

It is contended that the service of appellant was regularized in pursuance to judgment of Peshawar High Court in writ petition No. 2039-P/2014 handed down on 24.05.2017 and under the provision Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Adhoc Lecturers (Regularization of Services) Act 2014. The requisite notification was issued on 15.11.2107, wherein, the effect to regularization was given from the initial appointment of the appellant. However, the regularization was made conditional to the decision of CPLA No. 385-P/2017 pending before the august Supreme Court of Pakistan. Despite the fact that in the notification it was provided that the appellant shall and privileges contained in Khyber have all rights Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973, his name was not included in the seniority list of Lecturers (BPS-17) drawn upto 24.09.2018. It is also the arguments of learned counsel that under Section-8 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973, every civil servant is entitled to find a place in the relevant seniority list which right has been denied by the respondents to the appellant till date.

In view of the available record and arguments of learned counsel, instant appeal is admitted for regular hearing. The appellant is directed to deposit security and process fee within 10 days. ON ACCEPTANCE OF THE INSTANT APPEAL SENIORITY OF THE APPELLANT MAY \mathbf{BE} FIXED / DETERMINED FROM THE DATE **OF** HIS INITIAL APPOINTMENT AND ACCORDINGLY HIS NAME INCLUDED IN THE SENIORITY LIST OF LECTURERS BPS-17 COLLEGE CADRE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE KHYBER PAKHTUN KHWA CIVIL SERVANT ACT, 1973.

FACTS:-

Facts leading to the institution of the instant appeal are as under:-

- 1. That pursuant to the advertisement issued by the Secretary Administration, Information and Co-ordination FATA Secretariat on 29-05-2011, the appellant feeling himself as eligible for the subject post, duly applied to the respondents and after proper test/interview, the appellant was appointed as Lecturer on Ad hoc basis vide notification dated: 06-10-2011. Needless to mention that the contract of the appellant was extended from time to time by the respondents.
- 2. That during the service of the appellant, the Federal Govt. introduced a policy to regularize all contract and daily wages employees who were working in Ministries / Divisions etc and for this purpose constituted subcommittee of Cabinet Division and the said Sub-Committee held its meeting on 13-03-2013 and decided to regularize all contract and daily wages employees.
- 3. That it is pertinent to mention that in the year 2014, the Govt. of Khyber Pakhtun Khwa also passed "Khyber Pakhtun Khwa (Regularization of Service Act, 2014) and under the beneficial provisions of the said Act, a large number of Lecturers who were at par with the appellant stood regularized.
- 4. That the appellant being aggrieved of the situation, filed writ petition No. 2039-P/2014 before Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar and prayed for his regularization on his post. The Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar was pleased to allow the said writ petition vide order / judgment dated: 24-05-2017 by directing the respondents to regularize the services of appellant and others on their respective post since initial date of appointment. The relevant part is reproduced as below:-

"Hence this petition is accordingly allowed and the respondents are directed to regularize the same petitioners in their services from their date of initial appointment".

{True copy of order/judgment dated: 24-05-2017 are attached, as mark Annex-A}

- 5. That pursuant to the judgment of the Hon'ble Court, the respondents regularize the appellant in service from initial date of appointment.
- 6. That recently the appellant came to know that the respondents/department has issued the seniority list of Lecturers BPS-17 College Cadre, and he

was shocked and bewildered to find out that his name has not been included in the impugned tentative seniority list maintained by the department. The seniority list is not correct and liable to be corrected and modified in the light of the judgment of Hon'ble Peshawar High Court in W.P. No. 2039-P/2014 dated: 24-05-2017 and the regularization Notification dated: 15-11-2017 & 03-05-2018 wherein it has been specifically mentioned that the appellant will be regularized w.e.f. his initial date of appointment.

{True copies of regularization order dated: 15-11-2017 and impugned seniority list dated: 24-09-2018 are attached, as mark **Annex-B & C**}

7. That the appellant feeling aggrieved and dissatisfied from the impugned seniority list, preferred departmental representation on 27-11-2018 for inclusion and determination of his seniority in the list of Lecturers BPS-17 College Cadre. The appellant waited for statutory period of 90 days for rectification of the seniority list, but to no avail and the respondents have, inspite of the departmental representation, failed to act in accordance with law.

{True copy of the departmental representation is attached, as mark Annex-D}

8. That the appellant being constrained of the situation is filing the instant appeal before this Hon'ble Tribunal on the following grounds amongst the others:-

GROUNDS:-

- **A. Because** the impugned action and inaction of the respondents proclaims their own malafide.
- **B.** Because the inaction of the respondents to include the name of the appellant in the impugned seniority list and to give him his due seniority since the date of appointment in service i.e. 06-10-2011, violates the rights guaranteed and secured to the appellant under the law.
- C. Because when it has been settled by the august Peshawar High Court, Peshawar while deciding the writ petition No. 2039-P/2014 dated: 24-05-2017 that the appellant shall be regularized since the date of his initial appointment and the respondents have accordingly issued regularization order which clearly reflects the regular employment status since initial date of appointment then non-inclusion of name of appellant in the seniority list and failing to give him his due seniority shows the malafide intention of the respondents which is not warranted under the law.

- **D.** Because the respondents have failed to give any reason, plausible or what-so-ever that why the appellant has not been given his due seniority and why he has been kept out of the impugned seniority list. Malafide is apparent.
- E. Because inaction of the respondents to give seniority to the appellant since the date of initial appointment, offend the provision of Article 4 of the Constitution to enjoy the protection of law and to be treated in accordance with law which is the inalienable right of every citizen, wherever he may be every other person for the time being with in Pakistan.
- **F.** Because due to the inaction of respondents, the appellant has been deprived from his legitimate chances of promotion which is his inalienable right attached to his service. Hence the inaction of the respondents to give seniority since the date of appointment, is totally against the principles of Natural Justice, fair-play and equity.
- G. Because the action of the respondents while determining the seniority of the Lecturers without adopting proper criteria and codal requirements is against the judgments of the Hon'ble Superior Courts of Pakistan and therefore, the same is illegal practice and such practice adversely affects efficiency of incumbents and also reduces their confidence and faith in public.
- **H. Because** the appellant had been made victim of discrimination, demerits, partiality and favoritism without any just and reasonable cause thereby offending the fundamental rights of the appellant as provided by the constitution of 1973.
- I. Because the appellant was condemned unheard, his departmental appeal was not adjudicated. Further no chance of personal hearing was given to the present appellant in order to redress his grievances which shows the malafide of the Respondents, hence needs interference of this Hon'ble Tribunal.

- J. Because the Respondents erroneously exercised their powers against judicial principle, hence, the seniority list issued by respondents in gross violation of law is liable to be set aside.
- K. Because the action and inaction of the respondents is bad in the eyes of law.
- L. The appellant crave for leave to add further grounds at the times of oral arguments highlighting further contravention of the law and constitution.

PRAYER:-

It is humbly submitted that on acceptance of the present appeal, this Hon'ble Tribunal may graciously be pleased to:

- i. **Declare** the impugned Seniority List issued without including the name of the appellant as illegal, unlawful, without lawful authority and void ab initio.
- Direct the respondents to include and determine/fix the seniority of the appellant in accordance with Khyber Pakhtun Khwa Civil Servant Act, 1973, from the date of his initial appointment as envisioned in the regularization order dated: 15-11-2017 & 03-05-2018 and accordingly incorporate his name in the seniority list of Lecturers BPS-17 College Cadre.
- iii. Any further better relief may also kindly be granted in the circumstances of the appellant's case.

The petitioners 253 in number invoked the constitutional jurisdiction of this Court by filing instant writ petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 seeking relief for following prayer:

"It is humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:

i. Declare the act of the respondents whereby they have refused to regularize the services of the petitioners and extend the

2. Brief facts of the case are that respondent

No.5/Secretary Administration, Information & Coordination FATA Secretariat, Warsak Road, Peshawar invited applications for the posts of Lecturers in (BPS-17) on "adhoc basis" in various academic Disciplines from candidates belonging to Federally administered tribal domicile area and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa vide advertisement dated 29.05.2011. The petitioners considered themselves as eligible having required qualifications in their respective academic disciplines, applied for the same posts, participated in the selection

process and were declared as successful candidates, thereafter Chief Secretary Khyber Pakhtunkhwa vide lecturers No.SO(E-II)1-17/adhoc Notification (Male)/15286-97 dated 06.10.2011, appointed the petitioners on the posts of Lecturer in (BPS-17) on Adhoc basis for a period of one year. Similarly some of candidates who were declared successful in the selection process but did not join their duties other candidates next in merits after adopting legal procedure were appointed vide Notification No.SO(E-II)1-17/adhoc lecturers(2)/17621-30. Similarly vide Notification No.SO(E-II-17/adhoc dated 14.09.2011 141 lecturers were appointed by the Additional Chief appointment Notification vide Secretary No.FS/SSD/SO(E)/Adhoc dated Lec:/7920-32 27.12.2012, 119 lecturers were appointed vide No.S.O(FATA)EDU/1-0/2013/288-90 Notification dated 06.12.2013, 134 lecturers were appointed, similarly vide Notification No.S.O(FATA)EDU/1-0/2013/2891-100 dated 06.12.2013, 119 lecturers were appointed. The services of petitioners were extended from time to time but despite directives of Federal

Government the petitioners were not regularized, hence this petition on the grounds mentioned therein.

- No.3 to 5, who submitted their para-wise comments and refuted the submissions of petitioners by raising various legal as well as factual objections particularly raised objection that as petitioners were appointed on "Adhoc basis", therefore, no right had been accrued to them for regularization. Similarly they also objected that as the posts pertain to BPS-17 so it could only be filled through recommendations of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission so are not entitled for the relief prayed.
- **4.** Arguments heard, record perused.
- admitted position that petitioners were appointed after adopting due process of law and their service contract was extended as discussed above. Similar kind of legal controversy arose in WP No.379-P/2015 titled as Dr. Amir-uz-Zaman and others Vs Govt. of KPK & others and the same was settled vide judgment dated15.06.2016 according to which most of the

medical officers were regularized under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Medical Officers (Regularization of Service Act, 2015) but when petitioners of referred WP No.379-P/2015 moved application for their regularization, they were regretted vide order dated 11.09.2015 on ground that they were appointed for FATA and PATA so could not be regularized. The ratio of the judgment passed in WP No.379-P/2015 is as under:

"petitioners are appointed and posted on contract basis till the arrival of Public Service Commission selectees and as such the petitioners while holding the said posts comes within the purview of ibid Act so after the promulgation of the said Act they are regularize employees of the Provincial Government posted in FATA/Agency."

6. This Court vide order dated 28.05.2015

held that the petitioners mainly relied upon the

Larger Bench in WP No.969/2010 dated 07.11.2013 and the judgment passed in WP No.2307-P/2013 on 06.11.2014 whereby contract and daily wages employees of FATA were given status of regular employees whereas petitioners in the instant writ petition were initially appointed on "Adhoc basis" as lecturer subject to arrival of nominee from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission. Thus in view of above, the petitioners filed CM No.1211/2016 seeking relief for amendment in the instant writ petition which was allowed vide order dated 29.06.2016, therefore, the petitioners filed amended writ petition with following prayer:

"Because without prejudice to the above but in addition thereto, the petitioners are employees of Higher Education Department KPK working in FATA as evident from the decision arrived at in a aforementioned meeting held on 16.02.2016, summary for

Chief Minister and the comments filed by the respondent No.6, then the petitioners are entitled for regularization as similarly placed adhoc lecturers of Higher Education Department working in settled areas in the province has already been regularized by the respondents."

admitted position that the petitioners were appointed vide above said notifications. Similarly according to minutes of meeting held on 16.02.2016 for regularization of adhoc lecturers in FATA and Teaching Assistants of Higher Education Department a Committee comprising members of Establishment Department, Law Department, Finance Department and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission was constituted under the Chairmanship of Higher Education Department to prepare a comprehensive case for regularization of services of above said employees/petitioners.

8. In the meanwhile Federal Government introduced a policy to regularize all contract and daily working whether employees Ministries/Divisions etc and for this purpose a Sub-Committee of Cabinet Division was constituted with a clear mandate to consider and regularize contract and daily wages employees and in this respect a meeting of Cabinet Sub-Committee on "regularization" was held on 13th of March 2013 under the Chairmanship of the then Federal Minister of Religious Affairs so vide agenda item No.247 all those above said employees who served for more than one year were recommended Sub-Committee under the said policy for regularization. Consequently, in view of Cabinet Sub-Committee decision dated 13.03.2013 as many as 1282 employees of FATA were regularized but inspite of decision of Cabinet Sub-Committee, the matter of regularization of 1282 employees of FATA working as lecturers was delayed on one pretext or other, therefore, WP No.969-P/2010 was filed for which a larger bench of this Court was constituted who gave its verdict on 07.11.2013 wherein it was held that the services of all the petitioners including those who are

similarly placed persons and are serving on contract basis shall be regularized in the light of Cabinet Sub-Committee decision conveyed to FATA Secretariat by the Cabinet Division meeting held on 13.03.2013 but the services of present petitioners were not regularized despite clear directions of the Cabinet Sub-Committee. It is noticed that Provincial Assembly of Khyber an Act Pakhtunkhwa passed also Pakhtunkhwa (Regularization Service Act, 2014)" whereby services of 195 Male and 46 Female lecturers were regularized but petitioner's regularization was not considered. It is also an admitted position that the petitioners according to decision held in minutes of meeting on 16.02.2016 are employees of Higher Education Department, Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa working in FATA and PATA. Similarly the argument of learned counsel for petitioners that the petitioners became prey to discrimination in the context that most of the employees of higher education department had been regularized vide ibid act 2014 while the employees working in FATA have not been regularized despite the decision of Cabinet Sub-Committee. Even some lecturers working in some

settled area, FATA and PATA have also been regularized while petitioners have been deprived from their right to regularization which is a noticeable discrimination.

9. Thus we are of the firm view that according to the decision of Sub-Committee of Cabinet Division and under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Lecturer Services Regularization) Act 2014, the petitioners have been discriminated and their services have not been regularized despite the fact that they are working since their appointment from 2011 up till now, so are entitled to the similar treatment, hence this petition is accordingly allowed and the respondents are directed to regularize the same petitioners in their services from their date of initial appointment.





TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- i. They shall have all rights and privileges contained in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973.
- ii. In case of resignation, they shall have to give one-month prior notice. In absence of such notice, their one-month pay shall be forfeited to Government.
- They shall join their duty within 30 days of the issuance of this Notification. Charge report shall be submitted to all concerned. The Director, Higher Education, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, the Director Education FATA should furnish a certificate to the effect that the regularized lecturers have joined their posts or otherwise, after one month of the issuance of this Notification.
- iv. In case of disciplinary matters, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants, (Efficiency & Discipline Rules), 2011 shall be applicable.
- v. They shall be on probation for a period of one year which are to be extended automatically for another one year if not terminated by a specific order in terms of Section-15 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989.
- vi. They shall undergo mandatory training for the purpose of promotion / direct recruitment, as the case may be.
- vii. They shall get pay in BPS-17 including usual allowances as admissible under the rules. They shall be entitled to annual increment like other Civil Servants.
