3. Shortages in wheat storages at Malakand / Chitral Districts:

The Committee was briefed that DFCs Dargai & Chitral have reported shortage of thousands of bags of wheat in their Ware-houses. Similarly, the Provincial Inspection Team has recommended a thorough inspection of godowns at Dargai / Sakha Kot. In order to ascertain the actual facts, Food Department has constituted separate committees for probing into the ground realities and to adduce their observations / recommendations regarding the condition as well as quantity of wheat available in the stores of DFCs Dargai & Chitral. Moreover, M/s Sher Ali Food-grains Inspector Chitral & Mr. Samiullah, Food-grains Supervisor Chitral are facing inquiries under the Efficiency & Discipline Rules, 2011. The latter has also been suspended.

DFC Chitral informed the meeting that handing / taking processes with Mr. Sher Ali FGI have been completed, who has deposited a portion of the outstanding dues. He added that owing to suspension of Mr. Sher Ali FGI, vacuum has been created, which is affecting the recovery processes, as he has got the institutional memory to clear his transactions with various custodians of the Sale Points in his area of jurisdiction. He proposed withdrawal of suspension order of the incumbent officer in the best public interest.

Decision:

- a) The Committees constituted for probing into the condition & quantity of wheat in the godowns at Dargai-Sakha Kot & Chitral Districts shall expeditiously submit their findings.
- b) The delinquent officers / officials concerned shall clear their accounts by 31st August 2016 positively; failing which the Assistant Director Malakand Division shall take up with the NAB with relevant facts & figures for the registration of cases against them.
- c) Director Food may review his order of suspension of Mr. Sher Ali FGI, enabling him to assist the DFC Chitral in the recovery of dues outstanding against various Incharges of the Sale Points in his area. However, he shall not have the authority to deal with any other allied matter, which shall be the mandate of his successor.

4. Appointment of locals against the vacant posts of Food-grains Supervisors at Chitral:

The meeting was told that having peculiar geo-social conditions, remote location, scattered population & prone to natural calamities, Food Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has made special arrangements of food security for District Chitral. There are 32 Provincial Reserve Centers (PRCs) & about 100 sale points in that District. Due to shortage of executive staff, the provincial government has recently sanctioned 23 posts of Food-grains Supervisors (FGSs) BPS-7 so that each PRC could get one FGS for proper supervision. Being unattractive area coupled with the language barrier, officers and officials from down-districts shirk to perform duties in the said District. Even the locals

of Lower Chitral do not feel comfortable, if posted at Upper Chitral and vice versa. In the absence of effective supervision, numerous cases of embezzlement and misappropriation of public funds have been detected. It is thus need of the hour not only to induct local candidates, but also to give preference to those hailing from the particular valleys where PRCs are located. These arrangements, if approved by the competent authority by relaxing the appointment rules, shall ensure reformation, punctuality and proper supervision of government property. Above all, the masses being poor having sense of deprivation shall heave a sigh of relief.

Decision:

Proposal of the Food Department is tenable. A summary should be moved for approval of the Honorable Chief Minister Khyber Pakhtunkhwa to accord approval for induction of locals against the vacant posts of Food-grain Supervisors (BPS-7), through the competitive processes of NTS mechanism, from among the locals of Chitral District with due regard for the candidates belonging to the valleys where PRCs are located.

5. Reduction in transportation charges in lieu of decrease in the POL prices:

The meeting was told that Director Food Khyber Pakhtunkhwa floated tenders for transportation of wheat on PR to PR basis for the financial year 2015-16 and inked agreements with the successful bidders. Para 3.2 of the contract agreement provided as under:

"The effect of change in the POL will be reconsidered on quarterly basis. The increase / decrease in the POL rates will be calculated at the rate of fifty percent (50%) for the POL. However, impact below ten percent (10%) will not be considered."

It was explained that POL rates witnessed downwards trend during the 1st & 2nd quarters of the financial year, but the impact of decrease being below 10% during the corresponding period is not applicable. However, the average decrease during the 3rd quarter (Rs.12.868 i.e., Rs.6.434 @ 50%) as well as the 4th quarter (Rs.16.914 i.e., Rs.8.4571 @ 50%) are applicable in the light of above-cited provision. Summary of stock of wheat transported on PR to PR basis during 2015-16 (Annex-II) was placed before the Committee for consideration.

Decision:

Food Directorate Khyber Pakhtunkhwa may implement Para-3.2 of the Contract Agreement and make deductions from the Contractors concerned accordingly.



- According, this office sent letters No.1615/2/1-FG, dated 30/5/2016, No.1620/Sher Ali-FGI dated 30/5/2016 and No.1770/Samiullah dated 09/6/2016 and No.1806/Samiullah dated 10/6/2015, to Ex officials concerned with copy to Director Food Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar (Annex-A). Therefore, Director Food Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar constituted an inquiry committee comprising of Mr.Abdul Jaiil Assistant Director Food Malakand Division and Mr. Jahangir Khan, Assistant Director Food Kohet Division to probe the matter and submit its recommendations thereon for appropriate action against the ex -officials. The inquing committee submitted its report accordingly (Annex-B). After completing all codel formalities, the issue was then placed before the Provincial Food Committee in its meeting under the chairmanship of Manister Food held on 28/09/2016. As per decision of Provincial Food Committee, this office has been directed to looge a report with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Ehtesab Commission for taking judicial action against the above mentioned ex-officials (Annex-C).
- It is added that administrative action has already been taken in the instant case and both the ex-officials have been dismissed from service. Keeping in view recommendation of the Provincial Food Committee, it is requested that judicial action may kindly be taken against the ex-officials concerned and the embezzled money may kindly be recovered from them in the public interest.

3. Shortages in wheat storages at Malakand / Chitral Districts:

The Committee was briefed that DFCs Dargai & Chitral have reported shortage of thousands of bags of wheat in their Ware-houses. Similarly, the Provincial Inspection Team has recommended a thorough inspection of godowns at Dargai / Sakha Kot. In order to ascertain the actual facts, Food Department has constituted separate committees for probing into the ground realities and to adduce their observations / recommendations regarding the condition as well as quantity of wheat available in the stores of DFCs Dargai & Chitral. Moreover, M/s Sher Ali Food-grains Inspector Chitral & Mr. Samiullah, Food-grains Supervisor Chitral are facing inquiries under the Efficiency & Discipline Rules, 2011. The latter has also been suspended.

DFC Chitral informed the meeting that handing / taking processes with Mr. Sher Ali FGI have been completed, who has deposited a portion of the outstanding dues. He added that owing to suspension of Mr. Sher Ali FGI, vacuum has been created, which is affecting the recovery processes, as he has got the institutional memory to clear his transactions with various custodians of the Sale Points in his area of jurisdiction. He proposed withdrawal of suspension order of the incumbent officer in the best public interest.

Decision:

MINE (S)

- a) The Committees constituted for probing into the condition & quantity of wheat in the godowns at Dargai-Sakha Kot & Chitral Districts shall expeditiously submit their findings.
 - b) The delinquent officers / officials concerned shall clear their accounts by 31st August 2016 positively; failing which the Assistant Director Malakand Division shall take up with the NAB with relevant facts & figures for the registration of cases against them.
- c) Director Food may review his order of suspension of Mr. Sher Ali FGI, enabling him to assist the DFC Chitral in the recovery of dues outstanding against various Incharges of the Sale Points in his area. However, he shall not have the authority to deal with any other allied matter, which shall be the mandate of his successor.

4. Appointment of locals against the vacant posts of Food-grains Supervisors at Chitral:

The meeting was told that having peculiar geo-social conditions, remote location, scattered population & prone to natural calamities, Food Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has made special arrangements of food security for District Chitral. There are 32 Provincial Reserve Centers (PRCs) & about 100 sale points in that District. Due to shortage of executive staff, the provincial government has recently sanctioned 23 posts of Food-grains Supervisors (FGSs) BPS-7 so that each PRC could get one FGS for proper supervision. Being unattractive area coupled with the language barrier, officers and officials from down-districts shirk to perform duties in the said District. Even the locals

MINUTES OF THE MEETING DATED 21.07.2016

In order to deliberate upon the agenda points: Outstanding dues of PASSCO; Procurement Issues, 2016; Shortages in wheat storages at Malakand / Chitral Districts, Appointment of locals against the vacant posts of Food-grains Supervisors at Chitral & Reduction in transportation charges in lieu of decrease in the POL prices, a meeting of the Provincial Food Committee was held on 21st July 2016 at 11:00 a.m under the chairmanship of Minister for Food Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in his office. List of the participants is attached overleaf (Annex-I). After due deliberations, the following decisions were taken:-

1. Outstanding dues of PASSCO:

The meeting was told that during the period 2009-10, Food Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa purchased wheat from PASSCO. However, outstanding dues of the latter on this account to the tune of Rs.142, 831,570 were withheld due to an audit objection of alleged overpayments amounting to Rs.364.867 millions made to PASSCO by the Food Department KPK; followed by the PAC's decision duly adopted by the Provincial Assembly. Conversely, due to non-payment of its dues, notwithstanding no provision in the MOU so inked, PASSCO, *inter alia*, claimed mark up of Rs.617.639 million on the plea of being borrowing loans from the banks for running its affairs.

The Chair recalled that he coupled with his team made individual as well as collective hectic efforts, which ultimately resulted in the unprecedented review by PAC of its earlier decision. Accordingly, PASSCO's actual outstanding dues (Rs.142, 831,570) could now be liquidated by the Food Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and that the issue between the parities might stand settled without any further mutual dissention.

DG PASSCO expressed that, in the first instance, Food Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa may pay the principal outstanding amount as the issue of mark up was subject to approval of the BODs of the PASSCO / competent authority. He, however, manifested his principle agreement for settlement of the instant issue once and for all, after the actual outstanding dues are paid by the Food Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Decision:

Food Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa shall pay Rs. 142,831,570 to PASSCO as per reconciled statement & DG PASSCO shall get the issue of mark up settled at his own level.

2. Procurement Issues, 2016:

It was elaborated that the Federal Government had set a target of 350,000 metric tons of wheat for Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for the year 2016 out of which only 73,000 metric tons of wheat could be procured till date. The total existing wheat stock in the Province is 135,000 metric ton and that the shortfall of 215,000 metric tons shall have to be met as yet. It was due to escalation of rate of wheat in the open market that the procurement drive in the province has come to a standstill, which could be attributed to various factors: reduction in the wheat crop yield; transportation of wheat from Punjab to Karachi, its reported onwards smuggling to India due to wheat shortage there & hoardings by the dealers from Punjab etc.

In a recent meeting at the Directorate level, the Divisional Assistant Directors Food suggested grant of incentives in the shape subsidy to the growers in transportation charges on the analogy of the year 2014, otherwise, purchases from PASSCO shall have to be made to stabilize the rates of wheat atta in the market during the lean period (September 2016 to April 2017) and to maintain strategic reserves for the rainy days.

It was also pointed out that rates of wheat are fixed by the Federal Government as such subsidy cannot be extended to this effect. Alternately, the growers could be compensated / subsidized for the transportation charges they bear, which will be economical as compared to the incidental charges (Rs.1,000 approximately) to be paid to PASSCO per 100 KG bag.

Decision:

Food Department shall exercise all available options for ensuring stability in the market rates of wheat atta and food security in the province, particularly during the lean period (September 2016 to April 2017). The Committee proposed as under:

- a) In the first instance, on the analogy of 2014, the Competent Authority may allow the Food Department to compensate the growers in lieu of transportation charges as follows:
 - i. A flat subsidy of Rs.40 per 100 KG bag of wheat for D.I.Khan Division (in 2014 it was Rs. 50)
 - ii. A flat subsidy of Rs.100 per 100 KG bag of wheat for the rest of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (in 2014 it was Rs. 125).
- Department may purchase remaining quantity of wheat from PASSCO for replenishing its godowns up to total required quantity of wheat reserves of 350,000 metric tons, as last year about 300,000 metric tons of wheat was issued to the Flour Mills during the lean period for grinding, while 50,000 metric tons of wheat shall be kept as strategic reserves for meeting un-foreseen emergencies.
