Counsel for the appellant Mst. Robina Riaz present. Preliminary arguments heard. It was contended by learned counsel for the appellant that the appellant is serving in Social Welfare Department as Deputy Director. It was further contended that the appellant was imposed major penalty of reduction to the lower post for three years and recovery of amount Rs. 772975/- vide order dated 27.09.2018 on the allegation of misuse of financial power and negligence on her part. The appellant filed departmental appeal/review petition on 10.10.2018 which was partially accepted and the major penalty of reduction to the lower post for three years and recovery of amount Rs. 772975/- was modified into withholding of two increments vide order dated 15.02.2019 thereafter, the appellant filed service appeal. It was further contended that neither proper inquiry was conducted nor appellant was associated in the inquiry proceeding nor opportunity of personal hearing and defence was provided to the appellant therefore, the appellant was condemned unheard. It was further contended that the departmental authority was required to mention specific period of withholding of two increments but the respondent/department has not mentioned any specific period under FR-29 therefore, the impugned order is illegal and liable to be set-aside.

The contention raised by the learned counsel for the appellant needs consideration. The appeal is admitted for regular hearing subject to all legal objections. The appellant is directed to deposit security and process fee within 10 days, thereafter, notice be issued to the respondents for written reply/comments for 24.06.2019 before S.B.






