Mr. Muhammad Arshad Khan Tanoli, Advocate, for the appellant present. Preliminary arguments heard.

Learned counsel for the appellant has contended that no regular inquiry was conducted in the matter and major penalty of dismissal from service was awarded to the appellant without complying the mandatory provisions of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2011; that the marriage of the appellant was solemnized on 17.10.2021, however she was divorced on 14.12.2021, resulting in severe sock and depression to the appellant; that the appellant's mother submitted an application to the competent Authority for seeking leave but the same was not granted and she was transferred from one court to another as well as to record room Session court for scanning of files; that the appellant was awarded impugned major penalty of dismissal from service on 01.07.2022, which was challenged by the appellant through filing of departmental appeal on 16.07.2022, however the same was not responded within the statutory period; that the appellant was not provided an opportunity of personal hearing and she was condemned unheard.

Points raised need consideration, therefore, the appeal in hand is admitted to regular hearing subject to all legal and valid objections. The appellant is directed to deposit security and process fee within 10 days. Out district respondents be summoned through TCS, the expenses of which be deposited by the appellant within three days. To come up for submission of written reply/comments on 14.12.2022 before the S.B at Camp Court Abbottabad.
