The case of the appellant is that he was appointed on 10.03.2011 as Trade Instructor and at present is working as Junior Instructor (BPS-15). Ever-since, different seniority lists were maintained by the respondents in respect of degree holder Junior Instructors and diploma holder Junior Instructors separately. In the former the position of appellant was maintained at S.No. 1, as reflected in seniority list pertaining to the years 2016 and 2017. However, in the impugned seniority list issued on 24.05.2019, the seniority of all the Junior Instructors was combined and re-fixed, wherein, the name of appellant was dropped to S.No. 42, much below the Junior Instructors holding diploma and appointed prior to the appellant. His appeal to the department filed on or before 27.05.2019 was also not responded to.
