


The appellant is aggrieved with order dated 14.09.2012 vide which as many as 14 Sub Inspectors of the Police Department were confirmed under Police Rules- 13.1, 13.10.(2) and 13.18 . According to the appellant he was ignored despite the fact that he was senior to them and that he also performed as Offtg. <del>As</del> S.I w.e.f. 16.2.2002. Since his departmental appeal was also not replied, hence this appeal under Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974.</p> <p>3. Arguments heard and record perused.</p> <p>4. It appears from the reply of the respondent department that the appellant was on deputation. According to the said reply the S.Is who were confirmed vide impugned order dated 14.9.2012 had fulfilled the laid</p>



down criteria according to the rules but the appellant was found deficient, hence he was not confirmed.

5. While arguing for the appellant, the learned counsel for the appellant submitted that though service as SHO may be required for such confirmation but the respondent department did not provide any such opportunity to the appellant, therefore, he was wrongly penalized for no fault on his part. Conversely, it was submitted on behalf of the respondent department that for confirmation as Sub Inspector, display of performance as SHO is pre-requisite according to the Police Rules.



6. On the record, there is no cogent evidence that departmental appeal dated 10.10.2012 of the appellant has been examined by the respondent department as on record there is no order of the appellate authority. There is nothing on record like PER's of the appellant to show that the appellant was otherwise also deficient per laid down criteria beside performance as SHO, hence the matter of his suitability or non-suitability for confirmation cannot be examined by the Tribunal on the available record. In the stated circumstances, the Tribunal is of the considered view to remit the case of the appellant to the appellate authority with the direction to examine case of the appellant and to decide his appeal within a period of three months of the receipt of this judgment. The appeal is disposed off

accordingly. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record.

7. This judgment will also dispose of 2 other connected appeals bearing No. 499/2013 Umer Rehman and No. 500/2013 Muhammad Aurangzeb, involving common question of facts and law, in the same manner.

**PRAYER:**

*That on acceptance of this appeal the respondents may be directed to consider the appellant for confirmation in rank of S.I w.e.from February 2004 being due under Police Rules 1934 and have good record. Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit that may also be awarded in favour of appellant.*

**R.SHEWETH.**

- 1- That the appellant joined the Police Deptt: in the year 1980. The appellant has more than 30 years service at his credit with good record throughout.
- 2- That the appellant was confirmed as ASi w.e.from 1.7.2003 and was brought on List E, and was promoted as officiating S.I w.e.from 16.2.2002. All the dates are recorded in an order dated. 17.10.2009 the copy of which is attached as annexure – Annexure – A.
- 3- That the appellant's name in the E List is at S.No. 65 in the latest E list of Hazara Region whereas the names of the private respondents are far below that the appellant. Thus it is crystal clear that the appellant is senior to the private respondents. Copy of list is attached as Annexure – B.
- 4- That on 14.9.2012 an order was passed wherein the junior officials ( private respondents) were confirmed as S.I wher as the appellant was ignored despite he was due for confirmation as SI w.e.from April 2010 as per Police Rules 13:18. Thus the appellant was discriminated. Copy of the order is attached as Annexure – C.
- 5- That the appellant filed departmental appeal against ignoring him from confirmation on 10.10.2012 and waited for 90 days but no reply has been received by the appellant so far. Hence the present appeal on the following grounds amongst the others. Copy of the appeal with covering letter is attaché as Annexure – D.

**GROUNDS:**


- A- That not confirming the appellant as S.I w.e.from Feburary 2004 despite being due and not taking any action on the appeal of the appellant is against the Rules, norms of justice and material on record.
- B- That the appellant has been discriminated because many juniors SI to appellant have been confirmed while the said benefits have not been extended to appellant for no good reasons.
- C- That the appellant has good record and he is also entitled to the confirmation under Rule 13;18 of the Police Rules 1934 and other relevant rules.
- D- That many other officials have been confirmed as S.I by counting their officiating service towards probation period as special case. Thus the appellant is also entitled to the same benefits being have good record and reputation. Copy of the order is attached as Annexure – E.
- E- That the appellant is legally entitled for his claim and the respondents are also legally bound to treat the appellant according to the principles of justice by granting the appellant his due rights of confirmation without discrimination.
- F- That the appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed for.





Respected Sir,

1. With due deference it is submitted that I was enlisted as constable in 1980 in Abbottabad District Police. I had undergone lower class course in 1990 inter class course in 1994 and upper class course in 2010 from my respective District
2. That I was confirmed as ASI and brought on promotion list E with effect from 01-07-2003 (copy of order attached at Annex-A). According to my original seniority I was promoted as offg. Sub inspector with effect from 16-02-2002 with my other Colleagues correctly in order of merit Up to Promotion as Offg. SI my seniority and promotion remained intact.
3. That my service record and suitability reports were requisitioned from my borrowed department for confirmation in the rank of S.I. as my lien for further promotion is required to be made in my home District / region and it cannot be considered by the borrowed Department. Accordingly my suitability Report and service record with excellent/ok reports were sent from my borrowed Department. To the DIG of police Hazara Region Abbottabad. My ACRs are also satisfactory and there is nothing adverse against me. According to my original seniority as offg. SI in order of merit. I have undergone the upper class course, a pre-condition for confirmation as SI and further promotion to list F.
4. To confirm and promote the sub inspectors (Sis) a DPC was held on 31-08-2012 under the Chairmanship of DIG Hazara. 24 Sis appeared before the DPC including myself. 14 SIs were confirmed by DPC but my name was missing from the list of successful candidates list together with a few other Sis. It was a big shock for me and other deprived candidates. We were verbally informed that since we have not served as SHO out of home District for about one year period hence we were not considered for confirmation as SI.
5. For your kind information Sis who even never served as SHO and also had not qualified upper class course (a pre-condition for confirmation and promotion) during their service have been confirmed as Sis and promoted as officiating inspectors. Since I have qualified upper class course I believe I was deprived of my legitimate right of confirmation as SI and further promotion to officiating inspector keeping in view my past honest and dedicated performance for the department.

6. I also submit to the competent authority that now the situation is almost completely different because now in the department the number of Sis goes in to several hundreds and hence it is not possible that every Si should be posted as SHO keeping view the small number of police stations and frequently increasing numbers of SI in the province. Kindly also look in to this situation for future course of action in this regard.
7. Further I wish to point out here that if I had been posted as SHO of any police station out of my district by competent authority during serving period under reference I would have taken charges as SHO. The fact is that I have never given a chance to serve as SHO and subsequently I never refused to accept this challenging SHO position. Posting at any place as SHO is the absolute authority and discretion of the commanding officer and being SI how can I get posted myself as SHO and hence it is not my fault or failure. I have not been posted as SHO by the department during the period under reference hence in my case question of serving as SHO as per police rules 13.10 (2) does not apply for confirmation as SI.
8. At the time of previous DPC held in July 2011 DIG Hazara on our requests issued a letter No.10042/E dated Abbottabad 23-07-2011 in which he had very strongly asked PPO to look into this alarming issue and reconsider affected employees applications for confirmation like other departments I. e. CID crime Branch, training centers, Elite Force' s employees who have been given special consideration for waving off the condition of SHO duty outside the home district and likewise traffic police officials may also be given the same concession as had been given to above departments employees.

In view of the above facts and circumstances it is most earnestly prayed that my case may kindly be given your kind and sympathetic consideration and I may kindly be confirmed as SI. With my other colleagues with effect from ~~7-6-2011~~ in order to save me from irreparable loss and thrashing back unwontedly in my seniority I had maneuvered during my long and excellent Services.

I shall be thankful for this act of kindness and pray for your long life and prosperity.

Copies of the DPCs and the said rules are attached as Annexure "A, B, & C".

Executive Engineer/Deputy Director (BS-18) on 13-11-1995. In 1992 a new post of Director/Superintending Engineer (Horticulture) was notified on 25-4-1992, which was to be filled through promotion from Deputy Director (Horticulture) (BS-18) having 12 years service in (BS-17) and above or 7 years service in (BS-18). As claimed by the petitioner, he had legitimate expectation for such promotion being sole candidate having requisite eligibility. However, Ministry of Housing and Works converted/re-designated this post of Director (Horticulture) into that of Superintending Engineer (Planning and Design), which was allocated to the office of Chief Engineer, Central Zone vide letter dated 1-4-2004. Being aggrieved of the said conversion/re-designation, the petitioner approached the Federal Service Tribunal after rejection of his departmental appeal.

3. Learned Advocate Supreme Court for the petitioner mainly contended that the conversion/re-designation was violative of law as it was objected to by the Ministry of Finance, resultantly, the said re-designation has to be withdrawn. It was argued that such re-designation of the post was tainted with malice in order to deprive the petitioner of his vested right of being promoted to the said post. Learned Advocate Supreme Court contended that the petitioner was entitled to all the benefits of promotion after his retirement. In support of his contentions, learned Advocate Supreme Court for the petitioner has placed reliance on 1997 PLC (C.S.) 77, 1998 SCMR 736, PLD 1991 SC 1118, 1998 PLC (C.S.) 980, 1991 PLC (C.S.) 587, 1985 SCMR 1158, PLD 1997 SC 84, PLD 2003 SC 110, 2007 SCJ 41, 1997 PLC (C.S.) 1210 and 2001 PLC (C.S.) 654.

4. Having considered the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner, we find the same to be without force. It goes without saying that promotion to a certain post, has never been considered to be a vested right of a civil servant. It is well recognized principle of law that in case of non-selection post, the promotion is made on the basis of seniority cum fitness and no civil servant can ask for, or claim a promotion as a matter of right as it is within the exclusive domain of the government. Neither the promotion could take place automatically, nor the seniority alone is the deciding factor, as number of factors constitute fitness for promotion. The learned Advocate Supreme Court for the petitioner has not been able to show that there was any malice on the part of the respondents, so far as the conversion/re-designation of the post is concerned. An act of mere technical irregularity having been instantaneously rectified by the respondents after being pointed out by Ministry of Finance, per-se would not be sufficient to hold that such action has any taint of malice on the part of respondent Ministry. The conversion of the post was notified on 1-4-2004 and it is not the case of the petitioner that he was denied the right of consideration for promotion before the said date. It appears that soon after the rectification of the irregularity on 12-11-2005, the petitioner was allowed the charge of Director (Horticulture) (BS-19) on 31-1-2006 and after assuming the charge of higher post he was allowed special pay also for the same. Subsequently, on 4-8-2006, the petitioner was notified to be promoted on the said higher post on regular basis.

5. It is an admitted fact that during the pendency of his appeal the petitioner stood retired, as such could not be considered for promotion with retrospective effect.

6. It may be noted that the question of ante-dating the promotion would only arise, in case if, the petitioner was already promoted, which was admittedly not the case of the petitioner. We have had the benefit of considering the case law relied upon by learned Advocate Supreme Court for the petitioner, but it was found to be of no help to advance the case of the petitioner. The Federal Service Tribunal has dealt with the case of the petitioner strictly in accordance with settled principles of law. There is no illegality or perversity in the impugned judgment as such it requires no interference. The petition being without merit is therefore dismissed and leave declined.

Petition dismissed.

3. The respondent after submitting the departmental representation approached the Tribunal by filing an appeal, which had been accepted through the impugned judgment. Hence, this petition for leave to appeal by the Government of N.W.F.P.

4. We have considered the contentions raised by the learned Law Officer for the petitioners as well as respondent No.1 who appeared in person. We have also gone through the documents appended with this petition. We have noticed that apart from non-performance of duty as SHO, the reasons advanced by the Promotion Committee for non-confirmation and supersession were bad reputation, corruption and immoralities. We have gone through the reports appended with this petition and none of them speaks about corruption and immorality.

5. Furthermore, there is a force in the argument of the respondent that he had been treated in a discriminatory manner as two other officials namely Gulfat Hussain and Muhammad Ishfaq respecting whom the similar remarks were made, had already been confirmed.

6. So far as the ground of not completing a period of one year as an officiating Sub-Inspector in independent charge of a police

station in a district other than that in which his home is situated is concerned, he cannot be non-suited on that ground as he had already been placed on list "E" for the last more than 10 years and posting having an independent charge of a police station was not within his own control. If the authorities have thought him fit for the list "E" for his promotion to the rank of Sub-Inspector, he could have been tested for the same within all this period of more than 10 years. It would be advantageous to reproduce the determination of the Tribunal which is in the following terms:-

"The record shows that the appellant joined his service as ASI in the Police department. He served for sufficient time in different places of his posting. He also qualified all the training/courses and subsequently was promoted as offg. S.I. and his name was also brought on promotion list "E". He also passed the upper class course in the year 1994 and was thus eligible for confirmation. During this period no complaint or adverse entry has been made against him in his service record. A departmental Promotion Board was convened in Police Lines, Peshawar on 24.1.2001 for confirmation of Sub Inspectors under the Chairmanship of D.I.G. Peshawar Range in which the appellant was not confirmed as S.I. only on the basis of having bad reputation, corruption and immorality, and was thus superseded. But this fact is not supported by a single instance on the record much less in his ACRs which are good throughout. No plausible reasons have been given for the said act, in spite of the fact that the appellant deserved his promotion. No notice etc, regarding his bad reputation, corruption was produced before the court to prove the charge against the appellant. So the observation made by the Board is based on surmises and conjectures which cannot be considered in the eyes of law. It is thus clear that his case for confirmation has been mis-handled in a perverse manner."

7. The Learned Law Officer appearing for the petitioners has failed to point out any illegality in the impugned judgment, particularly so when other persons with same remarks were confirmed subsequently. Even otherwise, no question of law of general public importance as contemplated within the purview of Article 212(3) of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan is involved in the present case warranting interference in the impugned judgment. Resultantly, for what has been stated above, the instant petition being devoid of any merit is hereby dismissed. Leave is refused.

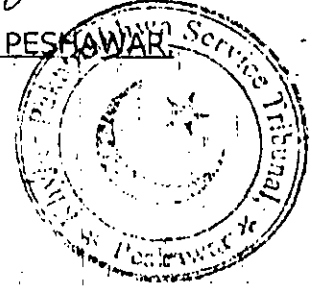

JUDGMENT

NOOR ALI KHAN, MEMBER.- This appeal has been filed by Shakeel Ahmad, the appellant under Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act 1974, against the order of respondent No. 2 dated 12.11.2012, whereby the application of appellant for confirmation in the rank of Sub Inspector was rejected. It has been prayed that on acceptance of the appeal, the impugned order may be set aside and the appellant be confirmed in the rank of Sub Inspector with retrospective effect enabling the appellant to get equal treatment like his other colleagues.

2. Brief facts of the case as narrated in the memo: of appeal are that the appellant joined the Frontier Reserve Police, on 4.4.1995 as Constable and served efficiently and to the entire satisfaction of his superiors. He was gradually promoted as Assistant Sub Inspector on 28.9.2007 and according to Rule 13.18 of Police Rules 1934, he was confirmed in the rank of ASI and his name was brought on promotion list "E" w.e.f. 1.7.2010 vide order dated 30.7.2010. On 29.1.2009, the appellant was promoted as Sub Inspector and assumed the charge of the post. The appellant was further promoted as Inspector on adhoc basis and posted as Reserve Inspector (Headquarter) Police Lines, Peshawar. The appellant being eligible in all respect, approached the respondent No. 3 for his confirmation/promotion in the rank of Sub Inspector, which was recommended and forwarded to respondent No. 2. The departmental appeal of the appellant was rejected on 12.11.2012 with the remarks that no ASI shall be confirmed in a substantive vacancy in the rank of SI unless he has been tested for at least a year as an officiating SI independent charge of a Police Station in a District other than that in which his home is situated or three years deputation period as Officiating Sub Inspector in Special Branch, PTC Hangu CID according to CPO direction during the year 2000 and two years in investigation/Elite Force as per Standing Orders. Hence the present appeal.

3. The appeal was admitted to regular hearing on 4.12.2012 and notices were issued to the respondents. The respondents have filed their joint written reply and contested the appeal. The appellant also filed rejoinder in rebuttal.

4. Arguments heard and record perused.

5. The learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant was promoted as Assistant Sub Inspector on 28.9.2007 and according to Rule 13.18 of Police Rules 1934, he was confirmed in the rank of ASI and his name was brought on promotion list "E". The appellant has been promoted as Sub Inspector on 29.1.2009 and served for sufficient time and eligible for confirmation/promotion in the rank of S.I Substantively. He also qualified upper College Course with excellent service record. As per Police Orders the duties and responsibilities of Frontier Reserve Police are the same as those of Regular Police and in the light of the notification dated 15.1.1988, Police Rules are fully applicable to Frontier Reserve Police. In the financial year 2002-03, the Finance

Department had also declared the FRP as a permanent budgetary force. So the appellant has the fundamental right to be dealt with in the same manner as the officers of the regular police. Under Rule 13.18 of Police Rules 1934, after successful completion of two years as Offtg. S.I he has to be confirmed w.e.f. 1.7.2010.. He stated that the appellant could not post himself as independent SHO to meet the requirement for confirmation. It was the responsibility of the respondents to post him as independent SHO! He produced a copy of judgment dated 23.5.2011, in Service Appeal No. 407/2011 of this Tribunal and stated that in similar circumstances, confirmation has been granted to appellant in the aforementioned service appeal without spending a period of one year independent SHO. The appellant is also entitled to the same treatment. He requested that the appeal may be accepted as prayed for.

6. The learned AAG argued that the appellant was promoted to the rank of ASI on 28.9.2007 and was later on confirmed into the same rank on 1.7.2009. He was promoted as SI but on officiating basis on 29.1.2009. For confirmation in the same rank he has to fulfill the requirements under the rules. The appellant has not spent one year as independent SHO which was one of the basic criteria for confirmation as Sub Inspector, hence he was not entitled for confirmation under Police Rules and Standing Orders. Hence his application for confirmation has rightly been turned down by the competent authority. He requested that the appeal may be dismissed.

7. The Tribunal observes that the main issue which falls for determination in the present case is that whether the appellant has rightly been ignored by the respondent department from confirmation/promotion as S.I on the ground of his not fulfilling the requirement to serve as SHO for a period of at least one year outside his home district before he is confirmed as S.I. The appellant was promoted as ASI on 28.9.2007 and according to Rule 13.18 of Police Rules 1934, he was confirmed and his name was brought on promotion list "E" w.e.f. 1.7.2010 vide order dated 30.7.2010. On 29.1.2009, he was promoted as Sub Inspector on officiating basis and assumed the charge of the post. The appellant also passed the Upper College Course and further promoted as Inspector on adhoc basis on 27.8.2010 and posted as Reserve Inspector (HQ) Peshawar, where he still serving in that capacity. It was the prerogative/discretion of the departmental authority to post him as SHO, for which the appellant cannot be held responsible and <sup>should not</sup> suffer for the acts of others. Under Rule 13.18 of Police Rules 1934, he has to be confirmed on successful completion of two

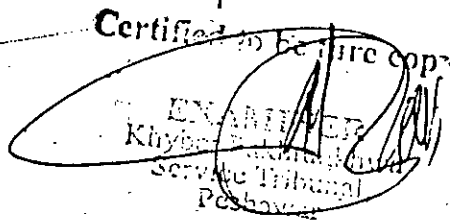
years period of probation or reverted back to his substantive rank. Since the appellant has not been reverted, and has further been promoted as Inspector on adhoc basis, was entitled for confirmation.

8. In view of the above, the appeal is accepted, the impugned order is set aside and the respondent department is directed to confirm the appellant as Sub Inspector w.e.f. 1.7.2010. as per rule 13.18 of Police Rules 1934. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record.

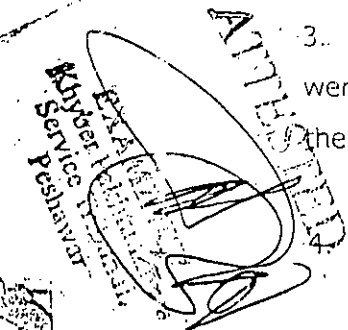
JUDGMENT

SYED MANZOOR ALI SHAH, MEMBER. This appeal has been filed by Nasir Khan, the appellant under Section 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974, against the order dated 30.7.2010, whereby his name has been included in List "F" with immediate effect instead of 20.2.2003 and against the order dated 17.1.2011, communicated to the appellant on 7.2.2011, whereby his departmental appeal has been filed. It has been prayed that on acceptance of the appeal, the impugned order dated 30.7.2010 may be modified to the extent that name of the appellant be enlisted in list "F" with effect from 20.2.2003 with all consequential and service benefits.

2. Brief facts of the case are that the appellant initially joined Frontier Reserve Police as Constable on 2.5.1991. After passing lower course at PTC Hangu, he was promoted to the rank of officiating Head Constable on 14.4.1998. In the year 1998, the appellant passed intermediate course at Hangu and his name was brought on list "D" w.e.f. 20.10.1998. On 17.2.2000, he was promoted as Selection Grade Head Constable in BPS-9 and on 4.4.2000; he was promoted as Officiating ASI in the FRP Headquarter, Peshawar. After qualifying Upper School Course at Hangu in the year, 2000, and being eligible for promotion, he was promoted to the rank of Officiating S.I under Police Rules 13.18, vide order dated 20.2.2001, on probation period for two years. His name was brought on List "E" w.e.f. 20.2.2002 and the same was also reflected in the Police Gazette. On 12.4.2002, the appellant filed an application for his transfer to his parent District Police Peshawar. The appellant already passed Lower Intermediate and Upper School Course and also on list "E". The post was available and the appellant was issued proper NOC and transferred to Capital City Police, Peshawar. He also applied for transfer of his lien to Capital City Police, and vide order dated 8.10.2002, his lien has been transferred from FRP to Capital City Police Peshawar with immediate effect and his name was placed at the bottom of seniority list "E" of Officiating S.Is in Capital City Police and allotted him Provincial Police number 167/P. In pursuance of CPO/DPC decision vide No. 18322/E-II, dated 8.9.2003 and No. 13161/E-II, dated 12.6.2007, the appellant had been reverted to the rank of IHC with effect from 8.9.2003 vide order dated 22.10.2007. After exhausting departmental remedy, he filed service appeal No. 1101/2007 in this Tribunal. The case was accepted as prayed for and the impugned orders were set aside by restoring the appellant's seniority on list "E" w.e.f. the notification dated 20.2.2002 to his original position with all back/service benefits. Vide order dated 30.7.2010, the appellant was promoted to the rank of Officiating Inspector and his name was also brought on list "F" but with immediate effect instead of 20.2.2003. Feeling aggrieved, the appellant filed departmental appeal on 21.8.2010, which was rejected on 17.1.2011, copy received by the appellant on 7.2.2011, hence the present appeal on 3.3.2011, which is well within time.

3. The appeal was admitted to regular hearing on 22.3.2011 and notices were issued to the respondents. They filed their joint written reply and contested the appeal. The appellant also filed rejoinder in rebuttal.

Arguments heard and record perused.



5. The learned counsel for the appellant argued that the appellant was promoted as Offtg. S.I on 20.2.2001. Under Rule 13.18 of Police Rules, 1934. He has to be confirmed on successful completion of two years probation period or reverted back to his substantive rank. Since the appellant has not been reverted therefore, he stood confirmed as Sub Inspector automatically w.e.f. 20.2.2003. He further argued that in the instant case basic right of the appellant has been violated, and there is no need of impleadment of junior colleagues of the appellant as respondents. In support of his arguments, the learned counsel relied on 2006-SCMR 1938. He stated that Inspector Zain Khan, has also filed service appeal for the same relief, which was accepted in limine, and while implementing the judgment dated 29.5.2007, he has been assigned revised seniority into promotion list "F" w.e.f. 15.12.1998. The appellant is also entitled to the same treatment as per judgment of the august Supreme Court of Pakistan as reported in 1996-SCMR-1185. The learned counsel for the appellant further stated that previously, the appellant filed service appeal No. 1101/2007, which was accepted on 23.9.2008 and his seniority restored on list "E" with effect from the notification dated 20.2.2002 to his original position with all back service benefits, but the department did not give all the back service benefits to the appellant despite of several presentation by the appellant. He requested that the appeal may be accepted as prayed.

6. The learned AGP argued that it is true that the appellant qualified Upper College Course in the year 2000, but the FRP was a temporary force till 2007 and all promotions in FRP were given as Officiating/temporary as per government policy. He further argued that name of the appellant was brought on list "F" and was promoted to the rank of Inspector on Officiating basis w.e.f. 30.07.2010. The appellant did not remain as SHO of a Police Station for a period of one year at relevant time and was confirmed in the rank of Sub Inspector and his name was also included in List "F" after serving for a period of three years w.e.f. 2.12.2005 to 1.12.2008, in Special Branch which was mandatory for confirmation as per Police Rules/Standing Order. So far as his reversion to the rank of IHC is concerned, the appellant was later on restored as per the judgment dated 23.2.2008 of this Tribunal and his grievances have been redressed. He requested that the appeal may be dismissed.

7. The Tribunal observes that the appellant was promoted as Officiating Sub Inspector vide order dated 20.2.2001. He would be on probation for a period of two years as per Rule 13.18 of Police Rules 1934. After completing two years period, the appellant stood automatically confirmed in absence of any order regarding extension of his probation period by the competent authority. It is also against the spirit of Police Rules 1934 to keep an official on probation for a long period, which

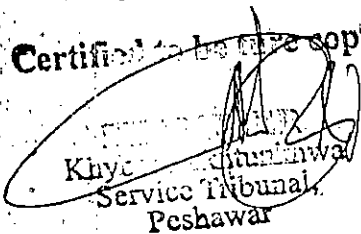
also resulted in confirmation and promotion of junior officials prior to the appellant. So far as the period of one year as independent SHO is concerned that also hold no ground because it was for the authority to give the appellant assignment of SHO being the discipline force, the appellant could not post himself as independent SHO to meet the requirement. The Tribunal also noted that the appellant remained independent Incharge of various Sections of Establishments i.e. OSI/FRP, Mess Manager of HQRs, Police FRP, Clothing Godown, Fuji Missal Section, Sector Commander Traffic Police as well as Additional SHO in various Police Stations, which also satisfy the condition of one year independent Service. The appellant has been confirmed w.e.f. 24.11.2008 instead of 20.2.2003, vide notification dated 18.11.2009 and his name was brought on list "F" vide notification dated 30.7.2010 with immediate effect and promoted as Inspector on officiating basis. So junior to the appellant have become senior to him and has been discriminated. The Tribunal agrees with the arguments advanced by the learned counsel for the appellant.

8. In view of the above, the appeal is accepted, the impugned notification dated 30.7.2010 is modified to the extent of appellant by enlisting his name in list "F" w.e.f. 20.2.2003 with all consequential/back benefits. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record.
