

That the addresses of parties as given above are correct and sufficient for the purpose of service.

That the petitioner was appointed as 'Laboratory Assistant' by the District Co-ordination Officer, D.I.Khan, vide letter No.9406/PS(Edu) bearing endorsement No.9407-10/PS (Edu) dated 29/07/2008. Thereafter, petitioner took over the charge of the post of 'Lab: Assistant'. Respondents No.4 & 5 in order to get start the salary of petitioner, submitted her particulars to the District Accounts officer and accordingly her salary was released and Personal No.00419560 was allotted to the petitioner. Copy of the appointment letter is enclosed as <u>Annexure A.</u>

That in the meanwhile Writ Petition No.17/2009 of one Mst. Sapna Kanwal (Lab: Assistant) was pending before this august Court and on the basis of same Writ Petition, Mst. Sapna Kanwal was reinstated but the respondent No.4 wrongly, malafidely & illegally cancelled the appointment of petitioner vide letter No.1552-4 dated 10/10/2010 under the garb of Judgment dated 24/04/2009 of this august Court. Copies of the letter No.1552-4 dated 10/10/2010 and the Judgment/Order dated 24/04/2009 in WP No.17/2009 are enclosed as <u>Annexure B & B-1</u> respectively.

That the petitioner was still in service and the then Executive District Officer/respondent No.6 vide letter No.4801-4 dated 14/04/2012 stopped the pay of present petitioner but thereafter vide letter No.8809-11 dated 16/06/2012 released her pay. Copies of both the letter No.4801-4 dated 14/04/2012 and letter No.8809-11 dated 16/06/2012 are respectively enclosed as <u>Annexure C & D</u>.

That thereafter vide letter No.280 dated 02/07/2013 (Annexure E) the respondent No.5 relieved the petitioner to report to the respondent No.6 (the then EDO) for final decision.

That in the meanwhile, respondents again vide letter No.22612 dated 22/06/2012 (allegedly issued by respondent No.6 but the same is a fake letter as there is no record of same in the Education Officer) stopped salary of the petitioner and she preferred an application on 21/07/2013 (Annexure F) for release of her salary but the same has not been paid any heed.

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That the petitioner's appointment was cancelled due to the Judgment/order dated 24/04/2009 passed in the WP No.17/2009 but in the said Judgment/order of this august Court there is no such direction to cancel the appointment of present petitioner rather direction for accommodation of one 'Sapna Kanwal' were issued. Now the petitioner is being victimized due to the letter No.1552-4 dated 10/10/2010 (Annexure B) despite the fact that she (petitioner) was serving with the respondent No.5 un-till relieved on 02/07/2013 vide letter (Annexure E) with direction to report to respondent No.6.

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That aggrieved of the cancellation of her appointment letter No.1552-4 dated 10/10/2010, the petitioner preferred Writ Petition No.430-D/2013 which came for final hearing before the Honourable Peshawar High Court, D.I.Khan Bench, on 28.03.2016 and the Honourable Court vide Judgment dated 28.03.2016 was pleased to disposed of the Writ Petition in the following manner:

"4. In view of the above concurrence, this petition is disposed of. The impugned order dated 10.10.2010 is set aside and the respondent No.5 [District Education Officer (Female)] is directed to pass an appropriate order on the petitioner's case after giving her the opportunity of hearing. As the case is too much old, therefore the respondent is directed to pass the order within a period of one month."

Certified copies of the Writ Petition No. 430-D/2016 and the Judgment dated 28.03.2016 are enclosed as <u>Annexure G & G-1</u> respectively.

That thereafter the District Education Officer (Female)/respondent No.4 constituted inquiry committee Chaired by Mst. Nighat Shaheen, Principal GGHSS Sherazi No.8, D.I.Khan with Two Members namely 1. Muhammad Ismail, Superintendent DEO (F) D.I.Khan and 2. Mst. Farhat Yasmeen, ADEO (F/S) D.I.Khan. The Inquiry Committee probed into the matter and also recorded the version of petitioner and finally submitted its

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report with the recommendation to create an appropriate way for the redressal of petitioner's grievance. Copy of the Notification for constitution of Inquiry committee and inquiry report is enclosed as **Annexure H & I.**

That by dint of Judgment dated 28.03.2016, the petitioner is back into service and respondents, despite direction to pass an appropriate order within one month, have not passed any order despite lapse of six months. Moreover, inquiry report also supported the appointment of petitioner.

That now six months have been passed and the Inquiry Report is also in the favour of petitioner, but the respondent No.4 is not taking into consideration the rights of petitioner; therefore, the petitioner has been left with no other remedy but to invoke constitutional jurisdiction of this august court for the restoration of her service and salary on, inter alia, the following grounds:

<u> GROUNDS:</u>

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That it is the matter of record that the appointment of petitioner was cancelled vide letter dated 10.10.2010 due to the Judgment dated 24.04.2009 of this Honourable Court in Writ Petition No.17/2009 filed by one Mst. Sapna Kanwal; although there was no such direction.

However, this Honourable Court vide Judgment dated 28.03.2016 in W.P. No.430-D/2013, filed by petitioner, was pleased to set aside the letter dated 10.10.2010 and respondents were directed to issue an appropriate order. After that, respondents conducted an inquiry committee who submitted its report which favours the petitioner. Even then the respondent No.4 is using delaying tactics and is not taking into consideration the right of petitioner. Hence a great injustice is being done to the petitioner.

That legally, after setting aside the letter/order dated 10.10.2010 (whereby appointment of petitioner was cancelled) the petitioner is back into service particularly when petitioner received monthly salary upto 22.06.2012;

now after the inquiry report too, there is no iota against the petitioner to question her appointment. Delaying tactics of respondents are without jurisdiction, without lawful authority and having no binding effect upon rights of petitioner accrued to her by dint of her appointment as well as inquiry report.

That the petitioner was validly appointed as "Lab Assistant" and thereafter her salary was also released and she was performing her official duties with zeal, devotion and to the best satisfaction of her superiors. Now the petitioner is entitled for restoration of her place of appointment and resuming of her salaries; and respondents are having no lawful justification to sabotage the rights of petitioner.

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That by dint of Judgment dated 28.03.2016, the petitioner is back into service and respondents, despite direction to pass an appropriate order within one month, have not passed any order despite lapse of six months. Moreover, inquiry report also supported the appointment of petitioner. Now there is no adverse order against the petitioner and she is thus entitled to perform her official duties and take monthly salaries. But respondents are not taking into account the rights of petitioner and instead posted the one Mst. Nazneen Rafi at the place of petitioner.

That the respondents are having no legal and justified reason to stop the petitioner from performance of her official duties. It is worthy to mention that after issuing appointment letter to petitioner by the then DCO, the then authorities of Education Department (respondents No.4 to 6) as well as the District Accounts Officer honoured the appointment of petitioner and no one objected the appointment order of the petitioner at that time. Copy of the service book and attendance register of petitioner are enclosed as <u>Annexure J</u>. Now the principle of estoppel is attracted against respondents and they are estopped to raise an objection against the petitioner.

That the counsel for petitioner may be allowed to argue additional grounds at the time of hearing of this Writ Petition. In wake of the above submissions, it is respectfully prayed that on acceptance of this Writ Petition, the respondents may kindly be directed to allow the petitioner to perform her official duties being in service with the respondent No.5 and also to release monthly salaries to the petitioner. Any other appropriate relief which this Honourable Court, in the given circumstances, may deem proper in the best interest of justice, may also be granted to the petitioner.



Moreover, the same has been refused/ rejected by the competent authority vide Letter No.6053-57 dated15.03.2019 (Annexed at A) and has constituted a committee comprised of senior Officers of the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education vide Order No 6058-67, dated the 15.03.2019 (Annexed at B) and ordered them to conduct a fresh inquiry to see the matter and come with clear YES/NO to solve the grievances of the petitioner if allowed under the Rules and Policy.


Proceedings of the meeting:

Meeting was started on 8:00 AM at the GGCMHS NO.1, D.I.Khan, chaired by Respected Principal. Meeting was attended by the petitioner, Maria Bashir and all members who were then served the attendance sheet for signing in. The recitation of Holy Quran was made to invigorate the theme of justice and truth in the minds of all participants. The petitioner, Maria Bashir, Ex-Lab Assistant, was then served the questionnaire which was duly explained to her by the Respected Chairperson and other members, when needed. After seeing through the verbal/written answers received from the petitioner, the following facts were observed.

Facts of the case in hand:

- 1. That the first appointment order of Mrs. Maria Bashir, Ex-Lab A**scind**ant was issued by the DCO D.I.Khan, hence, invalid ab initio; since the DCO has not been a competent authority to appoint or terminate employees in BPS 1-10 as held by the Worthy Judgment dated 27.10.2011, by the Honorable Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Services Tribunal in Service Appeal No. 1407 of 2010, titled as Mr. Abdus Salam and others vs. Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Secretary Education.
- 2. The petitioner's appointment order had been invalidated vide order by the Executive District Officer Elementary and Secondary Education D.I.Khan, dated 10.10.2010 and 14.4.2012, as the validity of the appointment order wasn't justified; whereas, the same has not been justified yet.





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That another, Mst. Sapna Kanwal was reinstated and posted on the only post of Lab Assistant at GGCMHS No.6 Chah Syed Munawar Shah, D.I.Khan, after the Worthy Judgment by this Honorable Court in Writ Petition No.17-D/2009; whereas, Appointment Order of Mrs. Maria Bashir, being in /alid and unjustified, ab initio, was cancelled vide No.1552-4 dated 10.10.2010 (without mentioning that the cancellation is made in compliance with the Worthy Judgment ibid.)

- 4. That the matter had once been inquired into but it had forwarded its report with no clear suggestions; hence, it was impracticable for any further action. Moreover, the same has been refused/ rejected by the competent authority vide Letter No.6053-57 dated15.03.2019 and has constituted another committee (this one) vide Order No 6058-67, dated the 15.03.2019 and ordered to conduct a fresh inquiry to see the matter and come with clear YES/ NO to solve the grievances of the petitioner, if allowed under the Rules and Policy.
- 1. That this committee provided the petitioner a consoling chance for proving/ telling how could she be exonerated and be reinstated in service, yet, she failed to prove her initial appointment/ service as rational/ legal.

DECISION:

In view of above submissions, this committee unanimously decides NOT TO REINSTATE services of the petitioner, Mrs. Maria Bashir, Ex-Lab Assistant, BS-7, GGHSS Chah Syed Munawar Shah, D.I.Khan.

It also recommends passing of a speaking order that will yield an effect of termination of services (from the date of appointment) for the case of petitioner and any case found in future with the same breaching offense –though, it shall be heard in prior and be given a chance to clarify on how it might be vindicated.

2. That after receiving appointment order, the petitioner was medically examined and issued medical certificate by the Medical Superintendent on 20.2.2008. Copy of the appointment medical certificate is enclosed as <u>Annexure 'B'</u>.

That there after the petitioner went to the concerned school i.e respondent No.3 for taking over the charge but the respondent No.3 refused to accept the charge of the petitioner without assigning any reason, therefore, the petitioner approached respondent No.2, who telephonically directed respondent No.3 to accept the charge of the petitioner but no positive result came out.

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





Respectfully Sheweth,

That the addresses of parties as given above are correct and sufficient for the purpose of service.

That the petitioner was appointed as 'Laboratory Assistant' by the District Co-ordination Officer, D.I.Khan, vide letter No.9406/PS(Edu) bearing endorsement No.9407-10/PS (Edu) dated 29/07/2008. Thereafter, petitioner took over the charge of the post of 'Lab: Assistant' and accordingly her salary was also released by the District Accounts Officer and Personal No.00419560 was also allotted to her. Copy of the appointment letter is enclosed as <u>Annexure A</u>.

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- 3. That in the meanwhile Writ Petition No.17/2009 of one Mst. Sapna Kanwal (Lab: Assistant) was pending before this august Court and on the basis of same Writ Petition, Mst. Sapna Kanwal was reinstated but the respondent No.4 wrongly, malafidely & illegally cancelled the appointment of petitioner vide letter No.1552-4 dated 10/10/2010 under the garb of order dated 24/04/2009 of this august court. Copies of the letter No.1552-4 dated 10/10/2010 and the order dated 24/04/2009 in WP No.17/2009 are enclosed as <u>Annexure B & B-1</u> respectively.
 - ⁷That the petitioner was still in service and the then Executive District Officer/respondent No.4 vide letter No.4801-4 dated 14/04/2012 stopped the pay of present petitioner but thereafter vide letter No.8809-11 dated 16/06/2012 released her pay. Copies of both the letters are respectively enclosed as <u>Annexure C & D</u>.

That thereafter vide letter No.280 dated 02/07/201**&** (Annexure E) the respondent No.6 relieved the petitioner to report to the respondent No.4 (the then EDO) for final decision.

That in the meanwhile, respondents again vide letter No.22612 dated 22/06/2012 (allegedly issued by respondent No.4 but the same is a fake letter as there is no record of same in the Education Officer) stopped salary of the petitioner and she preferred an application (Annexure F) on 21/07/2013 for release of her salary but the same has not been paid any heed.

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That the petitioner's appointment was cancelled due to the order dated 24/04/2009 passed in the WP No.17/2009 but in the said order of this august court there is no such direction to cancel the appointment of present petitioner rather direction for accommodation of one 'Sapna Kanwal' were issued. Now the petitioner is being victimized due to the letter No.1552-4 dated 10/10/2010 (*Annexure B*) despite the fact that she (petitioner) was serving with the respondent No.6 un-till relieved on 02/07/2013 vide letter Annexure E with direction to report to respondent No.4.

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That malafide of the respondents is apparent through the fact that they are not taking the case of petitioner seriously and also not releasing her salary despite the fact that she served under the control of respondent No.6 and now respondents are using delaying tactics and petitioner has been made a rolling stone.

That the Principal Bench of this august court while deciding a constitutional petition held that once an appointment order is taken legal effect, the same cannot be withdrawn/rescinded later-on and in view of the same verdict the appointment of petitioner too cannot be cancelled by the respondent No.4.

10. That now the petitioner has been left with no other remedy but to invoke constitutional jurisdiction of this august court to please declare the letter dated 10/10/2010 (Annexure B) as void, illegal, without jurisdiction, without lawful authority and having no binding effect upon rights of the petitioner, more particularly when the same has not yet been acted upon, and also to direct the respondents to release salaries of the petitioner and allow her to perform her official duties as there was no direction in the order dated 24/09/2009 passed by this august court regarding cancellation of the appointment of petitioner with such other relief as deemed appropriate in the interest of justice on, inter alia, the following grounds:

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GROUNDS:

i.

That the respondent No. 4 being a responsible officer and being a public servant was required to discharge his duties in a suitable manner judiciously; but instead, he under the garb of order dated 24/09/2009 passed in WP No.17/2009, cancelled the appointment of petitioner despite that fact that there was no such direction by this Honourable Court and this illegal, unlawful and irresponsible act of the respondent No.4 call for interference and judicial notice of this Honourable Court.

- *ii.* That the respondent No.8 was to be accommodated per directions of this august court on any vacant post of the Lab: Assistant. But instead the appointment of petitioner was cancelled due to malafide, quite in a non-judicial and ruthless manner.
- That even after the issuance of letter dated 10/10/2010, the salary of petitioner was released by the respondent No.4 vide letter No.8809-11 dated 16/06/2012 (Annexure D) released her pay, however, again vide letter No.22612 dated 22/06/2012 (allegedly issued by respondent No.4 but the same is a fake letter as there is no record of same in the Education Officer) stopped salary of the petitioner.

The petitioner served under the control of respondent No.6 till 02/07/2013, and thereafter, she was relieved with direction to report to respondent No.4, accordingly the petitioner reported to the respondent No.4 and many time visited his office but no response has been given to the petitioner.

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iv.

That the petitioner was validly appointed as "Lab Assistant" and thereafter her salary was also released and she was performing her official duties with zeal, devotion and to the best satisfaction of her superiors but the respondent No.4 has victimized the petitioner under the veil of this august court's order dated 24/04/2009, which in no effects the services of petitioner. Hence, a great injustice has been done to the petitioner. That the impugned letter dated 10/10/2010 and subsequent letters for stoppages of the salary of petitioner, are based on malafide, without jurisdiction, without lawful authority and are having no binding effect upon rights of the petitioner as the respondent No.4 was having no lawful authority to cancel the appointment order of the petitioner.

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- vi. That the petitioner requested the respondents to issue her copies of the despatched registered regarding issuance of letters dated 16/06/2012 (Annexure D) and the letter dated 22/06/2012 whereby the salary of petitioner was stopped. But the respondents did not provide the despatch register to her which amply proves that both these referred letters are antedated and bogus. Copie of the the eletter 22/06/2012 and the application dated 17/08/2013 are enclosed as Annexure G & H respectively.
- *vii.* That the Principal Bench of this august court while deciding a constitutional petition held that once an appointment order is taken legal effect, the same cannot be withdrawn/rescinded later-on and in view of the same verdict the appointment of petitioner too cannot be cancelled by the respondent No.4.
- viii. That the petitioner has been condemned unheard and not a single chance of hearing was given to the petitioner by respondents. Hence, the impugned termination order is liable to be declared as null & void.
 - That the counsel for petitioner may be allowed to argue additional grounds at the time of hearing of this Writ Petition.

In wake of the above submissions, it is respectfully prayed that on acceptance of this Writ Petition, the impugned letters dated 10/10/2010 are all the subsequent letters effecting the service of petitioner adversely, may graciously be declare as null & void, without jurisdiction, without lawful authority and having no binding effect upon rights of the petitioner, and the salary of petitioner may please be released. It is further prayed that the
