#### JUDGMENT:

SALAH-UD-DIN, MEMBER:- Through the instant service appeal, the appellant has invoked jurisdiction of this Tribunal with the prayer copied as below:-

"on acceptance of this appeal, the impugned orders dated 29.03.2019 and 06.01.2020 may very kindly be set-aside and the appellant may be reinstated into service with all back benefits or the appellant may be retired w.e.f 30.11.2018 on the basis of optional service. Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit may also be awarded in favour of the appellant.

2. Briefly stated the facts giving rise to filing of the instant service appeal are that disciplinary action was taken against the appellant on the allegations that he while posted as



Runner/Office Orderly to SP/Intelligence Special Peshawar, had prepared a fake NADRA verification reply in respect of Waris Khan S/O Anar Gul, which was forwarded to NADRA vide letter No. 9105/S dated 21.05.2018 mentioning him as national of Pakistan. On conclusion of the inquiry, the appellant was awarded major penalty of removal from service. The departmental appeal of the appellant was disposed of vide impugned order dated 06.01.2020, whereby the penalty warded to him was converted in to compulsory retirement, hence the instant service appeal.

- 3. Respondents contested the appeal by way of submitting para-wise comments, wherein they refuted the assertions raised by the appellant in his appeal.
- Learned counsel for the appellant has contended that the 4. appellant was assigned the duty of Runner/Office Orderly in the office of SP Intelligence Special Branch Peshawar and had nothing to do with regard to preparation of verification reply, therefore, the allegations against him are wrong and baseless; that no evidence regarding alleged involvement of the appellant in preparation of fake verification reply was collected during the inquiry but even then the appellant was wrongly and illegally awarded major penalty; that upon the request of the appellant, he was retired from service vide order dated 26.11.2018, however it is astonishing that his retirement order was cancelled and disciplinary action was wrongly and illegally taken against him; that Afghan National namely Waris Khan S/O Anar Gul, regarding whose status, fake verification reply was prepared, has been examined as witness during the inquiry, however he has not named the appellant to be having any connivance in preparation of fake verification reply; that the appellant was not provided any opportunity to cross examine the witnesses examined during inquiry, therefore, their statements could not be taken into consideration for awarding penalty to the appellant; that one Fazal-e-Amin Ex-Assistant Grade Clerk Special Branch, who was awarded major penalty on the same set of allegations had filed Service Appeal No. 1146/2019, which has already been

allowed by this Tribunal vide judgment dated 21.01.2021; that the mandatory provisions of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Rules, 1975 were not complied with, therefore, the impugned orders are liable to be set-aside.

- On the other hand, learned Assistant Advocate General for the respondents has contended that fake verification reply regarding Afghan National namely Waris Khan S/O Anar Khan was prepared through active connivance of the appellant and his quilt has been proved in a regular inquiry conducted against him; that upon initiation of disciplinary action against other officials of the department regarding preparation of fake verification reply, the appellant applied for retirement in order to avoid the taking of disciplinary action against him; that sufficient evidence regarding involvement of the appellant in fake verification reply preparation of available, therefore, the appellant was rightly awarded major penalty; that the appellant had himself requested the appellate Authority for conversion of his penalty of dismissal from service into penalty of compulsory retirement, therefore, the appellate him the punishment of compulsory Authority awarded retirement; that the inquiry proceedings were conducted in accordance with the relevant rules and there exist no material dent in the same. In the last he requested that the impugned orders may be kept intact and the appeal in hand may be dismissed with cost.
- 6. We have heard arguments of learned counsel for the parties and have perused the record.
- 7. A perusal of the record would show that the issue which triggered initiation of disciplinary action against the appellant pertains to preparation of fake verification reply in respect of an Afghan National namely Waris Khan S/O Anar Gul, whereby he was declared as Pakistani National. Available on record is the disputed letter No. 9105 dated 22.05.2018 sent by the Deputy Inspector General of Police Special Branch Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar to the Deputy Director Verification NADRA, Hayatabad Peshawar, whereby Mr. Waris Khan S/O Haji Anar Gul was verified as Pakistani National. According to

the charge sheet issued to the appellant, the aforementioned prepared bγ the appellant. reply was verification Admittedly, the appellant was performing his duties as Runner/Office Orderly to SP/Intelligence Special Branch Peshawar and has specifically alleged in his replies to the charge sheet as well as final show cause notice that he being Office Orderly was having nothing to do with preparation or dispatching of verification replies. One Muhammad Ibrahim Senior Clerk, who was working as Dispatch Clerk during the relevant days, has mentioned in his statement that it is the duty of Record Keeper to put up verification cases received from NADRA and the same are then handed over to Computer Operator for preparation of draft where-after Incharge ASB puts his initial on the same and are put up for signature before Intelligence Special Branch. According the aforementioned process of verification cases, an Orderly has been assigned no role in the verification process. The appellant was an Orderly and the department was required to have produced cogent evidence in support of the allegations against the appellant, however we have observed that the department has failed to substantiate the allegations against the appellant through any cogent material. Moreover, the respondents have failed to show that the appellant was provided an opportunity of cross-examination of the witnesses examined during the inquiry. Upon request of the appellant, he was retired from service with effect from 30.11.2018 vide order dated 26.11.2018, however the same was later on withdrawn vide order dated 24.12.2018. In absence of any cogent evidence about quilt of the appellant, mere his request for retirement could not be considered as a ground for awarding him major penalty.

8. While going through the record, it has been observed that it is not the case of the respondents that the disputed letter No. 9105 dated 22.05.2018 issued from the office of Deputy Inspector General of Police Special Branch Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar regarding verification of national status of Mr. Waris Khan S/O Haji Anar Gul was bearing any fake signature of SP Intelligence Special Branch Khyber

Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar. Verification letter regarding status of any person is issued in pursuance of the report obtained from the concerned officer/official of Special Branch, who makes thorough inquiry in the matter. The respondents have not alleged that any false inquiry report was submitted by any official of Special Branch. It appears that the disputed letter regarding verification of national status of Waris Khan S/O Haji Anar Gul was issued by SP Intelligence Special Branch Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar without going through the file of the concerned case. He was required to have checked the concerned file before issuing the disputed verification letter dated 22.05.2018. Moreover, the concerned SP Intelligence Special Branch Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar was a material witness in the matter, however the inquiry officer has not examined him for reasons best known to him. According to the relevant rules, it is the domain of the competent Authority to issue show-cause notice as well as charge sheet and statement of allegations to a delinquent official and also to pass an order upon receipt of the inquiry report. However, in the instant case, charge sheet as well as statement of allegations and final show-cause notice was issued to the appellant by SSP/Admn Special Branch Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar, while penalty was awarded to him by Deputy Inspector General of Police Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar, which fact has created material dent in the disciplinary proceedings.

9. In view of the above discussion, the appeal in hand is allowed by setting-aside the impugned orders. The appellant is granted retiring pension and shall be considered as retired from service with effect from 30.11.2018. Parties are left to bear their own costs. File be consigned to the record room.

#### **PRAYER:**

That on acceptance of this appeal the impugned orders dated 29.03.2019 and 06.01.2020 may very kindly be set aside and the appellant may be re-instated in to service with all back benefits OR the appellant may be retired w-e-f 30-11-2018 on the basis of optional service. Any other remedy which this august Tribunal deems fit that may also be awarded in favour of the appellant.

#### R/SHEWETH: ON FACTS:

That appellant was appointed on 10-03-1987 in the respondent department and had served the department for about 32 years. That the appellant had served the respondent department with zeal and zest, quite efficiently and up to the entire satisfaction of his superiors.

**2-** That service record and history of the appellant in the department is appreciable that in this long term of service no complaint or any allegations, whatsoever, had not been made against the appellant. That there is no adverse remarks or entry against the appellant in the entire service carrier.

- 3- That after completing his qualifying services, the appellant moved an application for retirement to the competent authority and the same application was accepted by the competent authority by retiring the appellant w-e-f 30-11-2018 vide order dated 26-11-2018. Copies of the retirement order dated 26-11-2018 and clearance certificate are attached as annexure.

  - **6-** That feeling aggrieved from the impugned order dated 29-03-2019, appellant filed Departmental appeal before the appellate authority on 08-04-2019. Copies of the Departmental appeal is attached as annexure.
  - **7-** That the departmental appeal of the appellant was accepted vide order dated 06-01-2020 and his punishment of removal from service was converted to the compulsorily retirement from service. Copy of the appellate order dated 06-01-2020 is attached as annexure.....F.
  - **8-** That appellant feeling aggrieved and having no other remedy filed the instant appeal on the following grounds amongst the others.

#### **GROUNDS:**

- A- That the impugned orders dated 29.03.2019 and 06-01-2020 are against the law, facts, norms of natural justice and materials on the record hence liable to be set aside.
- B- That appellant has not been treated by the respondents in accordance with law and rules on the subject noted above and as such the respondents violated Article 4 and 25 of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973.
- C- That no charge sheet and statement of allegation has been issued to the appellant.
- D-That no chance of personal hearing/defense has been provided to the appellant before issuing the impugned order dated 29-03-2019 and 06-01-2020.
- E- That it is worth to mention here that appellant was retired w-e-f 30-11-2018, then how an inquiry could be initiated against him as it is

the cardinal principal of service law that once an employee got retired then inquiry could not be initiated against him. Similarly if all ready an inquiry in going on against him that shall be abated by his retirement.

- F- That no right of cross examination has been provided to the appellant against the witnesses examined in the departmental inquiry before passing the impugned removal order dated 29-03-2019 which is mandatory as per Rule. Furthermore Article 10-A (Right to Fair Trial) of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 has been violated.
- G-That the respondent Department acted in arbitrary and mala fide manner by imposing major punishment of removal from service on appellant without providing the opportunity of fair trial.
- H-That the impugned orders dated 29.03.2019 and 06-01-2020 were passed in a hasty manner and without making recourse to the Rules and thus against the Law and Rules on the subject as well as against the principle of natural justice.
- I- That appellant seeks permission to advance other grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.

It is therefore, most humbly prayed that the appeal of the appellant may be accepted as prayed far.



#### **ORDER**

This order is passed in departmental proceedings initiated against Constable Nabi Amin No. 594/SB (hereinafter referred to as an accused officer).

Accused officer while posted as orderly to SP/Intelligence has allegedly made a fake/bogus NADRA verification of National status reply of an alien Waris Khan and got it signed fraudulently from SP/Intelligence. The same reply letter was forwarded to NADRA vide No. 9105 dated 21.05.2018 wherein alien Waris Khan was declared bonafide Pakistani National/Citizen. Charge Sheet and statement of allegations based on preparing fake/bogus verification of National status letter was served to accused officer vide letter NO. 7692-93/EB dated 28.12.2019. Muhammad Asfaq SP Security was appointed as Enquiry officer to scrutinize the conduct of accused officer with reference to the charges leveled against him. The Enquiry Officer accomplished the departmental proceedings and held the accused officer guilty of commission of gross misconduct beyond shadow of doubt as he was involved preparing fake/bogus NADRA verification reply which tarnished the image of this reputed Intelligence Agency. Thus the accused officer was served with final show cause notice and also heard in person but his reply and personal appearance was not satisfactory having no substance to defend.

In view the incorrigible character of accused officer who is proved involved in such cheating/fraud, I Muhammad Karim Khan Deputy Inspector General of Police, Special Branch, Peshawar being the competent authority imposed upon him major penalty of Removal from service within the meaning of Rule 4(1)(iii) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Rules 1975 (amended 2014) with immediate effect.

- 1. That the appellant joined this prestigious Branch/CCP, as a constable in the year of 10/03/1987 and were still serving in the same department for the last 32 years.
  - 2. That the appellant served with his zeal and zeast in this department for many years,

but there had been no adverse entry against the appellant, nor any complaint was ever moved against the appellant, rather the appellant has thoroughly been able to win the appreciations of his High Ups, throughout his career.

- 3. That the appellant filed in application for retirement after qualifying pension before the competent authority, whereas clearance certificate was too issued to the appellant. (Copy of slip dated 03/12/2018 is attached)

That intentionally involved in a bogus and fake inquiry with malafide intention ulterior motive just to deprive him from all pensionery benefits, the inquiry report is self explanatory that in inquiry namely wasris Khan who's NIC was blocked during in the course of inquiry the inquiry officer called Mr. Waris Khan who did not disclose the name of the appellant. (Copy statement of waris Khan 28/12/2018 is attached)
- 5. That besides these facts one of the ex-Officials Muhammad Ibrahim falsely





stated before the inquiry officer that once the appellant came and asked me about dispatch Number but nothing available in black n white on record but just to involve the innocent appellant by fraud in misrepresentation.

#### Grounds:

- 1. That the inquiry report and removal order is totally against the law and fact and nothing available on record to involved the innocent appellant in the frivolous case.
- 2. That the act of the competent authority is against the law and constitution which does not suggest the major penalty on such like cases.
- 3. That the appellant had filed application for retirement on the basis of qualifying pension on the service of 32 years but the department/high ups involved him in the bogus inquiry and suggested major penalty removal from service which is clear violation of the fundamental rights.
- 4. That no proper proceeding were adopted to bring the real culprit/facts by the inquiry officer but just made fill in the blanks by involving

innocent appellant just to fulfill the proceeding of the inquiry which is against the fundamental rights and constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

5. That the appellant is ready to swear on oath, that the appellant is quite innocent and depriving him from pensionary benefits.

It is, therefore, most humbly requested that office order No.3958-65/EB dated 29/03/2019 of the office of the competent authority/DIG, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa may be struck down and cancelled and the appellant may be reinstated on his own post and pay scale.

The petitioner was removed from service by Deputy Inspector General of Police, Special Branch, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar vide order Endst: No. 3958-65/EB, dated 29.03.2019 on the allegations that he while posted as orderly to SP/Intelligence has allegedly made a fake/bogus NADRA verification of National status reply of an alien Waris Khan and got it signed fraudulently from SP/Intelligence. The same reply letter was forwarded to NADRA vide No. 9105, dated 21.05.2018 wherein alien Waris Khan was declared bonafide Pakistani National/Citizens.

Meeting of Appellate Board was held on 13.06.2019 wherein petitioner was heard in person.

During hearing petitioner contended that he is innocent.

Perusal of service records reveals that petitioner was posted as Orderly to SP/Intelligence. He remained posted in Special Branch for 08 years and worked in various capacity. His duty was to present files before the officers. Reading all papers carefully and then signing them is the duty of the officers. #### RESPECTIVELY SHEWETH:

#### PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS:-

- a) The appeal is not based on facts.
- b) The appeal is not maintainable in its present form.
- c) The appeal is bad for miss-joinder and non-joinder of necessary parties.
- d) The appellant is estopped to file the appeal by his own conduct.
- e) Appeal is barred by law and limitation.
- f) The appellant has not come to this Hon'ble Tribunal with clean hands.
- g) The appellant has got no cause of action to file present Service Appeal.
- h) Appellant has wrongly cited the designation of Respondents No.2 as Additional Inspector General of Police Establishment instead of Assistant Inspector General of Police Establishment.

#### **FACTS**

- 1. Incorrect, appellant was recruited as Constable and he failed to earn promotion to next ranks despite long period of service at his credit, which establishes his inefficiency and lack of professional skill and qualities. Furthermore, he has wrongly contended that he served the department with Zeal and Zest because in addition to award of impugned major penalty, his service dossier contains several bad entries. (Copy of bad entry list enclosed as Annexure "A").
- 2. Para 2 of the appeal of appellant is absolutely wrong and false. According to the service record, appellant was punished departmentally on different occasion on charges of willful absence from duty. Eventually appellant

- involved himself in corruption and corrupt practices and major penalty was awarded to appellant after observing all codal formalities.
- 3. Incorrect, virtually disciplinary proceedings were initiated against other officials of Special Branch on charges of manipulating of false, bogus and fabricated verification report in respect of alien namely Waris khan wherein he was verified as citizen of Pakistan. During course of enquiry, the involvement and vicarious liability of appellant in the commission of above nefarious activities and misconduct also came to light. Appellant on realizing the above situation and the prospects of initiation of disciplinary action against him, malafidely managed retirement order with sole motive of defending and defusing the looming departmental charge. The guilty intention of appellant is evident from the fact that he submitted an application on 26.11.2018 for grant of pension with effect from 31.12.2018 and managed issuance of order on the same day i.e. 26.11.2018 with the active help of Ministerial staff. Furthermore, he all of a sudden submitted an application for retirement despite existence of long period of about 09 years for attaining the age of superannuation.
- Incorrect, the competent authority on perceiving the mens rea of appellant behind the retirement that appellant in view of ensuing departmental charge had applied for retirement. Therefore the competent authority withdraw the retirement order before its materialization and implementation while exercising powers vested in the authority under Section 21 of General Clauses Act, 1897 which empowers the authority to rescind his own order. Furthermore, the appellant had wrongly challenged the legality of the order at this belated stage. He resumed duties in compliance with the withdrawal of retirement order which amounts to admission of the legality of order. In case he was aggrieved of withdrawal compliance of the order, he would have challenged the Order before the proper forum without compliance. Therefore appellant is estopped by his own conduct to challenge the Order at this belated stage.
- Incorrect, proper enquiry was conducted against the appellant under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Rules 1975 (amended 2014) and full opportunity of defense was provided to appellant and he failed to rebut the charges. (Copy of the Findings report is enclosed as Annexure "B").

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- 6. Correct to the extent of submission of departmental appeal against the impugned Removal from service Order.
- 7. Incorrect, the departmental appeal was partially accepted on the request of appellant. He placed request before the appellate authority that the colleague officials were awarded punishment of Compulsory Retirement from Service, therefore his Removal from Service Order may be converted into Compulsory Retirement from Service. The appellate authority accepted the request as evident from the impugned Order.
- 8. Incorrect, Respondent has passed Order of compulsory retirement on the request of appellant therefore he is estopped to file the service appeal. Furthermore the grounds of the appeal are not tenable.

#### **GROUNDS:-**

- A. Incorrect, the Orders of the respondents are Just, legal, and have been passed in accordance with law and Rules governing the subject matters.
- B. Incorrect, appellant was treated in accordance with law. Proper enquiry was conducted for finding the truth of the charge, besides, proper speaking Orders were passed in the departmental proceedings.
- C. Incorrect, proper Charge sheet with Summary of allegation were issued to appellant on 28.12.2018. (Copy of Charge Sheet with Summary of allegations is enclosed as Annexure "C").
- D. Incorrect, appellant was heard in person as evident from the Orders of dismissal and compulsory retirement.
- E. Incorrect, the Retirement Order of appellant was withdrawn before its materialization and implementation. Appellant resumed duties on 26.12.2018 and he was proceeded against departmentally under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Rules 1975 (amended 2014). Furthermore, as per law provided under FR 54-A, a civil servant on attaining the age of superannuation then the pending departmental proceedings stands abated. Appellant Retirement Order was withdrawn thus he was proceeded against departmentally during service.
- F. Incorrect, all the codal, legal and procedural formalities were completed before passing the impugned Order.
- G. Incorrect, a penalty commensurate with the gravity of charge was imposed on appellant.

- H. Incorrect, the whole departmental probe against appellant was made against the appellant in accordance with law/ rules and facts.
- I. Respondents may be allowed to raise/ add others grounds/proofs at the time of hearing of appeal.

#### PRAYER:-

In view of the above, it is humbly prayed that on acceptance of Parawise comments, the instant Service Appeal may kindly be dismissed being meritless with cost.

Subject: Departmental Proceeding against Constable Nabi Ameen No 594 of Special Branch.

#### Background;-

In compliance with the orders issued by worthy SSP Admin Special Branch vide Charge Sheet No. 7692-93/EB dated 28.12.2018 to Constable Nabi Ameen No.594 regarding involvement in preparing of fake NADRA Verification report in respect of Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul. In the instant case 03 official of Special Branch were found guilty and were desired for major punishment. However, the subject accused official was also alleged for the same omission for which the departmental proceeding initiated against him and entrusted to the undersigned for further probe.

#### Allegations as per statements of Allegation

That he was posted as runner/office Orderly to SP Intelligence Special Branch and prepared a fake NADRA verification reply in respect of Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul which was forwarded to NADRA vide letter No. 9105/S, dated 21.5.2018 mentioning him as Pakistani National.

#### Proceedings:-

The brief facts of the proceedings are mentioned below:-

Charge sheet/statement of allegations against the accused official was served upon him for proper departmental proceedings under Police Rules 1975 as recommended in the previous inquiry conducted against 03 other officials.

Therefore, in order to find the reality of the issue, the following were summoned, examined and placed their statements on file for reference.

- i. The accused official Constable Nabi Ameen attached as F/A.
- ii. Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul the holder of illegal CNIC attached as F/B.
- iii. Muhammad Naeem, Assistant, Ex-Incharge ASB attached as F/C.
- iv. Fazal Amin Ex-Record Keeper of ASB Section attached as F/D.
- v. Ibrahim Khan Senior Clerk Ex-Dispatcher of ASB attached as F/E.
- vi. Akhtar Hussain Senior Clerk Present Incharge ASB attached as F/F.
- vii. Wajid Ali Ex-Computer Operator of IT Project attached as F/G
- viii. Sihat Ali SI/Ex-AGO City attached as F/H.
- ix. (Ahmad, Haseeb, Iftikhar and Irfan Alam) all Computer Operators of ASB Section attached as F/I.

## 1. Statements of the Accused official FC Nabi Ameen

Constable Nabi Ameen No.594 stated that he was working as Office Runner/Orderly with Officers since 2008. In the instant inquiry he denied all kinds of involvement and said that he does not know the knowledge of Computer to prepare NADRA reply neither know about dispatching of letters. He further added for forgiveness.

## 2. Statement of Waris Khan the Holder of illegal CNIC

Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul r/o Birun Yakatoot, Science College Road Noor Colony Peshawar stated that his CNIC was blocked in the year 2013 and was marked to JVC Peshawar for verification but not succeeded. After failure in JVC he met with Qari Abdul Raheem who assured him for obtaining his CNIC and for the process he has given Rs. 25000/- to Qari Abdul Raheem. During cross questions he doubtfully admitted the name of Wajid Ali for getting such amount from Qari Abdul Raheem.

## 3. Muhammad Naeem, Assistant, Ex-Incharge ASB

He stated that Record Keeper namely Fazal Ameen has not put the case for onward process, so how he processed the case, as the original PUC of the case was pending with record keeper and also with AGO City. Thus he denied all kind of omissions alleged against him.

## 4. Fazal Amin Ex-Record Keeper of ASB Section

Fazal Amin assistant Grade Clerk while posted as Record Keeper in the ASB section added that he did not put the previous record with the instant case. He added that during his tenure the instant case was kept pending in his custody and neither the AGO concerned has verified the case. So how he put the case for onward process he added. He denied all kind of omissions levelled against him.

## 5. Ibrahim Khan Senior Clerk Ex-Dispatcher of ASB

Ibrahim Senior Clerk Ex-Dispatcher of ASB section appeared before the undersigned and stated verbally that Constable Nabi Ameen alongwith the case came and asked him that SP Intelligence requires dispatch number thus he gave a number 9105 on a chit. Later on he did not handed over the case for further process.

## 6. Akhtar Hussain Senior Clerk Present Incharge ASB

Senior Clerk Akhtar Hussain while posted as Incharge of ASB Section stated that he was transferred to ASB section on 17.7.2018 and the

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number 9105/S quoted on the bogus letter has no record in this office neither it has been registered in the Dispatch register. He further stated that the NADRA case in respect of Waris Khan is pending in the record but its reply were illegally sent to NADRA. He disclosed that the initial of ex-Incharge ASB Muhammad Naeem is quoted on the bogus letter.

#### 7. Wajid Ali Ex-Computer Operator of IT Project

He stated that he was working in IT Section as project employee since 20.07.2012 till 23.6.2018. The project was expired on 30.6.2017 but his regularization process was pending in the court therefore he continued his services to 23.6.2018. He stated that he has no concern with ASB Section neither he knows the job of ASB Section. He further stated that his job was only to maintain Internet Services in all sections of Special Branch. On querying about Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul he stated that he does not know about Waris Khan neither any relation or contact with him.

#### 8. Sihat Ali SI/Ex-AGO City

He stated that inquiry about Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul was not assigned him neither kept pending on the part of AGO City. He further stated that the inquiry was assigned to him on 14.11.2018 after the action of the high-ups and submitted his report by declaring him as Afghani National.

## 9 (Ahmad, Haseeb, Iftikhar and Irfan Alam) all Computer Operators of ASB Section

Computer operators Ahmad, Haseeb, Iftikhar and Irfan Alam of ASB Section were appeared before the undersigned stated the same that they are unaware of the instant case and stated that they did not type any letter without NADRA record.

#### Findings:-

During the course of inquiry the following were found that:-

- 1. Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul is reluctant to tell the facts of the instant case by whom he obtained the CNIC and stating about an imaginary person namely Qari Abdul Raheem. Which has been died since 01 year ago and nobody knows his where about.
- 2. Senior Clerk Ibrahim has furnished several omissions in the instant case i.e.;-

- i. First of all he wrote a blank letter number i.e. 9105/S in the Dispatch Register in the instant case without any record.
- ii. Secondly as per his statement if the blank letter received by office orderly i.e.(Nabi Ameen) then why he did not justified the same letter number before his incharge as well as his supervisory officer.
- iii. After writing the letter number in dispatch register, he made another serious mistake of dispatching the same letter to NADRA and also wrote in the Peon Book.
- 3. Besides Muhammad Naeem Ex-I/C ASB, Fazal Amin Ex-Record Keeper and Ibrahim Ex-dispatcher ASB who are declared by the previous inquiry officer as main culprits of the instant case, Wajid Ali Ex-Computer Operator of IT Project is similar involved in this case as he was the Web Services Controller, knows the job of ASB Section and had the access of ASB Section.
- 4. Similarly Constable Nabi Ameen is also a part of chain in the instant case as the case was routed through his channel and he demanded for a blank letter number i.e. 9105/S from Dispatch Clerk.

#### Recommendation;-

The following is recommended if approved:-

1. Local Police may be requested for legal action against Wajid Ali ex-Computer Operator of IT project for proceeding U/Ss 419,420, 468 and 471 PPC.

Constable Nabi Ameen No.594 has liable himself for the punishment as granted to other guilty officials.

Departmental Proceeding against Constable Nabi Ameen No. 594 of Special Branch

#### Background;-

In compliance with the orders issued by worthy SSP Admin Special Branch vide Charge Sheet No. 7692-93/EB dated 28.12.2018 to \*Constable Nabi Ameen No.594 regarding involvement in preparing of fake NADRA Verification report in respect of Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul. In the instant case 03 official of Special Branch were found guilty and were desired for major punishment. However, the subject accused official was also alleged for the same omission for which the departmental proceeding initiated against him and entrusted to the undersigned for further probe.

#### Allegations as per statements of Allegation

That he was posted as runner/office Orderly to SP Intelligence Special Branch and prepared a fake NADRA verification reply in respect of Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul which was forwarded to NADRA vide letter No 9105/S, dated 21.5.2018 mentioning him as Pakistani National.

#### Proceedings:-

The brief facts of the proceedings are mentioned below:-

Charge sheet/statement of allegations against the accused official was served upon him for proper departmental proceedings under Police Rules 1975 as recommended in the previous inquiry conducted against 03 other officials.

Therefore, in order to find the reality of the issue, the following were summoned, examined and placed their statements on file for reference.

- i. The accused official Constable Nabi Ameen attached as F/A.
- ii. Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul the holder of illegal CNIC attached as F/B.
- iii. Muhammad Naeem, Assistant, Ex-Incharge ASB attached as F/C.
- Jiv Fazal Amin Ex-Record Keeper of ASB Section attached as F/D.
- v., Ibrahim Khan Senior Clerk Ex-Dispatcher of ASB attached as F/E.
- vi. Akhtar Hussain Senior Clerk Present Incharge ASB attached as
- vii. Wajid Ali Ex-Computer Operator of IT Project attached as F/G
- viii Sihat Ali SI/Ex-AGO City attached as F/H.
- (Ahmad, Haseeb, Iftikhar and Irfan Alam) all Computer Operators of ASB Section attached as F/I.

#### 1. Statements of the Accused official FC Nabi Ameen

Constable Nabi Ameen No.594 stated that he was working as Office Runner/Orderly with Officers since 2008. In the instant inquiry he denied all kinds of involvement and said that he does not know the knowledge of Computer to prepare NADRA reply neither know about dispatching of letters. He further added for forgiveness.

#### 2. Statement of Waris Khan the Holder of illegal CNIC

Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul r/o Birun Yakatoot, Science College Road Noor Colony Peshawar stated that his CNIC was blocked in the year 2013 and was marked to JVC Peshawar for verification but not succeeded. After failure in JVC he met with Qari Abdul Raheem who assured him for obtaining his CNIC and for the process he has given Rs. 25000/- to Qari Abdul Raheem. During cross questions he doubtfully admitted the name of Wajid Ali for getting such amount from Qari Abdul Raheem.

#### 3. Muhammad Naeem, Assistant, Ex-Incharge ASB

He stated that Record Keeper namely Fazal Ameen has not put the case for onward process, so how he processed the case, as the original PUC of the case was pending with record keeper and also with AGO City. Thus he denied all kind of omissions alleged against him.

#### 4. Fazal Amin Ex-Record Keeper of ASB Section

Fazal Amin assistant Grade Clerk while posted as Record Keeper in the ASB section added that he did not put the previous record with the instant case. He added that during his tenure the instant case was kept pending in his custody and neither the AGO concerned has verified the case. So how he put the case for onward process he added. He denied all kind of omissions levelled against him.

#### 5. İbrahim Khan Senior Clerk Ex-Dispatcher of ASB

Ibrahim Senior Clerk Ex-Dispatcher of ASB section appeared before the undersigned and stated verbally that Constable Nabi Ameen alongwith the case came and asked him that SP Intelligence requires dispatch number thus he gave a number 9105 on a chit. Later on he did not handed over the case for further process.

#### 6. Akhtar Hussain Senior Clerk Present Incharge ASB

Senior Clerk Akhtar Hussain while posted as Incharge of ASB Section stated that he was transferred to ASB section on 17.7.2018 and the

number 9105/S quoted on the bogus letter has no record in this office neither it has been registered in the Dispatch register. He further stated that the NADRA case in respect of Waris Khan is pending in the record but its reply were illegally sent to NADRA. He disclosed that the initial of ex-Incharge ASB Muhammad Naeem is quoted on the bogus letter.

### 7. Wajid Ali Ex-Computer Operator of IT Project

Fle stated that he was working in IT Section as project employee since 20.07.2012 till 23.6.2018. The project was expired on 30.6.2017 but his regularization process was pending in the court therefore he continued his services to 23.6.2018. He stated that he has no concern with ASB Section neither he knows the job of ASB Section. He further stated that his job was only to maintain Internet Services in all sections of Special Branch. On querying about Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul he stated that he does not know about Waris Khan neither any relation or contact with him.

#### 8. Sihat Ali SI/Ex-AGO City

He stated that inquiry about Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul was not assigned him neither kept pending on the part of AGO City. He further stated that the inquiry was assigned to him on 14.11.2018 after the action of the high-ups and submitted his report by declaring him as Afghani National.

## 9. (Ahmad, Haseeb, Iftikhar and Irfan Alam) all Computer Operators of ASB Section

Computer operators Ahmad, Haseeb, Iftikhar and Irfan Alam of ASB Section were appeared before the undersigned stated the same that they are unaware of the instant case and stated that they did not type any letter without NADRA record.

#### Findings:-

During the course of inquiry the following were found that:-

- 1. Waris Khan s/o Anar Gul is reluctant to tell the facts of the instant case by whom he obtained the CNIC and stating about an imaginary person namely Qari Abdul Raheem. Which has been died since 01 year ago and nobody knows his where about.
- 2 Senior Clerk Ibrahim has furnished several omissions in the instant case i.e.;-

- i. First of all he wrote a blank letter number i.e. 9105/S in the Dispatch Register in the instant case without any record.
   ii. Secondly as per his statement if the later in the later and the later in the later and the later in the later and - Secondly as per his statement if the blank letter received by office orderly i.e.(Nabi Ameen) then why he did not justified the same letter number before his incharge as well as his supervisory officer.
   After writing the letter has been as for a supervisory of the letter of the letter has been as a supervisory of the letter - iii. After writing the letter 'number in dispatch register, he made another serious mistake of dispatching the same letter to NADRA and also wrote in the Peon Book.
- Besides Muhammad Naeem Ex-I/C ASB; Fazal Amin Ex-Record Keeper and Ibrahim Ex-dispatcher ASB who are declared by the previous inquiry officer as main culprits of the instant case, Wajid Ali Ex-Computer Operator of IT Project is similar involved in this case as he was the Web Services Controller, knows the job of ASB Section and had the access of ASB Section.
- 4. Similarly Constable Nabi Ameen is also a part of chain in the instant case as the case was routed through his channel and he demanded for a blank letter number i.e. 9105/S from Dispatch.

### Recommendation;

The following is recommended if approved:-

 Local Police may be requested for legal action against Wajid Ali ex-Computer Operator of IT project for proceeding U/Ss 419,420, 468 and 471 PPC.



Constable Nabi Ameen No.594 has liable himself for the punishment as granted to other guilty officials.

You were served with charge sheet and summary of the allegation vide this office No.7692-93/EB, dated 28-12-2019. SP/Security Muhammad Ashfaq was nominated as Enquiry Officer who during the course of enquiry, found you guilty of misconduct and recommend you to impose Major punishment of Compulsory retirement from service.

After going through the findings of the Enquiry Officer, the material available on record and other connected papers, I am satisfied that you have committed the misconduct being defined under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Police Rules 1975 (Amended 2014). As a result thereof, I Qasim Ali, SSP/Admn: Special Branch Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar as competent authority has tentatively decided to impose upon you major penalty of Compulsory retirement from service under Police Disciplinary Rules 1975 (Amended 2014).

You are therefore, directed through Final Show Cause within 15 days as to why the aforesaid penalty should not be imposed upon you.

In case your reply is not received with in stipulated period, it shall be presumed that you have no defense to put and in that case an ex-parte action shall be taken against you.

Also state as to whether you desire to be heard in person.

#### **ORDER**

This order is passed in departmental proceedings initiated against Constable Nabi Amin No. 594/SB (hereinafter referred to as an accused officer).

Accused officer while posted as orderly to SP/Intelligence has allegedly made a fake/bogus NADRA verification of National status reply of an alien Waris Khan and got it signed fraudulently from SP/Intelligence. The same reply letter was forwarded to NADRA vide No. 9105 dated 21.05.2018 wherein alien Waris Khan was declared bonafide Pakistani National/Citizen. Charge Sheet and statement of allegations based on preparing fake/bogus verification of National status letter was served to accused officer vide letter NO. 7692-93/EB dated 28.12.2019. Muhammad Asfaq SP Security was appointed as Enquiry officer to scrutinize the conduct of accused officer with reference to the charges leveled against him. The Enquiry Officer accomplished the departmental proceedings and held the accused officer guilty of commission of gross misconduct beyond shadow of doubt as he was involved preparing fake/bogus NADRA verification reply which tarnished the image of this reputed Intelligence Agency. Thus the accused officer was served with final show cause notice and also heard in person but his reply and personal appearance was not satisfactory having no substance to defend.

In view the incorrigible character of accused officer who is proved involved in such cheating/fraud, I Muhammad Karim Khan Deputy Inspector General of Police, Special Branch, Peshawar being the competent authority imposed upon him major penalty of Removal from service within the meaning of Rule 4(1)(iii) Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Rules 1975 (amended 2014) with immediate effect.

but there had been no adverse entry against the appellant, nor any complaint was ever moved against the appellant, rather the appellant has thoroughly been able to win the appreciations of his High Ups, throughout his career.

- 3. That the appellant filed in application for retirement after qualifying pension before the competent authority, whereas clearance certificate was too issued to the appellant. (Copy of slip dated 03/12/2018 is attached)
  - 4. That meanwhile the appellant was intentionally involved in a bogus and fake inquiry with malafide intention and ulterior motive just to deprive him from all pensionery benefits, the inquiry report is self explanatory that in inquiry namely wasris Khan who's NIC was blocked during in the course of inquiry the inquiry officer called Mr. Waris Khan who did not disclose the name of the appellant. (Copy of statement of waris Khan dated 28/12/2018 is attached)
    - 5. That besides these facts one of the ex-Officials Muhammad Ibrahim falsely

stated before the inquiry officer that once the appellant came and asked me about dispatch Number but nothing available in black n white on record but just to involve the innocent appellant by fraud in misrepresentation.

#### Grounds:

- 1. That the inquiry report and removal order is totally against the law and fact and nothing available on record to involved the innocent appellant in the frivolous case.
- 2. That the act of the competent authority is against the law and constitution which does not suggest the major penalty on such like cases.
- 3. That the appellant had filed application for retirement on the basis of qualifying pension on the service of 32 years but the department/high ups involved him in the bogus inquiry and suggested major penalty removal from service which is clear violation of the fundamental rights.
- 4. That no proper proceeding were adopted to bring the real culprit/facts by the inquiry officer but just made fill in the blanks by involving

innocent appellant just to fulfill the proceeding of the inquiry which is against the fundamental rights and constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

5. That the appellant is ready to swear on oath, that the appellant is quite innocent and depriving him from pensionary benefits.

It is, therefore, most humbly requested that office order No.3958-65/EB dated 29/03/2019 of the office of the competent authority/DIG, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa may be struck down and cancelled and the appellant may be reinstated on his own post and pay scale.

## PARA-WISE COMMENTS IN REPLY TO DEPARTMENTAL APPEAL SUBMITTED BY Nabi Amin EX-CONSTABLE NO. 594/SB.

#### FACTS:-

- 1. Pertains to record hence no comments.
- 2. Incorrect, the appellant service roll was checked wherein he was found habitual absentee hence punished time and again on absenting himself from lawful duties which speaks his lack of interest and shows him non willing worker however his absentia periods were treated as leave without pay while taking lenient view by the competent authorities.
- Incorrect, appellant when noticed that the authority initiated enquiry in the matter of serious misconduct wherein an alien/Afghan National Waris Khan was declared bonafide Pakistani Citizen by cheating/fraud committed in this establishment. Hence being guilty in nature as the appellant was fully involved, he applied for retirement on pension from service to avoid such departmental proceedings. During enquiry, it was found beyond shadow of doubt that the appellant was the main culprit in this fraud/cheating who made a fake/bogus reply to NADRA verification letter of National Status regarding an alien Waris Khan in connivance of other officials by signing fraudulently from SP Intelligence being an office orderly. Having involved in such serious kind of misconduct, his retirement order was withdrawn by the competent authority and directed to report back for duty.
- 4. Incorrect, Waris khan indeed mentioned that his late friend bribed the official (name not known to him) of Special Branch for declaring him Pakistani Citizen. Later on, the appellant was directly charged during enquiry by Ex-Senior Clerk Muhammad Ibrahim who disclosed that the appellant made this fraud/cheating of declaring an Afghan National as Pakistani Citizen by signing fake/bogus letter of National Status verification of Waris Khan from SP Intelligence.
- Incorrect, Ex-Senior Clerk Muhammad Ibrahim disclosed vehemently to the enquiry officer while recording his statement that the appellant came to his desk having in hand the National Status verification case of Waris Khan and asked him that SP Intelligence requires blank dispatch number. Later on, fake/bogus letter of National Status verification of an alien/Afghan National Waris Khan was signed by the appellant from SP Intelligence and sent to NADRA wherein Waris khan was declared bonafide Pakistani

Citizen despite that the enquiry of Wanis khan was pending in the field office of Special Branch AGO City Peshawar.

#### **GROUNDS:-**

- Incorrect, all legal and codal formalities have been observed during conduct of departmental proceedings against appellant held under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Rules 1975 (amended 2014). During proceedings, ExSenior Clerk Muhammad Ibrahim accused appellant was having the National Status verification case of Waris Khan and asked him that SP Intelligence requires blank dispatch number regarding this case. Later on, fake/bogus letter of National Status verification of an alien/Afghan National Waris Khan was signed by the appellant from SP Intelligence and sent to NADRA wherein Waris khan was declared bonafide Pakistani Citizen. Fortunately, NADRA official while receiving routine dak mentioned the irregularity and returned the letter.
- 2. Incorrect, sufficient evidence exists against the appellant that fake/bogus verification letter was prepared by the appellant with connivance of other official and this is very serious nature of offence which comes under the orbit of misconduct within the meaning of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Rules 1975 (amended 2014) hence major punishment awarded to appellant is just legal and according to ibid rules. The authority however took lenient view by not registering criminal case of fraud against the appellant.
- 3. Incorrect, no fundamental rights of the appellant mentioned in the Constitution of Pakistan 1973 have been infringed as it is proved beyond shadow of doubt that the appellant was fully involved in this fraud of making bogus letter of verification of National Status of alien/Afghan National Waris Khan wherein he was deliberately declared Pakistani Citizen. Appellant when informed that enquiry initiated by the authority to unearth the culprits involved in this cheating/fraud, he immediately submitted application for retirement on the basis of qualifying pension of 32 years however the pension order was withdrawn.
- 4. Incorrect, no fundamental rights of the appellant mentioned in the Constitution of Pakistan were violated. Earlier, proper departmental proceedings were initiated against staff of this establishment under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency and Discipline) Rules, 2011 wherein three officials were found involved in this fraud of fake/bogus verification letter and major punishment of compulsory retirement was awarded to all of them. The enquiry officer in that enquiry

made responsible the appellant of committing this fraud therefore another regular enquiry was conducted against the appellant by withdrawing the retirement order. He was given ample opportunity to defend himself besides heard in person by the competent authority but the appellant was having no plausible reply to convince hence major punishment of removal from service under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Rules 1975 (amended 2014) was imposed upon him after proof of charge.

Incorrect, the appellant was not condemned unheard rather a regular enquiry was conducted in the matter wherein Ex-Senior Clerk Muhammad Ibrahim in a blatant manner accused the appellant as the master mind of this fraud. The appellant was given opportunity to examine Ex-Senior Clerk but he did not avail it hence major punishment of removal from service under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Rules 1975 (amended 2014) was imposed upon him after proof of charge.

#### Prayer:-

It is therefore humbly prayed that the departmental appeal of the appellant based on wrong facts may be filed.

The petitione removed from service by Deputy Inspector General of Police, Special Branch, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Pes vide order Endst: No. 3958-65/EB, dated 29.03.2019 on the allegations that he while posted as order SP/Intelligence has allegedly made a fake/bogus NADRA verification of National status reply of an alien Khan and got it signed fraudulently from SP/Intelligence. The same reply letter was forwarded to NADR No. 9105, dated 21.05.2018 wherein alien Waris Khan was declared bonafide Pakistani National/Citizens

Meeting of Appellate Board was held on 13.06.2019 wherein petitioner was heard in p During hearing petitioner contended that he is innocent.

Perusal of service records reveals that petitioner was posted as Orderly to SP/Intelligen remained posted in Special Branch for 08 years and worked in various capacity. His duty was to prese before the officers. Reading all papers carefully and then signing them is the duty of the officers. In the case, three (03) other officials were awarded punishment of compulsorily retirement from servic petitioner himself requested that he may be compulsorily retired. Therefore, the Board accepted his app he is hereby compulsorily retired from service.

This order is issued with the approval by the Competent Authority.

03. We have heard the learned counsel for the appellant, learned Assistant Advocate General on behalf of the respondents and have also gone through the available record:

04. At the outset, learned counsel for the appellant referred to the impugned order dated 15.01,2019 and stated that the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Special Branch, Peshawar/ respondent No.2 was not a competent officer, for the purpose of discipline, in the cases of ministerial staff of police. Referring to Section-purpose of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Act, 2017 it was contended that only the Provincial Police Officer was the competent authority to pass such orders. The impugned order was, therefore, void and could not sustain.

Learned Assistant Advocate General opposed the argument of learned counsel for the appellant and contended that by virtue of notification dated 28.12.2015, the Regional Police Officer was delegated the powers of disciplinary action against ministerial staff. In his view, the appellant was rightly proceeded action against and awarded major penalty of compulsorily retirement by the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Special Branch.

misconduct detailed therein on 18.10.2018. The exercise was under taken by SSP/Admin Special Branch, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Peshawar while on the other hand, the impugned order dated 15.01.2019 was passed by the DIG, Special Branch. Reading Section-44 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Act, 2017 in juxtaposition to the statement of allegations as well as the impugned order, it becomes clear that neither the competent authority/ Provincial Police officer, issued the charge facet nor the impugned order was passed by him. It shall be useful to reproduce hereunder the relevant part of Statute ibid:-

Ministerial staff etc.—(1) Subject to rules, Provincial Police Officer, may appoint ministerial staff and other employees to assist the Police.

assist the Police.

(2) Any person employed under sub-section (1) shall be under the direction and control of Provincial Police Officer.

(3) The powers of direction and control referred to in subsection(2) shall include the powers of discipline and dismissal.

(4) Subject to rules, Provincial Police Officer, may delegate his powers and authority under this section to an officer of appropriate rank.

In the circumstances of the case and in view of the above noted provision of law, we have no other option but to hold that the impugned order was *corum-non-judice* for all intents and purposes. Having been issued by an incompetent official/officer it can only be termed as void ab-initio. At the cost of repetition, it is noted that the Provincial Police Officer was the only competent authority for the purpose of case in hand. The respondents could not produce any instrument regarding delegation of powers of PPO, as provided by the law ibid in favour of some other officer. The notification dated 28.12.2015, as relied upon by learned Assistant Advocate General, was undeniably issued in the year 2015, much before the coming into force of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Police Act, 2017.

06. For what has been noted above, the appeal in hand is allowed as prayed for. The parties shall, however, bear their respective costs. File be consigned to the record room.
