APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT 1974 AGAINST THE TRANSFER ORDERS OF THE APPELLANT WHEREBY SHE HAS BEEN TRANSFERRED/POSTED ILLEGALLY AND WITHOUT LAWFUL AUTHORITY AND



# IN CONTRAVENTION OF THE SPOUSE POLICY, E-TRANSFER POLICY, BAN PERIOD AND ALSO AGAINST THE TENURE POLICY.

#### RESPECTFULLY SUBMITTED:

1. **That** the Appellant is a civil servant posted as Librarian (BPS-17) after she was recommended for appointment as Librarian BPS 17 and as her first posting joined GGHSS Chamkani on 25.05.2019. where her tenure is incomplete. The Appellant besides the above is a law abiding citizen of Pakistan and also hails from a respectable family.

#### Copy of the Appointment order is Annex-A.

- 2. That the appellant performed her duties due diligently and for almost a period less than two years at her first station of posting i.e. GGHSS Chamkani.
- **3. That** on 11-09-2019, the Respondent No. 2 has issued e-transfer policy for the entire department under Respondent No. 2.

#### Copy of the e-transfer policy is Annex-B.

**4. That** the Respondent No. 2 had on 28-09-2021 issued a notification, whereby complete ban on all transfers/postings was notified.

# Copy of the notification dated 28-09-202 **is** Annex-C.

5. That the appellant on 05-05-2021 received transfer orders dated 30-04-2021 whereby she was transferred and post as Librarian to GCET Jamrud, Khyber District. Vide the same transfer orders the respondent no. 5 was posted as Librarian to GGHSS on the post held by the appellant.

### Copy of the transfer order is Annex-D.

**6. That** immediately after receipt of the transfer orders, the appellant moved a departmental representation within 7 days stipulated within the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa provincial ESTA Code posting/transfer policy of the Provincial Government.

# Copy of the esta-code extract is Annex-E. Copy of the representation is Annex-F.

7. That no decision has been taken within the stipulated time frame of 15days as per the Esta Code posting/transfer policy.

8. That the appellant also moved an application to the Respondent No. 2 identifying a position within Peshawar in Lady Griifith School to where she may be transferred. However, no decision has been taken on that either.

### Copy of application is Annex-G

9. That it is also important to mention that the husband of the appellant is serving as a librarian in University of Peshawar National center of Excellence on regular basis. It is also important to note that the respondent no. 6 is single whereas the appellant is with kids.

authority, and with no immediate need for the same, also the fact that the person posted to the post of the Appellant is tainted with malafide, the Appellant having no other "effacious", efficient and proper remedy and after the lapse of the period of 15days in matters pertaining transfer of civil servants, the appellant approaches this Honorable Tribunal amongst others on the following grounds:

#### **Grounds:**

- a. **Because** the transfer/posting order is based in malafide and is inherently illegal, unlawful and without jurisdiction on the score of the ill-will involved in the order of transfer/posting and is thus liable to be set-aside.
- b. **Because** the violation of the spouse posting policy of the Government by the respondents is thus clearly illegal. The posting to Jamrud is clearly unprecedented as the appellant is made to work away from her spouse, who is posted at University of Peshawar.
- c. **Because** the transfer is also violative of the e-transfer policy of the Elementary and Secondary Education Department of the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- d. **Because** the transfer had taken place in a ban period against the spouse policy against the tenure system and all the norms of justice.
- e. **Because** the violation of the spouse policy also goes in straight conflict with judgments of the superior courts reported in:

2011 PLC (cs) 592 Lahore 2003 PLC (cs) 1322 Lahore 2015 PLC (cs) 1215 Balochistan Service Tribunal



# 2014 PLC (cs) 1032 Karachi High Court Sindh 2004 PLC (cs) 622 Lahore High Court

- f. **Because** The Rules designate certain posts as 'tenure posts' (rule 22 read with Schedule IV of the Rules) and prescribe a period of three years for an incumbent to serve on such posts. Such prescribed tenure may therefore be categorized as the ideal duration for which a civil servant should serve at a particular post. The post of the appellant is a tenure post, yet she has been transferred from her posting before the tenure was complete. Thus the appellant having not been allowed to complete her normal tenure and thus the order impugned is violation of transfer posting policy of the Government and the judgment of the apex court reported in PLD 1995 SC Page No 530 and PLD 2013 Supreme Court Page No 195.
- g. That the recently the august Supreme Court of Pakistan has in its Judgment reported in 2013 PLD SC 195, decided a point of law and while committing upon the transfer and posting and other related matters of service held as under:-
  - (i) Appointments. Removals and Promotions:- Appointments, removals and promotions must be made in accordance with the law and the rules made there under; where no such law or rule exists and the matter has been left to discretion, such discretion must be exercised in a structured, transparent and reasonable manner and in the public interest.
  - (ii) <u>Tenure. posting and transfer:</u> When the ordinary tenure for a posting has been specified in the law or rules made there under; such tenure must be respected and cannot be varied, except for compelling reasons, which should be recorded in writing and are judicially reviewable.
  - (iii) <u>Illegal Orders:</u> Civil servants owe their first and foremost allegiance to the law and the Constitution. They are not bound to obey orders from superiors which are illegal or are not in accordance with accepted practices and rule, based norms; instead, in such situations, they must record their opinion and; if necessary, dissent.
  - (iv) <u>O.S.D Officers</u> should not be posted as OSD except for compelling reasons, which must be recorded in writing and are judicially reviewable. If at all an Officer is to be posted as OSD, such posting should be for the minimum period possible and if there is a disciplinary inquiry going on against him, such inquiry must be completed as the earliest.



Relying upon the Judgment of the Supreme Court of Pakistan the Respondents are duty bound to have follow the law, judgment of the superior courts, and posting and transfer should not have been influenced in any manner whatsoever.

h. Because the Supreme Court of Pakistan in CP No. 2812/2017 clearly directed in the following terms:

".......The issues raised in this petition are substantial questions of law of public importance in terms of Article 212(3) of the Constitution, which we have dilated upon and which were left unattended by the learned chairman and members of the Tribunal. The Tribunal also did not take into account the referred to judgments of this Court. The Tribunal referred to a judgment of this Court, Zaka Ullah Bajwa v Chief Secretary, Government of the Punjab (2005 SCMR 13), which held that a civil servant, "is required to serve anywhere against the post to which he is transferred", however, that does not mean a civil servant can be made to serve under her subordinate or for a very brief period of time or that the minister can undermine the authority of the secretary of the department".

It was further observed in the said judgment that:

"The Chief Secretary and the secretaries of the departments of the Government are directed not to act pursuant to any notification, order and/or instruction whereby a minister orders the posting/transfer of a civil servant."

i. Because Section 10 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act states as follows:

"Every civil servant shall be liable to serve anywhere within or outside the Province in any post under the Federal Government, or any Provincial Government or local authority, or a an corporation or body set up or established by any such Government:

Provided that nothing contained in this section shall apply to a civil servant recruited specifically to serve in a particular area or region:

Provided further that where a civil servant is required to serve in a post outside her service or cadre, her terms and conditions of service as to her pay shall not be less favourable than those to which he would have been entitled if he had been so required to serve."

The aforesaid section does not empower the Government to cut short the normal tenure of a posted/transferred civil servant, and particularly without assigning any reason. In the case of Mahmood Akhtar Naqvi (Anita Turab case) (above) this Court held: "16. In the Hajj Corruption Case, the court reiterated its earlier ruling in Zahid Akhtar v. Government of Punjab (PLD 1995 SC 530), where it had been held that

"the normal period of posting of a Government servant at a station, according to Rule 21 of the Rules of Business is three years, which has to be followed in the ordinary circumstances, unless for reasons or exigencies of service a transfer before expiry of the said period becomes necessary in the opinion of the competent authority." Furthermore, with regard to transfers of civil servants, this Court has



stated that transfers by political figures which are not legally sustainable. Farrukh gulzar v. Secretary Local Government and Rural Development Department, Lahore and 2 others (1998 SCMR 2222). These are principles of law enunciated by this court and are to be followed in terms of Article 189 of the Constitution. We, however, repeatedly come across violations of such principles. This unnecessarily leads to litigation which, in turn, clogs Courts and Service Tribunals."

- j. Because in-fact there exist no exigencies of service nor can the order of transfer be termed as in the public interest rather the same has been issued in violation of the transfer and posting policy and in ban period.
- k. **Because** the Appellant has been treated illegally, unlawfully and against the spirit of the law.
- Because the mechanism provided under Article 212 is attracted for the reason of the order being corum non judice and illegal for the entrenched malice on part of the Respondents in the case.
- m. **Because** the Appellant has been seriously discriminated in line with the spirit of Article 25 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, as there is a blanket ban imposed on transfers of teaching faculty within the province, yet in order to settle score with the Appellant, there has been a dispensation sought and granted without even a remote reference as to how or why such dispensation was sought and granted by the competent authority. There has been no reason given. The record is clear that there is no reason other than the clear political pressure being exerted on the appellant.
- n. **Because t**he actions on part of the respondents seriously are in the negation of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 and the Civil Servants Act.
- o. **Because** before taking the impugned action, no due process of law has been adopted by the Respondents.
- p. Because the Fundamental Rights of the Appellant have been violated in relation to Article 4, 8, 9, 18 & 25 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973. The said rights flow out of the Constitution the terms and conditions of service of the Appellant and this Honorable Court being the custodian of the Fundamental Rights of citizens of Pakistan, as well as the protection afforded by the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973, is

why the Appellant seeks the redress of their grievances and to end the ordeal the Appellant is going through due to the illegal, unlawful and unjust acts and inaction of the Respondents.

**Because** the actions and inactions of the Respondents proclaim their own mala fide.

r. **Because** the Appellant has got the fundamental right of being treated in accordance

with law but the treatment meted out to the Appellant is on consideration other

than legal and he has been deprived of her rights duly guaranteed to him by the

constitution of Pakistan.

**Because** the Respondents cannot be allowed under the law to pass any illegal order.

Because the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law, hence her rights

secured and guaranteed under the Law are badly violated.

Because the Appellant crave for leave to add further grounds at the time of her oral

arguments before this Hon'ble Tribunal highlighting further contraventions of the

provisions of the Constitution & Laws which adversely affected the Appellant.

PRAYER:

In view of the above, it is humbly prayed that this honorable Tribunal may

graciously be pleased to declare that the transfer order dated 30-04-2021 by virtue

of which the appellant has been transferred be declared to be illegal, unlawful,

against the norms of justice and corum non judice and to Direct the respondents to

forthwith withdraw the impugned transfer/posting orders of the Appellant. Any

other relief deemed appropriate in the circumstance of the case may also be

granted.

**Interim Relief:** 

May it please this Honorable Tribunal to suspend the posting/transfer of the

Appellant till the final disposal of the appeal, and that no adverse action be taken

against her.

# **Posting and Transfer**



19

Statutory Provision.

Section 10 of the NWFP Civil Servants Act, 1973.

**Posting and Transfer**. Every civil servant shall be liable to serve anywhere within or outside the Province, in any post under the Federal Government, or any Provincial Government or Local authority, or a Corporation or body set up or established by any such Government:-

Provided that nothing contained in this section shall apply to a civil servant recruited specifically to serve in a particular area or region;

Provided further that, where a civil servant is required to serve in a post outside a service or cadre, his terms and conditions of service as to his pay shall not be less favourable than those to which he would have been entitled if he had not been so required to serve.

#### **POSTING / TRANSFER POLICY OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT**

- i) All the posting/transfers shall be strictly in public interest and shall not be abused/misused to victimize the Government servants
- ii) All Government servants are prohibited to exert political, Administrative or any other pressures upon the posting/transfer authorities for seeking posing/transfers of their choice and against the public interest.
- iii) All contrict Government employees appointed against specific posts, can not be ported against any other post.
- iv) The normal tenure of posting shall be three years subject to the condition that for the officers/officials posted in unattractive areas the tenure shall be two years and for the hard areas the tenure shall be one year. The unattractive and hard areas will be notified by the Government.

- vi) While making postings/transfer from settled areas to FATA and vice-versa, specific approval of Governor, NWFP needs to be obtained

Consequently authorities competent under the NWFP Government Rules of Business, 1985, District Government Rules of Business 2001, Posting/Transfer Policy and other rules for the time being in force, allowed to make posting/transfer subject to observance of the policy and rules.

needs to be obtained. Whereas, in case of posting/transfer of officers in BS-18 and above, from settled areas to FATA and vice versa, specific approval of the Governor NWFP shall be obtained.

- vi (a) All Officers/officials selected against Zone-I/FATA quota in the Provincial Services should compulsorily serve in FATA for atleast eighteen months in each grade. This should start from senior most scales/grades downwards in each scale/grade of each cadre.
- vii) Officers may be posted on executive/administrative posts in the Districts of their domicile except District Coordination Officers (D.C.Os) and DPOs/Superintendent of Police (SP). Similarly Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) shall not be posted at a place where the Police Station (Thaana) of his area/residence is situated.
- viii) No posting/transfers of the officer's/officials on detailment basis shall be made.
- ix) Regarding the posting of husband/wife, both in Provincial services, efforts where possible would be made to post such persons at one station subject to the public interest.
- x) All the posting/transferring authorities may facilitate the posting/transfer of the unmarried female government Servants at the station of the residence of their parents.
- Officers/officials except DCOs and DPOs/SPs who are due to retire within one year may be posted on their option on posts in the Districts of their domicile and be allowed to serve there till the retirement <sup>2</sup>DCOs and DPOs who are due to retire in the near future may also be posted in the District of their domicile subject to the condition that such posting would be against non-administrative posts of equivalent scales;
- xii) In terms of Rule-17(1) and (2) read with Schedule-III of the NWFP Government Rules of Business 1985, transfer of officers shown in column 1 of the following table shall be made by the authorities shown against each officer in column2 thereof:

Xiii) While considering posting/transfer proposals all the concerned authorities shall keep in mind the following:

To ensure the posting of proper persons on proper posts, the Performance Evaluation Report/annual confidential reports, past and present record of service, performance on post held presently and in the past and general reputation with focus on the integrity of the concerned officers/officals be considered.

b) Tenure on present post shall also be taken into consideration and the posting/transfers shall be in the best public interest.

Government servants including District Govt. employees feeling aggrieved due to the orders of posting/transfer authorities may seek remedy from the next higher authority / the appointing authority as the case may be through an appeal to be submitted within seven days of the receipt of such orders.

xiv)

Such appeal shall be disposed of within fifteen days. The option of appeal against posting/ transfer orders could be exercised only in the following cases.

- i) Pre-mature posing/transfer or posting transfer in violation of the provisions of this policy.
- ii) Serious and grave personal (humanitarian) grounds.
- 2. To streamline the postings/transfers in the District Government and to remove any irritant/confusions in this regard the provision of Rule 25 of the North West Frontier Province District Government Rules of Business 2001 read with schedule IV thereof is referred. As per schedule-IV the posting/transferring authorities for the officers/officials shown against each are as under:-





### **Preliminary Objections**

- 1. That the appellant has got no cause of action to file the instant appeal.
- 2. That the Appellant is not aggrieved person within the meaning of Article 199 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- 3. That Appellant is estopped by his own conduct to approach this Hon'able Tribunal.
- 4. That no vested right of the appellant has been infringed nor any provisions of the Constitution have been violated, therefore, the instant Service Appeal is not maintainable in the circumstances.
- 5. That the instant appeal is based on mala-fide intention just to put pressure on the Respondents for stay at her own choice of station.
- 6. The present appeal has been filed to entangle the Department unnecessarily in litigation and to waste the precious time of the respondents as well as of this Hon'able Tribunal.
- 7. That the present appeal is against the relevant provision of law and rules.
- 8. That in the instant Service Appeal the Appellant has suppressed material facts from this Honorable Tribunal which are sin-qua-non for the just and fair disposal of the case.
- 9. The appeal of the appellant is time barred.

### REPLY ON FACTS.

- Pertains to record, however, the said transfer/posting order was notified in the public interest and the appellant completed her normal tenure of two years as per posting / transfer policy (Annex-A).
- That each and every civil servant falling under the ambit of section-10 of KPK, Civil Servant Act 1973 is legally bound to serve the Respondent Department to the entire satisfaction of the Competent Authority.
- 3. That e-transfer policy was introduced in best interest of public and to transparent the posting policy and to facilitate the employee of Education Department.
- 4. That para 04 pertain to record.
- 5. Incorrect hence denied that the department issued transfer of the appellant on 30.04.2021 and the private respondent submitted her arrival report to the principal concerned on the




- very next day, hence the transfer order was in the knowledge of the appellant on the same day and the order has also been complied on the very next day.
- 6. The appellant has failed to file departmental appeal to proper forum i.e. Chief Secretary next higher authority and also the said transfer order was submitted by private respondent No. 5 on the very next day to the Principal concerned, hence the appellant departmental appeal is also time barred.
- 7. That the instant service appeal is also premature and the appellant is liable to wait for the disposal of the departmental appeal up to 90 days as per Hon'ble Tribunal Act.
- 8. That para-8 pertains to record.
- 9. As the appellant admitted herself that the private respondents is single and unmarried as per posting /transfer policy respondents No. 5 should be adjusted near to her parents, furthermore the University of Peshawar and Jamrud has hardly 5-10 Km away from each others.
- 10. Incorrect, hence not admitted. The appellant has not submitted / filed departmental appeal to proper forum. Hence the instant Service Appeal may be dismissed inter-alia on the following grounds.

### **REPLY ON GROUNDS**

- a. Incorrect and denied, the impugned Notification dated 30-04-2021 of the Respondents within legal sphere and is liable to be maintained in favour of the Respondent Department in the interest of justice and under the mandatory provisions of Section 10 of KPK, Civil Servant Act, 1973.
- b. Incorrect and not admitted. The stance of the appellant is illegal as the post of the Librarian BS-17 is purely a Provincial Cadre post in the Respondent Department and the appellant has been treated as per law, rules and policy.
- c. Incorrect and not admitted.
- d. Incorrect & not admitted. As already explained in forgoing Para-7 of the fact, that the instant service appeal is pre-mature and the departmental appeal not file to proper forum.
- e. As already explained in forgoing para -9 that private respondent No. 5 is unmarried, furthermore the University of Peshawar and Jamrud are hardly 5-10 Km away.
- f. Incorrect & not admitted. The plea of the appellant is illegal on the grounds that the Notification dated 30-04-2021 of the Respondent is in accordance with the provision of Section 10 of Civil Servant Act, 1973. As the post of the appellant is a Provincial Cadre in the Respondent Department and she can be posted anywhere in the province.
- g. That the Competent Authority by exercise his power vested him under law, transfer the appellant in the best interest of public.
- h. Incorrect and not admitted. That the appellant has completed her normal tenure of minimum of 02 years of posting and transfer and appellant has not been transferred on political grounds.
- i. Incorrect, hence denied.
- j. That the appellant has completed her normal tenure of posting transfer and the private respondent No. 6 is single lady to facilitate and posted near to her parents.





- 1. That the appellant has completed her normal tenure of minimum of two years.
- m. That the competent authority exercised his power vested him under law.
- n. That the instant service appeal is also premature the appellant is liable to wait for the disposal of the departmental appeal up to 90 days as per Hon'ble Tribunal Act.
- o. That each and every civil servant falling under the ambit section-10 of KPK, Civil Servant Act 1973 is legally bound to serve the Respondent Department to the entire satisfaction of the Competent Authority.
- p. Incorrect & not admitted. The plea of the appellant is illegal on the grounds that the Notification dated 30-04-2021 of the Respondent is in accordance with the provision of Section 10 of Civil Servant Act, 1973. As the post of the appellant is a Provincial Cadre.
- q. That the appellant has completed her normal tenure of posting transfer and the private respondent No. 6 is single lady to facilitate and posted near to her parents.
- r. That no fundamental right of the appellant has been violated by the respondent and the impugned notification with in ambit of posting / transfer policy presently prevailing in the province.
- s. The impugned notification with in legal spare and liable to be maintained.
- t. That the appellant has been treated in accordance with law, rules and policy.
- u. However, the Respondents also seek leave of this Honorable Tribunal to submit additional grounds, case law and record at time of argument on the date fixed

### Identification of Unattractive/Hard Areas policy;

I am directed to refer to the subject and to say that the Provincial Cabinet in its meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2010 inter-alia approved the following for the purpose of Posting/ Transfer Policy:-

- 1. The distinction between unattractive/hard areas should be done away with and both should be labeled as Unattractive areas.
- 2. Existing list of FATA areas be retained.
- 3. The following areas were recommended/approved to constitute unattractive areas in NWFP:
  - a. Kohistan District.
  - b. Tank District.
  - c.Chitral District.
  - d.Battgram District.
  - e. Shangla District.
  - f. Hungu District.
  - g.PATA areas of Mansehra (Kala Dhaka)

## Tenure of posting.

- i. The erstwhile normal tenure of 2 years be retained.
- ii. Existing tenure for unattractive areas be retained. However, in case of married civil servants, transfer should be made just at the beginning of school session and tenure should be one year instead of 1.5 year, so that academic disruptions are avoided.
- iii. At the time of entry in service, all civil servants be asked to give 4 options from unattractive areas.
- iv. After a stint of service in unattractive area, employees may be offered option to serve in district of choice.

### **Preliminary Objections:**

- ·1. That the appellant has got no cause of action to file the instant appeal.
- 2. That appellant is stopped by his own conduct to approach this Honorable Tribunal.
- 3. That no vested right of the appellant has been infringed nor any provisions of the Constitution have been violated, therefore, the instant Service Appeal is not maintainable in the circumstances.
- 4. That the instant appeal is based on malafide intention just to put pressure on the respondents for stay at her own choice of station.
- 5. The present appeal has been filed to entangle the Department unnecessarily in litigation and to waste the precious time of the respondents as well as of the Honorable Tribunal.
- 6. That the present appeal is against the relevant provision of law and rules.
- 7. That in the instant service appeal the appellant has suppressed material facts from the Honorable Tribunal which are sin-qua-non for the just and fair disposal of the case.

## REPLY TO FACTS.

- 1. Pertains to record. However, the said transfer/posting order was notified in the public interest and the appellant completed her normal tenure of two years as per posting/transfer policy.
- 2. Subject to proof about duties of diligently and as for as tenure of the appellant is concerned she has already completed her normal tenure at

GGHSS Chamkani. however That each and every civil servant falling under the ambit of section 10 of KP Civil Servants Act 1973 is legally bound to serve the Respondent Department to the entire satisfaction of the Competent authority.

- 3. That e-transfer policy was introduced in best interest of public and in transparent the posting policy and to facilitate the employee of Education Department.
- 4. That Para 04 pertain to record.
- 5. Incorrect hence denied as the department issued transfer of the appellant on 30.04.2021 and the private respondent No.5 submitted her arrival to the principal concerned on very next day, hence the transfer order was in the knowledge of the appellant on same day and the order has also been complied on the very next day. Moreover the appellant did not provide any proof that has received the transfer order dated 30.04.2021 on 05.05.2021.
- 6. The appellant has failed to file departmental appeal to proper forum i.e Chief Secretary next higher authority. Moreover the appellant did not file departmental within 7 days stipulated as per posting transfer policy of the Provincial government.
- 7. Pertain to official respondents.
- 8. Incorrect. As per section 10 of KP Civil Servants Act 1973, every civil servant is legally bound to serve any where the posted and no one can obtain posting of his/her own choice.
- 9. As the appellant admitted herself that the private respondent is single and unmarried as per posting transfer policy respondent No. 5 should be adjusted near to her parents, furthermore the University of Peshawar and Jamrud has hardly 5-10 Km away, while Chamkani is far away than Jamrud and if the appellant insist on spouse policy then Jamrud is more accessible to the appellant than Chamkani.
- 10.Incorrect. The appellant being a civil servant is liable to serve any where, under section 10 of KP Civil Servant Act 1973. Moreover she also completed her normal tenure in Chamkani and Jamrud is more accessible to her than Chamkani if she rely on spouse policy, hence the instant appeal may be dismissed inter-alia on the following grounds.

### REPLY ON GROUND.

- a. Incorrect and denied, the impugned notification dated 30.04.2021 of the Respondent within legal sphere and is liable to be maintained in favour of respondent department in the interest of justice and under the mandatory provision of section 10 of KPK, Civil Servant Act, 1973.
- b. Incorrect and not admitted. The stance of the appellant is illegal as the post of the Librarian BPS-17 is purely a Provincial Cadre post in the Respondent Department and the appellant has been treated as per Law, rules and policy.
- c. Incorrect. That e-transfer policy was introduced in best interest of public and in transparent the posting policy and to facilitate the employee of Education Department.
- d. Incorrect. Hence denied.
- e. Incorrect. The appellant did not come in the ambit of spouse policy as University of Peshawar and Jamrud has hardly 5-10 Km distance, while Chamkani is far away than jamrud and Jamrud is more accessible to her than Chamkani.
- f. Incorrect. The normal tenure for post is 2 years and the appellant has already completed her normal tenure at GGHSS. The appellant being a civil servant is liable to serve any where, under section 10 of KP Civil Servant Act 1973.
- g. Incorrect. As replied in para f above. Moreover every case has own legal and factual position and the reported judgment PLD 2013 SC 195 cannot applied to the case of the appellant.
- h. Incorrect. Every case has own legal and factual position and the judgment mentioned in para h appellant.
- i. Incorrect. The normal tenure for post is 2 years and the appellant has already completed her normal tenure at GGHSS. Moreover she was transferred in best public interest.
- j. Incorrect. The transfer order dated 30.04.2021 was passed in best public interest which also mentioned in the order.

- k. Incorrect. Hence denied.
- 1. Incorrect, hence denied.
- m. Incorrect. No discrimination has been done to the appellant and was after completing her normal at GGHSS Chamkani and has not been transferred on political grounds.
- n. Incorrect. The department did not violate any provision of the Constitution as well Civil servant Act 1973.
- o. Incorrect. Hence denied.
- p. Incorrect. No fundamental right of the appellant has been violated by the department while transferring the appellant.
- q. Incorrect. The department did not commit any malafide while transfer the appellant.
- r. Incorrect. The appellant has been treated as per law, rules and policy vogue in the province.
- s. Incorrect. Hence denied.
- t. Incorrect. The appellant has been treated as per law, rules and policy vogue in the province.
- u. The private respondent No.5 also seeks permission of this Honourable to advance other grounds and proof at the time of hearing.

In view of the above submission, it is therefore, most humbly prayed that the Honorable Tribunal may very graciously be pleased to dismiss the instant service appeal with cost in favour of the respondent in the interest of justice.
