It was contended by the appellant that he was serving as Senior Clerk (BPS-9) in the office of Political Agent South Waziristan. It was further contended that he was most senior of Senior Clerks. It was further contended that in the year 2010 Departmental Promotion Committee was constituted for promotion from the post of Senior Clerk to the post of Assistant but he was ignored, nor promotion order from the post of Senior Clerk to the post of Assistant was issued by the respondent-department. It was further contended that the respondent-department was asked to issue copy of Departmental Promotion Committee and other record but the respondent-department was reluctant and in this regard he also submitted application on 16.10.2019 but the respondent-department refused to issue copy.
