

PRAYER:

That on acceptance of this appeal the inaction of the respondents by illegally deducting:

- i. Health Profession Allowance @ of Rs. 240,000/-.
- ii. Conveyance Allowance @ of Rs. 68,544/-.

For the period from July 2018 to July 2020 whereby the salary of the appellant was stopped and was kept under suspension Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit may also be awarded in favor of the appellant.

Respectfully Sheweth:,

FACTS:

Brief facts giving raise to the instant appeal are as under:

1- That, appellant is the Law abiding, Peaceful & bonafide citizen of Pakistan and is a civil servant working under the control of respondents.

Copy of the CNIC is attached as ANNEXURE

- 2- That, appellant is the employee of the respondents Department and was appointed as Medical Technician vide order dated 08-03-1986 and after serving for sufficient time was promoted to the post of Senior PHC Technician (BPS-14).
- 3- That, the appellant has served the Department quite efficiently, whole heartedly and upto the entire satisfaction of his superior and as such the appellant has an unblemished service record.
- 4- That appellant while performing his official duty at Category-D Hospital Gara Tajik District Peshawar salary of the appellant was stopped from July 2018 the reason of which would be best known to the respondents and where after the services of the appellant was suspended on account of items that were missing from the store of the hospital vide order dated 02-11-2018.

5- That the appellant filed a writ petition no. 7056-P/2019 before the Peshawar High Court, Peshawar which was allowed vide judgment dated 18-06-2020 with the direction to the respondents to reinstate the appellant and released the outstanding salaries from the date when it was stopped.

6- That the appellant was reinstated and all the salaries were released from the date of its stoppage but unfortunately when the appellant received the salary slip for the month July 2020 the appellant come to know that Health Professional Allowance & Conveyance Allowance for the period from July 2018 to July 2020 has been deducted from the outstanding and accordingly necessary entry had also been made in the service book of the appellant.

7- That, the appellant feeling aggrieved from the illegal deduction of Health Professional Allowance and Conveyance Allowance for the suspended period filed Departmental Appeal dated 10-09-2020 before the respondent no. 2 for tackling up the case of the appellant with respondent no. 4 which was properly allotted with diary number but no response has been received to the appellant within the statutory period of 90 (ninety) days.

Copy of Departmental Appeal dated 10.09.2020 & diary numbers is attached as ANNEXURE E & F.

8- That, appellants feeling highly aggrieved from the act of the respondent and having no other adequate or efficacious remedy but to file the instant appeal before this Honourable Tribunal on the following grounds amongst other:

GROUNDS:

- A- That, the act of the respondents by illegally deducting Health Professional Allowance and Conveyance Allowance for the period from July 2018 to July 2020 is void ab-initio, unconstitutional, against the Law, fact, Rules, norms of Natural Justice and material available on record hence not tenable in the eye of Law.
- B- That, the appellant has not been treated by the respondent Department in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article 4 and 25 of the constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- C- That, the treatment met out to the appellants is highly discriminatory while illegally deducting Health Professional Allowance and Conveyance Allowance for the period from July 2018 to July 2020 and not releasing the same.
- D- That, the respondent acted in an arbitrary and malafide manner while illegally deducting Health Professional Allowance and Conveyance Allowance for the period from July 2018 to July 2020.
- E- That according to Section-6 of the E&D Rule 2011 the period of suspension is only 90 days but the act of the respondents by keeping the appellant suspended illegally for such long was beyond the approach of the appellant hence deduction of Health Professional Allowance and Conveyance Allowance for the period from July 2018 to July 2020 is illegal and is liable to be released to the appellant.

- F- That the appellant was kept under suspension from 2018 till June 2020 and as per various judgment passed by the apex Supreme Court of Pakistan the employee is entitle for all the allowances during suspension period.
- G- That, act of the respondents is also a clear violation of Article-38 (e) of the Constitution of Islamic republic of Pakistan which states that:
 - "to reduce disparity in the income and earning of the individual including the persons in Service of Pakistan".
- H- That the appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that appeal of the appellant may kindly be accepted as prayed for



2. Brief facts, as averred in the writ petition are that the petitioner while serving in the respondent department on the post of Senior PHC Technician, was suspended vide order dated 02.11.2018 on account of missing items from the store of the hospital. The monthly salary of the petitioner was also stopped against which he filed several applications before the competent Authority and finally filed an application/request before respondent No.2 but till date neither the petitioner has been re-instated nor his salary stopped since October 2018 has been released. Hence this writ

petition.

4. Rule-6 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa
Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline)
Rules, 2011 deals with the matter of suspension. For
the purpose of convenience, the same is reproduced
below;

"6.Suspension.—A Government servant against whom action is proposed to be initiated under rule 5 may be placed under suspension for a period of ninety days, if in the opinion of -competent authority, suspension is necessary or expedient, and if the period of suspension is not extended for a further period of ninety days within thirty days of the expiry of initial period of suspension, the Government servant shall bedeemed to be reinstated"

5. The impugned suspension order was passed on 02.11.2018 and since then sufficient time has been elapsed. Nothing is available on record to show that the said suspension was ever extended.

Therefore, under Rule-6 of the Khyben
