APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KP SERVICE TRIBUNALS ACT, 1974 AGAINST THE SENIORITY LIST DATED 31.07.2021 OF ADEO'S & ASDEO'S BPS-16 REGULAR MANAGEMENT CADRE MALE. AND ALSO AGAINST NOT DECIDING THE DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT WITHIN STATUTORY PERIOD OF 90-DAYS.

PRAYER:

THAT ON THE ACCEPTANCE OF THIS APPEAL IMPUGNED SENIORITY LIST DATED 31.07.2021 MAY BE CORRECTED BY AWARDING CORRECT MERIT POSITION IN THE MERIT LIST WITH ALL BACK BENEFITS. FURTHER THE DEPARTMENT MAY ALSO BE DIRECTED TO CONSIDER THE APPELLANT FOR PROMOTION TO THE POST OF SDEO'S BPS-17 W.E.F MUHAMMAD SALIM PROMOTED BEING JUNIOR TO THE **AUGUST** WHICH REMEDY TRIBUNAL DEEMS FIT AND APPROPRIATE AWARDED IN FAVOUR OF THE MAY ALSO BE APPELLANT.

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:



FACTS:

- 1. That the appellant got appointed as ASDEO on 05.05.2011 and working in District Nowshera on the same post. Copy of appointment orders dated 05.05.2011 is attached as Annex-A.
- 2. That there was tug of war going on between teaching cadre and management cadre employees. The teaching cadre employees were given undue favour and were accommodated on the posts of management cadre. However, certain judgments of this Honorable Court were passed and it was held that the teaching cadre employees shall not hold the post of Management cadre as it would give rise to corruption and corrupt practices. It was elaborately discussed in the initial judgment that these kinds of employees are involved in corruption in Education Department and Mismanagement by the superiors in posting and transfers have collapsed all the departments.
 - 3. That after passing of the judgment, contempt of court petitions as well as writ petitions were filed and in those petitions, it was directed that the posts of Management Cadre and teaching cadre shall be rationalized and the service structure of Management cadre employees shall be framed. Later on, the service rules of management cadre employees came into being; however, the teaching cadre employees still hold the posts of Management Cadre employees which have affected their seniority. Copies of Judgment dated 11.01.2018, and judgment dated 12.06.2018 are attached as Annex-B & B1.
 - 4. That as mentioned above, service structure/rules came into being in the year 2018 and fresh seniority list was issued by the respondents on 17.08.2018, however, the errors and issues therein were not rectified by the respondents which were obligatory on the part of respondents and to redress the grievances of those employees whose seniority was affected due to wrong entry in the list. Copy of service rules of management cadre employees and seniority list dated 17.08.2018 are attached as Annex-C & D.
 - 5. That it is important to mention here that a regulation 29(g) which has been imposed by the respondents on the petitioners only got deleted vide notification No. PSC/Regulations/2003 dated 12.02.2011. The regulation 29(g) as deleted is reproduced here as under for assistance of this Honorable Court:
 - 1. One mark shall be deducted for passing an examination in parts or availing additional attempt either in case of failure in one or more than one subjects or improvement of marks or division in any examination. One mark shall be deducted supplementary qualify in candidates who the The whole. a if as Examination even

Universities/Institutions who run two Sessions in a year i.e Spring and Autumn, the spring will be considered Annual and Autumn Supplementary. Therefore, one mark will be deducted who qualify in autumn. The deduction ceiling shall be four in the case of professional and three for non-professional posts.

- 6. That the appellant filed appeal for correction of seniority and merit position, on the basis which inquiry committee was constituted vide order dated 09.07.2020 to dig out the real facts. The inquiry officers gave recommendation in favour of the appellant. Copy of the inquiry report is attached as annexure-E.
- 7. That even after inquiry report the seniority position was not corrected by the respondents, so for the said purpose the appellant also approached to Peshawar High court Peshawar but not succeeded. Now the deptt: issued another seniority list wherein seniority position of the appellant is same. The every seniority list give fresh cause of action, so the appellant being feeling aggrieved filed departmental appeal against the same. Which was not responded within statutory period of 90 days hence the present appeal on the following grounds amongst others. Copies of seniority list dated 31.07.2021 and departmental appeal are attached as Annex-F & G.

GROUNDS:

- A) That the inaction of the respondents by not allowing three marks to the appellant in the merit list under regulation 29 (g) is against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and material on the record.
- B) That appellant has not been treated by the respondents in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article 4 & 25 of the Constitution of Pakistan 1973.
- C) That all public powers are in the nature of a trust and public functionaries must act as repository to such trust. In the instant case, the respondents were under legal obligation to process the claim of the appellant as per rules and law but instead of doing the same the respondents issued the final seniority list for the cadre of ADEO's BPS-16.
- D) That the respondents acted in arbitrary and malafide manner but not placing the petitioners at the right position in the merit list as well as seniority prepared for the post/cadre of ADEO's BPS-16.
- E) That the respondents violated Article 38(e) of the Constitution of the Pakistan 1973 by not allowing due place to the appellant in the open merit list as well as in the seniority post/cadre of ADEO's BPS-16.

- That respondents inspite of knowing the fact that Regulation 29 (g) has been deleted vide Notification dated 12.02.2011 has wrongly and illegally deducted three marks from appellant which caused the appellant badly in the merit list as well as in the seniority list.
 - G) That in the Year 2014 the respondent No. 2 revised the merit list for the cadre of ADEO's BPS-16 wherein many colleagues of the appellant have been allowed their required marks in light of the said deletion of regulation 29 (g) of the rules ibid. that appellant also requested the concerned authorities but of no avail.
 - H) That the respondents discriminated the appellant on the subject noted above and as such the impugned merit list and seniority list are not tenable in the eye of law.
 - I) That as mentioned in the Department Appeal (Annexed-G) that Muhammad Salim who have merit position i.e 63/35 marks is junior to the applicant/appellant because of his less interview marks as per rules 33 clause 2 & 3 of regulation 2003; the said ADEO has been already promoted to the post of SDEO vide Notification No. SO(SM)E&SED/3-2/2018/Promotion of ASDEO BPS-16 to SDEOs BPS-17 dated 04.09.2019. so the appellant is also entitled to be promoted w.e.f the date of Mr. Muhammad Salim gets promoted vide Amendments Rule 2017 of Promotion Policy 2009 but it is not possible due to not making correction in appellant's merit position and non providing the actual aggregate score of 63/38 of the appellant by the PSC Peshawar according to the other colleagues whom merit positions were corrected in the revised merit list of 10.02.2014.
 - J) That it is also very pertinent to mention here that in the year 2014 the respondent No. 2 revised the merit list for the cadre of ADEO's BPS-16 wherein many colleagues of the appellant have been allowed their required marks in light of the said deletion of regulation 29(g) of the rules ibid. that appellant also requested the concerned authorities but if no avail. Copies of merit list 2011 and revised merit list is attached as Annex-H & I.
 - K) That the appellant has been condemned unheard and has not been treated according to law and rules.
 - L) That the appellant as mentioned in Paragraph No. 1 were appointed in the month of May, 2011 whereas, the notification of deletion of 29(g) was deleted in the month of February, 2011 and according to the law, notification does not have retrospective effect and have prospective effect, however, in the case of appellant, the delted regulation has been applied on them just to bring them on the bottom of seniority list. Copy of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission Regulations, 2003 is attached as Annex-J.

M)That the appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

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Terms and conditions:-

- 1. Their services will be considered regular but without Pension & Gratuity in terms of Section-19 of the NWFP Civil Servant Act, 1973 as amended vide NWFP Civil Servants (Amendment) Act, 2005. They will however be entitled to Contributory Provident Fund in such a manner and at such rates as per prescribed by the Gout.
- 2. In case, he is already in Govt: service and working against pensionable post on regular basis before 1st day of July 2001, without any service break, on application to Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission through proper channel and selection by the Commission, is appointed and allowed choice of option either to retain benefit of pension & gratuity as allowed to his under his previous terms of appointment or to avail the benefit of Contributory Provident Fund allowed to his under new appointment.



Their services are liable to termination on one month's notice from either side. In case of resignation without notice their one-month pay/allowances shall be forfeited to the Government.

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- 4. They should join their posts within 30 days of the issuance of this notification. In case of failure to join their posts within one month of the issuance of this notification, their appointment will expire automatically and no subsequent appeal etc shall be entertained.
- 5. They would be on probation for a period of one year extendable for another one year.
- 6. They will be governed by such rules and regulations as may be issued from time to time by the Govt.
- 7. Their services can be terminated at any time, in case their performance is found unsatisfactory during probationary period. In case of misconduct, they shall be proceeded against under the NWFP Removal from service (Special powers) Ordinance, 2000 and the rules framed from time to time.
- 8. Charge report should be submitted to all concerned.
- 9. The EDOs concerned would furnish a certificate to the effect that the candidate have joined the post or otherwise after one month of the issue of their posting orders.
- 10. Their seniority will be maintained as determined by the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission.
- 11. No TA/DA will be allowed to the appointees for foining their duties.

OALANDAR ALI KHAN, J.- Ghulam Habib and 21 others, petitioners, challenged notifications with regard to appointment of private respondents from Teaching Cadre as SDEO (BPS-17), which were admittedly Management Cadre Posts.

In their writ petition, the petitioners pointed out that on the basis of National Education Policy, 2009, the Elementary & Secondary Education (E&SE) Department separated Management Cadre from Teaching Cadre vide notification dated 04.05.2009; with nomenclature of Posts of Management Cadre as follows;

District Education Officer E&SE (DEO BPS-19);



- Deputy District Education Officer E&SE (DDEO BPS-18);
- Sub-Divisional Education Officer E&SE (SDEO BPS-17); and
- Assistant District Education Officer/Assistant
 Sub-Divisional Education Officer E&SF
 (ASDEO/ADEO BPS-16).

The petitioners were appointed as Assistant District Education Officers (ADEOs B-16) on the recommendation: of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Public Commission , vide notification dated 05.05.2011. According to the petitioners, the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa did not frame/issue Service Rules/Service Structure of the petitioners deliberately, thereby trying to derail the system of Management Cadre and issued amended notification dated 07.04.2012 whereby the rules framed in pursuance of Education Policy, 2009, were amended to the extent of making employees of Management Cadre transferable to the Teaching Cadre and vice versa. The said notification dated 07.04.2012 was challenged before this Court in W.P No.3663-P/2012, titled Sultan Mehood Mian..Vs..Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and others, which was accepted vide judgment dated 08.05.2013, thereby declaring the impugned notification dated 07.04,2012

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in contravention of main Policy/Statute, illegal, arbitrary and against the law; but the posts of SDEOs (BPS-17) formally known as DDOs/Assistant Directors (BPS-17) remained to be occupied by the Officers from Teaching Cadre despite the same being Management Cadre posts since Establishment of the Management Cadre. Likewise, Officers from Teaching Cadre were appointed/posted against the newly created 88 posts of SDEOs/Assistant Directors (BPS-17) in the Management Cadre by the respondent/department vide notification No.26.09.2016, in contravention of the Government Policy in 2009. The petitioners claimed that they were in the promotion zone, and they were thus deprived of promotion by promoting teachers from Teaching Cadre to take up positions of Management Cadre; hence the instant writ petition by the petitioners with prayer for issuance of writs against the respondents for (a) framing of Service Structure for employees of Management Cadre within reasonable time; (b) filling of posts of SDEOs from employees of the Management Cadre (Petitioners); (c) not posting anyone out of Teaching Cadre against the said posts in presence of employees of Management Cadre; (d) issuance of seniority list of the petitioners in

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Management Cadre; and (e) setting aside impugned



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notification relating to transfer of private respondents from Teaching Cadre to Management Cadre instead of the petitioners.

In response to pre-admission notice issued to <u>3.</u> the respondents, Mr. Muhammad Rafique Khattak, Director Education, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, and Mr. Moeen-ud-Din Hamayun, AAG, appeared; and stated at the bar that employees from Teaching Cadre have been transferred as SDEOs as a stopgap arrangement, only because of non availability of employees from Management Cadre to be appointed against the newly created posts of SDEO, and also because of absence of provision in existing rules for promotion of employees in the Management Cadre. They also informed the Court that a case for making provision in the rules with regard to promotions in the Management Cadre has been recommended to the Provincial Government, which is likely to approve the same shortly, thus paving way for removal of the 'anomaly'.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioners also seemed satisfied with assurance rendered on behalf of the respondents at the bar with regard to opening of avenues for promotions from Management Cadre; but his grievance subsisted with regard to transfer of employees from Teaching Cadre to Management Cadre in contravention of the Government Policy and

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also judgment of this Court. Anyhow, since the impugned transfers/postings have been made as a stopgap arrangement till postings/appointments of regular SDEOs (BPS-17), according to statement at bar of the Director Education and learned AAG, and process for making provision in the rules with regard to promotions in the Management Cadre is in the final stages, the writ petition is disposed of in the terms that besides finalizing the case for making provision in the Rules with regard to promotions in the Management Cadre within three months of the receipt of this judgment/order; the respondent/department shall also rationalize postings/transfers against Management Cadre posts in the light of the relevant rules/policy and



Brief History of the Case:

Grounds taken by both the ASDEOs (MC).

1. That their last 03 examinations (FA/FSc +BA/BSc+ B.Ed.) score were wrongly calculated during the initial appointment as ADEO/ASDEO and 13 academic marks were wrongly allotted to Mr. Yousaf Shah instead of legal 15 marks, similarly 13 academic marks were wrongly allotted to Mr. Sahib Kamal instead of 15 legal marks.

2. That their experience marks were also allotted wrongly; Mr. Yousaf Shah experience marks were calculated wrongly as 4 marks instead of 5 legal experience marks while Mr.Sahib Kamal experience marks were wrongly calculated as 3 instead of 4 legally experience marks.

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3. That both the ASDEOs i.e Yousaf Shah was placed at s.no.187 in the light of wrongly calculated aggregate score as 60/38 and Sahib Kamal was placed at s.no.227 in the light of wrongly calculated aggregate score as 59/40.

4. That Yousaf Shah has been deserving to place him at his legal seniority position with a legal and factual score as 63/38 similarly Sahib Kamal has been deserving to place him at his legal seniority

position with a legal and factual score as 62/40.

Facts of Merit/Seniority's issue under inquiry:

Yousaf Shah ASDEO;

Sahib Kamal ASDEO;

FA Marks + BA Marks + B.Ed.(Obtaining Marks) Divided by Total Marks Multiplied by 30 460+287+534/2550*30= 15.07 counted as 15 in round number as per PSC Rules.

ADEOs' advertisement year =2009, B.Ed. passing year= 2000

Total experience 2009-2000= 9 years= 9 Marks 5 marks excluded as eligibility for the post, Remaining experience marks 9-5= 4 marks

Total aggregate score = academic marks + Experience Marks+ M.Ed. (1 marks) +Additional Relevant Qualification marks (1 M.A ,2 marks per M.A) +interview marks 15 + 4 + 1 + 2 + 40 = 62 Marks/score Merit position = 62/40Interview marks= 40

Main Findings:

1. Mr. Yousaf Shah ASDEO (MC) has been deprived of his legal merit/seniority position in the light of his aggregate score as 63/38 and he was allotted wrongly as 60/38 aggregate score.

2. Mr.Muhammad Saleem S/O Ghulam Sarwar having the score of 63/35 is junior than Yousaf shah because of less marks in interview and allotted him seniority No. as 68 in the final seniority list of 15/08/2018. Hence Yousaf Shah is deserving for seniority no as 67 legally.

3. Mr. Sahib Kamal ASDEO (MC) has also been deprived of his legal merit/seniority position in the light of his aggregate score as 62/40 and he was allotted wrongly as 59/40 aggregate score.

- 4. Mr. Muhammad Tahir having the same score of 62/40 but junior than Sahib Kamal by date of birth as 14/5/72 and allotted him seniority No. as 77 in final seniority list of 15/08/2018.
- 5. Other colleagues of both the officers were allotted actual/legal merit positions in the light of their academic and experience marks such as 5 marks for passing B.Ed. in the year of 1999 and 4 marks for passing B.Ed. in the year of 2000.
- 6. Even a candidate namely Haya said, has been given 01 marks as experience on passing B.Ed. in the year of 2004 and made him senior by allotting him wrongly 60/38 score on S.No.153 score instead of his legal 59/38 merit position which is more junior to both the applicants under inquiry.
- 7. Another colleague of the applicants Mr.Muhammad Rehman Shah academic score comes as 15 but allotted him18 score with an aggregate score as 65/45 but granted him 66/45 score wrongly.
- 8. Other colleagues of the applicants such as Sharafat Khan, Syed Ikram, Syed Mehmood ul Hassan, Habibullah, Ghulam Jilan, Bakht Zada, Hameedur Rehman, Imtiaz Khan, Shamsur Rehman, Hamid Rasool, Irshad Khan, Muhammad Ishaq, Wisal Muhammad, Imtiaz Ali, Wasim Fazal etc. were allotted their legal and right merit/seniority positions in the light of their submitted appeals.

Conclusion/Inferences:

- 1. Both the officers i.e. Mr. Yousaf Shah ASDEO Circle Pabbi and Mr. Sahib Kamal ASDEO Circle Jallozai were discriminated by not giving them their right/legal and actual merit/seniority positions.
- 2. Both the officers knocked out so many times the doors of all the competent authorities for granting them their legal merit/seniority positions through formal appeals/correspondence but their appeals were not honored.

Recommendations:

The following humble recommendations have been submitted under the rules;

- 1. Mr. Yousaf Shah ASDEO Circle Pabbi (D.O.B. 27/3/73) may please be allotted his actual legal merit position as 63/38, his seniority may also be fixed on S.No. 67 and replaced him senior than Mr. Muhammad Saleem s/o Ghulam Sarwar being junior because of less marks in interview by having the merit position as 63/35.
- 2. Mr.Sahib Kamal ASDEO Circle Jallozai (D.O.B. 11/5/72) may please be allotted his actual legal merit position as 62/40, his seniority may also be fixed on S.No.77 and replaced him senior than Mr.Muhammad Tahir being junior by date of birth (14/05/72) and having the same merit position as 62/40.
- 3. Both the officers under inquiry may please be promoted according to their mentioned above junior promoted colleagues from the date of their juniors get promoted respectively.

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The educational documents of Mr. Yousaf Shah and Sahib Kamal (ASDEOs) may be verified from the concerned institutions after issuing their promotion letters to the posts of SDEOs and formal action may be initiated as per rules in case of any fake or bogus documentation.



That your good office has issued the tentative seniority list 2021 of the ADEOs/ASDEOs wherein the name of the appellant has been placed at serial no.74 with Merit Score 60/38 in the merit list of 2011 and revised merit list of 12/2/2014 as well.

That it came into the knowledge of appellant from the lists of ADEOs/ASDEOs annexed with some of the writ petitions either disposed of or pending before the Honorable High Court that the appellant was awarded the academic marks as 13 instead of 16, due to 2nd attempt in BSc. FSc and B.Ed in Autumn and three marks have been deducted from the applicant/appellant under Rule 29 (g) of Khyber

That the said rule has already been deleted vide notification No.PSC/Acets/Regulation/2003/4539 dated 12/02/2011, much earlier than the issuance of recommendation and appointment order dated 05/05/2011 and also before finalization of ADEOs' revised seniority list dated

6. That the said rules were not applied on other colleagues of the applicant some examples are; Muhammad Rehman Shah, Muhammad Tahir

That some colleagues for instance Mr. Habib Ullah was granted 33 Marks in interview in the Merit list 2011 of ADEOs/ASDEO but made him senior to the applicant by granted him 2 extra marks in interview as 35 and brought his merit position to 62/35 from 60/33 in revised Merit list of 2014, similarly Mr. Wasim Fazal was granted 30 Marks in interview in the Merit list 2011 of ADEOs/ASDEO but made him senior to the applicant by granted him 3 extra marks in interview as 33 and brought his merit position to 60/30 (in revised Merit list of 2014) from 57/30; it is pertinent to mention here that the score of Mr. Wasim Fazal have been wrongly calculated because he falls in the series/order of 30 interview marks like his other two senior colleagues (Attur Rehman & Sahmsul Rehman) whom were also allotted 30 marks each in interview and his correct score can be calculated as 15+7+4+1+30=57/30 but he is allotted wrongly as 60/30.

That the following ADEOs/ASDEOs merit positions were corrected ignoring the applicant/appellant and brought to the top from the bottom by granting them 1 to 3 extra marks in the revised merit list of 10/02/2014 and made them senior to the applicant/appellant (Copies of 2011 & 2014 merit lists enclosed as Annexure A & B).

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

In exercise Notification No. ²KP/PSC/31550. conferred by Section 10(A) of the ³[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Public Service Commission (Amendment) Ordinance, 2002 (4[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Ordinance XXVII of 2002), the Commission is pleased to make the following Regulations.

PART – I

GENERAL

- These Regulations may be called the ⁵[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] (a) 1. Public Service Commission Regulations, 2003.
 - They shall come into force at once. (b)·
- In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires: -2.
 - "Attached Department" means the department as defined in (a) the ⁶[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Government Rules of Business, 1985.
 - "Appointing Authority" means the officer or authority (b) designated as such in the Service Rules framed by the government for the post.
 - "Commission" means the ⁷[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Public (c) Service Commission.

- (d) "Member" means the Member of the Commission and includes the Chairman.
- (e) "Department" means a department as defined in the ⁸[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Government Rules of Business, 1985.
- (f) "Departmental Representative" means the senior officer of the department of the government to which post/s relates and who assists the Committee / Panel of the Commission for conducting the viva-voce / interview.
- (g) "Subject Specialist" means the advisor called for interview by the Commission from the University / Colleges / Institutions / Autonomous Bodies / Retired Officer directly or through the Head of Department.
- (h) "Government" means the Government of ⁹[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa].
- (i) "Committee" means the Committee of one or more Members constituted by the Chairman for any specific task.
- (j) "Panel" means the interviewing Panel of one or more Members of the Commission constituted by the Chairman to conduct viva-voce / interview for selection to the specified posts.
- (k) "Requisition" has the same meaning as in Rule 13 of the ¹⁰ [Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Civil Servants (Appointments, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989.
- (1) "Requisition Form" means the requisition form as prescribed by the Commission.
- (m) "**Test**" has the same meaning as assigned to it in Rules 3 and 6 of the ¹¹[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Public Service (Functions)

Rules, 1983 and includes Screening Test, Aptitude Test, General Knowledge Test, Subject Test (related to post and qualifications) or any other test.

(n) In "Parts" means passing an examination in more than one attempt or Supplementary Examination or Autumn Examination of University or Board where two courses are run in a year and also includes improvements where the candidate makes additional attempt for the improvement of his division or marks in an examination.

PART - II

REQUISITIONS

- Only the requisition furnished on the prescribed form shall be entertained. The requisition shall be signed by the Administrative Secretary or the Additional Secretary of the Department in respect of posts in BPS-17 and above while posts in BPS-16 and below shall be singed by the Head of attached Department and accompanied by: -
 - (a) Zonal Allocation worked out strictly in accordance with the Zonal Allocation Formula notified by the S&GAD vide No. SORI (S&GAD)3-39/70 dated 03.02.1990 and zonal rotation cycle circulated by the Commission vide No. 3-89-DS/3241 dated 19.03.1990 or in accordance with the other instructions of the Government as issued from time to time.
 - (b) Printed or notified copy of the service rules relevant to the post to which recruitment is to be made, particular of academic qualification, experience, sex and age limit prescribed under the relevant rules.
 - (c) In case the rules have not been notified, the Commission shall examine the requisition in accordance with the draft rules as approved by the Rules Sub-Committee and the Commission.
 - (d) Where service rules do not exist, guidance may, if considered necessary, be obtained from the suggested rules of the department and if there is no such rules, the service rules existing for the similar post in the same department or another department or another provincial / federal government will be taken into consideration.
 - (e) Job description and job analysis of vacancies or any other instruction of the government issued from time to time shall also accompany the requisition.
 - (f) The requisitioning authority shall also provide Certificate to the following effect:
 - (i) That the requisition has been examined and is complete in all respects.
 - (ii) That no other requisition has been sent to the Commission for this vacancy / these vacancies.

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- (iii) That previous recommendation of the Commission for the similar post/s have been implemented and no recommendee remains to be appointed.
- (iv) That according to the ratio fixed for initial recruitment and promotion in the service rules this vacancy / these vacancies fall to the share of the initial recruitment.
- (v) That this requisition includes all the available vacancies with the department either occupied by the adhoc / contract appointees or lying vacant due to new creation or retirement / promotion of official / officer etc.

4. <u>ACTION ON INCOMPLETE REQUISITION.</u>

12 ["A requisition received should be examined and put up to the Member concerned within one week. Where a requisition is found to be in-complete, a back reference shall be made to the Department, within two days of the decision by the Member, to have the same completed within a month. In case, the defects pointed out are not rectified within the given time and the Commission considers that the advertisement of the post is not possible without rectification of the defects by the department, the requisition shall be returned to the department concerned and the case closed under intimation to the E&AD.

After decision on complete requisition, the draft advertisement should be referred to the DS/ Officer concerned within three days for inclusion in consolidated advertisement which should be sent to the Press/ Director Information through Secretary on regular basis.]

5. EXERCISE OF POWERS.

The Member Incharge shall be competent to decide that a requisition is complete and is also in accordance with the notified Service Rules, or otherwise. Where a case is to be closed under Regulation 4 or is to be examined in the absence of notified Service Rules, approval of the Commission shall be obtained.

6. ADVERTISEMENTS.

The posts which are to be filled through the Commission shall as far as possible contain the following particulars: -

- (h) Qualification and experience.
- (i) Departmental Permission.
- (j) Required Permission from the government in the case of candidates married to foreigners.
- (k) Rejections of applications received late or found incomplete.
- (l) Deposit of applications fee.
- (m) Consideration of applications in absentia for candidates having exceptionally higher qualifications.
- (n) Reservation of quotas for different categories if made by the requisitioning departments and accepted by the Commission.
- (o) Number of chances availed from the specified date.
- (p) No extra time for postal transit.
- (q) Screening of the candidates on the basis of Written / Academic / General Ability Test.
- (r) Experience to follow the minimum qualification if not provided otherwise in the relevant Service Rules.
- (s) Determination of qualifications, experience and age limit on the last date fixed for the receipt of applications for incountry

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candidates if not provided otherwise in the relevant Service Rules.

- (t) Last date for receipt of applications which shall be at least four weeks for in-country candidates and six weeks for candidates applying from abroad.
- (u) (i) Additional posts if received before the completion of preliminaries in an earlier requisition shall be added to the posts already advertised by notifying the addition in the press either by way of corrigendum or through fresh advertisement at the discretion of the Commission.
 - (ii) Where a requisition is withdrawn after the post has been advertised a notice canceling such advertisement shall be published.

7. ADVERTISEMENT ABROAD.

Post may not be advertised abroad. However, an adequate number of copies of the advertisement shall be supplied to the Director, National Talent Pool, Government of Pakistan Manpower Department, Islamabad for onward transmission to the Pakistan missions abroad.

PART – III

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS BY THE AND ADMISSION **CANDIDATES** APPLICATIONS.

- An application by an eligible candidate shall be submitted on (a) 8. the prescribed form of the Commission obtainable from the designated branches of the National Bank before the closing date. 13[Eligible candidates can also apply online on the prescribed form downloadable at website of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission. However, the candidates will have to deposit application fee in the relevant head of account of receipts on or before the closing date of advertisement.]
 - If the prescribed application form is not available to the candidate outside Pakistan, he may apply on plain paper indicating particulars of his age, qualification, experience and domicile alongwith supporting documents. However, he will have to apply on the proper form when he returns to the country.
 - (c) All applications must reach the Commission office on or before closing date and time. The Diary Branch shall receive all the applications submitted by hand or by post and shall submit the same to the Secretary, on the same day, who will record his initial with date on each application and return these to the Diary Branch on the same day or a day after. ¹⁴[On return, the Diary Branch shall diarize each application in the diary register and shall handover all the applications to the respective Assistants of the branch concerned within three days and obtain their signatures as a token]. An application received after closing date shall be stamped "LATE" by the Diary Branch after diarizing the same. However, while scrutinizing the applications, the late application of indoor patients and candidates arriving from abroad will be considered as given in Regulation 9(d) (i) and (iii).

Cases recommended for direct interview should immediately be scrutinized and those for Screening Test or Ability Test be referred to the Exam: Wing or Psychology Wing as the case may be.]
- 9. (a) Unless otherwise altered and notified the closing date for receipt of applications from the candidates shall be as declared in the advertisement.
 - (b) Normally such date shall be three to six weeks from the date of publication of the advertisement.
 - (c) If the closing date fixed for the receipt of the application falls on an official holiday, the next working day shall be considered as the closing date.
 - (d) An application received after the closing time and date shall stand rejected except where the candidate:
 - (i) has been ill and has remained admitted in the government / reputed hospital for period from the publication of the advertisement till the closing date;
 - (ii) has informed the Commission in writing about his illness before the closing date alongwith the medical certificate in that behalf from the *competent authority*; and
 - (iii) when the candidate was abroad and advertisement was published and he / she arrives after the last date specified for receipt of applications and produces proof thereof, the concession allowed shall be available only to such candidates who submit their applications

PART - IV

19. ACADEMIC QUALIFICATIONS.

- (a) Only the qualification possessed on the closing date of the ¹⁸[advertisement] fixed for the incountry candidates shall be taken into consideration.
- (b) ¹⁹[A candidate who has been declared to have passed a particular Degree / Diploma examination may be considered provisionally on the basis of provisional certificate(s) signed by the Controller of Examination [or competent authority] provided that he[/she] will have to produce proper degree to the Commission till last date of interviews for the post(s). In case original certificate(s) / degree (s) are not provided by a candidate falling in the selection orbit within ten days of the conclusion of the interview, his candidature shall stand cancelled.]
- (c) The grade or division of the recognized foreign Degrees / Diplomas shall be assessed by the Commission on individual merits
- (d) When the Degrees / Diplomas granted by a Pakistani University does not mention the division / grade, but gives marks obtained by a candidate the division in which the candidate passed a particular examination shall be worked out in accordance with the following formula:

- Minimum qualifying marks in each subject and aggregate shall be as 22. laid down by the government.
- i) In all direct recruitment cases if disproportionate ²³23. number of applications are received as against the number of available vacancies, the Commission shall hold one of the following tests in order to bring the candidates to a manageable level for interview:
 - a) Subjective type Screening Tests;
 - b) General Knowledge Test;
 - c) Ability Test in the relevant subject/ field
 - d) Psychological Test

Where no such test is held, shortlisting can also be made on the basis of such academic and / or candidates as the professional record of the Commission may decide to take into consideration.

Where for certain posts the number of candidates is very small or few, in such cases the chairman shall decide whether direct interview shall be held.]

²⁵[The Chairman shall decide the nature of the ²⁴(a) 24. screening test keeping in view the qualification and experience prescribed for the post. The Chairman, if he deems appropriate or necessary, he may solicit the opinion of a committee of Members that he may constitute for the purpose]. Admission letter will contain the detail in respect of date, time, centre and nature of the test alougwith other necessary instructions. The top ten candidates on the merit list shall be called for interview against a post reserved for merit while five candidates per post shall be called against zonal post. he qualifies the interview but could not be recommended due to zonal adjustment etc, such a chance will not be counted towards chance limitations.

- Call notices shall be issued under registered cover to all ²⁷28. eligible candidates as far as possible fifteen days before the interview. However, where a Competitive Examination or screening test is to be held such notices may be issued through ordinary mail twenty-one days before the start of examination. The date of examination shall also be notified in the press.
 - ²⁸[(b) The Director Recruitment should ensure that urgent requisitions are prioritized for early scheduling of interview thereof. Interview schedule for next month should be prepared by the first week of every current month.

PART - VII

MARKING SYSTEM FOR POSTS FILLED ³⁰[BY] OTHER THAN SYLLABUS BASED COMPETIVE EXAMATIONS.

29. (a) Marking in the case of posts filled other then prescribed syllabus based examination will be made out of 100 marks to be distributed between the academic achievements of the candidates and the interview as follow: -

- (b) Minimum passing standard in the interview is 60%. In case experience is not a laid down qualification for any category of posts, the 10 marks allocated for experience shall be added to interview marks.
- Academic scoring in respect of professional posts shall be based on the last three or four professional examinations, as the case may be, on the basis of percentage to 30 marks reserved for academic record and not on division wise basis.

 For example, if a candidate obtains 2150 marks out of 3650 marks out of a total three or four professional examination his credit will come to 17.67 marks out of 30. So in such cases, the candidate will be entitled to 18 marks.
- (d) In the case of non-professional posts, last three board or university examinations shall be taken into account. In the case of lecturer the marks obtained in Intermediate, Bachelor and Masters Examinations will be taken into account.
- (e) Decimal fraction of 0.5 and above shall be considered one mark while less than that shall be ignored. To elaborate, a candidate securing 19.5 marks shall be considered to have secured 20 marks.

- In cases where aggregate marks of different boards / (f) universities are at variance conversion of marks shall be made both in the case of aggregate and secured marks of the candidates so as to maintain equity and uniformity in the calculation of overall score of the candidate.

- In cases where basic qualifications for the post are either (h) intermediate or bachelor degree only last two or three examinations 32[including] Matriculation shall be taken into account.
- In cases where the candidate fails to provide the proof of (i) secured marks in a particular examination, he shall be deemed to have passed in parts and with the lowest passing marks.
- ³³[Distinction marks shall be allowed only for standing first in (j) the last/ final University / Board examination prescribed for the post. The entitlement of distinction marks shall be further subject to the condition that the examination was passed by obtaining 60% (Grade-B) and above marks.

- Experience marks shall be awarded only in those cases where experience forms part of the requisite qualifications. While awarding experience marks, the period of minimum requisite experience shall be deducted and thereafter one mark per year shall be awarded for additional experience upto five years. In case additional experience exceeds the limit of five years then the credit thereafter shall be one mark for two completed years. However, in the case of Teaching / Specialist posts in the medical profession involving experience, one mark per year shall be allowed after the requisite postgraduate qualification. The experience acquired before post-graduation for such category of post, shall count only for the purpose of eligibility.
- (n) The fraction of experience less than one complete year shall be ignored.
- (o) The marks obtained in screening test / ability test shall be counted only for shortlisting purpose.

PART - VIII

EXPERIENCE

- When experience is laid down as a part of qualification the following principles shall be followed in determining the experience: -
 - (1) If not specifically provided otherwise in the relevant Service Rules, prescribed experience means the experience gained in line in a regular full time paid job acquired after obtaining the prescribed qualification. Period spent on studies whether inside or outside the country during service except the period in acquiring Ph.D or M. Phil in the relevant field will be excluded from the claimed length of experience. In the case of Teaching posts where M.A. M.Ed and M.A. B.Ed are the minimum qualification the teaching experience will be counted after acquiring Master Degree in one of the general subjects or M.Ed. The period spent on acquiring teaching degree like M.Ed or B.Ed will be excluded as a study period if acquired during the service or required experience after Master Degree.

Associate professor/ Professor etc in Government Colleges where the minimum qualification is M. Phil / Ph. D the teaching / research experience shall be counted from the date the candidate joined the post of Lecturer / Research Assignment on the basis of Master Degree irrespective of the fact that the candidate improved his/ her qualification during the service or otherwise.

- (2) Experience gained during appointment on adhoc or contract basis or in officiating capacity shall be counted towards eligibility.
- (3) Period of practical training undergone by a candidate for becoming eligible for the award of actual Degree shall be counted as Experience, if such experience has been gained after and not during the academic session.
- (4) Experience gained in a recognized institution shall be taken into consideration if it is supported by valid documentary proof.

(5) The experience gained as a General Duty Medical Officer in the Armed Forces will be counted only in Surgery and Medicine in the ratio of 50:50.

PART - IX

31. ADVISORS

- (1) The department concerned shall be asked to send an advisor to assist in the Viva-Voce as Departmental Representative. However, the Commission can also call the Departmental Representative directly to maintain confidentiality of the name of advisor.
- (2) Ordinarily an Additional Advisor as Subject Specialist shall also be called from the Universities / Colleges / Institutions / Autonomous Bodies directly or through the Head of the Institution.
- (3) Letters inviting the advisors shall be issued at least a week before the date of the interview. In case the advisor(s) is / are unable to assist the Commission on the date fixed for the interview the Commission may conduct the interviews in the absence of either or both if in the opinion of the Commission such absence is not likely to affect the assessment of the candidates. Their absence will not vitiate the proceedings of interviewing board.
- (4) The Commission will maintain a list of advisors consisting of Retired / Inservice Officers of the Universities / Colleges / Institutions / Autonomous Bodies for its use any time at the discretion of the Commission.
- (5) The Advisors will not participate in the interview, if one or more than one of their relatives is appearing in the said interview.

PART - X

32. INTERVIEWS.

- (1) Oramarily all candidates selected for interview shall appear in person before the Commission. The candidates from abroad may, however, be considered on paper qualifications, provided they possess distinctly higher qualifications than the minimum prescribed for the post and the credentials of such person are known either to the Departmental Representative / Subject Expert.
- (2) When a near relative of the Chairman or a Member, is being interviewed he shall not be present during the interview of such candidates.
- (3) An application for a change in the date of interview received from a candidate before such date shall be decided by the Member Incharge on merit. However, a candidate who absents himself without submitting such an application shall, unless good reasons are shown to the satisfaction of the Commission, be marked absent.
- (4) ⁴¹[]When all the candidates called for a particular date have been interviewed, the Commission shall determine the final grades of the candidates based on the assessment of the Advisors and the Member of the Commission. In case a unanimous decision cannot be taken, the majority decision of the Members will prevail. In the event of a tie, the Panel Chairman will exercise a casting vote.

PART - XI

MERIT LIST / ZONAL ALLOCATION / RECOMMENDATION

33. MERIT LIST.

- When all the eligible candidates who applied in response to a particular advertisement have been interviewed, the Director Recruitment / Director Examination as the case may be, shall prepare a merit list as per the marks indicated on the evaluation sheet and submit the case for the Commission's consideration.
- (2) Merit list shall be prepared keeping in view the aggregate marks secured by various candidates.
- marks in aggregate the candidate who has secured higher marks in the interview shall be marked senior. In case the marks in aggregate and also the marks in the interview are the same; the candidate who is older in age shall be placed senior to the one who is younger. In case all the above-mentioned factors are the same, marks obtained in the final examination of the prescribed qualification for the post shall be the deciding factor.
- (4) In the case of Competitive Examination the merit list shall be prepared in accordance with the laid down provisions of the syllabus of the respective service.

34. ZONAL ALLOCATION.

- (1) The zonal allocation of the vacancies shall be made in accordance with the zonal allocation formula wherever applicable.
- (2) Subject to Government Policy on zonal substitution, it is to be made, with prior approval of the Govt. due to deficiency of qualified candidates from the particular area(s). Such vacancies shall be filled in accordance with the proportionate ratio of the zones given in zonal allocation formula as contained in Regulation 3(a) from among the qualified candidates of other zones appearing on the merit list.

35. RECOMMENDATIONS.

- (1) A decision about recommendations to be made shall be approved by the Commission irrespective of the fact as to whether the interviews had been conducted by a panel or by full Commission. After approval the Director concerned shall convey the recommendations to the concerned Department. The candidates recommended for appointment shall be informed of their selection within three days of the release of recommendation to the department. Non-adjusted and Non-marked candidates shall also be informed of their results.
- (2) Where the experience forms part of the requisite qualifications, the recommendation of in-service candidates shall be conveyed provisionally subject to perusal of their ACRs by the Commission and finding these satisfactory.
- (3) (a) Where a large number of subjects / specialties are included in an advertisement, recommendations may not be pended till the finalization of the entire batch but instead zonal allocation be worked out subject-wise and recommendation conveyed to the Department without indicating to them the zonal allocation and the inter-seseniority. In recommendations to the Department it shall be made clear that the inter-se-seniority of the recommendee is linked with other subjects and the overall merit position and zonal adjustment will be intimated on the completion of interviews in all subjects. The chronological order of the recommendees shall not confer any right of seniority.
 - (b) The combined merit list shall be against a particular advertisement where the posts were advertised collectively but recommendations were staggered due to interview schedule or any other reason.

PART - XII

36. PANEL OF EXAMINERS / CONDUCT OF COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION.

- (1). The Commission shall maintain a panel of approved Examiners for various written examinations. The panel shall be reviewed periodically by the Chairman to ensure that a sufficient number of competent Examiners are available on the panel.
- (2). The Examiners for various examinations shall be appointed from the approved panel by the Chairman / Members authorized by the Commission in this behalf. As far as possible the answer sheets will be evaluated by the examiners who had prepared the question papers. In case the appointed examiner is unable to mark the papers for certain reasons then the ⁴²[Chairman] in its discretion may appoint another examiner from the approved panel.
- (3). There shall be no rechecking, reevaluation and reappraisal of the awarded marks and score once given on the answer sheet by the examiner shall be final. However, where some answer is left unmarked or an arithmetical mistake made by the examiner is noticed, necessary rectification of the mistake shall be made by the same examiner.

37. CONDUCT OF COMPETITIVE EXAMINATIONS.

- (1). The Director Examinations shall be the overall incharge of the examinations including appointment of the supervisory staff for different examinations and shall ensure that the examinations are conducted in accordance with the laid down instructions of the Commission.
 - (2). A Member or an Officer of the Commission shall be designated as incharge of an examination center / centers. He shall be issued brass seals for each center for sealing the canvas bags in which the scripts are placed.
 - (3). The brass seals shall be delivered to the examination center under the supervision of the Member / Officer. At the end of examination, these will be promptly collected. If there are two

papers in a day, the scripts of the morning papers must be sealed immediately at the end of the examination. After completion of the After Noon's paper, the canvas bags shall be sealed and the scripts delivered to the Director of Examination or his representative.

- (4). The seals shall remain in the custody of the Member / Officer incharge till the scripts are dispatched to the examiners concerned.
- (5). The canvas sealed packets / bags shall be opened by the Chairman or Member Incharge. These will be embossed in his presence and the fictitious numbers marked on the scripts. The roll number slips duly marked with the fictitious numbers shall be placed in an envelope and sealed. The sealed envelope shall be delivered to the Chairman, and the answer book handed over to the Registrar Examinations.
- (6). The Registrar Examinations shall be responsible for checking and transmission of the scripts to the Examiners.
- (7). The Registrar Examination shall deliver the sealed question papers to the Member / Officer Incharge of the center. The Member / Officer Incharge shall arrange delivery of the sealed question papers to the examination centers under his own supervision.
- (8). During the examination, the Member / Officer incharge shall arrange to get the scripts sealed with his special rubber stamp. If the number of centers are such that stamps cannot be affixed in every center it may be done as is possible. It may be ensured that in a center which is selected for this purpose scripts of all the examinees be stamped as far as possible.
- (9). The respective representatives of the Commission appointed in various examination halls shall be responsible to deliver the sealed canvas bags to the Director Examination or his representatives if the Examination is held locally. In the case of outstation examination, the sealed bags shall be handed over to the concerned Member/ Officer who may deliver the same to the Examination Section on his return.
- (10). The Director Examination shall maintain a complete record of each paper on Form PSC.23.

- (11). Ordinarily there shall be no change of Examination Centre. However, in order to avoid hardship the Chairman may authorize change of centre in exceptional cases.
- (12). Where candidate suffers from a disability which renders him / her unable to write, may apply to the Commission duly supported with the disability certificate before the written examination for the arrangement of an amanuensis. The Commission shall provide the amanuensis from the office who shall be of lower grade of education than the candidate.
- Answer books of candidates will be retained in the office of KP PSC for one year after recommendations against the posts are issued and thereafter these will be destroyed. Similarly, application forms/ copies of documents of non-selected candidates shall also be destroyed after one year of the issuance of recommendations. Any query relating to their answer books or application forms should be made by the candidates within the specified period, thereafter, no request in this regard shall be entertained. However, answer books or applications forms/ copies of documents of candidates wherein a query or an enquiry or a court case is pending shall be kept on record till final disposal of the query/ enquiry/ court case.

PART - XIII

38. RULES OF PROCEDURE

- (1). The decisions of the Commission shall be by a majority of votes of the Members present and in the case of tie, the Chairman shall have, a second or casting vote.
- (2). If the Chairman is unable to be present at a meeting of the Commission, the next senior Member shall preside over the meeting with all the powers of the Chairman and any decision taken in that meeting shall be valid.
- (3). The quorum for a meeting of the Commission shall be four but the Chairman may adjourn any business at a meeting if he is of the opinion that it cannot conveniently be transacted owing to the non-attendance of any Member.
- (4). The Proceedings of the Commission shall not be invalidated by the reasons of any vacancy in the office of the Chairman or other Member.
- (5). All decisions of the Commission shall be recorded in such a manner as the Commission may direct. It shall be open to any Member who dissents from a decision to record his dissent and, if he thinks fit, his reasons for dissenting.
- (6). Whenever the Commission is required to give advice on a policy matter or to forward proposals the decision of the Commission shall be communicated in a letter signed by the Secretary. Neither the fact nor the grounds for dissent by any Member shall be communicated unless the Commission so directs.
- (7). The Chairman or, in his absence, the Senior Member present may deal with any matter requiring immediate action. Such action shall be reported to the Commission as early as possible.
- (8). The Commission may refer any matter to an individual Member or to a Committee consisting of Member and any other persons, the Commission may appoint, for consideration and report to the Commission.

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- (9). (a) The Commission may, subject to such directions as it thinks fit, delegate to a Committee constituted from among the Members, any of its functions.
 - (b) Every such Committee shall consist of not less than two Members.
 - (c) The decision of the Committee shall be communicated to the Chairman who shall refer it to the Commission for final decision.
 - (d) For the purpose of interview, the Commission may work in Panels as constituted by the Chairman.
 - two Members of the Commission. However, in emergency or extreme load of work a single Member Panel can also be constituted. In addition, as far as possible, two advisors i.e. one subject specialist and one departmental representative may assist the Panel during the interview for posts in PBS-16 and above while for posts in BPS-11 to BPS-15 only departmental representative will be associated during the interviews, but where necessary, subject specialist may also be associated.
 - ⁴⁴(f) The panel of interview for the posts of PMS/ ETO, Civil Judges shall be three Members including the Chairman and for other BPS-18 and above posts, at least two Members of the Commission will be on the panel. However, before, interview, psychological/ aptitude test for recruitment against the posts of PMS/ ETO and Judicial Officers shall be compulsory.
 - (10). When the office of the Chairman becomes vacant through death, resignation, completion of terms of office, or otherwise, the senior-most Member shall exercise all the powers and functions of the Chairman until the vacancy is duly filled in.
 - (11). If the Commission desires to call for any record or report or information which may, in their opinion, be necessary to enable them to discharge their function, they shall address the Secretary to the Government of the Department Concerned.

- (12). When a file is to be circulated for obtaining the decision of the Commission it shall be put up first to Member-in-Charge who shall examine it and record his observations if any, and then mark it to the other Members of the Commission in such a way that it moves from Junior Members to Senior Members.
- (13). If a Member other than the Member-in-Charge wants the office to add some other information / documents to the case, he shall send the case through the Member Incharge.
- (14). Where the decision taken by a Member is contrary to any Regulation, Government instructions or an established practice of the Commission in the opinion of respective Head of the Wing, the matter shall be brought to the notice of such Member and if he dis-agrees with the office views it shall be brought to the Chairman's notice for taking such action as he may deem proper provided where an interpretation of rule / regulation is involved the matter shall be referred to the Commission.
- (15). In matters for which no provision exists in these rules the Chairman may regulate its proceedings in a manner as he thinks fit.

PART - XIV

39. REPRESENTATION.

Representation addressed to the Commission shall be decided by the Commission on merit.

40. A MENDMENT IN THE REGULATIONS.

(a) An amendment or addition to the regulations shall be approved by the full Commission. Such amendments or additions shall have prospective effect.

RELAXATION IN REGULATIONS.

(b) Any of the above regulations may be relaxed by the Commission to avoid hardship provided such relaxation does not amount to violation of any law, rules or Government Orders.

41. ISSUANCE OF STANDING ORDERS / PROCEDURAL INSTRUCTIONS

The Commission for the conduct of its day-to-day business may issue standing orders / procedural instructions in respect of the matters not explicitly covered under these Regulations.
