JUDGMENT

ROZINA REHMAN, MEMBER (J): Appellant has filed the instant service appeal U/S 4 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 against the order dated 04.01.2016, whereby, he was removed from service.

Briefly stating the facts necessary for the disposal of the lis in 2. hand are that appellant was appointed as Baheshti who served the Department from 20.01.1990 to November, 2013. Due to worst law & order situation in the area and severe threats to the Government servants from terrorists, appellant opted to leave his hometown. He was, therefore, proceeded against departmentally and was removed from service on the allegations of absence from duty. He filed



departmental appeal which was regretted, hence, the present service appeal.

- 3. We have heard Rozi Khan appellant and Asif Masood Ali Shah learned Deputy District Attorney for the respondents and have gone through the record and the proceedings of the case in minute particulars.
- 4. Appellant while arguing his case in person, inter-alia, submitted that the order of removal from service is against law and facts as due to law & order situation in the area, he was not able to perform his duties. He further contended that he has put in regular service for a considerable period, therefore, by taking lenient view, major punishment of removal from service may kindly be converted into major punishment of compulsory retirement.
- 5. Conversely, learned D.D.A submitted that appellant applied for leave which was sanctioned, where-after, he remained absent from duty w.e.f 01.12.2013 till his removal on 04.01.2016, therefore, he was served with notices and in this regard, he was also informed through publication in the newspaper but he failed to report for duty, therefore, he was removed from service according to prevailing rules.
- 6. From the record, it is evident that the appellant was appointed as Baheshti on 20.01.1990 at Government Girls Degree College Thana. He served the Department for a considerable period of almost 23 years. It is not denied that law & order situation in the area was worst, therefore, he applied for leave which was accordingly sanctioned. However, he did not resume duty, where-after, he was proceeded against departmentally for willful absence. However, there is nothing on record which could show that he was a habitual



absentee. Keeping in view the last request of appellant and without touching other merits of the case, we are of the view that since the appellant has put in considerable regular service for almost 23 years, it would be appropriate keeping in view the circumstances of the case to convert major penalty of removal from service into that of compulsory retirement.

7. We, therefore, allow this appeal, set aside the impugned orders of the authority and convert his removal from service into compulsory retirement. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.


