The qualifying test will be held out of the following core topics.

1. Legal categories of Forests and various Forest types.
2. Nursery, plantation techniques and maintenance of Journals.
3. Chalking of damage reports, prosecution and compensation cases.
4. Measurement of trees logs and scunts.
5. Writing Reports on applications for permits, TPs etc.
6. Identifications of various species and their requirements
7. Engineering Techniques (i.e. Check Dam Terracing)

You are therefore requested to nominate and send all untrained forester and forest guards of your respective circle to be appeared in qualifying test at KPFS to be held out on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2022 at 1100 hours in KPFS.

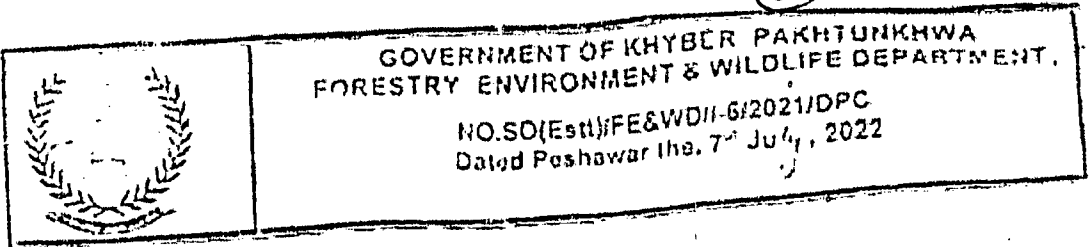

Also ensure that there is no seniority dispute in Siran Forest Division. In case the ACRs dossier of the senior official is incomplete or any other document / information required by DPC for determining his suitability for promotion is not available or in case of involvement in any pending inquiry, his promotion case may be deferred, and a post will be reserved for him as per Para-V of the Promotion Policy. In pursuance of the training strategy framed for Forestry/ Wildlife paraprofessionals at Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Forest School Thai Abbottabad, it has been decided that all untrained Deputy rangers, Foresters, Forest Guards and Wildlife Watchers who have more than five years of service experience and have not yet undergone Forester/Forest Guard mandatory training course at KPFS will be enrolled in the training course on the provision of qualifying entry test from the month of August. The entry test of wildlife trainees will be conducted on the basis of papers provided by Chief Conservator Wildlife to the undersigned, while the entry test of forest trainees will be designed by the school from the field experience related activities such as:

1. Legal categories of Forests and various Forest types
2. Nursery, plantation techniques and maintenance of Journals.
3. Chalking of damage reports, prosecution and compensation cases.
4. Measurement of trees, scants and logs
5. Writing reports on applications for permits, TPs etc.
6. Identifications of various species and their requirements
7. Engineering Techniques (i.e. Check Dam Terracing)

Based on the qualifying entry test, more than five years of service experience will be considered, evaluated for 08 months of training at KPFS and for the rest of 04 months, they have to join the ongoing course regularly at KPFS and will be pass out with the course on schedule date

It is, therefore, requested to send the list of all untrained Deputy Rangers, Foresters, Forest Guards and wildlife Watchers of your respective divisions, who have more than five years of service experience, before 14 February 2022. So the school administration may make necessary arrangements for their entry test and enrollment.

Furthermore also send the list of trained foresters of your respective divisions for 03 months mandatory training course at KPFS which commencing from 1st March 2022.
