Clerk of learned counsel for the appellant present. Mr. Kabirullah Khattak, Additional Advocate General alongwith Mr. Ihsan Ullah, Litigation Officer for the respondents present.

Learned Additional Advocate General stated at the Bar that the instant execution petition is related to Higher Education Department and not to the Elementary & Secondary Education Department against which punitive action has so far been initiated. He further stated; this fact has previously been brought into the notice of Bench as well as into the notice of the office of Registrar in a formal way. Today, copy of the correspondence dated 19.07.2022 was produced before the Bench. Similarly, a copy of the minutes of meeting dated 08.11.2022 was also produced whereby financial implication on account of payment of arrears to the petitioner w.e.f 04.02.2009 to 19.03.2018 is to be worked out and submitted to the Finance Department by the Higher Education Department, for their sanction/approval. In pursuance of the minutes of the said meeting, the Directorate of Higher Education has worked out Rs 1130230/- as arrears to be paid to the petitioner. All these documents be placed on court file. At the end of the day, learned Additional Advocate General requested for adjournment to gain some time for submission of final implementation report on the next date. Request is acceded to as a last chance being an old execution petition seeking implementation of the judgement of Service Tribunal dated 02.11.2017. To come up for final implementation report on 13.12.2022.
