





Respectfully Sheweth,

1. That the Petitioner is a naturally born bonafide citizen of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan & hails from a respectable family.

X,

- That in fact the petitioner was serving as binder in BPS-6 in the Respondent Printing & Stationary Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa & was posted at Peshawar. (Copy of the Service Book are annexed herewith as Annexure "A").
- 3. That the date of birth of the petitioner which has correctly been mentioned in School Leaving Certificate, issued back in the year 1977 i.e. on 16.06.1977 as 15.02.1965. (Copy of School Leaving Certificate is annexed herewith as Annexure "B").
- 4. That the petitioner has been inducted into service on 08/11/1987 & after serving for the long 33 years, the petitioner got retired from service on 27/08/2020 vide Order No: 298-301, i.e. 27/08/2020 w.e.f 31.08.2020 at the age of 55 years upon his own request. (Copy of Retirement dated 27/08/2020 is annexure "C").
- 5. That the grievances, the redressal of which the petitioner is seeking from this August Court is that the real & correct date of birth of petitioner is 15.2.1965 & the same has correctly been mentioned in the School Leaving Certificate. In fact at the time of preparation of Service book of petitioner, the incorrect & wrong date of birth was inadvertently mentioned & inserted by the officer/ official, who was preparing the service book of the petitioner, concerned, as 1959 inspite of the fact that the School Leaving Certificate, duly issued on 16.06.1977 had already been submitted with the department where upon the petitioner

had been appointed in service on dated 8.11.1989. But due to mistake of reporting officer, the wrong date of birth was mentioned i.e. 1959 in the service book of the petitioner.

- 6. That after coming into knowledge about the wrong entry of incorrect Date of Birth of the Petitioner in service book, the Petitioner moved application for correction of his Date of Birth and the same was accordingly rectified and corrected back in the year of 2000 A.D i.e. vide letter No. 2286 dated 11-05-2000. (Copy of Service Book is already annexed as Annexure "A").
- 7. That after rectification of the Date of Birth of the petitioner in service book, the same was reflected in all the relevant documentations of all the concerned officials including the pay slips, office orders etc and since then the correct Date of Birth is being used for all intents and purposes, in all record. (Copies of pay slips and office orders are annexed herewith as Annexure "D")
- 8. That the same preceding correct Date of Birth remained intact till, the Petitioner moved a request for retirement, which was duly sanctioned and the Petitioner got retired from service vide office order No. 298-301 dated 27-08-2020 w.e.f 31-08-2020.
- 9. That the irony of the fate is that when the Petitioner got retired from service on his own request vide office order dated 27-08-2020 and the Petitioner processed his case for release of pension, that office of the Accountant General Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

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raised objections upon the Date of Birth of the Petitioner and its correction, which took place back in the year 2000.

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- 10. That in order to appease the A.G Office, the Petitioner was again issued a retirement order vide office order No. 1031-34 dated 24-12-2020 w.e.f 30-06-2019 on alleged superannuation basis in light of office letter No. Pen-I/N-26/2020-21 Dated 23-09-2020 of Account Officer, Accountant General Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar. (Copies of A.G Office letter dated 23-09-2020 and impugned retirement order dated 24-12-2020 are annexed herewith as Annexure "E & F") respectively.
- 11. That not only the petitioner was issued another impugned retirement order dated 24-12-2020 and his request was substituted with notion of superannuation basis, but rather the wrong Date of Birth which had already been rectified back in the year 2000 was again raised and even recoveries were started from the petitioner for the alleged over stay in the service, which again is not only illegal and void, but quite strange and stunting as well. (Copy of recovering notion is annexed herewith as Annexure "G").
- 12. That feeling aggrieved from the highheadedness. omissions, adamany, and unfettered exercise of discretionary powers vested in respondents, the Petitioner approached this August Court in Writ Petition No. 793-P/2021. which was disposed off vide order dated 18-03-2021 with the directions to the respondents to

decide Representation of the Petitioner within 30 days. (Copies of Writ Petition No. 793-P/2021 and Order dated 18-03-2021 are annexed herewith as Annexure "H & J" respectively).

- That the representation of the Petitioner was decided by the Respondent Department vide Office Order No. 2213/ESTT Dated 18-05-2021. (Copy of office order dated 18-05-2021 is annexed herewith as Annexure "J").
- 14. That from the supra-mentioned episode, the grievances that comes into existence having no other efficacious remedy available elsewhere and forum to addressed at, the Petitioner approaches this August Court for recognition. enforcement and acknowledgement of his due and fundamental rights, inter-alia, upon the following grounds;

Grounds:-

- A. That there exist no other expedient- cumexpeditious and adequate remedy available elsewhere, hence the instant petition under the extra-ordinary jurisdiction of this August Court.
- B. That the petitioner is naturally born bona-fide citizen of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan and is fully and equally, on equality basis, entitled to all basic and fundamental rights as enshrined in the fundamental law of the land, interpreted,

guaranteed and enforced by the laws and law Courts of the land.

- C. That where the real and correct Date of Birth was already entered into and rectified back in the year 2000 and through proper channel and after following and observing the law on the subject, then again raising the same issue is not only illegal and void, but is unconstitutional and against the fundamental rights of the petitioner.
- D. That where not only the service book was rectified, but as well as the same was repeatedly and persistently reflected in the very monthly salary slips, issued by the same Accountant General Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Office, who is raising the issue of alleged wrong Date of Birth, again and again!
- E. That where once the retirement order was issued, then how come yet another retirement order could be issued?
- F. That where the Petitioner was retired on his own request, then how again he was retired on alleged ground of superannuation?

- G. That where the offices concerned, at all levels and at all relevant departments, did rectified the wrong entry viz-a-viz
 Date of Birth of the petitioner even by competent authority, then how that can be undone after twenty long years?
- H. That how the order of the competent authority can be undone after twenty years by non-competent and irrelevant authority?
- I. That where the correction was made and twenty years passed and certain vested rights accrued in favor of the Petitioner, how the same can be taken away in utter violation to the law.
- J. That even, if at all, the wrong Date of Birth of the Petitioner is taken into consideration, for the sake of arguments, and the petitioner is allegedly overstayed, in the department, even then neither any recovery can be affected from the petitioner for over-stay, nor his pension can be subject to any deduction, nor can be withheld, as the petitioner did performed his duties during all this alleged over-stay period and has been

paid for the work done and not as a booty at all?

- K. That even, if at all, the Petitioner's Date of Birth is taken as that of 1959 and if the Petitioner has even allegedly over-stayed in his service, even then no recovery can affected from the petitioner, as the petitioner has rendered service during all this long period.
- L. That above all, it was the mistake of respondent department, who did not retired the petitioner on alleged basis of superannuation and not of the petitioner, and the petitioner now cannot be made an escape goat for the alleged wrong done by others.
- M. That first of all, the correct date of birth of the petitioner is 15-02-1965 and same has rightly been rectified in the service record of the petitioner and lastly, even if the same has not been rectified, even then, no recovery of the alleged overstayed from the petitioner can be affected.

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N. That any other ground not raised here may graciously be allowed to be raised at the time of arguments.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of the instant petition, a writ of quo-warranto be issued to the respondents to explain that under what authority of law, a second retirement order be issued, when already one is issued, and;

> (i) By declaring the petitioner as validly retired from service vide office order No. 298-301 i.e. 27-08-2020 w.e.f 31-08-2020 upon his own request and be declared as fully entitled for the whole pension, all ancillary, fruitions attached to his service spread over long 33 years.

> > To declare the impugned retirement order No. 1031-34, i.e 24-12-2020 as illegal, void and unconstitutional.

(ii)

(iii) To declare the alleged deduction from pension and recovery of allegedly over-stay in service from the petitioner as illegal and void. (iv) To declare that the incorrect date of birth of the petitioner i.e. 1959 has correctly been rectified and corrected in the service book vide office order No. 2286 i.e. 11-05-2000 and any subsequent denial thereof, or insisting upon incorrect date of birth i.e 1959 is wrong, illegal and void.

> To issue directions to respondents to sanction and release the full pension along with all its attached allowances etc with arrears, strictly as per orders of retirement No. 298-301 i.e. 27-08-2020 and be paid till 31-08-2020 without any deduction and recovery therof.

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Even if the alleged date of birth of the petitioner is remained to be 1959, then direction be issued to the respondents to not to make any recovery of alleged over-stay, as the petitioner has already rendered services and case of similar nature has already been dealt with by respondents themselves. Any other relief not specifically asked for, may graciously be extended in favor of the petitioner, in circumstances of the case.

Interim Relief:

By way of interim relief, the respondents be restrained from with-holding the pension etc from the petitioner or carrying any deduction or recovery viz-a-viz alleged over-stay in service, till the final disposal of the instant petition.

That in order to appease the A.G Office, the Petitioner was again issued a retirement order vide office order No. 1031-34 dated 24-12-2020 w.e.f 30-06-2019 on alleged superannuation basis in light of office letter No. Pen-I/N-26/2020-21 Dated 23-09-2020 of Account Officer, Accountant General Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar. (Copies of A.G Office letter dated 23-09-2020 and impugned retirement order dated 24-12-2020 are annexed herewith as Annexure "E & F") respectively.



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

MUHAMMAD NASIR MAHFOOZ, J:-. Through the instant petition filed under Article 199 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, petitioner has prayed this Court for the following relief:-

> It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of the instant petition, a writ of quo warranto be issued to the respondents to explain that under what authority of law, a second retirement order be issued, when already one is issued, and;

(i) By declaring the petitioner as validly retired from service vide office order No.298-301 i.e. 27.08.2020 w.c.f. 31.08.2020 upon his own request and be declared as fully entitled for the whole pension, all ancillary, fruitions, attached to his service spread over long 33 years.







(ii) To declare the impugned retirement order No.1031-34, i.e. 24.12.2020 as illegal, void and unconstitutional.

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(iii) To declare the alleged deduction from pension and recovery of allegedly over-stay in service from the petitioner as illegal and void.

(iv) To declare that the incorrect date of birth of the petitioner i.e. 1959 has correctly been rectified and corrected in the service book vide office order No.2286 i.e. 11.05.2000 and any subsequent denial thereof, or insisting upon incorrect date of birth i.e. 1959 is wrong, illegal and void.

(v) To issue directions to respondents to sanction and release the full pension alongwith all its attached allowances etc, with arrears, strictly as per orders of retirement No.298-301 i.e. 27.08.2020 and be paid till 31.08.2020 without any deduction and recovery thereof.

(vi) Even if the alleged date of birth of the petitioner is remained to be 1959, then direction be issued to the respondents to not to make any recovery of alleged over-stay, as the petitioner has aircady rendered services and case of similar nature has already been dealt with by respondents themselves.

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After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and learned AAG for the respondents at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that regarding the grievance raised in the instant writ petition, the petitioner has also submitted representation before the competent authority

and he may be directed to pass an appropriate order on the same within 30 days.

3. The learned AAG also agreed to the said request, hence, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction that the representation of petitioner submitted before the respondents/Competent Authority shall be positively decided within 30 days after providing him opportunity of hearing.



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



"That under Para 116 of GFR vol-1 read with S&GAD (Regulation Wing) letter No.SOR(S&GAD) 5/(40)/87, dated: 15/02/1989, the Date of Birth of any Government Servant once recorded in the service documents gets finality and cannot be changed/altered except in case of clerical mistake. The Government Servant can apply for corrections of DOB within two years from the date of his entry in to Government Service. (Annex-D &E)"

- 4) Incorrect to the extent that as the D.O.B of the Petitioner mentioned in his Service Book as 1959, accordingly his correct date of retirement is 30/08/2019 instead to 31/06/2020. In this regard over and above Pay & allowances which the Petitioner has illegally been received upon his over stay are liable to be recovered under the rules.

- 6) As mentioned in Para "3" above the Administrative Department has no Power to change/alter the DOB of the Petitioner at this belated stage.

Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973---

---R. 12A---Constitution of Pakistan, Art.212(3)---Alteration in date of birth recorded at the time of joining service---Scope---Date of birth of civil servant (petitioner) was recorded as 2-2-1953 in his secondary school certificate and the Service Book---After many years in service civil servant claimed that his actual date of birth was 2-2-1958, and consequently instituted a suit for correction of his date of birth, which suit was decreed in his favour---Civil servant approached his department for correction of his date of birth but to no avail---Departmental representation filed by civil servant failed and appeal filed before the Service Tribunal was also dismissed----Validity---According to Rule 12A of Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973 date of birth once recorded at the time of joining government service would be final and thereafter no alteration in the date would be permissible---In the present case idea to have the date of birth altered appeared to be an afterthought of the civil servant---Question was as to how the civil servant, who joined the service in 1982, could not know about his actual date of birth despite the passage of more than two decades, especially when at various stages during his studies as well as service he filled many examination forms, pro formas as well as service book---Petition for leave to appeal was dismissed in circumstances.

JUDGMENT

EJAZ AFZAL KHAN, J.---This petition for leave to appeal has arisen out of the judgment dated 24-12-2012 of the learned Service Tribunal, Quetta whereby it <u>dismissed appeal</u> filed by the petitioner.

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2. Brief facts giving rise to the instant petition are that the petitioner was appointed as Assistant Engineer in BS-17 in the Irrigation Department, Government of Balochistan on 10-5-1982. He, after

stepping up many rungs in terms of scales, lastly held the post of Chief Engineer. His date of birth in the secondary School Certificate and the Service Book was recorded as 2-2-1953. Somehow, it dawned upon him that his actual date of birth is not 2-2-1953 but 2-2-1958. He, thus instituted a suit for declaration and correction of his date of birth. The decree asked for was granted. He approached the Secretary Irrigation Department for correction of his date of birth but of no avail. He filed a representation but that too yielded no result. He then filed an appeal before the Service Tribunal but it too met the same fate.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contended that when the relevant record was looked into, it transpired that the actual date of birth of the petitioner was 2-2-1958, therefore, he asked for its correction. It was liable to be corrected, argued the learned counsel, when a decree in this behalf was also passed. The learned counsel to support his contention placed reliance on the case of "Muhammad Sharif v. Chief Secretary and another" (2011 PLC (C.S.) 35).

4. We have gone through the record and the judgment cited by the learned counsel for the petitioner and have also considered the arguments addressed at the bar.

5. Before we discuss the merits of the case and arguments addressed at the bar it is worthwhile to refer to Rule 12A of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973 which reads as under:--

[12A. Alteration in the date of birth.---The date of birth once recorded at the time of joining government service shall be final and thereafter no alteration in the date of birth of a civil servants shall be permissible.].

6. The above quoted rule reveals that a date of birth once recorded at the time of joining government service shall be final and thereafter no alteration in the date shall be permissible. This provision was inserted by SRO 521(I) on 31st July, 2000. An alteration before 31st July, 2000 could well be made but not thereafter. Reference to the case of "Muhammad Sharif v. Chief Secretary and another" (supra) will not be of any help to the petitioner as in that case the date of birth recorded in the Secondary School Certificate as well as Service Book was the same whereas it is not the case here. The idea to have the date of birth altered appears to be an off shoot of an afterthought. It, as a matter of fact, has become a common practice with the civil servants to file a civil suit for correction of date of birth when they come to the verge of their retirement just to prolong their tenure for enjoying the perks and privileges for a few more years at the cost of others.

7. How comes this that the petitioner who joined the service in 1982 could not know about his actual date of birth despite the passage of more than two decades. Especially when at various stages during his studies as well as service he filled many examination forms, other pro formas as well as service book. In the case of "Khalil Ahmad Siddiqui. v. Pakistan through Secretary Interior, Interior Division, Government of Pakistan and 5 others" 2003 PLC (C.S.) 696), one of us while dealing with an identical situation held as under:--

"A perusal of the record would reveal that the date of birth of the petitioner was recorded as 19-12-1941 in the Secondary School Certificate as well as the service record. It may be true that the petitioner moved an application for the correction of his service record in the year 1966 before his High-Ups but it is equally true that the said application was not pursued to its logical end. It is also the that another application was moved in this behalf in the year 1982 but again it was left the halfway and never perused whole heartedly to the desired culmination. Why did the petitioner sit and sleep overful for decades and decades together has not been plausibly explained anywhere either in the writ petition of in rejoinder or during the course of arguments addressed at the bar. Why did the petitioner make no effort to get corrected the very basic document of Secondary School Certificate from the Board concerned is another circumstance which violently militates against the genuineness of the stand adopted by him as to the date of birth. If at all the petitioner was in know of some document showing is actual date of birth lying somewhere in Bijnoor, he could well have gone to India to fetch it in mid or late sixties. Why did he postpone his purposeful visit to India till 1998 and why did he not use the good offices of his relatives

to have the same is yet another question whose answer cannot be found either from the record or the counsel representing the petitioner. It, is a matter of fact, has become a common phenomenon and usual practice that the Government Servants if and when they come at the verge of their retirement, they question their dates of birth just to prolong their tenure and enjoy the perks and privileges of their service for a few more years at the cost of others. This idea never creeps across their mind earlier and in case it does, it is never taken seriously and pursued to the desired end. It is clearly and sequarely a case of estoppel of conduct which will certainly bar and barricade the petitioner from seeking the correction asked for at least at such a belated stage".

8. In the case of "Khalil Ahmed Siddiqui v. Pakistan, through Secretary Interior, Islamabad and 5 others" (2004 PLC (C.S) 1044), this Court while dismissing the petition against the aforesaid judgment held as under:--

"There is no cavil to the proposition that the above rule having no retrospective effect, would not apply to the cases in which the date of birth of the Government servant was corrected before its promulgation but the request of the petitioner in this behalf was turned down by the department having been found without any foundation and consequently the operation of the rule in question in the case of petitioner would not be excluded. Learned counsel for the petitioner while placing reliance on Government of Balochistan through Secretary S&GAD, Quetta v. Marjan Khan (2003 PLC (C.S.) 245 and Tarb Arif Fatimi v. President of Pakistan (PLD 1994 SC 562) has contended that the matter was not properly considered by the High Court in the light of law laid down by the superior Courts on the subject. We, in the above factual background of the case, do not feel it necessary to further dilate upon the question of applicability of rule 12-A ibid, or the claim of petitioner on the ratio of above referred judgments. The petitioner without producing any proof in support of his claim, sought correction of his date of birth only on the basis of oral assertion that his date of birth given in the Secondary School Certificate was not correct. We are afraid, the controversial question of fact cannot be adjudicated by the High Court in its Constitutional jurisdiction. The matter relating to the correctness or otherwise of the date of birth in the service record being purely question of fact, cannot be determined without recording of evidence and detailed scrutiny of facts and such exercise cannot be undertaken in writ jurisdiction. Further the learned counsel has not been able to convince us that the jurisdiction of the High Court in the matters connected with the terms and conditions of the service of a civil servant is not ousted under Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973. This petition having no substance is accordingly, dismissed. Leave is refused".

When viewed against this backdrop, we don't find any merit in this petition.

9. For the reasons discussed above, this petition being without merit is dismissed and the leave asked for is refused.

MUHAMMAD NASIR MAHFOOZ, J. Through the

instant petition filed under Article 199 of the Constitution

of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, petitioner (Abdul

Qayum) seeks the following relief:-

"It is, therefore, requested that on acceptance of this writ petition, the respondent may kindly be directed to issue and release all the pension contributions of the petitioner and to accept the correct date of birth 01.07.1959 instead of 01.07.1956. It is further requested that any other remedy which may deem fit may also be granted."

2. Brief facts as per contents of the writ petition are that petitioner was appointed as Chowkidar on 10.06.1984 in the respondents' department and at that time his date of birth was recorded in the service book as 01.07.1956 instead of 01.07.1959; later on, when he came to know about the wrong entry, he applied for correction. Accordingly, correction was made and the date of birth was corrected as 01.07.1959. On attaining the age of superannuation, petitioner applied for pension, however, the Accounts office of District Buner did not consider the date of birth i.e. 01.07.1959 and asked him to produce medical certificate from the Medical Board. Thereafter, petitioner produced the report of Standing Medical Board but the same was also not considered. The Accounts Office of District Buner sent the case of petitioner to the office of Accountant General, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar for guidance, however, the A.G office returned the case back to Accounts Office, Buner with the direction to examine the case in the light of

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S&GAD letter dated 15.02.1959 read with GFR 116-117 accordingly. The petitioner time and again requested the department for grant of pensionary benefits but in vain; hence, the instant writ petition.

3. Respondents submitted their comments, wherein they have mentioned that the actual date of birth of petitioner is 01.07.1956, by alteration the date has been changed to 01.07.1959. The Standing Medical Board too verified 01.07.1959 to be the true and correct age of petitioner. In view of this date of birth, he performed his duties till his retirement on 17.06.2019.

We have heard arguments of learned counselfor the parties and have perused the documents availableon the file.

5. After considering the entries of service book, it appears that the date of birth of petitioner in the NIC and the computerized Pay Roll from the year, 2006 till his retirement is the same i.e. 01.07.1959. Though, the report of Standing Medical Board is much after the date

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of retirement but this Court in another identical case


bearing W.P.no. 3858-P/2014 decided on 25.11.2015

held as under:-

"In view of the foregoing discussion, we hold that the petitioner stood retired from service on 30.06.2009 as per his date of birth dated 01.07.1949 recorded in his service book at the time of his induction in service in 1976 and that the subsequent change of date of birth was not in accordance with law and rules. Simultaneously, we also hold that since the petitioner had served the respondent/Department till 30.06.2014 under the bonafide belief in view of his changed date of birth as 01.07.1954 and thus performed duties for five long years accordingly and no one objected to his overstay in the department, therefore, no monetary recovery in respect of the said five years be made from the pensionary benefits etc. to which he is entitled.

This writ petition stands disposed of in the above terms."

6. The case of petitioner is *pari materia* to the above mentioned decided case as he has continued to perform his duty till 17.06.2019 and in case his date of birth was to be reckoned as 01.07.1956, then he was to retire on 17.06.2016. The instant writ petition is disposed of with similar directions that no monetary recovery in



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respect of the said three years be made from the pensionary benefits of the petitioner.

This appeal is directed against the judgment and decree dated 08.11.2017, passed by learned Civil Judge-VI, D.I.Khan, whereby suit filed by the appellant/plaintiff was dismissed.

Facts in background are that, plaintiff brought a suit for permanent injunction against defendants wherein he prayed for incorporating his correct date of birth i.e 05.01.1963 in their record as per decree dated 13.11.2015 passed by learned Civil Judge-III, D.I.Khan in his favour. It is further alleged in the plaint that as per service book has already been rectified by the headmaster of his school whereas defendants are reluctant to rectify their record, hence the suit.

The defendants were summoned who appeared before the Court but thereafter remained absent, therefore, they were placed exparte and plaintiff was directed to produce his ex-parte evidence.

Plaintiff in support of his case recorded his own statement as PW-1 and closed his ex-parte evidence. Thereafter, ex-parte arguments of appellant/plaintiff were heard.

2

The learned trial Court after hearing ex-parte arguments dismissed the suit of the appellant/plaintiff, hence the instant appeal.

Arguments heard and record perused.

Learned counsel for the appellant/plaintiff argued that judgment & decree of the learned trial court is against law, facts & evidence on record hence untenable. He further argued that the correct date of birth of appellant/plaintiff is 05.01.1963 but the defendants are reluctant to correct their record. He added that the Judgment delivered by the learned trial Court has resulted in gross miscarriage of justice and thus requested that the same be set aside.

The representative/Junior Auditor of DAO, respondents/defendants fully supported the case of respondents/defendants and prayed for dismissal of the instant appeal.

Perusal of record reveals that the appellant/plaintiff tiled the suit in the instant case wherein he sought correction of his date of birth in the record of respondents/defendants on the basis of judgment/decree dated 13.11.2015, passed by learned Civil Judge-III, D.I.Khan, in a suit wither "Mushtaq Ahmad Vs NADRA" filed by the appellant/plaintiff on 18.06.2015 for declaration-cum-permanent injunction. It is apparent from the record that the respondents/defendants were not impleaded as a party to that suit, therefore, they had not been provided an opportunity to refute the stand taken in the suit of appellant/plaintiff, therein, furthermore the

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appellant/plaintiff had not made any prayer for correction of his age in the record of respondents/defendants in the said suit. I am directed to say that under the existing rules, immediately after his induction into service, every civil servant is required to declare the date of his birth by the Christian era with as far as possible confirmatory/conclusive evidence such as matriculation certificate, municipal birth certificate and so on. This is supplemented by the opinion of the Civil Surgeon/Standing Medical Board. The department after full satisfaction with age and on the basis of medical examination of the new entrant in the department, enter the same in an authentic document i.e. Service Book/History of Service etc. The said document is maintained by the Department/ Audit and is always checked periodically.

2. The date of birth of a civil servant as recorded in his service documents remains constantly in his knowledge. This is reiterated in his ACRs and the Seniority List issued by the department from time to time. The preparation of service record of an officer is an official act and according to law, it is presumed to be correct. GFR-116 also provides that the date of birth once recorded cannot be altered except in the case of clerical error, without the previous orders of the Local Administration. Despite this, certain Government Servants are complacent with the state of affairs and sleep over their rights for decades knowing fully about their dates of birth entered in their Service Books etc. It would therefore be too much to accept such a belated claim from a Civil Servant that he was born on a date other than the one entered in his service documents and that the delay in representation was due to ignorance of the alleged erroneous entry. After all, there is always attached a finality to decisions taken by competent authorities.

3. I am, accordingly, directed to request that all concerned may please be informed in clear terms that in future a request for an alteration in the recorded date of birth of a Government servant may only be entertained by the Appointing Authority in the case of officers in BS-17 and above and by the Administrative Department in the case of civil servants in BS-16 and below, after special enquiry and only if the Government servant applies for it within two years from the date of his entry into Government service.

	i) By declaring the petitioner as validly retired from service vide office order No.298-301 i.e. 27-08-2020 w.e.f 31-08-2020 upon his own request and be declared as fully entitled for the whole pension, all ancillary, fruitions attached to his service spread over long 33 years.
	ii) To declare the impugned retirement order No.1031-34, i.e. 24-12-2020 as illegal, void and unconstitutional.
	iii) To declare the alleged deduction from pension and recovery of allegedly over-stay in service from the petitioner as illegal and void.
	iv) To declare that the incorrect date of birth of the

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To issue directions to respondents to sanction and release the full pension alongwith all its attached allowances etc. with arrears, strictly as per orders of retirement No.298-301 i.e. 27-08-2020 and be paid till 31-08-2020 without any deduction and recovery thereof.

vi) Even if the alleged date of birth of the petitioner is remind to be 1959, then direction be issued to the respondents to not to make any recovery of alleged over-stay, as the petitioner has already rendered services and case of similar nature has already been dealt with by respondents themselves.

vii) Any other relief not specifically asked for, may graciously be extended in favour of the petitioner, in the circumstances of the case.

3. We have heard Mr. Javed Iqbal Gulbela, Advocate, learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

4. On the face of the record, the relief sought falls within the jurisdiction of Service Tribunal under Article 212 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973. As such, we direct that it be forwarded to the worthy Service Tribunal for its disposal. The parties are directed to appear before the Service Tribunal on 27.09.2022.

5. The instant writ petition is disposed of in the above terms.
