIKhan Division, the official appears at S. No. 15, 17, 22 & 23. Comments received from Assistant Secretary (List), Board of Revenue is also perused.

Under Section 8(4) of the Civil Servants Act, 1973, seniority in a post, service or cadre to which a Civil Servant is promoted shall take effect from the date of regular appointment to the post. Petition / request for assigning seniority w.e.f 29.05.2008 can not be acceded to. Appeals are accordingly rejected.

4. The appellant is estopped by his conduct to bring the present Service Appeal.


ON FACTS

1. Para No.1 pertains to record and thus needs no comments.
2. Correct to the extent that the official was appointed as Naib Tehsildar on (Acting Charge Basis) on 02.07.2008.
3. Correct to the extent that on arrival of fresh appointees from Public Service Commission, the official was reverted to his original post.
4. Correct to the extent that the Hon'able Service Tribunal has ordered that official respondent appoint the senior most amongst the petitioners before it on regular basis as Naib Tehsildar while the others may be regularized as and when vacancies are available. But they shall remain as Naib Tehsildar for the period for their promotion is permissible under the law either on Current Charge Basis or on acting charge basis. The then Senior Member, Board of Revenue, considered and implemented the Judgment of Service Tribunal and issued an administrative order without holding Departmental Promotion Committee and regularized their services as Naib Tehsildar (the judgment/ order is annexed-A).
5. The name of the appellant and respondent No.3 have been included in the Seniority List of Naib Tehsildars on the basis of their promotion through Administrative Orders which are under review in the Department and an enquiry is also under process in National Accountability Bureau (Annexure-B).
6. Incorrect.

ON GROUNDS.

- A. Incorrect. The Seniority List was issued according to Law/Rules.
- B. Incorrect. His services were regularized through Administrative order without adopting proper procedure i.e holding of Departmental Promotion Committee which is the proper forum for promotion under Section – 5 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment Promotion and Transfer) Rules 1989.
- C. Incorrect. The appellant has been treated according to the law and rules.
- D. Incorrect. No discrimination has been done as Administrative promotion order has no legal footing.
- E. Incorrect. Promotion is always made with immediate effect, and not with retrospective effect.

In view of the above, the service appeal has no merits and may be dismissed with costs.

JUDGMENT

ABDUL JALIL, MEMBER :- This appeal has been filed by the appellant against the order dated 8.12.2009 whereby he was reverted from the post of Naib Tehsildar (BPS-14) and posted as Kanungo (BPS-9).

2. Brief facts of the case are that the appellant was initially appointed as Patwari. He was promoted as Kanungo on 15.1.2007. He qualified Naib Tehsildari departmental examination. On the recommendation of Departmental Promotion Committee he was promoted as Naib Tehsildar on acting charge basis by the competent authority (SMBR). He was senior amongst his colleagues. He was senior to Respondent No. 4 (Abdul Rashid Khan). The appellant's promotion was withdrawn without hearing him or to issue show cause notice as such he was condemned unheard. The appellant was

promoted on acting charge basis in view of his eligibility and availability of vacancy of Naib Tehsildar. Respondent No. 4 who was junior to the appellant and was promoted on acting charge basis was regularized while the appellant was reverted.

3. Arguments heard and file perused.

4. The learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant was eligible for promotion. He was promoted on acting charge basis. Respondent No. 4 being junior to the appellant was also promoted on acting charge basis, but his services were regularized while the appellant was reverted. He referred this Tribunal judgment dated 19.5.2008, the relevant part of which is reproduced below :-

15. The dispute, therefore, between the parties is not that whether Javed Khan was fit for promotion as Naib Tehsildar or to hold the post of Naib Tehsildar. The dispute was that whether Javed Khan could be appointed on regular basis in preference to both the appellants. As both the appellants are senior to Javed Khan (Respondent No. 2), the officially respondents were legally bound to consider the seniority of the appellants versus Respondents No. 2 and 5 and to appoint the senior most amongst them on regular basis, while the others were to be appointed either on acting charge basis or, as the case might be, on temporary basis till the arrival of recommendees of the NWFP Public Service Commission, or till a regular vacancy was, turn by turn, available for them.

16. In the light of the above, we partially accept both the appeals to the extent that the official respondents shall take up the exercise to consider the seniority of the appellants and respondents No. 2 and 5, and appoint the senior most amongst them on regular basis as Naib Tehsildar, while the others may be regularized as Naib Tehsildars as and when vacancies are available for them. But they shall remain as Naib Tehsildars for the periods for which their promotion as Naib Tehsildar is permissible under the law, either on current charge basis or on acting charge basis. In view of the complicated nature of the case, we leave the parties to bear their own costs."

5. The A.G.P argued that the appellant is basically Field Kanungo and was promoted as Naib Tehsildar on acting charge basis through D.P.C. The Commissioner is fully empowered of the service matters of Naib Tehsildar, therefore, he reverted the appellant from the post of Naib Tehsildar. He referred Notification dated 12.12.2009 issued by the Establishment Department which says that the Divisional Commissioner is empowered to deal with the service matters of Naib Tehsildars. The appellant was

promoted on acting charge basis. It was a temporary promotion and when the recommendees of the Public Service Commission submitted their arrival reports, as a result the appellant was reverted to his original post to accommodate the recommendees of Public Service Commission. The nominees of the Public Service Commission have superior rights than the officials who were working on acting charge basis. He also contended that under the Provision of Section (9) of the NWFP Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules 1989 clearly envisages in Sub Section 6 that acting charge appointment shall not confer any vested right for regular promotion to the post held on acting charge basis.

6 He also argued that promotee Naib Tehsildars are in excess in the Division as per detail provided by the Commissioner office.

7. In the light of the above referred judgment, the official respondents shall take up the seniority of appellant and Respondent No. 4 and appoint senior most among them on regular basis as Naib Tehsildar while the other may be regularized as Naib Tehsildar as and when vacancies are available for them. But they shall remain as Naib Tehsildars for the period for which their promotion is permissible under the law either on current charge basis or on acting charge basis.

8. This judgment will also dispose of the other connected appeals bearing Nos. 560/2010 by Gohar Zaman and 568/2010 by Haq Nawaz, involving common question of law, in the same manner.

No order as to costs. File be consigned to the record.



