Petitioner with counsel present. Mr. Kabirullah Khattak, Additional Advocate General alongwith Mr. Suleman, Senior Instructor for the respondents present.

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated at the Bar that claims on account of "pensionary benefits of the late petitioner were submitted to the department by legal heir (widow) but final outcome is yet to be communicated and submitted in the court by the respondents.

Being a hardship case, the department is granted last chance to implement the judgement of Service Tribunal dated 02.02.2022 in letter and spirit on or before the next date positively. In case of failure coercive measures shall invariably be initiated against the respondents at fault. For timely action, learned Additional Advocate General is also directed to coordinate with the concerned respondents so as to expedite implemention. To come up for final and conclusive implementation report before the S.B on 07.11.2022.
