Appeal under Section 4 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Act, 1974 read with other enabling provision of law applicable to the matter against impugned order, dated 26-02-2021 whereby through impugned transfer orders the Appellant has been illegally, without any lawful authority, transferred from Khyber Teaching Hospital (MTI) to Director General Health by Respondent No 4/Hospital Director without any rhymes, reasons and obtaining proper approval from competent authority against which the departmental representative/ appeal dated 20th April, 2021 received on 22nd April, 2021 has not been responded till-date within expiry of statutory period, hence the instant appeal

Respectfully Sheweth:

Brief facts leading to this service appeal are as under:-

- 1) That the Appellant is initially appointed on temporary basis in the Respondent's Officer Khyber Teaching Hospital MTI and was later on regularized on permanent posts and since then the Appellant is working against the permanent posts. (Copy of the initial appointment is attached as Annex 'A').
- 2) That the Respondents/Khyber Teaching Hospital MTI Peshawar through Respondent No 1 issued impugned transfer order dated 26-02-2021 of Appellant and attached

the salary of the Appellant without any rhymes, reasons and in violation of law, rules and regulations. (Copy of impugned order is attached as Annex 'B'). 3

- 3) That initially, the Appellant filed appeal under Section 16-A of MTI Reforms Act 2015 (Amended Act 2020), read with Section of Medical Teaching Institution (MTI) before the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Medical Tribunal Hayatabad, Peshawar against the impugned order of transfer, but the same was withdrawn vide order dated 07-07-2021; but the Chairman Medical Tribunal, to approach the proper forum. (Copy of the order dated 07-07-2021 is attached as Annex 'C').
- 4) That against the impugned transfer order dated 26-2-2021, the Appellant filed departmental appeal/representation on 20-04-2021, which was received by the Respondent on dated 22-04-2021 but the same has not been responded by the Respondent/department after expiry of statutory period under the law. (Copy of the grounds of appeal and receiving order on the merge of departmental appeal is attached as Annex 'D').
- 5) That the Appellant being aggrieved from the impugned order, filed departmental appeal before the competent authority, which departmental appeal has not yet been entertained and the Appellant has been constrained to

knock the door of the competent forum for the redressal of his grievances on the following grounds, inter-alia:-

4

GROUNDS:-

- A) That the Appellant is law abiding citizen of Pakistan and is employee at Khyber Teaching Hospital-MTI, Peshawar.
- B) That the Respondents/Khyber Teaching Hospital MTI Peshawar has acted beyond its jurisdiction and thus committed gross illegality.
- C) That the impugned order of transfer and attached of salary is illegal and the same is not tenable in the eyes of law and procedure as well as the dictums of the apex Court of Pakistan.
- D) That the allegations leveled by the Respondents are strictly denied by the Appellants and such allegations have not yet been proved in fact finding inquiry by any independent and reliable source. The word "Show Cause" meant to make clear of apparent, which has been held in 2006 SCMR 37 and 2007 CLC 1123 by the august Supreme Court of Pakistan, as by evidence testimony or reasoning to prove some guilt.
- E) That Appellant, with good record of service for more than 15 years, fully aware of his official responsibilities and being a disciplined official have not committed any wrong, therefore, the whole story and allegation are baseless and

neither proved nor any case was registered. Therefore, no any single iota of evidence is available in this regard. (5)

- F) That the imposition of penalty of transfer and attachment of salary of the Appellant is against the law, rules and regulations.
- G) That the authority initiated the disciplinary proceeding on receiving an anonymous complaint, without giving any show cause to the Appellant. The complainant has not been examined in support of allegations in the presence of Appellant. In such eventuality, the allegations would be deemed to have not been proved in accordance with law. Such inquiry would be illegal and no punishment could be imposed on the accused on the basis of such inquiry. (Reliance is placed on 2005 PLC (CS) 1015).
- H) That the transfer and attachment of salary of the Appellant is a major penalty and it is settled principle of law that such major penalty cannot be imposed without proper and regular inquiry. This view has been constantly maintained by this Honourable Tribunal as well as by the august Supreme Court of Pakistan. Reliance is placed on the following judgments.
- i. 2001 TD (Service) 147
 - ii. PLJ 2002 (SC) 525
 - iii. NLR 2003 Service 133 (SC)
 - iv. 2003 TD (Service) 413

- v. 2003 SCMR 681
- vi. NLR 2004 Service 22 (SC)
- vii. 2004 SCMR 294
- viii. 2004 PLC (CS) 328 and 344 (SC)
- ix. 2005 PLC (CS) 256 and 263

- I) That the transfer order was not a speaking order as against the Section 24-A of the General Clause Act, 1897, which stipulates that every order should be speaking one and well-reasoned. It has been held in a case reported as 2002 PLC (CS) 1480, that "Any order passed by the executive authority must be speaking one and shall be well reasoned". Therefore, the transfer order being against the Section 24-A of the General Clauses Act, 1897 is liable to be set aside.
- J) That after withdrawal of appeal under MTI rule, the Respondents relieved the Appellant, but the relieving order has not been executed upon the Appellant neither the Appellant has assumed the charge at his new place of posting nor the Appellant has relinquished the charge from the old place because the MTI rules has not been applicable on Appellant.
- K) That any other ground, not raised specifically may graciously be allowed to be raised at the time of arguments.



Any other relief, which this Honourable Tribunal deems proper in the circumstances of the appeal, may also be granted in favour of Appellant.



**PARA-WISE COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF
RESPONDENTS NO. 4-10**

RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:-

The Respondents No. 4 to 10 most earnestly seeks permission of this Learned Tribunal to submit as under:-

Preliminary Objections:

1. That no cause of action has accrued to the appellant as the appellant has no vested or legal right to continue remain posted for more then the tenure stipulated by law and or regulations.
2. That no right of the appellant has been infringed by the answering respondents as such the appeal is not maintainable before this learned forum.
3. That the appellant has come to this court with sullied hand, by concealing material facts.
4. That the subject petition is also not maintainable for mis-joinder and non-joinder of necessary parties.
5. That with utmost respect this learned tribunal has no jurisdiction to entertain the subject lis.
6. That the appellant does not fall within the definition of an aggrieved person therefore the subject appeal is not maintainable.

FACTS:-

1. Paragraph Number 1, being introductory needs no comments on part of the answering respondents. The appellant is put to strict proof.
2. Paragraph Number 2 is correct to the extent of promulgation of the impugned order of repatriation. However it is clarified that section 16 (3A) of the MTI Act, 2015 deems all civil servants working in MTI to be deputationist, for easy reference the ibid provision is being reproduced as under;

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- (3A) *Civil servants who do not opt for absorption in the MEDICAL teaching Institution, so notified, shall be dealt with in such a manner as provided in section 11a of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa^{CS} Act, 1973, for their future posting, which includes deputation to the Medical Teaching Institution subject to a request being made by the Board;*

Provided that a civil servant working in a medical Teaching Institution, shall at all time, be deemed to be on deputation. All deductions made from the pay of such civil servants shall be deposited by the borrowing authority.(emphasis added).

(3B) A Civil servant at the request of the board may be sent on deputation to a Medical Teaching Institution by the Government. For civil servants on deputation to the Medical Teaching Institution, pension contribution shall be made by the Medical Teaching Institution. The deputation of a civil servant to a Medical Teaching Institution may be terminated by the Board at any time without assigning any reasons thereof and such civil servants services shall revert to the Government immediately upon such termination being notified by the Board.)

BOG decision is Annex A

3. Paragraph Number 3 is misconceived as the appeal pending before the MTI Tribunal was withdrawn in simpliciter, neither any permission was sought nor was any direction given to approach this Honorable Tribunal as such by principles of constructive res-judicata too the lis at hand is liable to be dismissed.
4. Paragraph Number 4 needs no comments on behalf of the answering Respondents.
5. Paragraph Number 5 is correct as the competent authority of the civil servant is not the BoG but the Respondent Numbered 1, as explained

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earlier the status of the Appellant is/was that of a deputationist only. In view of the replies to proceeding paragraphs, there exists no grievance of the appellant and such the appeal of the appellant is ill founded and liable to be dismissed.

GROUND:-

- A. Ground A & B are incorrect and strenuously denied. As stated earlier the impugned office order has legal backing in the MTI act of 2015, moreover even otherwise the law of the land is quite clear on the matter of deputationist having no vested right to continue to work on deputation, neither is it necessary in law for the borrowing department to give reason for repatriating the deputationist.
- B. Ground C is incorrect and sternly denied. The impugned order is strictly legal, the appellant is assured that the Respondents bear no ill-will or grudge against him.
- C. Grounds D & E are incorrect, hence denied. The appellant cannot work on deputation indefinitely nor has any legal right accrued in his favour, furthermore repatriation back to his parent department is not a stigma by any stretch of imagination nor does law envisage giving right of personal hearing in matters of posting, transfer and/or repatriation to the employees, furthermore being a deputationist the proving or disproving of the allegations comes within the ambit of the Respondent Number 1 only.
- D. Ground F is incorrect and therefore denied. No provision of law, what to say of the constitution has been infringed by repatriating the appellant back to his parent department, nor is transfer/repatriation any penalty.
- E. Ground G is misconceived hence incorrect.
- F. Ground H is incorrect. The repatriating of the appellant back to his parent department cannot be construed as a penalty major or minor.
- G. Ground I is incorrect. The order of repatriation being the prerogative of the Answering Respondents has been issued legally nor has it infringed the provision of section-24A of the General Clauses Act.
- H. Ground J is incorrect. The appellant willfully failed to execute the relieving order showing his lack of affinity in following law and order.

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- I. Ground K requires no comments. The Answering Respondents seek permission and reserve the right to agitate any further legal and factual ground at the time of hearing of the subject petition in the interest of fairness and justice.
- J. That any other fact/ground not specifically accepted herein shall be deemed to have been denied by the Answering Respondents. Furthermore in view of the provisions of Section 16-A of the MTI Act this Honorable Tribunal with utmost respect has no jurisdiction to adjudicate on the lis.

PRAYER

It is therefore, submitted with profound respect that this Honorable Tribunal may very graciously be please to

- I. **Dismiss** the subject petition with costs being meritless and non-maintainable.
- II. **Grant** any other relief to the Respondents No. 4-10 as deemed appropriate in the facts and circumstances of the case.
