JUDGMENT

AHMAD HASSAN, MEMBER .- Arguments of the learned counsel for the

parties heard and record perused.

ARGUMENTS

Learned counsel for the appellant argued that he joined the Police Public 02. School as Teacher vide order dated 07.09.1991 and was confirmed through order dated 10.12.1996. That while in service respondent no.2 advertised posts of Headmaster (BPS-17) for which the appellant applied through proper channel and got selected. His appointment was notified on 24.09.2007 and relieved by respondent no.5 vide order dated 24.09.2007. The appellant approached the respondents for grant of pensionary benefits and counting his previous service

towards the length of service in the present post but without any success. He invited attention to letter dated 24.08.1995 issued by the Finance Department, whereby employees of the Autonomous Bodies were held eligible for grant of pensionary benefits on appointment against regular post in the government. Initially the Police Public School enjoyed the status of government institution but through notification in 1989 its status was changed. The matter was agitated through a writ petitioner before Peshawar High Court, which was accepted as prayed for vide judgment dated 29.02.2012 and subsequently upheld by the august Supreme Court of Pakistan vide judgment dated 28.05.2013. Another writ petition no. 2311-P/2014 filed by the appellant was disposed of by the Peshawar High Court vide order dated 21.01.2015. They were directed through the above order to dispose of representation of the petitioner within two months through a speaking order. Finally, the same was regretted vide order dated 09.07.2015 on the pretext that Police Public School and College being a private school, therefore, amount of pension could not be transferred to any other department. Against this decision, the appellant filed C.O.C no. 172-P/2016 which was disposed of vide order dated 14.06.2017, hence, present service appeal. He further contended that case of the appellant was not properly handled by the respondents and pension and other allied benefits were denied to him in a arbitrary manner.

03. Learned Deputy District Attorney conceded that through he was initially appointed as Teacher at Police Public School and subsequently Headmaster (BPS-17) in the Education Department. However, the Police Public School being a private institution was not authorized to transfer the pension contribution to a government department. The matter was thoroughly deliberated and decided in a meeting of

ESTED vice

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executive committee on 09.07.2015 and outcome was conveyed to the appellant vide letter dated 25.08.2015. Being an Autonomous Body/Institution the employees were not eligible for counting of service for grant of pension and other fringe benefits out of government exchequer. The managed their expenses out of their own resources. They were neither civil servants nor government servants.

CONCLUSION

04. Careful Examination of the present service appeal revealed that the appellant served as Teacher under the administrative control of respondent no.5 from 07.09.1991 to 24.09.2007. According to the terms and conditions of his appointment settled with the above mentioned respondent, his service was pensionable. This fact has also been conceded by the respondents in a meeting held on 09.07.2015, wherein it was clarified that pension would be paid to an employee upon retirement.

05. On the other hand, the appellant joined the Education Department as Headmaster (BPS-17) vide order dated 24.09.2007. Upon joining the Education Department, he made a request to respondent no.5 to transfer his pension contribution to respondent no.2 and counting his service rendered in the Police Public School towards the length of service against the present post. To cut the long story short his request was turned down on the pretext that Police Public School being a private institution governed by its own BOG was not authorized to transfer pension contribution of an employee upon his selection in government department. This issue was also thoroughly discussed in the meeting of Executive Committee held on 09.07.2015 and further decided that pension shall only be paid to a retired

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Teacher personally. The respondents have also taken the stance that the appellant was neither a civil servant or government servant. Being an employee of Autonomous Body his case was not covered under any rules/notification by the provincial government, as these institution managed their expenses out of their own resources.

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We are not inclined to agree with the stance of the respondents for the simple 06. reasons that the appellant rendered more than sixteen years service in Police Public School Peshawar. According to terms and conditions of appointment settled between the parties concerned being a pensionable job, his pension contribution was maintained by respondent no.5 in the relevant head of account. Moreover, he had earned this pension contribution in lieu long service rendered in the above institution which has not been disputed by the respondents. Once he got selected in the Education Department as Headmaster, we did not come across any rules framed by the said respondent that prohibited transfer of pension contribution of the appellant to the respondent no.2. The views of the Police Public School that pension would only be paid to a retired employee are self-contradictory. Employees leaving the institution for better service prospects and that too with the permission of the authorities had every right to transfer their hard earned pension to the department where they are serving now. They are not demanding any undue favour. The claim of the appellant is quite genuine and the respondents miserably failed to justify denial of pension contribution during the course of arguments. So far as second part of his prayer to count his previous service towards the length of service in the present appointment the same cannot be acceded being not covered under any existing law/rules.

07. In view of the foregoing, the appeal is partially accepted and respondent no.5 is directed to transfer pension contribution of the appellant w.e.f 07.09.1991 to 24.09.2007 to respondent no.2 without further loss of time.
