

Respectfully Sheweth,

1. That the Appellant is a naturally born bonafide citizen of Islamic Republic of Pakistan and hails from a respectable family.
2. That after going through the mandatorily required criteria laid down for Selection via Public Service Commission, the Appellant got inducted into service back in the year 2009 as lecturer.
3. That in fact Public Service Commission called for Selection, as Lecturers, in different disciplines through advertisement No: 01/2008, dated:05/01/2008 this advertisement was followed by another advertisement No. 03/2008 dated:20/05/2008. **(Copies of Advertisement No.1/2008, and 03/2008 are annexed herewith as Annexure "A & B" respectively).**
4. That the recruitment process commenced and completed in the light of advertisement No 3/2008 which was followed by completion of recruitment in the light of Advertisement No 1/2008. Both recruitment processes, i.e. commencement and culmination took place and completed in light of Advertisement No. 3/2008 prior to any initiation of recruitment process or completion of any recruitment process in the light of advertisement No. 01/2008, which was completed much after.
5. That the appellant is the one who got recommended and later on selected as Lecturer (BPS-17) in the light of Advertisement No. 3/2008, back in the year 2009 w.e.f 19-03-2009. **(Copy of appointment order is annexed "B/1).**
6. That after getting onto the rolls of the Respondent prestigious department, the appellant was duly placed at his due place in the Seniority List, kept and meant for lecturers. **(Copy of Seniority**

List is annexure "C" showing the due placement of appellant as lecturer).

7. That this seniority remained intact till the year 2018 when the appellant with rest of the colleagues were promoted as Assistant Professors (BPS-18) and even upon promotion the interse Seniority of the Appellant remained intact and was afforded due place in the Seniority list of the Assistant Processor. **(Copy of the Seniority List meant for Assistant Professor (BPS-18) is annexed as Annexure "D")**
8. That this Seniority List remained intact, till the pendulum reached the present, herein impugned seniority list dated 17/06/2021 was circulated through impugned Notification No: SO(CE &MS)HED/1-23/21-4(1-2), dated 17/06/2021, whereby the whole seniority of the Appellant as well as all seniority lists since 2009 till 2021 have been shattered for ulterior motives and against the rules and law governing the subject. **(Copy of the impugned Notification & seniority list dated 17/06/2021, is annexed as Annexure "E & F" respectively).**
9. That thus the Appellant has been wrongly placed in the impugned Seniority List & placed at Serial No: 83 instead of 71 by depriving him of his due placement in the Seniority List which remained intact since 2008, and now juniors have been placed ahead of the Appellant from S.No: 56 to S.No: 76, which under the law is void & illegal.
10. That feeling aggrieved the Appellant preferred a Departmental Appeal, but that went futile as inspite of lapse of statutory period, the same remained undecided. **(Copy of Departmental Appeal is annexed as Annexure "G").**
11. That feeling aggrieved, the Appellant prefers the instant appeal for his due placement in the Seniority List, whereby Juniors have been placed ahead of the Appellant, upon the following grounds, inter-alia:-

Grounds:

- A. That the impugned notification as well as the Seniority List circulated there under are wrong, void, ab-initio and are liable to be discarded and set aside.
- B. That impugned Seniority List has been framed on the caprices and whims of the competent authority which under the law is not allowed.
- C. That the Seniority List have been disturbed just to accommodate certain blue eyed ones and to honor them by placing ahead of the appellant and above no one even raised any sort of objection over the seniority list, but even then, the same was disturbed without any justification.
- D. That in fact the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission Regulation 2003 has provided in Rule 35, the mode and manner in which the Seniority List is to be ordained. This Rule 35 (3) (a) (b) read as under:-
- (a) Where a large number of subjects/ specialties are included in an advertisement, recommendations may not be pended till the finalization of the entire batch but instead zonal allocation be worked out subject-wise and recommendation conveyed to the Department without indicating to them the zonal allocation and the inter-se seniority. In recommendations to the Department it shall be made clear that the inter-se-seniority of the recommendee is linked with other subjects and the overall merit position and zonal adjustment will be intimated on the completion of interviews in all subjects. The Chronological order of the recommendees shall not confer any right of seniority.
- (b) The combined merit list shall be against a particular advertisement where the posts were advertised collectively but recommendations were staggered due to

interview schedule or any other reason. **(Copy of the Rule 35 of PSC Regulation 2003 is annexed as Annexure "H")**

E. That this PSC Regulation 2003 was replaced by PSC Regulation 2017. In Regulation 2017 the former Rule 35 was replaced with certain amendments through Rule 34 which reads as under:-

- (c) At the time of advertisement, separate serial numbers and sub-serial number shall be given to each subject. [serial-wise / sub serial-wise] recommendations along with inter-se-seniority shall also be conveyed to the department.
- (d) [After selection/ recommendation, if any discrepancy is found in documents/ particulars of a candidate, the selection / recommendation could be cancelled/ withdrawn by the Commission before appointment. If the candidate is appointed by the department then the matter shall be referred to the department concerned for initiating disciplinary action based on the report of the Commission.

(Copy of Regulation 2017 is annexed as Annexure "I")

F. That besides the above Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Promotion and Transfer Rules 1989, in its Rule 17 provides for Seniority which reads as:

Rule 17: Seniority,--- (1) The seniority inter se of civil servants [appointed to a service, cadre or post] shall be determined.—

- (a) In the case of persons appointed by initial recruitment, in accordance with the order of merit assigned by the Commission [or, as the case may be, the Departmental Selection Committee;] provided that persons selected for appointment to post is in earlier selection shall rank senior to the persons selected in a later selection; and
- (b) In the case of civil servants appointed otherwise, with reference to the dates of their continuous regular appointment in the post; provided that civil servants selected for promotion o a higher post in once batch shall,

on their promotion to the higher post retain their inter se seniority as in the lower post.

Explanation-I,--- if a junior person in a lower post is promoted to a higher post temporarily in the public interest, even though continuing later permanently in the higher post, it would not adversely effect the interest of his seniors in fixation of his seniority in the higher post.

Explanation-II,---if a junior person in a lower post is promoted to a higher post by superseding a senior person and subsequently that senior person is also promoted the person promoted first shall rank senior to the person promoted subsequently; provided that junior person shall not be deemed to have superseded a senior person if the case of the senior person is deferred for the time being for want of certain information or for incompleteness of record or for any other reason not attributing to his fault or demerit.

Explanation-III—A junior person shall be deemed to have superseded a senior person only if both the junior and the senior persons were considered for the higher post and the junior person was appointed in preference to the senior person

(2) Seniority in various cadres of civil servants appointed by initial recruitment vis-a-viz those appointed otherwise shall be determined with reference to the dates of their regular appointment to a post in that cadre; provided that if two dates are the same, the person appointed otherwise shall rank senior to the person appointed by initial recruitment.

(3) in the event of merger/ restructuring of the departments, attached departments or subordinate Offices, the inter se seniority of civil servants affected by the merger/ restructuring as aforesaid shall be determined in accordance with the date of their regular appointment to a cadre or post]. **(Copy of the Rule 17 of APT Rules 1989 are annexed as Annexure "J").**

- G. That now the issue in odd is that two different advertisements were issued in the year 2008. i.e. 01/2008, 03/2008. Interestingly the recruitment process in the light of Advertisement No. 03/2008 commenced and completed in the year 2009 i.e. before any completion of any recruitment process in the light of advertisement No. 1/2008 which was completed in 2010 & 2011. Now upon completion of recruitment process seniority lists were duly issued wherein all the appointees were given their due places strictly as per law. Now when more than a decade was passed and even promotions to the next grade of Assistant Professor of (BPS-18) was carried and much water was flown under the bridge, the same undisputed seniority list was made disputed for certain ulterior motives just to appease certain blue eyed ones.
- H. That the PSC Rules does provides for ordaining seniority as per the merit position and as well as postulates that the seniority would be reckoned from the year of advertisement, but in thoroughly silent in two aspects, one that what would be mechanism when more than one advertisement for the same cadre and post in the same department are issued? then how the seniority among the candidates would be determined when they have been selected in different processes under different advertisements of the same year. The second point that is not covered by any PSC Regulation is that when two different advertisements were issued and the selection process got commenced and completed under subsequent advertisements

prior to the first one, then how the seniority of those selected in earlier selection process shall be determined viz-a-viz, those selected through the first advertisement whose process commenced and culminated after the same was over under the subsequent advertisements?

- I. That even if at all, if for the sake of arguments, if the process of recruitment commenced in the light of the first advertisement but that was kept, maliciously so procrastinated slow over that in the meanwhile certain other recruitment process got accomplish, so in that scenario as well the general law i.e. APT Rules 1989 shall prevail, while in the earlier two aspects, where both the repealed and repealing regulations of PSC are silent and gives no solution to the issue in hand. So in given circumstances the established law in that, the General law shall prevail that is to say that the APT Rules 1989 shall be the parameters for evaluating the herein impugned Seniority List.
- J. That the APT Rules 1989 has categorically provided that the selectees of one batch shall be senior to the selectees of any other batch that comes on the roles of the department in any subsequent selection process.
- K. That besides the above except the herein seniority list, no other Seniority Lists of any Department or even of the same department of the Appellant has been disturbed, but only the Appellant have been victimized and jeopardized for certain ulterior motives. Even all the seniors of the Appellant now posted in BPS-18, 19 and 20, are having the same position as that of the Appellant was enjoying before the instant unwarranted misplacement and wrong placement and all seniors of Appellant as well as in all other departments of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, all are enjoying the Seniority strictly of per rule 17 of APT Rules 1989 as well as, as per merit assigned by PSC, but batch-wise selection criteria and none is disturbed, but only the Appellants

have been formidably envisaged present dilemma that the batch-wise selection is ignored and violated upon the caprices and whims of certain black sheep in the directorate which under the law is neither allowed, nor hold any water.

- L. That even promotion took place upon the same earlier undisputed Seniority List for which PSC hold its meetings, seniority was requisitioned by PSC, the same was furnished to PSB. And there was no objection upon the same at that time and consequently the promotion took place but when one black sheep reached the directorate, the whole seniority was disturbed upon wishes of that black sheep and now when much water flows under the bridge, herein impugned seniority was brought by replacing undisputed one and time tested one.
- M. That even earlier these issues of inter-se seniority of the same Appellant and same respondent were agitated before the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court Peshawar as well as before this Hon'ble Tribunal and interestingly the appellant and the herein respondents were sailing the same boat and in same seniority list, which has now been disturbed illegally, was upheld by this Hon'ble Tribunal to be correct one for intents and purposes. And it were the same respondents as in herein the instant appeal and none of them neither objected nor denied the due placement, nor agitated otherwise, but abruptly the whole scenario was changed volta-facie and all the juniors respondent placed ahead of the appellants, which under the law is neither allowed, nor valid as well as sheer violation of the relevant judgment of this Hon'ble Tribunal, passed service appeal No: 1085/2013 titled as "Ikhtyar Zada - VS- Province of K.PK & Others". **(Copies of the judgment dated 25/04/2019 in Service Appeal No: 1085/2013 annexed herewith as Annexure "K").**
- N. That thus under the APT Rules 1989 all the juniors that have been placed ahead of the appellant in the impugned Seniority List are

required to be sent back to their earlier positions and seniority of the appellant is required to be restored with all back benefits.

O. That any other ground not raised here may graciously be allowed to be raised at the time of arguments.

It is, therefore, most humbly prayed that on acceptance of the instant Appeal, the impugned Notification No: SO(CE&MS)HED/ 1-23/21-4 (1-2), dated:17/06/2021 may graciously be declare wrong, illegal, void ab-initio and be set aside and by doing so, the seniority list circulated/ issued there under may also graciously be set aside and the Seniority of the Appellant may very graciously be restored with all back benefits and be placed ahead of the private respondents i.e. to be brought to Serial No: 71.

Any other relief not specifically asked for may also graciously be extended in favor of the appellant in the circumstances of the case.

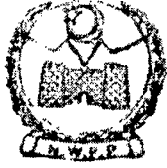

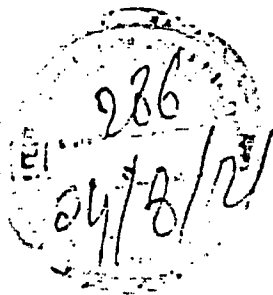

Subject: Departmental Appeal / Representation against Notification No. SO(CE&MS)HED/1-23/21-4(1-2) Dated Peshawar the 17.06.2021 circulated on 04.08.2021 Wherein the appellant has been relegated from his original position in the seniority list.

Respectfully submitted as under:

- 1) That the appellant / objector is the bonafide resident of District Mardan and presently serving as Assistant Professor (BPS-18) at Govt. College of Management Sciences Mardan.
- 2) That certain posts of instructors / lecturers for Govt. Colleges of Commerce / Govt. Commercial Training Institutes were advertised by the then NWFP Public Service Commission vide Advertisements No. 01/2008 dated 05.01.2008 and Advertisement No. 03/2008 dated 20.05.2008.
- 3) That pursuant to the advertisements, appellant / objector along with other candidates applied for the posts of Instructor / Lecturer advertised via advertisement No. 03/2008 dated 20.05.2008. The appellant / objector was turned successful after the completion of written test / interview process. Consequently, the then NWFP Public Service Commission recommended the appellant / objector for appointment as Instructor / Lecturer in Economics.
- 4) That the KPPSC recommended 01 Male Instructors / Lecturers vide Letter dated 26-03-2009 who were notified vide Notification bearing Endorsement No. SOIII(IND)TE/3-6/2007/11787 dated 26.03.2009 (Annexure-A).
- 5) That after appointment, provisional seniority list of Lecturers (other than commerce) BPS-17 of Govt. Colleges of Commerce / Govt. Colleges of Management Services as stood on 31.12.2011 was circulated on 27.01.2012 with the following directions therein:

"In case there is any objection, the aggrieved person should route an appeal within 30 days of the issue of this letter, failing which the provisional seniority list will be treated as final. It must be kept in mind that the appeal should be

supported by documentary proof for consideration of the competent authority".

- 6) That no objections of any sort whatsoever were placed before the competent authority. Hence, the provisional seniority list got finality. The same seniority was kept intact and acted upon till 2018 and prior to promotion of the appellant / objector, it was circulated by the department vide No. DGCE&MS/Admin/Seniority/463(1-37) dated 20.02.2018.
- 7) The appellant / objector was promoted to the post of Assistant Professor (BPS-18) list vide Notification No. SO(CE&MS)HED/1-2/213/1-2019 dated 10.08.2018. Needless to mention that the appellant / objector was promoted in the same order of seniority determined / fixed as stood on 31.12.2011 which was kept intact till 20.02.2018.
- 8) That pursuant to the promotion Notification dated 10.08.2018, tentative seniority list of Assistant Professor BPS-18 was circulated vide Office Letter No. DGCE&MS/Admn/Misc-19/232411-38 dated 07.01.2020 where appellant / objector was placed at Serial 83 of the seniority list. It is worth mentioning that the same order of seniority was followed as determined / fixed after the initial recruitment of appellant / objector.
- 9) That objections were invited, in the usual course of finalizing seniority list, from all the quarters concerned. Appeals were preferred and for disposal of the said appeals a committee was constituted vide Office Notification No. DGCE&MS/Admn/6-1(4)3510(1-4) dated 03.02.2020. The committee furnished the recommendations vide Committee report dated 26.02.2020.
- 10) That placing reliance on the committee report, drastic changes were made and that too where it suited a particular purpose. The tentative seniority list, with major changes detrimental to the vested interests and legally accrued rights of appellant / objector, was circulated vide Letter No. DGCE&MS/Admn/Misc-16/64 dated 08.01.2021 received on 12.01.2021.
- 11) That objections were placed before the Director General Commerce & Management sciences Department KPK Peshawar raising various legal and factual reservations for restoring the seniority list as stood on 31-12-2019.
- 12) That the Director General Commerce and Management sciences constituted a committee bearing Endst No. DGCE&MS/Admn/Enquiry Gen/1312/(1-4) dated 23.02.2021 comprising professors of the department. The

committee was provided with sufficient documents and grounds by the appellant.

- 13) That the said committee in its recommendations in the shape of Notification No. SO(CE&MS)HED/1-23/21-4(1-2) Dated Peshawar the 17.06.2021 altering the previous seniority list that stood on 31-12-2019; despite of providing clear and strong supportive documents by the appellant; 25 junior Assistant Professors (Who not even filed the appeal) from serial 71 to 83 (including even those who are more than one year junior in terms of service to the appellant) were placed senior on the recommendation of the committee as reflected in finalized seniority list circulated on 04-08-2021 is illegal, against the law and facts, inoperative upon the legally accrued rights of appellants / objectors, inter alia, on the following grounds(Annexure-D).

GROUND:

- a) That the appellant / objector is a civil servant and for all intents and purposes, his service is governed by Civil Servants Act, 1973. The constitution of committee for preparing the seniority list or removing the anomalies is beyond the mandate of Section 08, Civil Servants Act, 1973. Hence placing of reliance on recommendations of the said committee while revising the already finalized seniority list is of grave concern to the appellant.
- b) That all the appeals heard and disposed of positively were time barred. Delay of a single day can defeat the otherwise established rights of a civil servant. In the case in hand delay of approximately ten years was condoned with a single stroke of pen and in a slipshod manner. It is a settled notion that law aids the vigilant and not the indolent (*vigilantibus, non dormientibus, jurasubverninent*) To add fuel to the fire, the committee recommended that those lecturers / assistant professors who have not bothered to prefer even an appeal can take benefit from the generous recommendations of the committee. Such recommendations are not legally sustainable.
- c) That an erroneous, illogical and illegal inferences were drawn while interpreting section 17(1)(a) of the Appointment, Promotion and Transfer Rules, 1989. It is simply based on the premise that person selected for appointment to post in earlier selection would rank senior to person selected in later selection. The highest and final judicial forum has already interpreted Section 17(1)(a) in Zahid Arif case (1998 PLC (C.S.) 456. Relevant

Para is reproduced for ready reference:

"----R. 17(a)---Constitution of Pakistan (1973), Art. 212(3)--- Seniority— Appointment of civil servant to post in later selection---Petitioner's name had been placed next to respondents although he had been placed higher on merit list than respondents---Civil servant's appeal against seniority list had been dismissed mainly on the ground that respondents being nominees for first batch were to rank higher than civil servant on account of their initial selection---Rule 17(a), North-West Frontier Province (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989, provided that person selected for appointment to post in earlier selection would rank senior to person selected in later selection---Judgment of Service Tribunal was not shown to suffer from any infirmity---Service Tribunal having acted in accordance with rule laid down in R. 17(a), North-West Frontier Province (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989, its judgment did not appear to be open to any exception---Leave to appeal to Supreme Court was refused in circumstances.

- d) That through two different advertisements; different recommendations (selection) and different appointment notifications, lecturers / instructors were appointed. A subject wise selection was made, notified and acted upon. Consequently, seniority list was prepared in the year 2012 and was kept intact till 2018 where after promotions were made on the strength of the already finalized seniority list. Subsequent alterations, review or revision of the seniority list is not legally justified.
- e) That wrong interpretation from the judgment reported in 1998 PLC (C.S) 456 has been drawn where earlier selection has been linked with advertisement while in order to give benefit to the blue eyed reliance has been placed on Federal Govt. Civil Servants Seniority Rules, 1993 as the same criteria has no application to civil servants of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- f) That promotion of a civil servant to next higher rank depends upon seniority cum fitness. The appellant / objector was also promoted vide promotion Notification on the basis of the already determined / fixed seniority. Thus, at this belated stage when this esteemed department acknowledged the seniority of appellant / objector at the time of promotion / then reversion of appellant / objector from Serial No. 71 to Serial No.83 thus placing 29 Junior Assistant Professors' senior to the appellant negates the very acknowledgment of the department.
- g) That no consolidated merit list was forwarded by KPPSC after finalization of the entire interview process. If it was so the same would have been received by the appellant / objector. Similarly, the alleged anomalies would not have been caused if such consolidated merit list was available after conclusion of the interviews process / selection process.

- h) That the "Green Book" under Article 25 guarantees equality before law, stresses equal protection of law and discourages discrimination. The appellant / objector was not only discriminated but also not treated equally. The criterion set forth by the worthy Director General was not followed in respect of the Associate Professors BPS-19 and Professors BPS-20. This aspect speaks volumes of nepotism, favoritism, discrimination and negates the fundamental right of the appellant / objector pertaining to equality before law and equal protection of law.
- i) That the matter of seniority of the appellant / objector was also endorsed by the KP Service Tribunal, Peshawar when Amended Appeal No. 1085 of 2013 was dismissed on 25.04.2019.
- j) That the impugned revised final seniority list is against applicable laws and rules governing the seniority / inter-se seniority. Plethora of judgments favours the contention of appellant / objector.
- k) That regulations of commission are framed for carrying out their business and such regulations in no way can deprive the appellant / objector from his legally accrued rights given by the rules and acts passed by the legislature. Regulations of the commission are subservient to the law passed by the legislature. So, the regulations contrary to the law made by legislature or detrimental to the accrued rights of civil servants under that law cannot be followed.
- l) That it is a well settled principle of service jurisprudence that seniority amongst the persons holding similar posts in the same cadre has to be determined on the basis of length of the service / date of appointment and not on any other fortuitous circumstances. The appellant / objector, on the basis of length of service / date of appointment is entitled to retain his previous seniority determined / fixed at the time of entry into Government Service. The subsequent alteration in the seniority of Assistant Professor is misconceived one, and liable to be rectified.
- m) That placement of appointees of Advertisement No. 01/2008 on the basis of prior advertisement (who not even objected the seniority list that stood on 31-12-2021) is illegal, against the law and already determined / fixed seniority of the appellant / objector. Similarly, the inter-se seniority of appointees of advertisement No. 03/2008 was fixed on the strength of their subject wise merit list furnished by the KPPSC and appointment Notifications. The KPPSC never prepared or sent the

consolidated merit list after finalization of entire interview process and so the subject wise seniority lists forwarded by KPPSC got finality. Subsequent preparation of consolidated seniority list after 10 years certainly portrays the ulterior motives behind the later acts. In absence of consolidated seniority list at the time of entry into Govt. Service, the method of earlier selection / appointment is to be followed.

- n) That the regulations of 2003 of the then NWFP Public Service Commission were not acted upon by the commission itself and the provision of consolidated seniority list was omitted in the recent amendments in the year 2017, so on the strength of the regulations of 2003 the seniority cannot be altered / modified on the basis of the omitted clause in the regulation.
- o) That the appellant / objector request to be heard in person.
- p) That any other ground, with permission of the worthy competent authority will be taken at the time of personal hearing.

It is, therefore, requested that the seniority list circulated vide Letter No. DGCE&MS/Admn/Misc-16/64 dated 08.01.2021 may kindly be struck down and the original seniority list maintained till 31.12.2019 since the selection of the appellant be restored and oblige.

35. RECOMMENDATIONS.

- (1) A decision about recommendations to be made shall be approved by the Commission irrespective of the fact as to whether the interviews had been conducted by a panel or by full Commission. After approval the Director concerned shall convey the recommendations to the concerned Department. The candidates recommended for appointment shall be informed of their selection within three days of the release of recommendation to the department. Non-adjusted and Non-marked candidates shall also be informed of their results.
- (2) Where the experience forms part of the requisite qualifications, the recommendation of in-service candidates shall be conveyed provisionally subject to perusal of their ACRs by the Commission and finding these satisfactory.
- (3) (a) Where a large number of subjects / specialties are included in an advertisement, recommendations may not be pending till the finalization of the entire batch but instead zonal allocation be worked out subject-wise and recommendation conveyed to the Department without indicating to them the zonal allocation and the inter-se-seniority. In recommendations to the Department it shall be made clear that the inter-se-seniority of the recommendee is linked with other subjects and the overall merit position and zonal adjustment will be intimated on the completion of interviews in all subjects. The chronological order of the recommendees shall not confer any right of seniority.
- (b) The combined merit list shall be against a particular advertisement where the posts were advertised collectively but recommendations were staggered due to interview schedule or any other reason.

 - (d) "Member" means the Member of the Commission and includes the Chairman.
 - (e) "Department" means a department as defined in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Rules of Business, 1985.
 - (f) "Departmental Representative" means an officer of the department of the government or public sector organization to which post(s) relate and who assists the Panel of the Commission for conducting the viva-voce / interview.

MERIT LIST / ZONAL ALLOCATION / RECOMMENDATION

32. MERIT LIST.

- (a) When all the eligible candidates called for interview for particular post have been interviewed, the Director Recruitment, Director Examination or any other authorized officer, as the case may be, shall prepare the merit list as per the marks recorded on the evaluation sheet and submit the case for the Commission's approval.
- (b) Merit list shall be prepared keeping in view the aggregate marks secured by all the qualified candidates.
- (c) When two or more than two candidates have secured equal marks in aggregate the candidate who has secured higher marks in the interview shall be marked senior. In case the marks in aggregate and also the marks in the interview are the same, the candidate who is older in age shall be placed senior to the one who is younger. In case all the above-mentioned factors are the same, marks obtained in the final examination of the prescribed qualification for the post shall be the deciding factor.
- (d) In the case of Competitive Examination the merit list shall be prepared in accordance with the laid down provisions of the syllabus of the respective service.

33. ZONAL ALLOCATION.

The zonal allocation of the vacancies shall be made in accordance with the zonal allocation formula wherever applicable.

34. RECOMMENDATIONS

- (a) ²⁵[A decision about recommendations to be made shall be approved by the Members of Interview Panel concerned, the Member incharge of the subject and the Chairman]. Merit list shall be uploaded on website of the Commission. After approval, the Director concerned shall also convey the recommendations to the concerned Department. If suitable candidates are not available then posts may be re-advertised at the earliest and Secretary of concerned Department, Chief Secretary, Principal Secretary to Chief Minister / Principal Secretary to Governor

and Minister Incharge shall also be kept informed accordingly. The candidates recommended for appointment shall be informed of their selection within three days of the release of recommendation to the department. Non-adjusted and Non-marked candidates shall also be informed of their results.

(b) ²⁶[Where the experience forms part of the requisite qualifications, the recommendations of in-service candidates shall be conveyed provisionally subject to perusal of their PERs by the Department concerned and finding these satisfactory.]

(c) At the time of advertisement, separate serial numbers and sub-serial number shall be given to each subject. ²⁷[serial-wise / sub serial-wise] recommendations alongwith inter-se-seniority shall also be conveyed to the department.

(d) ²⁸[After selection/ recommendation, if any discrepancy is found in documents/ particulars of a candidate, the selection/ recommendation could be cancelled / withdrawn by the Commission before appointment. If the candidate is appointed by the department then the matter shall be referred to the department concerned for initiating disciplinary action based on the report of the Commission.

(APPOINTMENT, PROMOTION & TRANSFER) RULES, 1989**

PART-I
GENERAL

1. **Short title and commencement:** - (1) These rules may be called the ²[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. **Definitions:**-(1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:-

(a) "Appointing Authority" in relation to a post, means the persons authorized under rule 4 to make appointment to that post;

(b) "Basic Pay Scale" means the Basic Pay Scale for the time being sanctioned by Government, in which a post or a group of posts is placed;

(c) "Commission" means the ³[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Public Service Commission;

⁴(d) "Departmental Promotion Committee" means a committee constituted for making selection for promotion or transfer to such posts under a Department, or offices of Government, which do not fall within the purview of the Provincial Selection Board;

⁵(dd) "Departmental Selection Board" means a Board constituted for the purpose of making selection for initial recruitment /appointment to posts under a Department or office of Government in Basic Pay Scale 17 not falling within the purview of the Commission:

Provided that more than one such committees may be constituted for civil servants holding different scales of pay".

(e) "Departmental Selection Committee" means a committee constituted for the purpose of making selection for initial appointment to posts under a department, or office of Government [in Basic Pay Scale 17 and below not falling within the purview of the Commission];

(f) "Post" means a post sanctioned in connection with the affairs of the Province, but not allocated to all Pakistan Unified Grades ; and

PART-VI

SENIORITY

17. **Seniority :-** (1) the seniority inter se of civil servants ⁴⁷(appointed to a service, cadre or post) shall be determined:-

- (a) in the case of persons appointed by initial recruitment, in accordance with the order of merit assigned by the Commission ⁴⁸[or as the case may be, the Departmental Selection Committee;] provided that persons selected for appointment to post in an earlier selection shall rank senior to the persons selected in a later selection; and
- (b) in the case of civil servants appointed otherwise, with reference to the date of their continuous regular appointment in the post; provided that civil servants selected for promotion to a higher post in one batch shall, on their promotion to the higher post, retain their inter se seniority as in the lower post.

Explanation-I:- If a junior person in a lower post is promoted to a higher post temporarily in the public interest, even though continuing later permanently in the higher post, it would not adversely effect the interest of his seniors in fixation of his seniority in the higher post.

Explanation-II:- If a junior person in a lower post is promoted to a higher post by superseding a senior person and subsequently that senior person is also promoted the person promoted first shall rank senior to the person promoted subsequently; provided that junior person shall not be deemed to have superseded a senior person if the case of the senior person is deferred for the time being for want of certain information or for incomplete record or for any other reason not attributing to his fault or demerit.

Explanation-III:- A junior person shall be deemed to have superseded a senior person only if both the junior and the senior persons were considered for the higher post and the junior person was appointed in preference to the senior person.

(2) Seniority in various cadres of civil servants appointed by initial recruitment vis-à-vis those appointed otherwise shall be determined with reference to the dates of their regular appointment to a post in that cadre; provided that if two dates are the same, the person appointed otherwise shall rank senior to the person appointed by initial recruitment.

⁴⁹(3) In the event of merger/restructuring of the Departments, Attached Departments or Subordinate Offices, the inter se seniority of civil servants affected by the merger/restructuring as aforesaid shall be determined in accordance with the date of their regular appointment to a cadre or post.

⁵⁰(4) The inter-se-seniority of civil servants in a certain cadre to which promotion is made from different lower posts, carrying the same pay scale shall be determined from the date of regular appointment/promotion of the civil servants in the lower post.

Provided that if the date of regular appointment of two or more civil servants in the

lower post is the same, the civil servant older in age, shall be treated senior.

18. **General Rules:** - In all matters not expressly provided for in these rules, civil servants shall be governed by such rules as have been or may hereafter be prescribed by Government and made applicable to them.

19. **Repeal:-** The ⁵¹[Khyber Pakhtunkhwa] Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1975, are hereby repealed.

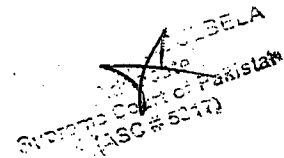





2. The facts, as noted in the memoranda of appeals, are to the effect that the appellants were appointed to different positions in Directorate of Technical Education FATA on contract basis. Their service as such was extended from time to time. The Provincial Government promulgated Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009, whereby, the service of all employees who were holding posts on contract basis or ad hoc basis on 31.12.2008, or till the commencement of the act were deemed to have been validly appointed on regular basis provided they had the qualification and experience for a regular post. The appellants applied to the respondents for regularization of their service under the Act *ibid*, however, the needful was not done. The appellants, consequently, filed Writ Petition(s) before the Honourable Peshawar High Court, wherein, the relief claimed was in terms of regularization of their service under the provisions of Act *ibid*. Pertinently, the respondents had stopped payment of salary to the appellants w.e.f 30.06.2010. The Writ Petition(s) were allowed by the Honourable High Court on 08.03.2012 granting the relief to the appellants for regularization of their service under the Act. Pursuance to the judgment, a notification was issued on 31.12.2012 by the respondents, wherein, the services of appellants were regularized with immediate effect. Aggrieved from the contents of notification dated 31.12.2012, the appellants submitted departmental representations which were not responded to, hence the appeal in hand.

3. We have heard learned counsel for the appellants in all the appeals, learned counsel for private respondents and learned Deputy District Attorney on behalf of the respondents. We have also gone through the available record.



Learned counsel for the appellants contended that the judgment of Honourable Peshawar High Court, passed in favour of the appellants while deciding Writ Petition No. 1289/2010 and connected Writ Petitions No. 1145/2010, 1252/2010, 2639/2010, 1870/2011, 2992/2011, 3244/2011, 3285/2011 and 46/2012, it was held that the petitioners shall be deemed to be regular and permanent employees of respondents' No. 1 & 2 department within the meaning of N.W.F.P. (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009 while the respondents were directed to issue requisite notification of regularization within a period of one month. The Notification pursuantly issued on 31.12.2012 was however, given immediate effect which was not in accordance with the judgment of the Honourable High Court. He further contended that no appeal against the said judgment was ever preferred by the official or private respondents, therefore, the same attained finality. On the other hand, a petition under Section 12(2) CPC was preferred in the year 2015 in respect of judgment in favour of the appellants which was decided in negative by the Honourable High Court on 10.01.2019. Learned counsel for the appellants further contended that the regularization of service of appellants, from the date of notification, had put in jeopardy the seniority of appellants and also they were deprived of due monetary benefits from the date of promulgation of Act ibid i.e. 24.10.2009.



On the other hand, learned counsel for private respondents attacked the appeals on the grounds that there was no original or appellate order which was questioned in the appeals, therefore, the same were not competent under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974. He further maintained that in the departmental appeals submitted by the appellants prayer was distinct than that in the service appeals and, for that reason too, the appeals were not

maintainable. It was also the argument of learned counsel that the notification dated 31.12.2012 was not questioned by the appellants and their purported grievance was pertaining to the same. The relief prayed for, therefore, could not be granted.

Learned Deputy District Attorney adopted the arguments of learned counsel for the private respondents.

4. It is a matter of record that the prayer in all the appeals is "to treat the appellants as regular from 1st January, 2009 and to release them the salary from 1st January, 2009 till the issuance of the notification dated 31.12.2012, and accordingly determination of their seniority". In the memoranda of appeals it is, inter-alia, noted that the appellants were entitled to regularization of their service from commencement of the N.W.F.P Employees (Regularization of Services) Act, 2009 and also entitled to the pay and other benefits from 01.01.2009.

It is abundantly clear from the appeals as well as arguments of learned counsel for the appellants that their grievance was essentially caused by the issuance of regularization notification dated 31.12.2012, with immediate effect. The payment of salary for the crucial period and determining seniority of the appellants are only the consequences of the notification.

In Appeal No. 1039/2013 and 1040/2013 the date of submission of departmental representation was 05.03.2013 while in Appeal No. 1049/2013 it was 07.03.2013. In Appeals No. 1088/2013, 1093/2013 and 1099/2013 the departmental representations were preferred on 20.03.2013. Noticeably, Copy of the notification dated 31.12.2012 was duly forwarded to the appellants under the endorsement at S.No. 16. Their departmental representations/appeals were clearly barred by time in view of the above facts and Rule 3 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appeal) Rules, 1986. The said rule prescribed a maximum period of thirty days for the purpose. It is held in judgments of the Apex Court reported as 2012-SCMR-195 and 2006-SCMR-453 that time barred appeal before the departmental authority rendered the appeal before Service Tribunal as incompetent.

6. There is yet another aspect of the appeals in hand. The grievance of appellants revolved around the effective date of regularization notification dated 31.12.2012. The contents of the notification No. SOS-III(IND)TE/3-9/2012, unequivocally suggest that it was issued in pursuance to the judgment of Honourable Peshawar High Court Peshawar passed in Writ Petition No. 1289/2010. In the said context, it is also useful to refer to proceedings initiated before the High Court by way of Contempt of Court (No. 96-P/2013 and 97-P/2013) in Writ Petition No. 1289/2010 and Writ Petition No. 1145-P/2010,






