Counsel for the appellant present. Preliminary arguments heard. It was contended by learned counsel for the appellant that the appellant was serving in Local Government & Rural Development Department as Progress Officer (BPS-16). It was further contended that since the services of the appellant was on contract basis therefore, the appellant filed Writ Petition for regularization of his services before the Worthy Peshawar High Court, Peshawar but the Writ Petition was dismissed. It was further contended that the appellant also challenged the judgment of the worthy Peshawar High Court Peshawar before the apex Supreme Court of Pakistan but the said was also dismissed. It was further contended that thereafter the appellant was terminated and the appellant filed service appeal against the termination order but the service appeal of the appellant was dismissed by this Tribunal. It was further contended that again the appellant filed CPLA in the august Supreme Court of Pakistan which was allowed and the respondent-department was directed to reinstate the appellant alongwith other from the date of their termination from service. It was further contended that in the light of the judgment of the Supreme Court of Pakistan the respondent department reinstated the appellant from the date of termination from service i.e 30.05.2003 with all back benefits and regularized the services of the appellant from the date of his initial appointment vide notification dated 10<sup>th</sup> November 2005. It was further contended that the final seniority list of the post of Assistant Director (BPS-17) in the Local Government Department was prepared vide notification dated 22.08.2017 wherein the date of promotion of the appellant from BPS-16 to BPS-17 was shown as 16.05.2013. It was further contended that the appellant also filed departmental appeal but the same was not responded. It was further contended that according to the criteria of promotion the length of service for promotion to BPS-17 is three year and the appellant was appointed in the year 1988 therefore, the respondent-department was required to promote the appellant since 1997 but the appellant has been illegally shown promoted in the year 2013 in the seniority list pertaining to the year 2017 therefore, the same is illegal and liable to be rectified.
