JUDGMENT

<u>ROZINA REHMAN, MEMBER (J)</u>: Appellant has filed the instant service appeal U/S 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 against the order dated 17.09.2019, whereby, penalty of compulsorily retirement from service was imposed upon him.

2. Brief facts of the case are that appellant was appointed as Junior Clerk. He served the Department for about 39 years. While



performing his duties, he was asked for information and certificates of passed candidates for promotion to the post of Naib Tehsildar and accordingly, list with requisite information was forwarded. During preparation of aforesaid list, another letter having the same number and date was forwarded in a hasty manner. A show cause notice was issued to the appellant, wherein five allegations were based for his removal from service and vide order dated 17.09.2019, appellant was compulsorily retired from service. Feeling aggrieved, he preferred review petition but to no avail, hence, the present service appeal.

3. Learned counsel for appellant contends that the impugned order is against law, facts and norms of natural justice, hence, not tenable. He argued that the appellant was not treated in accordance with law and rules on the subject and as such, the respondents violated Article-4 & 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973. It was further submitted that the candidates who did not pass their departmental examination of Naib Tehsildar, were shown in the list of letter dated 03.06.2019 at Serial No.14 & 15 and the appellant was made a scapegoat on the fake & bogus letter having the same number and date which bogus letter was withdrawn/cancelled. Learned counsel submitted that no charge sheet and statement of allegations was served on appellant before issuance of the impugned order and he was condemned unheard.

4. Conversely, learned A.A.G submitted that the appellant deliberately issued bogus certificate, whereby, two Kanungos of

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District Peshawar were shown to have passed the departmental examination for promotion to the post of Naib Tehsildar despite the fact that those two Kanungos had not even appeared in the examination. That it was an attempt on the appellant's part to get their unjustified promotion through backdoor with malafide. He submitted that appellant got the clue that his conduct was detected and that a show cause notice was served on him, he, therefore, preferred to withdraw/cancel his earlier letter which proved to be a futile attempt on his part to bluff the Department and in the meanwhile, he requested for early retirement and lastly, he submitted that the appellant has already attained the age of superannuation i.e. 60 years, therefore, any decision in his favor would not accrue any financial gains at this stage.

5. From the record, it is evident that appellant was served with a show cause notice for issuing bogus certificate with regard to passing of departmental examination of Naib Tehsildar in respect of Inayat ur Rehman and Muhammad Nadeem Kanungos of District Peshawar to get their accelerated promotion as Naib Tehsildar, whereas, one of the Kanungo even did not appear at all in the departmental examination of Naib Tehsildar, whereas, Inayat ur Rehman had recently appeared in the departmental examination the result of which was yet to be announced but they were shown as passed and when the appellant came to know about all the facts, then both the letters issued by him were canceled and the certificates were

provided without any approval of the competent authority and were issued at his own risk tantamount to misconduct. Reply to this show cause notice was submitted, 26.07.2019 and the impugned order was passed on 17.09.2019, whereby, major penalty of compulsorily retirement was imposed upon him. It is settled law that when a major penalty is to be imposed on a civil servant, a regular inquiry is to be held to determine the factual basis of the allegations which are required to be proved in accordance with the law. The appellant was proceeded against under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011 which explicitly ordains a regular inquiry before taking any action which can in the relevant context only be dispensed with under Section-5(1) (a) of the Rules ibid in the event of sufficient documentary evidence being available against the civil servant or for reason to be recorded in writing showing satisfaction of the competent authority as to absence of need for holding an inquiry. In the instant case, most of the allegations required explicit proof and no reason for dispensing with the requirement of an inquiry appear to have been recorded. Reliance is placed on Chief Election Commissioner of Pakistan and others Vs. Miss Nasreen Parvez reported in 2009 S.C.M.R 329 and Abdul Ghaffar Vs. Superintendent of Police, South Zone, Karachi reported in 2011 P.L.C (C.S) 387. It is also on record that the appellant also submitted an application seeking retirement from service on 30.07.2019. As per his Secondary School Certificate Examination and his CNIC, his date of birth is 10.12.1960 as such, was due for retirement on 09.12.2020.

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The impugned order was passed on 17.09.2019 while he himself requested for retirement w.e.f 01.09.2019.

6. The offshoot of the above discussion is that this appeal is partially allowed and the compulsory retirement is converted into voluntary retirement w.e.f 17.09.2019. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.

<u>R/SHEWETH:</u> <u>ON FACTS:</u>

- 1- That appellant was initially appointed as Junior Clerk on 24.06.1981 and joined the present Department in 1984. Since then performing his duties in this Department quite efficiently, whole heartedly and up to the entire satisfaction of his superior for about 39 long years.
- 2- That while performing my duties the board of revenue asked for the information and certificates of passed candidates for promotion to

The appellant had no concern with that fake and bogus letter. Similarly that fake and bogus letter was later on withdrawn/ cancelled will within time. Copy of reply to the show cause notice is attached as annexure......D.
- **7-** That feeling aggrieved from the impugned order dated 17-09-2019 the appellant preferred review petition on 25-09-2019 before the competent authority. Copy of the review petition is attached as annexure.
- 8- That having no other remedy the appellant preferred the instant appeal on the following grounds amongst others.

GROUNDS:

- A- That the impugned order dated 17.09.2019 is against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record, hence not tenable and liable to be set aside.
- B- That appellant has not been treated by the respondents in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article 4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973.
- C- That the respondents acted in arbitrary and malafide manner while issuing the impugned order dated 17.09.2019 which is not tenable and liable to set aside.

- F- That no charge sheet and statement of allegation has been served on appellant before the issuance of the impugned order dated 17-09-2019 hence the respondents had violated the principle of natural justice and the rules enumerated in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Efficiency and Disciplinary) Rules, 2011.
- G- That appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of appellant may be accepted as prayed for.

> ii) That one Muhammad Nadeem Kanungo even did not appear at all in the Departmental Examination of Naib Tehsildar, but you in connivance to him, issued fake & bogus certificate to which no such record exists.

> iii) That while Mr.Inayat-ur-Rehman Kanungo recently appeared in the Departmental Examination of Naib Tehsildar under R.No.NT19-340, the result of which is yet to be announced, but you in contivance to him, showed him as passed vide letters as referred to above to which no such record exists.

iv) That when you came to know about all these facts, you withdrawn/cancelled both the letters quoted above.

That you provided such certificates/passed clarity information without any permission/approval of the competent authority and issued at your risk, hence tantamount to be misconduct, inefficient & guilty of corruption.

2. I am satisfied that your these acts and omissions come under the purview of misconduct, inefficiency & corruption as such make you liable to be proceeded against under Rule-7 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011.

3. As a result thereof, I, as competent authority, have tentatively decided to impose upon you penalty of <u>Removal For</u> under Rule-4 of the rules ibid.

4. You are, therefore, required to show cause as to why the afforessid penalty should not be imposed upon you and also intimate whether you desired to be heard in person.
5. If no reply to this notice is received within seven (07) days or not more than tifteen (15) days of its delivery, it shall be presumed that you have no defence to put in and in

that case an ex-parte action shall be taken against you.

- 4. The Board of Revenue again asked information about the candidates that the said candidate shown as untraceable that candidates are shown as "NOT PASSED" which was clarified vide letter dated 03.06.2019. Copy of the letter date 03.06.2019 is attached. (Flag-C).
- 5. The Board of Revenue again issued another letter while requisitioning information about the first letter issued on 08.05.2018 and accordingly the Board of Revenue was properly assisted vide letter dated 24.06.2019 Copy of the letter dated 24.06.2019 is attached.(Flag-D).

6. That the above mentioned letter is issued due to miss conception hence the same was withdrawn/ cancelled well in time. Copy of the letter is attached (Flag-E).

- 7. No one from the letters issued from the office of the undersigned has been suffered nor has any loss occurred to the Government exchequer hence the allegation of malpractice leveled against me is baseless.
- 8. While issuing the show cause notice and notice and placing allegation therein against me are baseless and incorrect, I am performing my duty in the last year of my service very honestly I am the only one to support my hole family I have 14 Children four of them are disable. (Copy of CNIC are attached) an opportunity of personal hearing may kindly be give to me please.

Most humbly appellant begs to submit as under:

That appellant was the employee of Revenue Department and has served the concerned Department for more than 39 years quite efficiently and up to the entire satisfaction of his superiors.

- 2. That during service the appellant was promoted to the post Superintendant (BPS-17) and after promotion the appellant has served the department with all zeal and zest.
- 3. That during service the appellant was served with show cause notice on the basis of anonymous complaint. That in the aforementioned show cause notice with certain allegations of malpractice against the appellant and appellant properly replied the said show cause notice along with documentary proofs and denied all the allegations leveled against the appellant.
- 4. That astonishingly the concerned authority without entering into the controversy issued the impugned order dated 17.09.2019 whereby major penalty of compulsory retirement has been imposed on the appellant.
- 5. That appellant feeling aggrieved from the impugned order dated 17.09.2019 preferred the instant review petition before your good self on the following grounds amongst the others.

GROUNDS:

Subject:

- 1- That the impugned Notification dated 17.9.2019 is against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record hence not tenable and liable to be set aside.
- 2- That appellant has not been treated by the concerned authority in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the concerned authority violated Article-4 and 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973.
- 3- That no charge sheet and statement of allegation has been issued to the appellant before issuing the impugned order dated 17.09.2019.

That the show cause notice so issued to the appellant contain no issue no and also undated, therefore the same is also not tenable in the eye of law and rules.

- That no regular inquiry has been conducted in the matter which is necessary as per Supreme Court judgments.
- 6- That no chance of personal hearing/ defense has been provided to the appellant which is mandatory as per judgment of the apex Court before taking punitive actions against the civil servants.

7- That the action has been taken against the appellant on the basis of anonymous complaint. That as per ESTA CODE instruction "anonymous communications must invariably be filed on their receipt and no action of any kind is to be taken on them".

> It is therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of this review petition the major penalty of compulsory retirement imposed on the appellant vide impugned Notification dated 17/09/2019 may very kindly be set aside and the appellant may be reinstated with all back benefits. Any other remedy which your good self deems fit that may also be awarded in my favor.

PARAWISE REPLY/COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENTS NO. 1, 2 & 3

PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:

- a. That the Appellant has already attained the age of superannuation for retirement i.e. 60 years as according to his CNIC his date of birth is 20.09.1959, as such was due for retirement on 19.09.2019. The appellant had also requested for retirement vide application dated 30/07/2019 (Annexure-A).
- b. That the Appellant was earlier compulsorily retired from service on the ground of his misconduct and inefficiency. However, on the directions of this Hon'able court was conditionally reinstated subject to any contrary order of Supreme Court of Pakistan as CPLA has been filed, which is still adjudicated.
- c. That the Appellant has got no cause of action.
- d. That the Appellant has not come with clean hands to this Honourable court.
- e. That the Appellant has no locus standi to bring the present appeal.
- f. That the Appellant has no legal grounds in support of his appeal.
- g. That the appeal is bad on account of non-joinder and mis-joinder of un-necessary parties.

ON F A C T S:

1. That the contents of Para 1 are admitted to the extent that the Appellant joined the respondent Department in the year, 1984 and continued to serve there till the date of his compulsory retirement on account of misconduct and inefficiency till 17.09.2019.

Though it may not have any bearing on the fate of the instant appeal, yet in order to keep the record straight, it is submitted that during his stay in this department, a number of adverse reports/ complaints of corruption, inefficiency & misconduct were registered against the Appellant which are part of his personal record.

2. That the contents of Para 2 are misleading, mischievous and hence denied. In fact, vide his letter No. 2851/LR-I/20-DENT dated 08.05.2018 (Annexure-B), addressed to Assistant Secretary (Estt), BoR, KP, duly endorsed vide his letter No. DENT/3138 dated 24.06.2019 (Annexure-C), the Appellant deliberately issued fake/bogus certificates, whereby two Kanungos of District Peshawar viz; M/s Inayat-ur-Rehman and Muhammad Nadeem, were shown to have passed the Departmental Examination for promotion to the post of Naib Tehsildar despite the fact that these two Kanungos had not even appeared in the examination in question. It was an attempt on the Appellant's part to get their unjustified promotion through back door with malafide.

3. That the contents of Para 3 are misleading and hence vehemently denied. In fact the Appellant got the clue that his conduct was detected and that a 'Show Cause Notice' was served on him, he preferred to withdraw/cancel his earlier letters vide another letter No.7590/DENT dated 03.07.2019 (Annexure-D). This, however, proved to be a futile attempt on his part to hoodwink the department.

In the meantime, he requested for early retirement vide his application dated 30/07/2019 (Annexure-A).

- 4. That the contents of Para 4 are not correct, hence denied. The 'Show Cause Notice' was served upon the Appellant for his willful acts of misconduct, inefficiency and corruption (Annexure-E) as defined in the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules 2011.
- 5. That the contents of Para 5 are incorrect, mischievous and misleading, hence denied. His reply was duly examined but was found unsatisfactory as the Appellant, vide his letter dated 08.05.2018, mentioned the names of two Kanungos of Peshawar (M/s Inayat-ur-Rehman and Muhammad Nadeem) in the list of successful candidates for promotion to the post of Naib Tehsildar for which he was asked to 'Show Cause' (Annexure-E).
- 6. That the contents of Para 6 are incorrect, hence denied. It may please be appreciated that, in order to serve the norms of justice and with a view to afford him a fair chance of defending himself, the Appellant was served with the 'Show Cause Notice'. In this connection, the following points deserve to be noted:
 - i. That the Appellant submitted his reply vide his letter dated 26.07.2019 (Annexure–F) which was duly examined.
 - ii. That the Secretary to Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Auqaf, Hajj, Religious & Minority Affairs Department, was nominated by the competent authority (Chief Secretary) to hear the accused officer in person and submit his recommendations/findings (Annexure–G).
 - iii. That the Appellant appeared in person before the authorized officer mentioned in sub-para ii above and could not present any convincing arguments in his defense. (Annexure-H).
 - iv. That the authorized officer mentioned in sub-para ii above, after having examined the charges and evidence produced before him, statement of the accused official as well as personal hearing, submitted report/ recommendations whereby the charges levelled against the accused official were found established (Annexure–I).

V.

- That thereafter, the competent authority, in exercise of the powers vested on him under Rule 4(b)(ii) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules 2011, decided to impose the penalty of "**Compulsory Retirement**" from service on the Appellant with immediate effect i.e. 17.09.2019 (Annexure–J).
- vi. That in the meantime, the Appellant requested for early retirement vide his letter dated 30/07/2019 (Annexure-A).
- 7. It is important to mention that the date of birth of the Appellant, as per his CNIC, is 20.09.1959 (Annexure-K). As such, he has already attained the age of superannuation i.e. 60 years, on 19.09.2019. Therefore, any decision in his favour would not accrue him any financial gains at this point of time.

8. That the contents of Para 8 are incorrect, hence denied. As explained vide para 2 of the Facts

<u>GROUNDS:</u>

- A- That the contents of Para- A are unreasonable and incorrect, hence vehemently denied. As sufficiently explained in the preceding paras, all actions have been taken in accordance with the requirements of standard Rules and the codal formalities were duly fulfilled and all fair chances of defending himself were afforded to the Appellant before arriving to the final decision.
- B- That the contents of Para-B are incorrect, hence denied. The Appellant has been treated very judiciously and has always been given full opportunities of defending himself. However, he failed to prove himself innocent.
- C- That the contents of Para-C are mere rhetoric, having no relevance whatsoever with the facts of the matter, hence denied.
- D- That the contents of Para-D are not correct, hence denied. As sufficiently explained in the preceding paras, the Appellant deliberately attempted to extend benefit to candidates who even did not appear in examination. It was unprecedented and definitely for ulterior motives. These dishonest people do not deserve any sympathy.
- E- That the contents of Para-E are misleading, hence denied. As explained in the preceding paras, the Appellant is a clever person. When he got the clue that the matter was taken into consideration for initiating action by the authorities and that a 'Show Cause Notice' was being served upon him, he withdrew/cancelled his earlier letters vide another letter No.7590/DENT dated 03.07.2019 (Annexure–D). It was, however, a futile attempt on his part to hoodwink his department.
- F- That the contents of Para-F are unrealistic, hence denied. As explained in the preceding paras, the Appellant was given full opportunities of defending himself, as required under the rules but he failed to prove himself innocent. Since charges were admitted by the appellant, hence action was initiated as required under rules 7 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servant (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules 2011.
- G- That the contents of Para-G need no comments/reply. The respondent may be allowed for any additional grounds at the time of hearing.

A complaint received from Mr. Muhammad Humayun, Muhammad Waqif, Saeedullah Khan & Muhammad Jabbar (presently working as Naib Tehsildars in OPS) against the result card of Mr. Inayat-ur-Rehman and Muhammad Nadeem Kanungos of District Peshawar (Annexure-A).

2. After examination of the record, it was found out that Superintendent of the office of the Director Land Records, Mr.Ghulam Nabi has signed contradictory letters and without any approval of the Competent Authority, addressed to Assistant Secretary (Establishment), Board of Revenue, showing Mr.Inayat-ur-Rehman and Muhammad Nadeem Kanungos as passed candidates in the Departmental Examination of Naib Tehsildar. However, the result Notification issued vide No.5916/LR-I/DENT/08, dated 19.04.2008 does not match any of the details provided by Superintendent. As is elaborated under:-



Precise facts arising out of the plaint are that plaintiff has filed the instant suit for declaration & permanent mandatory injunction against the defendants to the effect that correct date of birth of plaintiff is 10/12/1960 whereas defendants wrongly mentioned the same in their official record as 01.01.1959 which is wrong and ineffective upon the rights of the plaintiff. So plaintiff came to this court for the said correction.

In response to summons, defendants appeared through representative as well as through counsel and submitted written

statement wherein they flatly denied the contentions of the plaintiff. Divergent views of the parties out of their pleadings, framed into the following issues:

Issues:

1. Whether the plaintiff has got a cause of action?

2. Whether this court has got the jurisdiction?

3. Whether the plaintiff is within time?

4. Whether the correct date of birth of the plaintiff is 10/12/1960 and the same is wrongly entered in the record of the defendant as 01.01.1959, which is wrong and the same is liable to correction?

5. Whether the plaintiff is entitled to the decree as prayed for?

6. Relief.

After formulation of issues, parties produced pro and contra evidence of their choice. After perusal of evidence and hearing of arguments my issue wise findings are as under.

Issue NO. 2

Burden to prove this issue was upon the plaintiff. He has filed instant suit for correction of his date of birth in the CNIC and official record of defendant/NADRA which is a matter of civil nature. Though it has been admitted by the plaintiff in his plaint as well as court statement recorded as PW-3 that he is government servant as "Senior clerk" in the Board of Revenue, however he has neither made party, the Board of Revenue nor has sought any relief

from the said government institution. Although the date of birth in the service book of a government servant comes within the definition of terms and conditions of service and any such change in the date of birth of a government employee can be only made through the order of the Service Tribunal in the service book, however, in the present case plaintiff does not want any change of date of birth in his service record, nor any decree passed against the present defendant will be legally binding against the third party/institution who is not made defendant in the present suit. As such this court alone being competent civil court under Section 9 CPC has jurisdiction to adjudicate upon the matter or pars a decree against the present defendant/NADRA. Consequently it is held that this court has jurisdiction to adjudicate upon the matter between the present parties and any such decision will be binding only on the parties to this case. Hence, this issue is decided in positive.

Issue NO. 3

Burden to prove this issue was upon the plaintiff. It has been stated in the written statement of defendants that the instant suit is time barred. Defendants recorded statement through representative as DW-1. In his examination in chief he has not stated a single word regarding the limitation. A fact stated in the pleadings and not supported by the evidence produced by the said party h's no legal value in the eye of law. Fresh cause of action arises from each and every wrong entry m; de in the official record.

In the present case the limitation reekoned from the date

on which plaintiff came to know about the wrong entry of his date of birth in the record of the defendants. It is stated by plaintiff that he approached the defendants for correction but they refused to do so. There is no rebuttal on record from defendants' side of these facts. Therefore, limitation will start from the day, first when he came to know about the wrong entry and then when the defendants refused to correct the same. As such this suit is fully within time. Hence this issue is decided in positive.

Issue NO. 4

Burden to prove this issue was upon the plaintiff primarily. He has filed instant suit for correction of his date of birth. He recorded his statement as PW-3 and produced his secondary school certificate as Ex: PW3/1. He also produced office order for correction of Date of Birth in CNIC as Ex:PW-3/2. He has reiterated the same facts regarding his correct date of birth as already mentioned in the plaint: Plaintiff also produced Record keeper of Board of Revenue as PW-1 in his support. Who stated that according to service book record the date of birth is mentioned as 10/12/1960 and Exhibit service books as Ex; PW1/1 and payroll slip as Ex; PW 1/2 and SSC certificate as Ex; PW 2/3. Further Plaintiff produced Record keeper BISE Peshawar as PW2 who further supported the stance of plaintiff and produced Matric admission form as Ex;Pw 2/1 where the date of birth is mentioned as 10/12/1960. On the other hand defendants have recorded statement through representative as DW-1 who produced computerized record of the

plaintiff as Ex; DW1/1 wherein the alleged incorrect date of birth of the plaintiff i.e..01.01.1959 has been mentioned.

All the PWs have been cross examined but nothing adverse has been brought on record from them. Plaintiff has proved his stance through oral and documentary evidence. Hence, this issue is decided in affirmative.


Issues No.1 & 5:

Onus to prove these issues was upon the plaintiff. In support of his plaint he has recorded statement as PW-3 and also produced Record keeper of Board of Revenue as PW-1 record Keeper of BISE Peshawar as PW2 in his support with documentary evidences.

On the other hand defendants through representative have recorded statement as DW-1. Plaintiff through reliable and confidence inspiring evidence has proved his claim, while the defendants failed to counter his narrative. Therefore, plaintiff has not only got cause of action, but is also entitled to the decree as prayed for in his plaint. Both these issues are answered in positive.

Relief:

From the above issue wise findings plaintiff has been able to prove his claim through reliable and ćogent oral and documentary evidence. Consequently, suit of the plaintiff is hereby decreed against the defendants/NADRA as prayed for, subject to condition that the same would not affect the rights of any third person, and also with the observation that any such correction shall be liable to the prevailing government fees/taxes, if any. Parties to



bear their own costs.

Case file be consigned to the record room after its necessary completion and compilation.

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
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
