The Appellant most respectfully submits as under:-

**BRIEF FACTS:**

1. That the appellant joined the police department as Driver/Constable vide appointment order No. 228 dated 18/10/2004 and performed his duties with great zeal and zest, in this respect the service record of appellant is evident.
2. That during the performance of his duties, the respondent#3 issued the impugned order No. OB-199 dated 19/03/2019 by the respondent#3 with the false and baseless allegations that one Rehmatullah son of Matiullah Marwat r/o District Tank had made a complaint against the appellant vide which Mr. Rehmatullah alleged that the appellant did not return the amount of loan of Rs. 50000/- to him. The respondent#3 vide impugned order ibid, awarded punishment of one year services forfeiture and is warned to remain careful in future and avoid relations with Anti State Elements. Copy of

- e) That counsel for the appellant may graciously be allowed to raise additional grounds at the time of arguments.

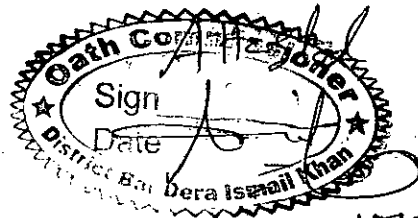

5. That this honourable court has got vast and ample powers to entertain the application in hand.


