


law, are of no effect whatsoever.


2. We have gone through the available record carefully and considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. We, in the light of our judgment / order dated 02.10.2014, passed in the identical Writ Petition No.2980-P/2014, titled Dr. Muhammad Ali Chohan vs. Government of KPK, in the instant case, too, without dilating upon the merits of the case and without pre-empting the jurisdiction of the Service Tribunal, only by confining ourselves upto the interim relief, send the matter of the petitioner to the KPK Service Tribunal / Chairman for decision strictly in accordance with law and for considering the competency / maintainability of the appeal and also direct the petitioner to appear before the same on 16<sup>th</sup> instant for the purpose. The impugned orders dated 17.07.2014 and 05.08.2014 shall remain suspended till then. This writ petition is disposed of accordingly.

**PETITION UNDER ARTICLE 199 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF ISLAMIC REPUBLIC

Respectfully Sheweth:

The petitioner most humbly craves permission to submit as under;

**BRIEF FACTS**

1. **That**, the petitioner was appointed as Junior Clerk on 20/10/1986 in the Agriculture Department. A post of Steno Typist became vacant for direct recruitment and the

petitioner was appointed as Junior Scale Stenographer in the BPS-14 on 16/11/1987. The petitioner has been serving the department efficiently and diligently for the last 28 years.

2. **That,** a “C” type Quarter situated in the Agriculture Colony Muslim Abad Mardan was illegally occupied by one Mr. Abdul Wadood, Ex-District Accounts Officer, who refused to vacate the quarter, hence the then EDO Agriculture sought intervention of the District administration and the then DCO deputed the ACO to resolve the issue. On 16/01/2009 the issue was resolved and the illegal occupant was given two months time to vacate the quarter, after thorough negotiations. On 02/01/2009, the then EDO wrote a letter to the DCO, stating that the issue has been resolved and that the quarter will be occupied by the petitioner after its vacation by the illegal occupant. The EDO also requested the DCO to declare the said quarter along-with others as Non-designated to settle the issue permanently. The District Coordination Officer Mardan vide order dated 09/02/2009 declared the said quarter as Non-designated and consequently it was allotted to the petitioner vide order dated 13/02/2009, issued by the EDO Agriculture Mardan. The allotment order contained that the petitioner would occupy the said quarter on 15/03/2009, after its vacation as per the promise of the illegal occupant.

**Copy of the orders are annexure A and B.**

3. **That,** the petitioner, later-on occupied the said quarter, duly allotted to him, and shifted his family to live therein. It was in the start of the year 2014 that the Agriculture Officers of district Mardan started a campaign to eject the petitioner from the said quarter and allot it to a blue-eyed. The petitioner was issued notices to vacate the quarter on the false plea that the petitioner was not entitled to allotment of a “C” type accommodation. The petitioner filed a number of representations/ appeals to the concerned authorities, explaining therein the position that he was entitled to remain in the said quarter and that it had duly been allotted to him, however, the respondents turned a deaf ear to all his requests and issued him a final notice for vacation on 20/02/2014. The respondent no.3 stated in the final notice that the petitioner was not entitled to the said accommodation and that he has caused huge loss to the govt. treasury, despite the fact that the house rent had duly been deducted from the petitioner’s salary.

**Copies of the Final Notice and the petitioner’s representation are annexure C and D**

4. **That,** it may kindly be noted that the petitioner had, on the day of the final notice, requested the respondent no.3 to allot him a “D” type quarter, if as per their stance, he is not entitled to “C” type, however, the respondents, out of sheer mala-fide turned inimical

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towards the petitioner and recommended him for disciplinary proceedings to the respondent No.2, who conducted an enquiry and ordered transfer of the petitioner from Mardan to District Shangla vide order dated 17/07/2014. The transfer order contained that it was issued in light of the enquiry report. Besides the transfer order, another order was issued on 05/08/2014, whereby an amount of Rs. 1,40,640 was ordered to be recovered from the petitioner on account of house rent, and the house was ordered to be vacated within 10 days. Furthermore it was also ordered that Adverse Entry should be given in his PERs. The anger and fury of the respondents was so uncontrolled that it was brought into the notice of the Audit Committee too that the petitioner was not entitled to retain the said house and that he has thereby caused loss to the govt. treasury.

**Copies are annexure E, F and G**

5. **That**, resultantly, the audit committee recorded a para to the effect that recovery be made from the petitioner for the illegal allotment. The respondent department replied to the audit para that the petitioner was asked to vacate the house in February and March 2014 and that subsequently he has been proceeded against and also transferred to District Shangla as a penalty.

**Audit para is annexure H and the department's reply is annexure I**

6. **That**, eventually the petitioner succumbed to the pressure exerted by the respondents and he vacated the house on 01/09/2014 and intimated the vacation to the respondent no.3., who allotted the same to respondent no.4 vide order dated 02/09/2014.

**Copies are annexure J and K**

7. **That**, the petitioner was deeply aggrieved of the acts of the respondents, whereby he was transferred from the district, penalties were imposed upon him and audit para for recovery of house rent was recorded against him and he was ejected of the house as well. The petitioner filed an appeal/ representation before the respondent no.2 for cancellation of the transfer order on the grounds that his wife was also a civil servant, serving in the same district and under the spouse policy both of them shall be posted in the same district and secondly that his children were studying schools in Mardan and district Shangla being a remote station, their schooling would suffer the most. Finding no response from respondent no.2, the petitioner approached the civil court, however, upon advice that the matter did not fall within the jurisdiction of civil court, he withdrew his suit.

**Copy of the representation is annexure L**

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8. **That**, the petitioner being aggrieved of the afore-mentioned acts of the respondents, and having no other adequate, efficacious and alternate remedy, approaches this Hon'ble Court on the following grounds amongst other;

**GROUND**

- A. **Because**, the whole proceedings are outcome of mala-fide and colourful exercise of authority. The whole drama was staged just to get the house vacated from the petitioner so that it could be allotted to a blue-eyed.
- B. **Because**, the said house was allotted to the petitioner as per the prevalent rules and entitlement of the petitioner and after evacuation of the illegal occupant. The orders of the competent authority have already been annexed which shows that the then officers including EDO agriculture and DCO Mardan duly recognized the petitioner's entitlement and after declaring the house, along-with other similar houses, as Non-designated allotted it to the petitioner. The petitioner was not an illegal occupant of the house rather he was a legitimate allottee of the said house then how an audit para can be raised regarding recovery of house rent and how the Director General can impose penalties upon him including recovery of house rent.

**The Rules applicable in Peshawar for allotment of Govt accommodation are annexure M**

- C. **Because**, the house was duly allotted to the petitioner and he had been paying the house rent, which deduction always reflected in his salary slips.
- D. **Because**, the petitioner cannot be transferred from District Mardan to District Shangla, that too as a penalty, as his wife is serving the education department in the BPS-15 and is currently posted as Primary School Head Teacher (PSHT) in Govt. Girls Primary School (GGPS) Wali Abad Toru District Mardan. The spouse policy of the provincial Govt. does not allow the respondent Department to treat the petitioner in the afore-said manner. Moreover, the petitioner has seven children and all of them are school/ college going and are studying in different schools/ colleges in Mardan, who are not only ousted of the govt accommodation but are made to suffer even more due to the transfer of the petitioner to a place where he cannot continue the education of his children.

- E. **Because**, the penalties imposed upon upon the petitioner are unfounded, baseless and a nullity in the eyes of law. Firstly, Rule 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa E&D Rules describes the penalties and transfer is neither mentioned in the list of the major penalties nor in minor penalties. Secondly, as a consequence to a so-called enquiry, three other penalties have been imposed upon the petitioner besides his transfer. This Hon'ble Court may very graciously note that the whole proceedings against the petitioner were aimed at one point and that was vacation of the house.
- F. The petitioner seeks prior approval of this Hon'ble Court to take additional arguments at the time of hearing of the instant petition.

### PRAYER


It is, therefore, submitted with profound respect that this Hon'ble Court may very graciously be pleased to:

- i. **Declare** that the audit para recorded against the petitioner for recovery of Rs. 1,40,640 is a nullity in the eyes of law and is illegal because the said house was duly allotted to the petitioner and he has been deducting house rent to that effect.
- ii. **Declare** that the transfer order of the petitioner dated 17/07/2014 is illegal being against the spouse policy in vogue at the relevant time and is the outcome of mala-fide.
- iii. **Direct** the respondents No.2 to cancel the transfer order and restore the allotment of the house to the petitioner.
- iv. **Declare** that the penalties imposed upon the petitioner are baseless and unfounded hence of no legal effect and a nullity in the eyes of law.
- v. Any other relief deemed appropriate in the circumstances may also very graciously be granted.

- (i) Posting of husband and wife at the same station should not be made by dislocation of any Government servant already serving at a particular station unless his transfer is necessitated by compelling reasons of public interest or within the frame work of general policy of postings and transfers.
- (ii) The prescribed selection authority should be consulted in each case.







Subject: ENTITLEMENT SCHEDULE FOR GOVERNMENT RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION.

Sir,

While examining complaints/representations of Government Servants against the Waiting Lists maintained for allotment of fresh as well as better accommodation it was observed that the Residential Accommodation at Peshawar (Procedure for Allotment) Rules, 1980 are lacking declaration of entitlement of various grades of Government Servants to the various types of accommodation. Moreover the allotments being made are not in accordance with the Federal Government Rules and standard of residential accommodation approved by ECNEC.

2. Attached schedule of entitlement of Government servants to various types of residential accommodation at Peshawar with certain conditions is circulated for the information of all Government Servants.

3. The names of those Government servants who have been enlisted for better accommodation but are not entitled according to the attached entitlement schedule or residing in the accommodation of their entitlement shall be omitted from the waiting lists. However, the Government servants whose names are on the waiting list and are also entitled for the type of accommodation enlisted for need not apply afresh and their seniority will be considered from the date of application or from the date of promotion whichever is later. However they are required to intimate to Estate Office through their departments that they have not been retired from service or posted outside Peshawar or have not constructed their own houses in Peshawar.

4. For out of turn allotment, the officers who had, prior to their posting at Peshawar, designated houses outside Peshawar and who were required to vacate the houses for their successors in tehsil or districts or divisional Headquarters of the Province or outside the province may apply for enlistment of their names in the out of turn waiting list.

1. The quarters in Civil Colony, Civil Quarters and Irrigation Colony for Government Servants in B-16 and above shall not be allotted to the officers directly recruited.
2. For each type of entitlement, Govt: Servants shall apply for enlistment. For example a Government Servant in BPS-10 is enlisted for a house in Category-VI and in the meantime he is promoted to BPS-12, he may again apply for enlistment for allotment of Category-V type of accommodation and in case of failure he shall be allotted on his turn the type of quarter meant for BPS-10 and not for BPS-12. His name will appear in both the lists and in case he gets allotment for BPS-10 he shall not lose seniority on the waiting list for BPS-12.
3. A Government servant found subletted a quarter shall not be allotted Government accommodation for 5 years.
4. No Government servant shall be entitled to retain Government accommodation after proceeding on leave without pay. However, an allottee leaving his headquarters on leave with pay may retain the Government accommodation on payment of normal rent for a period of 6 months with the permission of Estate Officer in case he is forced to leave his family in the accommodation for good and sufficient reasons.
5. The allotments made upto now shall stand valid and shall not be affected by application of the above scale of entitlement.
6. An applicant who was enlisted for Government accommodation and in the meantime he changed his cadre or department without break in service shall not lose his turn on the waiting list provided that:-
  - a) his entitlement for both the posts is the same; and
  - b) he is not posted outside the limits of Municipal Corporation, Peshawar.

SUBJECT:- POLICY OF POSTING OF SERVING HUSBAND/WIFE  
IN THE SAME STATION.

Sir,

In continuation of this Department's circular letter of even number, dated 20-5-1998, I am directed to say that the following policy of the Federal Govt with regard to the posting of husband and wife at one station of duty, has been adopted by the Provincial Govt of N-WFP in respect of its employees working in Govt Departments, Autonomous and Semi-Autonomous Bodies in the N-WFP:-

- (i) Where a request is made for posting at a different station in the same department/service/cadre in which an employee is already serving, the request may be accepted subject to availability of a post in the same BPS.
- (ii) If a request involves temporary deputation to another deptt, it may be processed in consultation with the concerned Deptt and may be accepted on the prescribed terms of deputation subject to availability of a post in the same BPS.
- (iii) When a request is made for permanent transfer to/absorption in another department/agency, the request may be processed in consultation with the department concerned, subject to the condition that in the event of permanent transfer, seniority shall be determined in accordance with Section 8 of the N-WFP Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion & Transfer) Rules, 1989.
- (iv) If there is a tie between two or more Govt Servants for posting at the same station in the same department/unit of an organization, the Govt servant with greater length of service may be preferred.
- (v) Request for posting by a spouse facing serious medical problems may be accorded highest priority.
- (vi) Spouses already posted at one station, including those posted on deputation beyond the prescribed maximum period may normally not be disturbed without compelling reasons of public interest. Requests for extension of deputation period beyond the permissible limit may be considered with compassion if interests of public service would permit.

The above guide-lines are subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) Posting of husband and wife at the same station should not be made by dislocation of any Government servant already serving at a particular station unless his transfer is necessitated by compelling reasons of public interest or within the frame work of general policy of postings and transfers.
- (ii) The prescribed selection authority should be consulted in each case.
