After arguing the matter at length, learned counsel for the appellant submitted that the appellant had to first get her seniority determined from the authority under Section-8 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Civil Servants Act, 1973 read with Rule 17 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1989, which, the learned counsel for the appellant submits, has not been determined by the authority till date. For the purpose he wants to make an application to the department, which the department has to consider in accordance with law. As regards this appeal, he does not press it for the time being and submits that he would re-agitate the seniority list if not legally fixed by the department. Disposed of accordingly. Consign.
