The appellant has filed this appeal against the impugned refusal order of the respondents for not promoting the appellant from the post of Tehsil Accountant (BPS-08) to the post of District Revenue Accountant (BPS-14).</p> <p>03. Appellant submitted that he, being senior on the seniority list of the Tehsil Accountants, office of the Deputy Commissioner, Dir Lower, was entitled to be promoted to the post of District Revenue Accountant in District Malakand, where the vacancy was available. When asked about any original or appellate order from which the appellant was aggrieved, he referred to his application made to the Commissioner, Malakand Division, wherein he had himself offered for the desired promotion and had stated at the bar that since he was senior, so he ought to have been consider for the promotion. There is no original or appellate order enabling the appellant to file this appeal before this Tribunal. Therefore, this appeal seems to be premature and is dismissed in limine. Consign.</p>
