

Appeal u/s 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 against the impugned original order dated 29.11.2017 and against final order dated 19.03.2018 but both orders were not communicated to the appellant. The final order dated 19.03.2018 was obtained by the appellant on 25.03.2018 against which this service appeal is filed before this hon'ble Tribunal within a period of 30 days since 25.03.2018, which is well within time.

Note: ***It is pertinent to mention that the office of Inspector General of Prison did not officially communicate the impugned final order dated 19.03.2018 to the appellant.***

Prayer:

On acceptance of this service appeal, the impugned original order dated 29.11.2017 and impugned final order dated 09.03.2018 which was obtained by the appellant through his office colleague on 25.03.2018 may kindly be set aside and the appellant may be reinstated in service with all consequential back benefits and specifically direct the official respondents to also pay the appellant the salary from the **period 01.02.2017 to 31.03.2017 for the duties which were performed by him.**

Any other relief to whom the appellant is found entitled during course of hearing may also be granted.

Respectfully Sheweth;

Brief facts giving rise to the instant appeal are as under:-

- 1) That the appellant was appointed on 10.04.2004 as Warder and as such resumed his duties at Central Prison D.I.Khan.
- 2) That the appellant has more than 13 years service at his credit when he was unceremoniously removed from his service vide order No.3651 dated 29.11.2017 on the charges of willful absence from duty. (Copy of impugned original order dated 29.11.2017 is as Annex: "A").
- 3) That the appellant preferred his departmental service appeal dated 08.01.2018 against the impugned original order dated 29.11.2017 before the appellate authority i.e. the Inspector General of Police, KP, Peshawar, which was declined vide order Endst No.8060 dated 09.03.2018. The

office of respondent No.1 did not officially communicate the impugned final order dated 09.03.2018 to the appellant but the same was obtained by him through his office colleague on 25.03.2018 from the concerned office. (Copy of departmental appeal and impugned final order passed by respondent No.1 are attached as Annex: "B & C")

- 4) That the appellant feeling aggrieved against the original impugned order dated 29.11.2017 and impugned final order dated 09.03.2018 which was obtained by the appellant through his official colleague on 25.03.2018, constrained to file the instant service appeal for his reinstatement in service on the following amongst other grounds:

GROUND FOR APPEAL:

- a) That the impugned orders dated 29.11.2017 and 09.03.2018 are against the law, facts and material available on record, hence not tenable in the eyes of law, which is violative of Article 4 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

"All citizens shall be treated in accordance with law".

- b) That the respondent No.2 has passed a combined order by dent of which 82 Warders were punished by inflicting different punishments of different magnitude including the appellant appearing at Sr.No.61 who was removed from service on the charges of willful absence from duty without passing a separate order viz-a-viz each Warder which is legally speaking cannot be tenable within the four corners of law. The respondent No.2 was legally bound to pass a separate order, hence this mandatory requirements has not been fulfilled, therefore, the impugned original order

and the final order are liable to be set aside alone on this ground.

- c) That the impugned orders are also violative of section 24-A of General Clauses Act as the competent authority and appellate authority failed to pass a speaking order with reasons viz-a-viz the allegations without holding a regular inquiry.
- d) That competent authority has initiated the summary proceedings on the basis of vague and unspecific and one-sided allegations as no inquiry was conducted while making observation that the appellant absented himself from 22.03.2017 to 28.11.2017 for a period of 8 months, which was treated as extraordinary leave without pay.
- e) That no initial show cause notice nor any final show cause notice was served upon the appellant before imposition of the major penalty of removal from service which factum is against all the canons of justice, fair play and equity. Equity demands that sufficient opportunity of providing defence should have been provided by conducting a regular inquiry, which mandatory exercise has not been carried out, therefore, the impugned orders are bereft of any legal sanctity, which can be termed as void ab-initio.
- f) That ***no statement of allegation nor any charge sheet*** was served upon the appellant before imposition of the major penalty of removal from service bypassing the mandatory procedure which is a nullity in law.
- g) That the allegations as contained in the impugned order are vehemently denied by the appellant ***firstly, for the reason that the appellant was regularly attending his official duties at Central Prison, but his salary was illegally withheld by the respondents from 01.02.2017 to 31.03.2017 for a period of two months and secondly, that the official respondent No.2 has forcefully restrained the appellant from performing his duties at Central Prison, Haripur and he was asked to join his***

duties at Sub Jail Dassu, Kohistan against the genuine request of the appellant that his mother and young kids were seriously ill during those days but the respondent No.2 rudely and sarcastically abused the appellant and told him not to come for his duties not only at Central Prison Haripur but also sub jail, Dassu Kohistan by ignoring his genuine request which behaviour of respondent No.2 is not only against Code of Conduct to treat subordinate but also inhuman as subordinate staff deserve leniency keeping in view exception circumstances of hardship while performing toughest job of watch and guard duties. The appellant never refused to join even his duties at Sub Jail Dassu but he was restrained from joining his duties by the rude and sarcastic behaviour of respondent No.2, hence the charge cannot be termed as willful absence from duty, as mentioned in the impugned original order and impugned final order.

- h) That no ***opportunity of personal hearing*** was afforded by the competent authority nor by the appellate authority, which is another instance, which could be considered as a flagrant violation of the E&D Rules or any other concerned rules hence, the impugned orders are against the well recognized principles of natural justice which sufficient to vitiate the entire disciplinary proceedings carried out against the appellant at his back in his absence.
- i) That the competent authority was required under the rules to conduct a regular inquiry through an inquiry officer or inquiry committee which procedure has altogether has been scrapped and acted as complainant, inquiry officer and judge by imposing the penalty of removal from service in a fashion alien to law which functions could not be validly undertaken by the competent authority alone.
- j) That the impugned order is also violative of the mandatory provisions of ***Article 10-A*** of the Constitution of Pakistan.

It is settled preposition of law that when a thing requires to be done in a particular manner it had to be done in that manner, otherwise the same would be a nullity in law.

- k) That the malafide of the impugned orders can be reflected from the fact that the salary of the appellant was illegally withheld from 01.02.2017 to 31.03.2017 for a period of 2 months and thereafter illegal charges of willful absence were leveled against the appellant. (Copy of revised last pay certificate is Annex: "D").
- l) That additional grounds will be raised at the bar with kind permission of this Hon'ble Tribunal.

Keeping in view, what has been stated above, it is, therefore, humbly requested the impugned original order dated 29.11.2017 and impugned final order dated 09.03.2018 which was obtained by the appellant through his office colleague on 25.03.2018 may kindly be set aside and the appellant may be reinstated in service with all consequential back benefits and specifically direct the official respondents to also pay the appellant the salary from the **period 01.02.2017 to 31.03.2017 for the duties which were performed by the appellant.**


