SALAH-UD-DIN, MEMBER:- Through the instant service
appeal, the appellant has invoked jurisdiction of this Tribunal with
the prayer copied as below:-

*"on acceptance of instant service appeal,
impugned Notifications dated 10.05.2018 and
12.12.2018 may kindly be modified to the
extent of appellant by giving him promotion as
officiating Inspector with effect from
10.05.2018 instead of 12.12.2018 alongwith
his batch-mates/colleagues/Juniors at right
place in seniority with grant of all
consequential service back benefits.*

2. Precisely stated the averments as raised by the appellant in
his appeal are that he was confirmed as Sub-Inspector on
07.03.2016 and was admitted to list "F" on 19.07.2016. The
appellant had obtained 04 marks of Operational Command

Course also, which were required to have been counted toward the marks of courses performed by the appellant. However, the Training Branch did not count the aforementioned 04 marks towards marks of the Courses, therefore, the name of the appellant was not included in the list of Officiating Inspectors notified on 10.05.2018. The appellant had fulfilled all the requirements for promotion as Officiating Inspector but he was wrongly ignored and his colleagues as well as juniors were promoted as Officiating Inspectors vide Notification dated 10.05.2018. The appellant filed departmental appeal/review before provincial Police Officer Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar. In the meanwhile, the appellant was also promoted as Officiating Inspector (BPS-16) vide Notification dated 12.12.2018 but with immediate effect, despite the fact that the appellant was entitled for promotion as Officiating Sub-Inspector with effect from 10.05.2018. The appellant challenged the same through filing of representation/review petition, however the same was not responded within the statutory period, hence the instant service appeal.



3. Respondents contested the appeal by way of submitting para-wise comments, wherein they refuted the assertions raised by the appellant in his appeal.

4. Arguments have already been heard and record perused.

5. Available on the record are minutes of meeting of Departmental Promotion Committee, which was held on 04.05.2018 for discussion of the cases of confirmed Sub-Inspectors on list "F" for their promotion to the rank of Officiating Inspectors. The name of the appellant is mentioned at serial No. 81, who was deferred for the reason that as per Standing Order No. 3/2015 and amended Police Rule, 19.25-A, he had not obtained a total of (09) marks and his ACRs for the period from 01.01.2017 to 31.12.2017 were not available. The appellant was though later on promoted as Officiating Inspector on 12.12.2018 but with immediate effect, while he is claiming that he was entitled to such promotion alongwith his colleagues/juniors with effect from 10.05.2018. The appellant has


categorically alleged that he had successfully qualified Operational Command Course in the year 2017, therefore, in view of letter dated 14.05.2018 of Deputy Commandant Elite Force Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar as well as Standing Order No. 01/2018, issued from the office of Inspector General of Police Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar, the appellant was entitled to have been allotted 04 marks but the same were not allotted and he was wrongly and illegally deprived of promotion as Officiating Inspector with effect from 10.05.2018. We have observed that such stance of the appellant, regarding his entitlement to 04 marks, has not been specifically denied by the respondents in their comments. The departmental representation dated 28.02.2019, submitted by the appellant was forwarded by Regional Police Officer Hazara Region at Abbottabad to Provincial Police Officer Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar through covering letter No. 6717/E dated 15.03.2019 but the same was not responded. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, it would be appropriate that the departmental representation/review petition may first be decided by the appellate Authority.

6. In view of the above discussion, it is directed that the appellate Authority shall positively decide the departmental appeal/review petition dated 28.02.2019 through a speaking order within a period of 30 days of receipt of copy of this judgment. In case, the appellant finds himself aggrieved of the order passed on his departmental appeal/review petition, he may challenge the same through filing of appeal before this Tribunal. The appeal in hand is disposed of accordingly. Parties are left to bear their own cost. File be consigned to the record room.

2. Precisely stated the averments as raised by the appellant in
his appeal are that he was confirmed as Sub-Inspector on
07.03.2016 and was admitted to list "F" on 19.07.2016. The
appellant had obtained 04 marks of Operational Command

issued by three High-ups of the Police Force like Addl. IGP KPK Peshawar etc (Copy of Certificate is attached as "B").

4. That the worthy Deputy Commandant, Elite Force Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar vide his letter dated 14-05-2018 has also clarified allocation of 04 marks of Operational Command Course to the qualified upper subordinates. (Copy of letter dated 14-05-2018 is attached as "C").
5. That Addl. Inspector General Police/Elite Force KPK has also endorsed the allocation of 04 marks of Operational Command Course to the upper subordinates for promotion as INSPECTOR vide its note dated 16-05-2018. (Copy of the letter is attached as "D").
6. That Training Branch has not included the appellant's 04 marks of Operational Command Course towards the marks of courses. The very act of Training Branch has deprived the appellant from his due and legitimate right of promotion as INSPECTOR with the batch-mates/colleagues promoted vide Notification dated 10-05-2018.
7. That despite the fact that according to Police Rules the appellant fulfilled all the requirements for promotion as Inspector but has been ignored while considering his batch-mates/colleagues for promotion as Officiating INSPECTOR by the competent authority vide order dated 10-05-2018. (Copy of the order dated 10-05-2018 is attached herewith as "E").
8. That appellant deserves his 04 marks of Operation Command Course to be counted towards the total marks of courses for consideration his case of promotion as Officiating INSPECTOR with his batch-mates/colleagues at right place according to seniority. (Copy of Minutes dated 10-8-2017 is attached as 'E/1').

1. That petitioner was enrolled in the police force on
24-01-2002 and subsequently promoted as Sub
Inspector. Appellant along-with his batch

mates/colleagues was confirmed as Sub. Inspector on 07-03-2016 and admitted to list "F" on 19-07-2016. Seniority list of Sub Inspectors issued by the IGP KPK Peshawar vide No. 618-36/E-II dated 29-06-2018 the name of appellant stands at S/No. 612. **(Copy of seniority list dated 29-06-2018 is Annex-"A")**.

2. That the appellant had **11 marks** of courses at his side. Out of these 11 marks 04 related to Operational Command Course and transparently mentioned in the Certificate issued in the year 2017 by three High-ups of the Police Force like Addl. IGP KPK Peshawar etc. **(Copy of Certificate of Operational Command Course is Annex-"B")**.
3. That the worthy Deputy Commandant, Elite Force Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar vide his letter dated 14-05-2018 has clarified allocation of 04 marks of Operational Command Course to the qualified upper subordinates. **(Copy of letter dated 14-05-2018 is attached as Annex- "C")**.
4. That Addl. Inspector General Police/Elite Force KPK has also endorsed the allocation of 04 marks of Operational Command Course to the upper subordinates passed it for promotion as INSPECTOR vide his note dated 16-05-2018. **(Copy of the letter dated 16-05-2018 is attached as Annex-"D")**.
5. That similarly vide DIG of Police Training, PK Peshawar minutes of meeting issued on 10-08-2017

and Standing Order No. 01/2018 also confirm allocation of 04 marks of Operational Command Course to those who have passed the same. **(Copies of Minutes of Meeting dated 10-08-2017 and Standing Order No.01/018 are Annex-"E & F").**

6. That Training Branch had not included the appellant's 04 marks of Operational Command Course towards the marks of courses. The very act of Training Branch deprived the appellant from his due and legitimate right of promotion as INSPECTOR with his batch-mates/colleagues/juniors promoted vide Notification dated 10-05-2018.
7. That despite the fact that according to Police Rules the appellant already fulfilled all the requirements for promotion as Inspector but was not considered with his batch-mates/colleagues/juniors for promotion as Officiating INSPECTOR when they were being given promotions vide order dated 10-05-2018. **(Copy of order dated 31-12-2018 is attached as Annex-"G").**
8. That appellant submitted review petition/representation dated 06-11-2018 but without taking it into consideration, the appellant has been given promotion as Oftg INSPECTOR by the IGP Peshawar vide Notification No.906/E-II dated 12-12-2018 with effect from 12-12-2018 instead of 10-05-2018 contrary to the facts and his seniority. **(Copies of**

earlier representation dated 06-11-2018 and Notification dated 12-12-2018 are Annex "H & I").

9. That appellant preferred a representation dated 28-02-2019 against the Notification dated 12-12-2108 which was forwarded vide Regional Police Officer Abbottabad covering letter No. 6717/E dated 15-03-2019, but never responded by the Provincial Police Officer KPK Peshawar. **(Copy of representation dated 28-02-2019 & Covering letter dated 15-03-2019 are Annex-"J & K")**. Hence instant service appeal inter alia on the following:-

GROUND:

- a) That both the impugned Notifications dated 10-05-2018 and 12-12-2018 of the respondents to the extent appellant's rights of promotion are illegal, unlawful, void-an-initio, passed in slipshod, perfunctory and arbitrary manner, against the law, rules & regulations, facts & circumstances of the matter, hence are liable to be modified to his extent by giving him promotion to the rank of Ofg Inspector alongwith his batch-mates/colleagues/juniors with effect from 10-05-2018 instead of 12-12-2018.
- b) That the respondents have not treated appellant in accordance with law, departmental rules, regulations and policy on the subject and have acted in violation of Article-4 of the constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973 & unlawfully issued the impugned

notifications, which are unjust, unfair hence, are liable to be modified to the extent appellant.

- c) That the appellate authority has also failed to abide by the law and even did not take into consideration the grounds taken by appellant in the memo of appeal/representation for his promotion as officiating Inspector alongwith his batch-mates/colleagues/juniors on 10-05-2018. Thus the impugned notifications of respondents are contrary to the law as laid down in the KPK Police Rules 1934, other departmental rules regulations read with section 24-A of General Clause Act 1897 and Article 10-A of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- d) That when on 04-05-2018 the meeting of promotion committee had been considering promotions of appellant's batch-mates/colleagues/juniors as Oftg Inspectors of which notification was issued on 10-05-2018 the appellant already fulfilled all the conditions, requirements and qualifications for promotion to the post of Inspector but he was not considered without any reason and contrary to the law and departmental rules and regulations and was deprived of his promotion on due date.
- e) That the appellant being qualified and fulfilling all requirements was eligible for promotion as Inspector on 10-05-2018 along with his batch-mates/colleagues/juniors but was deliberately deprived of his legitimate promotion on 10-05-2018 and deferred till 12-12-2018

against the law, departmental rules and regulation. He deserves to be promoted as Oftg Inspector with effect 10-05-2018 instead of 12-12-2018 at right place in his seniority with his colleagues/juniors Inspectors.

- f) That instant appeal is well within time and this honorable Service Tribunal has got every jurisdiction to entertain and adjudication upon the same.

PRAYER:

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that on acceptance of instant Service Appeal both the Notification dated 10-05-2018 and 12-12-2018 of respondents may graciously be modified and appellant be promoted as Oftg Inspector with effect from 10-05-2018 instead of 12-12-2018 alongwith his batch-mates/colleagues/juniors with grant of all consequential service back benefits.

Parawise Comments on behalf of Respondents are as under:-

Preliminary Objections.

1. That the appellant has no cause of action or locus standi.
2. That the appellant has not come to this Tribunal with clean hands.
3. That the appeal is bad for miss-joinder and non-joinder of necessary parties.
4. That the appellant is estopped by his own conduct.
5. That the appeal is barred by law & limitation, hence liable to be dismissed without any further proceeding.
6. That the appellant has suppressed the material facts from this Honourable Tribunal hence, not entitled for any relief and the appeal is liable to be dismissed.
7. That the honourable Tribunal has no jurisdiction to adjudicate the matter.

UP ON FACTS:-

1. Pertains to record.
2. In reply to this para it is submitted that the appellant did not fulfilled the requisite criteria for confirmation in the rank of sub-inspector. Therefore, he could not be confirmed as sub-inspector.
3. As stated above. Moreover, the appellant was not confirmed as sub-inspector as he did not possesses the requisite criteria/ courses.

4. In reply to this para, it is submitted that the request of the appellant was forwarded by the commandant Elite Force. However, he did not allocated the 04 marks to appellant.
5. Pertains to record.
6. In reply to this para, it is submitted that the appellant did not fall on the criteria/ qualification. Hence, he was not promoted as officiating inspector.
7. Incorrect, the appellant did not fulfilled the necessary qualification for promotion as officiating inspector.
8. In reply to this para, it is submitted that when appellant was found fit for promotion as officiating inspector, he was promoted vide Notification No. 906/E-II dated 12.12.2018. (Copies of DPC & minutes are attached as annexure "A and B").
9. In reply to this para, it is submitted that the appellant was dealt with as per law, when he was found fit for promotion. He was promoted as officiating inspector on 12.12.2018.

GROUND:-


- a. Incorrect, the Notification No. 906/E-II dated 12.12.2018 is proper notification in accordance with law and is maintainable. The appellant was promoted as officiating inspector when he fall on the criteria/ qualification.
- b. Incorrect, the appellant has been dealt with in accordance law, rules, regulations and standing orders applicable. Hence, this service appeal is not maintainable.
- c. Incorrect, the appellant was dealt with in accordance when the appellant fulfilled the criteria/qualification for promotion of officiating inspector he was promoted accordingly.
- d. Incorrect, the appellant was not promoted as officiating inspector vide notification dated 10.05.2018, on the ground that he did not fulfill the requisite qualification/ marks for promotion as officiating inspector.


So, being found not eligible for promotion as officiating inspector, he was not promoted.







 - v. No Departmental Enquiry Certificate.


