

KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA SERVICE
TRIBUNAL ACT 1974 FOR DECLARATION
TO THE EFFECT THAT THE APPELLANT
GOT APPOINTMENT IN THE RESPONDENT
JUDICIARY AS COMPUTER OPERATOR
VIDE ORDER DATED 01/07/2022. THE
APPELLANT WAS SUFFERING FROM
MULTIFARIOUS DISEASES AS WELL AS
ACUTE DOMESTIC PROBLEMS WHICH

RESULTED INTO DIVORCE OF THE APPELLANT. IN THE MEANWHILE, THE APPELLANT WAS FREQUENTLY TRANSFERRED FROM ONE PLACE TO ANOTHER VIDE POSTING ORDERS DATED 03/03/2022, 09/04/2022 & 02/06/2022, AS AS MENTIONED ABOVE, THE APPELLANT WAS NOT FEELING WELL BUT INSPITE OF THAT, SERVED THE DEPARTMENT WITH COMPLETE DEVOTION AND DEDICATION BUT ON THE BASIS OF MERE ALLEGATION OF MISCONDUCT, THE APPELLANT HAS BEEN DISMISSED FROM SERVICE VIDE IMPUGNED ORDER DATED 01/07/2022 WITHOUT FOLLOWING PRESCRIBED PROCEDURE WHICH IS SINE QUA NON FOR AWARDING MAJOR PENALTY OF DISMISSAL FROM SERVICE. HENCE, IMPUGNED DISMISSAL ORDER DATED 01/07/2020 IS LIABLE TO BE SET-ASIDE.

PRAYER; ON ACCEPTANCE ON SERVICE APPEAL OF THE APPELLANT, THE IMPUGNED DISMISSAL FROM SERVICE ORDER DATED 01/07/2022 MAY

GRACIOUSLY BE SET-ASIDE AND RESPONDENTS' MAY BE DIRECTED TO REINSTATE THE APPELLANT IN SERVICE WITH ALL SERVICE BACK BENEFITS. ANY OTHER RELIEF WHICH THIS HONOURABLE TRIBUNAL DEEM APPROPRIATE IN THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE CASE MAY ALSO BE GRANTED TO THE APPELLANT.

Respectfully Sheweth;-

The facts forming the background of the instant service appeal are arrayed as under;

1. That the appellant got appointment as Junior Clerk vide appointment order dated 27/06/2018. Copy of appointment order of the appellant is attached as Annexure "A".
2. That the appellant was appointed as Computer Operator in BPS-16 vide appointment order dated 6.11.2019 of the appellant. Copy of appointment order of the appellant as Computer Operator is attached as Annexure "B".

3. That the appellant served the respondent Judiciary with complete devotion, dedication, zeal and zest and left no stone unturned in the smooth functioning of the department. Besides, the appellant served with due diligence and worked from dawn to dusk.
4. That the appellant contracted marriage with Saima Yousaf on 17/10/2021 and the said husband of the appellant divorced her on 14/12/2021. Copy of divorce deed is attached as Annexure "C".
5. That this sudden shock badly affected mental capabilities of the appellant therefore, she became a psycho case. Therefore, she started her treatment from Prof. Dr. Aftab Alam Khan who is psychiatry physician. Copy of some of the medical paper of the appellant are attached as Annexure "D".
6. That during this period, mother of the appellant submitted an application to

respondent No. 2 to the effect that the appellant was suffering from acute depression and sought two months leave for getting the appellant treated but respondent No. 2 did not entertain the application of the mother of the appellant. Copy of application dated 22/06/2022 of mother of appellant are as Annexure "E".

7. That during the period of the ailment of the appellant (i.e) acute depression due to her sudden divorced she was posted from the court of Civil Judge-VI, Abbottabad and the court of Civil Judge-XI vide order dated 03/03/2022 and thereafter again, the appellant was transferred from the court of Civil Judge-XI to the court of Civil Judge-III, vide order dated 09/04/2022 and similarly, she was thrice posted from Civil Judge-III to record room Session Court for scanning vide order dated 02/06/2022. Copy of posting order is attached as Annexure "F".

8. That during this period, the appellant was suffering from acute depression and mental problems and she was under treatment of the said deceases. As a result, without following the prescribed procedure mentioned in E&D rules 2011, a final show cause notice was issued by respondent No. 2 on 23/06/2022 which was not delivered to the appellant. Copy of final show cause notice dated 23/06/2022 is attached as Annexure "G".

9. That thereafter, in a hasty manner without observing the codal formalities dismissed the appellant from service vide impugned dismissal order dated 01/07/2022. Copy of dismissal order dated 01/07/2022 is attached as Annexure "H".

10. That feeling aggrieved, the appellant filed departmental appeal before respondent No. 1 on 16/07/2022 which is yet to be decided by the appellate authority. Copy of departmental appeal is attached as Annexure

“T”. Hence, instant service appeal is filed, inter-alia on the following grounds;-

GROUNDS:-

- a. That the impugned dismissal from service order dated 01/07/2022 of the appellant is malafide, discriminatory, against the law and is based on whims and wishes of respondent No. 2 which is liable to be set aside.
- b. That respondent No. 2 did not issue show cause notice, statement of allegation, charge sheet as well as no proper inquiry as per E&D Rules 2011 has also not been conducted prior to the dismissal of the appellant. Hence, impugned dismissal order dated 01/07/2022 is not maintainable at law.
- c. That the appellant has not been provided opportunity of personal hearing which is mandatory for imposing major or minor penalties as per E&D Rules 2011. It is obvious that respondents willfully without

any lawful justification dismissed the appellant from service just to accommodate some blue eye in place of the petitioner.

d. That the impugned dismissal order dated 01/07/2022 is ex-parte, and is a result of Audi-Alterm-Parterm. Therefore, the dismissal from service order dated 01/07/2022 is liable to be cancelled because no opportunity of defending the case was provided to the appellant which is perverse, discriminatory, against the law and the impugned dismissal order dated 01/07/2022 is ineffective on the rights of service of the appellant.

e. That when law sets a procedure dealing with particular nature of cases, the competent authority are bound to adhere to the procedure and deviation thereof is nullity in the eye of law. The appellant is absolutely innocent and during the period of dismissal, as mentioned in the preceding paras she was suffering from acute depression due to her divorce and was under treatment under the

supervision of psychiatry physician and the circumstances were beyond her control as a human being.

f. That the circumstances which were faced by the appellant, respondents' were supposed to consider the application of the mother of the appellant for leave for two months for investigation and diagnosing the issues in has disposition from the hospitals. It is further submitted that the appellant submitted her medical documents to the respondent but respondent did not get the medical paper of the appellant verified from the next higher medical authority as per Section 13 of Civil Servant Revised Leave Rules 1981.

g. That medical leave cannot be refused by the authority as per Section 13 of the ibid Rules. That when, the appellant was dismissed from service, was under treatment and during dismissal from service order dated 01/07/2022, had aggravated her physical health. Now the appellant with the grace of

Almighty Allah is fit for service. The appellant has been dismissed from service due to no fault on her part. Therefore, the impugned dismissal from service order dated 01/07/2022 is set-aside.


- h. That the other points shall be urged at the time of arguments.

It is therefore, very humbly prayed, that on acceptance on service appeal of the appellant, the impugned dismissal from service order dated 01/07/2022 may graciously be set-aside and respondents' may be directed to reinstate the appellant in service with all service back benefits. Any other relief which this Honourable Tribunal deem appropriate in the circumstances of the case may also be granted to the appellant.

4. That the appellant was indisposed and could not come to resume her duties. As a result, during the absence of the appellant, she was proceeded X-Parte and has been dismissed from service impugned dismissal order dated 01.07.2022 this is already referred in para-01 above.

Respected Sir,

- a. That she met mishap due to family disorder. The mother of the appellant provided medical certificate to the District & Sessions Judge, Abbottabad, but, he did not considered the said certificate as per Revised leave Rules

1981, in the meantime, the competent authority without considering the circumstances of the appellant which was beyond her control, dismissed the appellant from service which is perverse, discriminatory and is a result of (audi alter partem).

- b. That the allegations of the mis-behaving with the presiding officer by the appellant is incorrect. The appellant ever remained dutiful and served with due diligence. As a result, she earned good and very good ACRs. In this regard your good-self may requisitioned the ACRs of the appellant from the Judicial Department, Abbottabad.
- c. That besides, the service carrier of the appellant is unblemished neat and clean and spotless. It is further submitted that no explanation, letter of warning or censure have been issued by the authority. The appellant is absolutely innocent and has been dismissed from service due to no fault on the part of the appellant.
- d. That the appellant ever remained dutiful and performed here duties with in the parameter of Rules and Regulations and the allegations levelled against her are baseless as the appellant was suffering from ailment and was admitted in the Hospital therefor, without affording opportunity of personal hearing and cross examining the complainants, if any, as per E&D Rules, 2011.

In view of the above it is prayed that impugned dismissal from service order dated 01.07.2022 may graciously be ordered to be set aside and re-instate the appellant in service with effect from 01.07.2022.
