		appellant was serving as Family Welfare Assistant (M)(BPS-05) when subjected to enquiry on the allegation of willful absence and
		dismissed from service vide impugned order referred to above.

- 4. Learned counsel for the appellant has argued that the impugned order is against facts and law as the appellant was neither proceeded against within meaning of Rule-9 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Govt Servant (E&D) Rules, 2011 nor afforded opportunity in the enquiry proceedings despite his availability. That the appellant has not remained absent and was condemned unheard.
- 5. Learned Government Pleader has argued that the appellant was proceeded against in accordance with law. That since the appellant has received show cause notice as such publication in two leading news papers as required under Rule-9 were not warranted. That the appellant was at Afghanistan and has never performed his duty. He also placed reliance on case law reported in 2011 PLC (C.S)990 (Supreme Court of Pakistan) wherein it was observed that when absence is admitted then there would be no need for conducting a formal enquiry.
- 6. We have heard arguments of learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.
- 7. Show cause notice placed on record would suggest that the same was issued on 11.04.2013. According the stance of the appellant he has received the same on 16.04.2013. The appellant was required to answer the allegation in the show cause notice within fifteen days from its date of delivery. The appellant has been dismissed from service on 29.04.2013 i.e. prior to the lapse of fifteen days as prescribed in the show cause notice dated 11.04.2013. In

such eventuality we are of the view that the competent authority has failed to adhere to the required procedure and has passed the impugned order without giving due attention to the contents and requirements of the said show cause notice.

8. We would, therefore, and without touching the other merit of the case, accept the instant appeal and as a consequence thereof reinstate the appellant in service for the purpose of enquiry and would place the respondents at liberty to conduct *de-novo* enquiry against the appellant on the afore-stated charges enumerated in the show cause notice within a period of two months from the date of receipt of this judgment. The respondents shall conduct the enquiry in accordance with the prescribed procedure wherein opportunity of hearing including defense should be afforded to the appellant. The issue of back benefits shall be subject to outcome of the *de-novo* enquiry. The appeal is accepted in the above terms. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.



  - b. That you kept the Population Welfare Department in dark regarding your ex-Pakistan engagement or leaving of the country.
  - c. That you committed gross negligience by keeping yourself engage in foreign country without seeking NOC from the competent authority.
  - d. That you could not defend yourself despite written direction.
- 2. As a result thereof I as competent authority have tentatively decided to impose upon you one of the penalties including removal from service under Rule 4 of the above rules.
- 3. You are therefore required to show cause as to why the above mentioned penalties should not be imposed upon you and also intimate whether you desire to be heard in person.
- 4. If no reply to this notice is received within 15 days of its delivery, it shall be presumed that you have no defense to put in and in that case an ex-parte action shall be taken against you.
- 5. A copy of the findings and recommendations of the Enquiry Committee is enclosed.

Appeal from the order bearing No.1 (15)/2013-Admn: dated 29/04/2013 whereby the District Population Welfare Officer, Peshawar, dismissed the services of the appellant

(male) BPS-5 in the District Population Welfare Office, Peshawar. The appellant has rendered 12 years service in the Department and had sufficient earned leave in his leave credit account.

The appellant in continuation of his leave on medical grounds till 14/12/2011 had applied for leave without pay for one year from 15/12/2011 to 14/12/2012 on grounds of some indispensable domestic affair but the appellant received no order either of acceptance of application or rejection. The appellant again submitted an application for leave for 5 months without pay from 15/12/2912 to 15/4/2013. However, as he had requested the competent authority to grant him leave without pay for the said period he remained on extraordinary leave.

The appellant's application, after medical leave, for one year extension as extra ordinary leave has not been accepted nor has his subsequent application for 5 months leave without pay been accepted and he knew of that only when he received a show cause notice on 16/04/2013 without intimating him in connection with any inquiry against him.

The appellant was preparing his reply to the show-cause notice but he received his dismissal order dated 29/04/2013, impugned above on 04/05/2013, which is illegal and unlawful on the following grounds:

1. The appellant has not been engaged in the process of inquiry and his legal and constitutional rights have been infringed.

- 2. The appellant has not been served upon any charge sheet, sheet of allegations and no reply thereto has been asked from him.
- 3. The appellant has not been given the opportunity of hearing.
- 4. The appellant has not been given the opportunity of legally stipulated time of 15 days mentioned in the show cause notice to reply to it.
- 5. That even the medical leave for one month of the appellant till 14.12.2011 has been considered as absence.

The appellant has been dismissed from service illegally and unlawfully; he therefore, submits the instant appeal before your honour in view of the above grounds. The appeal may very kindly be accepted as the appellant has served very regularly and to the satisfaction of his superiors. There is no previous complaint or disciplinary action against the appellant and still wants to serve under your kind control please.

#### PARA WISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENTS NO. 1 to 3

Respectfully Sheweth:

#### Preliminary objections:

- 1. That the appeal is not maintainable in its present form.
- 2. That the appellant / petitioner has no locus standi to file the appeal.
- 3. That the appeal is not maintainable due to non joinda & misjoinda of necessary factices
- 4. That the appeal is time barred.
- 5. That the appellant has not come to this tribunal with clean hands.
- 6. That the appellant has no cause of action.

#### Facts:

- 1. Incorrect. As per office record, the appellant was appointed as Family Welfare Assistant (Male), BPS-05 vide offer of appointment dated 26/05/2001.
- 2. Incorrect. The appellant uphold that he had got admission in ACCA qualification in Glasgow UK on 21/07/2009 (as contained in page No. 10 of the appeal) while 365 days leave without pay w.e.f 01/02/2008 was requested on 15/01/2008 citing domestic reasons (annex-A) and the same was granted.
- 3. Incorrect. The application for study leave of two years w.e.f 01/03/2009 to 28/02/2011 was not considered on the ground that his first request for one year leave was on the ground of domestic problems and the second request was for continuation of ACCA

study for which the appellant has not requested for NOC and continuously absented himself from duty at the cost of suffering his official duty. As a result, he was issued show cause notice and in reply to the show cause notice he informed that he had some land issues due to which he was out of Peshawar (annex-B). Keeping in view his reply, lenient view was taken and he was warned to be careful in future. If his carefulness is proved, his absence period from 01/03/2009 to 28/02/2011 will be converted into leave without pay.

- 4. Incorrect. The appellant didn't submit his arrival on 01/03/2011 at Family Welfare Centre Hazar khwani and continuously remained absent (copy of attendance register of Family Welfare Centre Hazar Khwani during March & April, 2011 is enclosed at annex-C).
- 5. Incorrect. On the verbal request of the appellant's father, he was posted in Family Welfare Centre Chaghar Matti where he reported for duty but continuously absented himself from duty as is evident from the statement of Mrs. Fozia Gul, Family Welfare Assistant (Female), Family Welfare Centre Chaghar Matti (annex-D).
- 6. Partially correct. He was given medical leave of one month w.e.f 15/11/2011 to 14/12/2011 but neither before nor afterward he could turn up for his official duty. It is also pertinent to mention that on expiry of his medical leave, he couldn't produce certificate of medical fitness.
- 7. False, misconceived and concocted, hence denied.
- 8. With regard to evidence on record i.e annexure-D & attendance register (annexure-E) regarding his continuous absence, the showcase notice issued upon the appellant by this office was legal and lawful. Matter of the fact is that according to the verbal statement of the father of the appellant, the appellant is doing some job in Afghanistan since 2009 and appears in ACCA Exam from there as mentioned in Examination Attendance Docket submitted by him along with his appeal, his center of examination is Kabul American University of Afghanistan Darul Aman Road Kabul (Annexure-F).
- 9. Pertain to record.
- 10. No comments.

Reply of each ground has been given below:-

#### <u>Grounds</u>

- A. Incorrect. The order is legal and lawful and an inclusive of the evidence on record.
- B. Incorrect. Though he submitted his arrival report in Family Welfare Centre Chaghar Matti but he remained willfully absent since then. Statement of the incharge of Family Welfare Centre Chaghar Matti manifests of his unauthorized absence (Annexure-G).
- C. Incorrect. During his absence, the District Population Welfare Officer, Peshawar visited the Family Welfare Centre Chaghar Matti on 15/11/2012 and found him absent. The remarks of which was recorded in the attendance register at annexure-E. knowing this, he managed medical certificate for grant of medical leave for one month from 15/11/2011 to 14/12/2011 but again he failed to submit his arrival report & medical fitness and remained absent from official duty without any intimation.

- D. Incorrect. Preliminary inquiry was conducted on complaint lodged by Incharge Family Welfare Centre Chaghar Matti in which statement of Family Welfare Assistant Chaghar Matti and attendance register was checked and it was observed that the appellant was continuously absent from his official duty since May, 2011 and there was no need of further inquiry in the matter. It may also be added that appellant was earlier warned to be careful in future but he couldn't improve himself and proved himself guilty of misconduct (inquiry report annex-H)
- E. As stated in Para-D above. It is also to mention that sufficient evidence was available on record and there was no need of further inquiry.
- F. Incorrect. The appellant failed to submit reply to the showcase notice wherein but he failed to submit reply.
- G. Show cause notice was issued on 11/04/2013 and the appellant was likely to submit his reply within the stipulated period of time but he failed to submit till date.

In view of the above submitted facts & evidence on record, the appeal is devoid of legal footing, merits and the appellant was dismissed under provision made in the E&D rules, therefore humbly prayed that the appeal may kindly be dismissed please.

# Inquiry report about the unauthorized long absenteeism of Mr. Sajid ali, Family Welfare Assistant (M)

As reported by the Incharge Family Welfare Centre Chaghar Matti on 25/2/2013, the District Population Welfare Officer being competent authority ordered undersigned to inquire into the matter regarding continuous absence of Mr. Sajid Ali Family Welfare Assistant BPS-05.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Mr. Sajid Ali was appointed as FWA-M in 2001. In 2008 he had applied for one year leave without pay on account of domestic reasons and the leave was granted. Again he applied for two years leave in 2009 for study purpose and the same was denied because it was transpired that his earlier request of one year leave was also for study purpose but he concealed the facts and absented himself and resultantly, a show cause notice was issued to him. In response to show cause reply the department took lenient view and warned him to be careful in future otherwise his services will be terminated without any warning.

On February 25, 2013 the Incharge of Family Welfare Center, Mrs. Rabia Gul complained that Mr. Sajid Ali is continuously absent since June, 2011.

#### **Proceedings:-**

The undersigned visited the FWC-Chagharmatti in order to ascertain the facts. It was observed that Mr. Sajid Ali remained regularly absent from his duty since his arrival report which was submitted on 20/5/2011. In the meanwhile in January, 2013 he managed to transfer himself from FWC Chaghar Matti to FWC Shakar Pura but he did not submit his arrival.

The FWA(F), FWC Chaghar Matti in her written statement stated that Mr. Sajid Ali never attended the FWC since his posting. She also added that the then Incharge Mrs. Sabiha Norin used to attend FWC twice a week and stressed her to mark the attendance of Mr. Sajid Ali but she refused to do so because Mr. Sajid Ali was regularly absent. However his father used to come to the center and deposit sale proceed. After her refusal, Mrs. Sabiha Noreen herself marked his proxy attendance. The undersigned went through the attendance

register record and observed that bogus sign of Mr. Sajid Ali were appended on the register. It is observed that Mr. Sajid Ali did not attend his duty since his posting in May, 20, 2011.

### **FINDINGS:**

- Mr Sajid Ali is absent from his official duty since his posting in FWC, Chaghar Matti since May 20, 2011.
- Mrs. Sabiha Noreen aided and abetted in the misconduct of MR. Sajid Ali.
- Some of field staff stated verbally that Mr. Sajid Ali is in Afghanistan and doing some job there.

#### Recommendation:

- Disciplinary action may be taken under the rules against Mr. Sajid Ali.
- Warning may be issued to Mrs. Sabiha Noreen for her role of giving illegal coverage to Mr. Sajid Ali.
